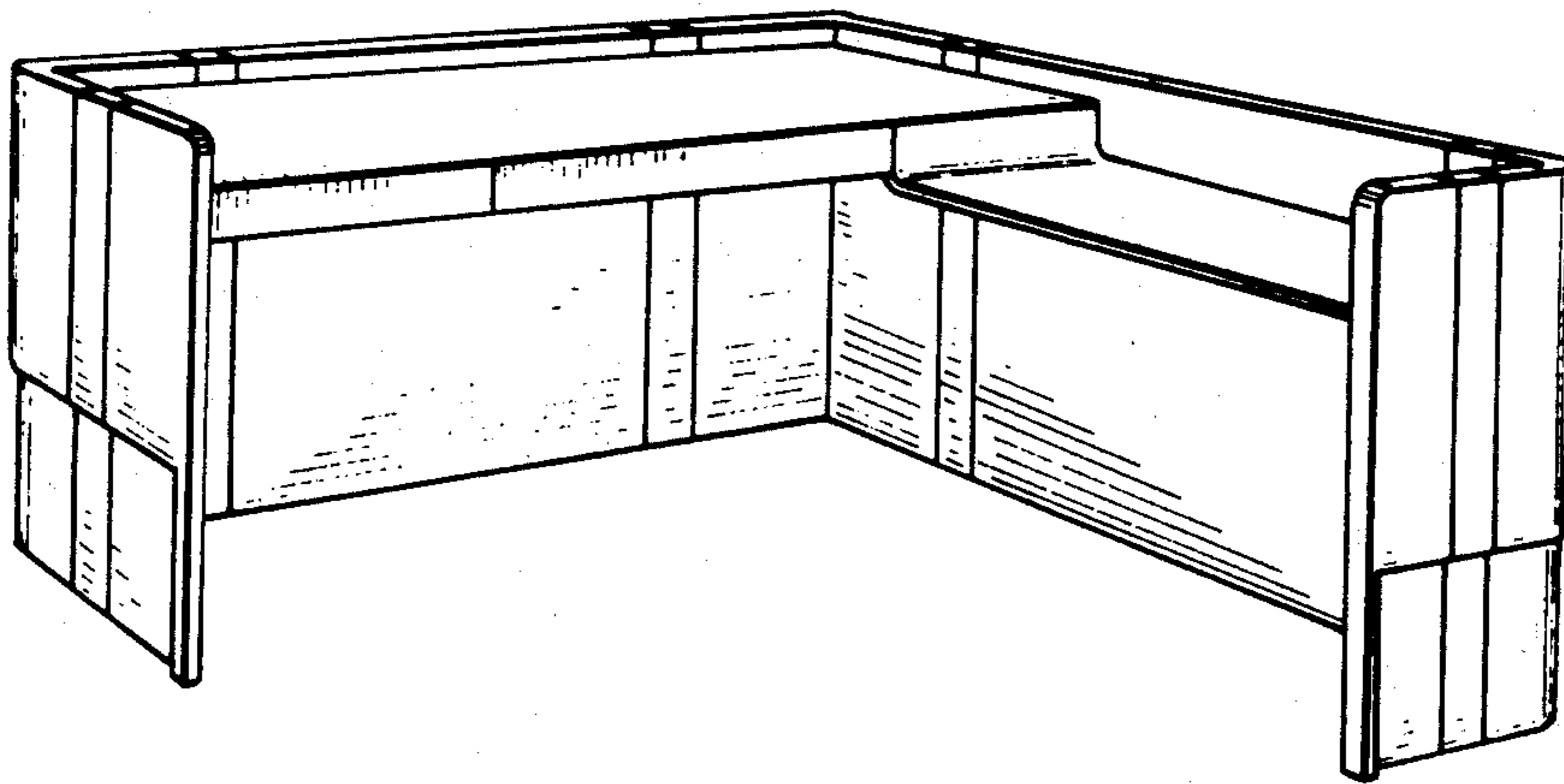

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a desk showing our design; and
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the desk of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the desk shown in FIGS. 1 and 2; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the desk shown in FIG. 4.



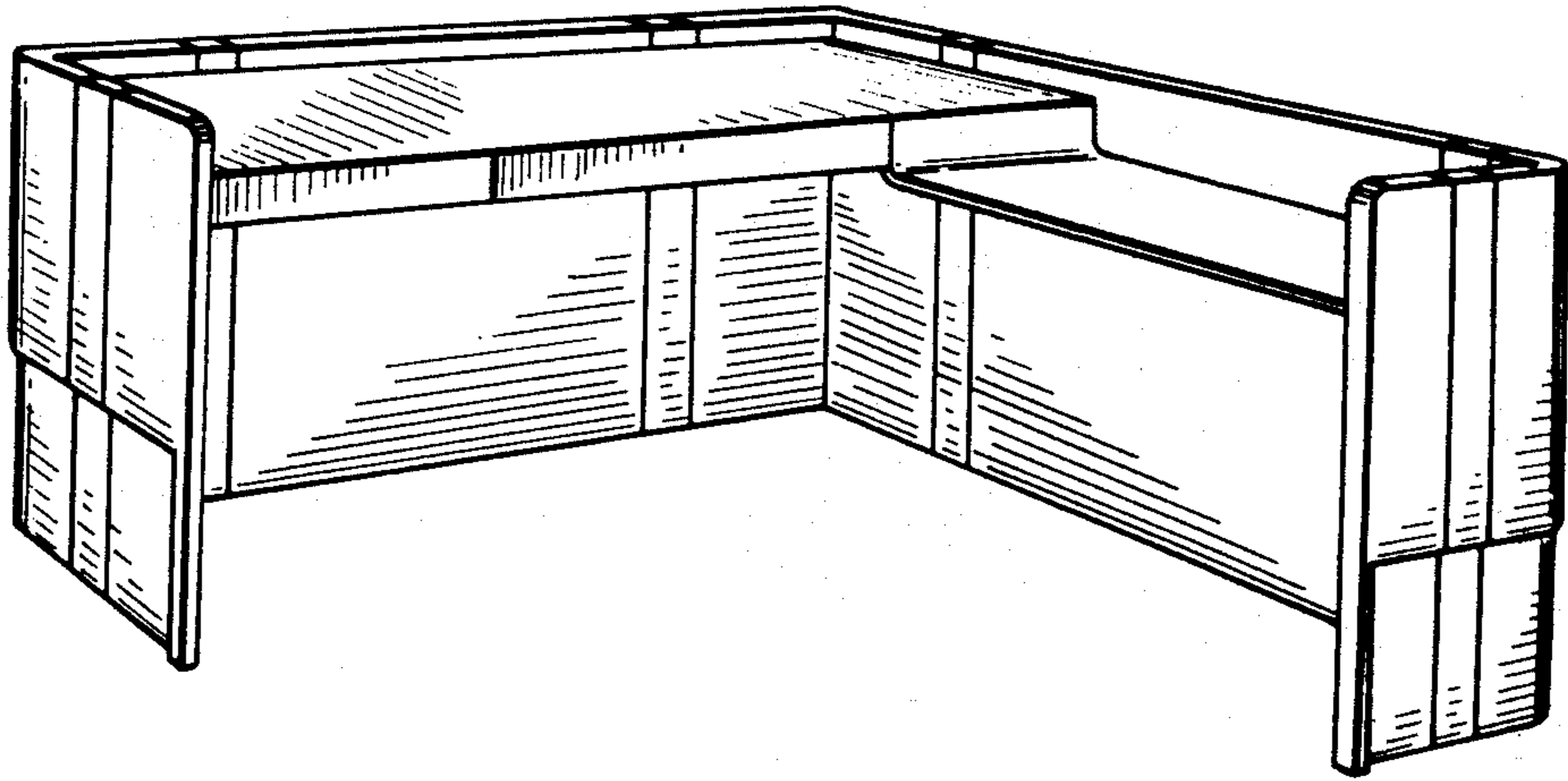

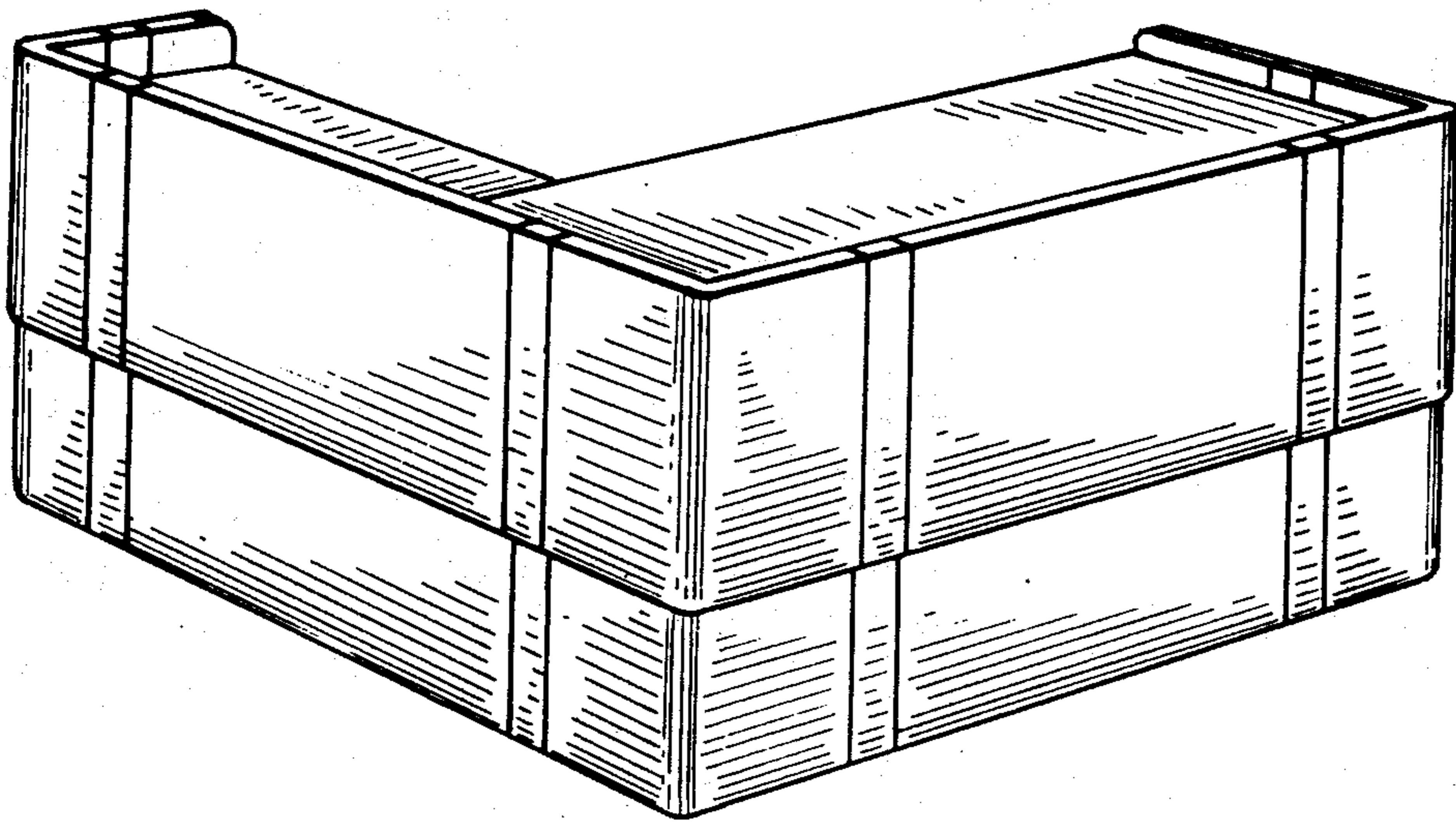

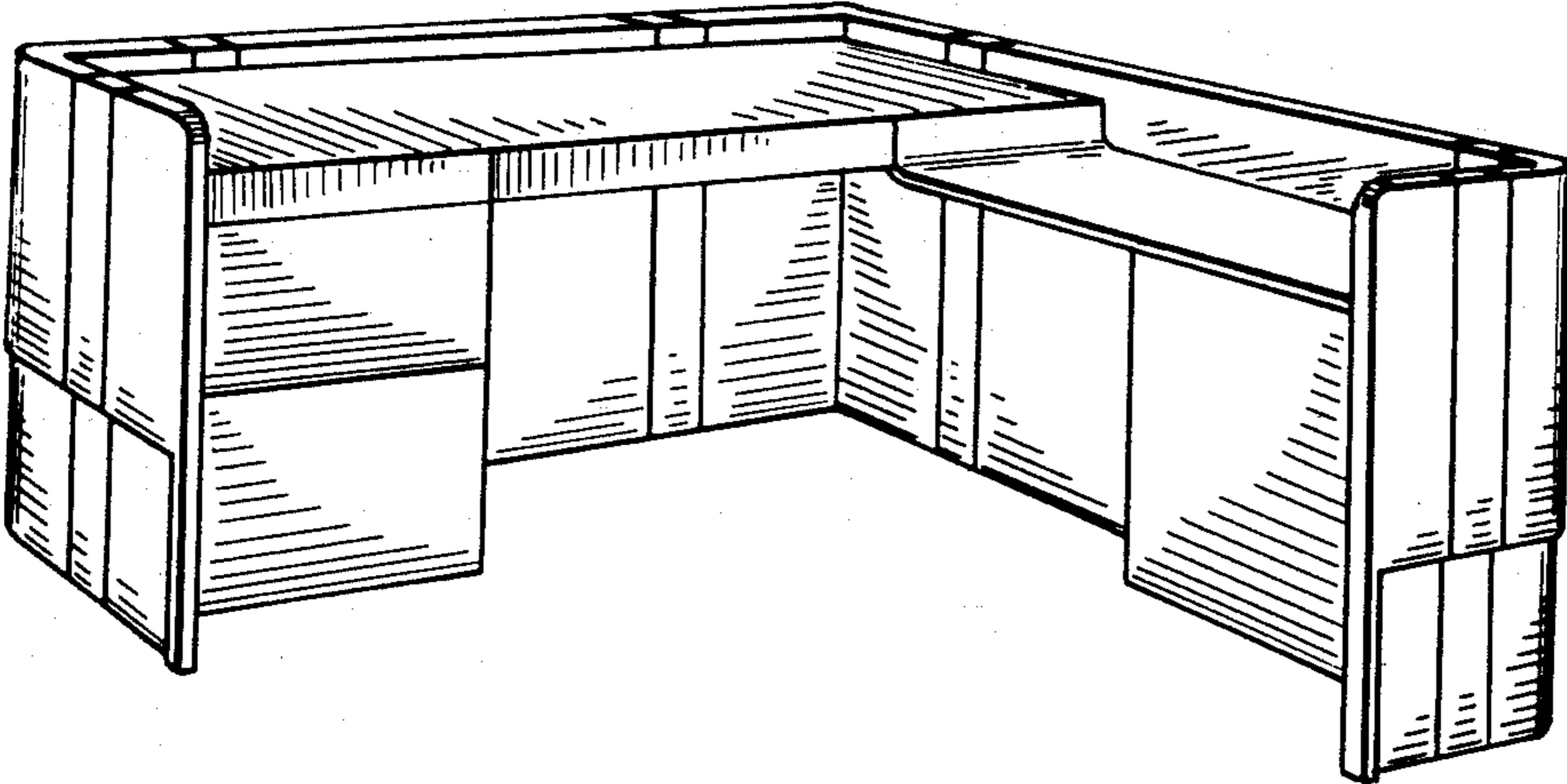

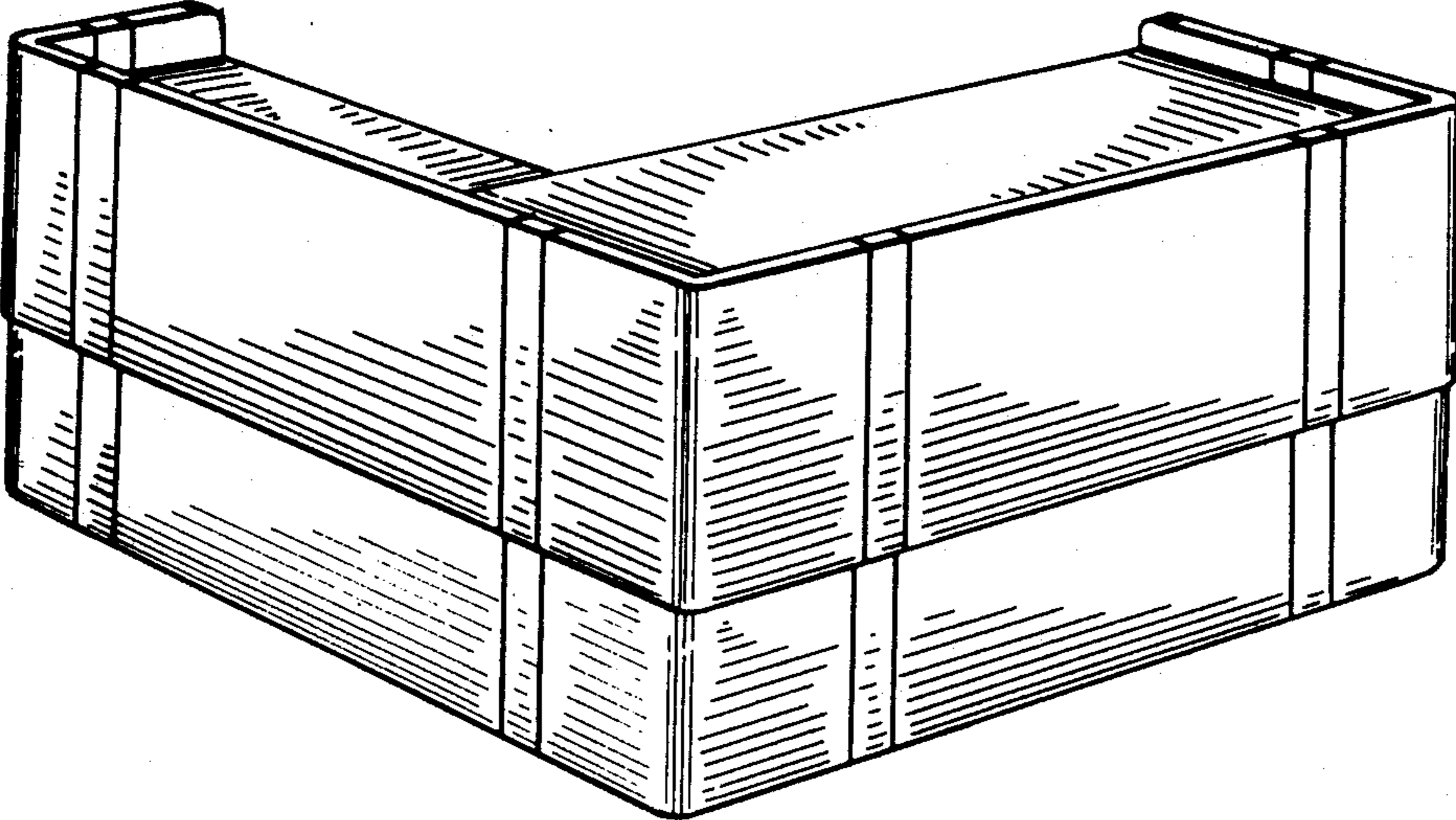

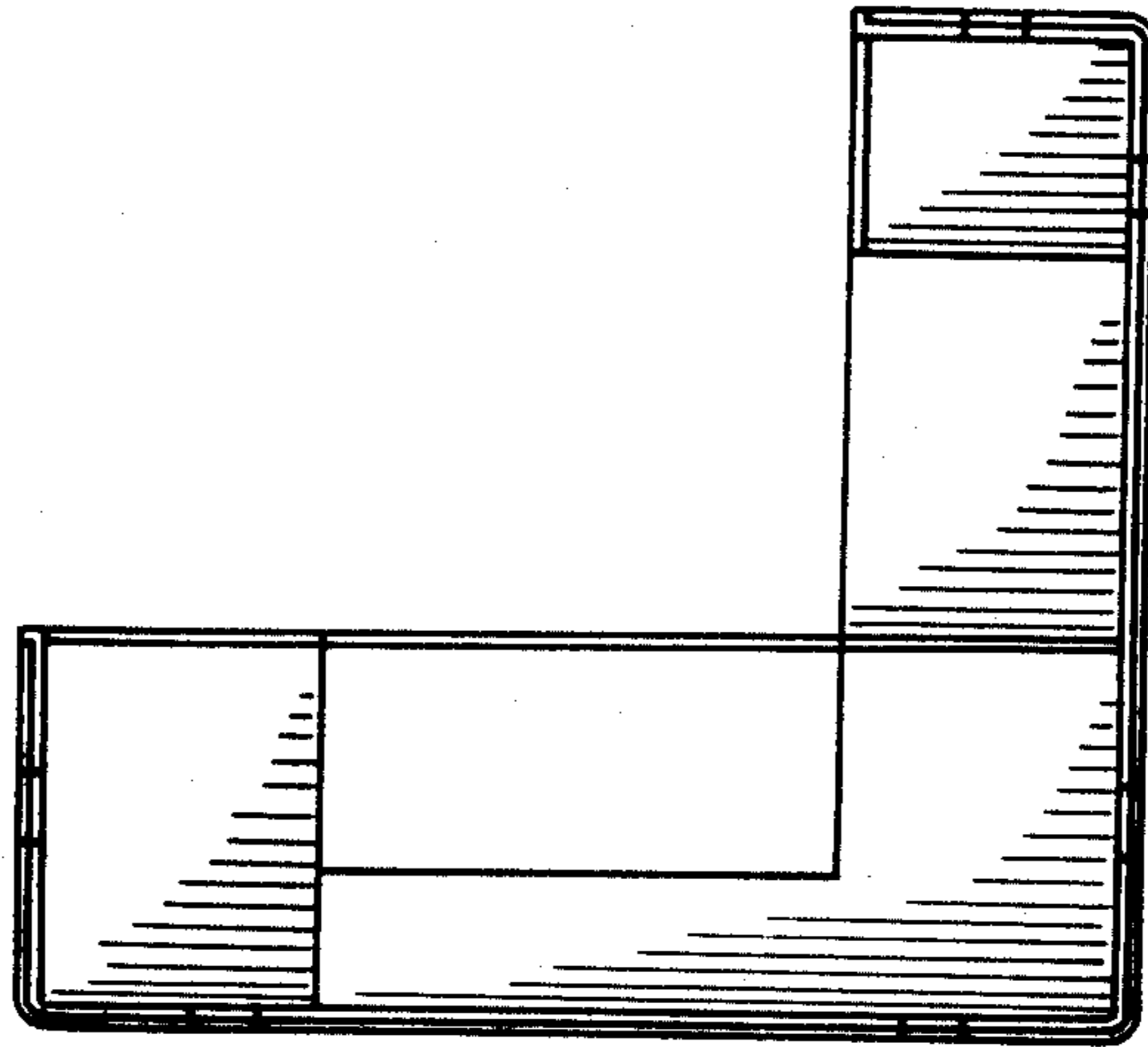

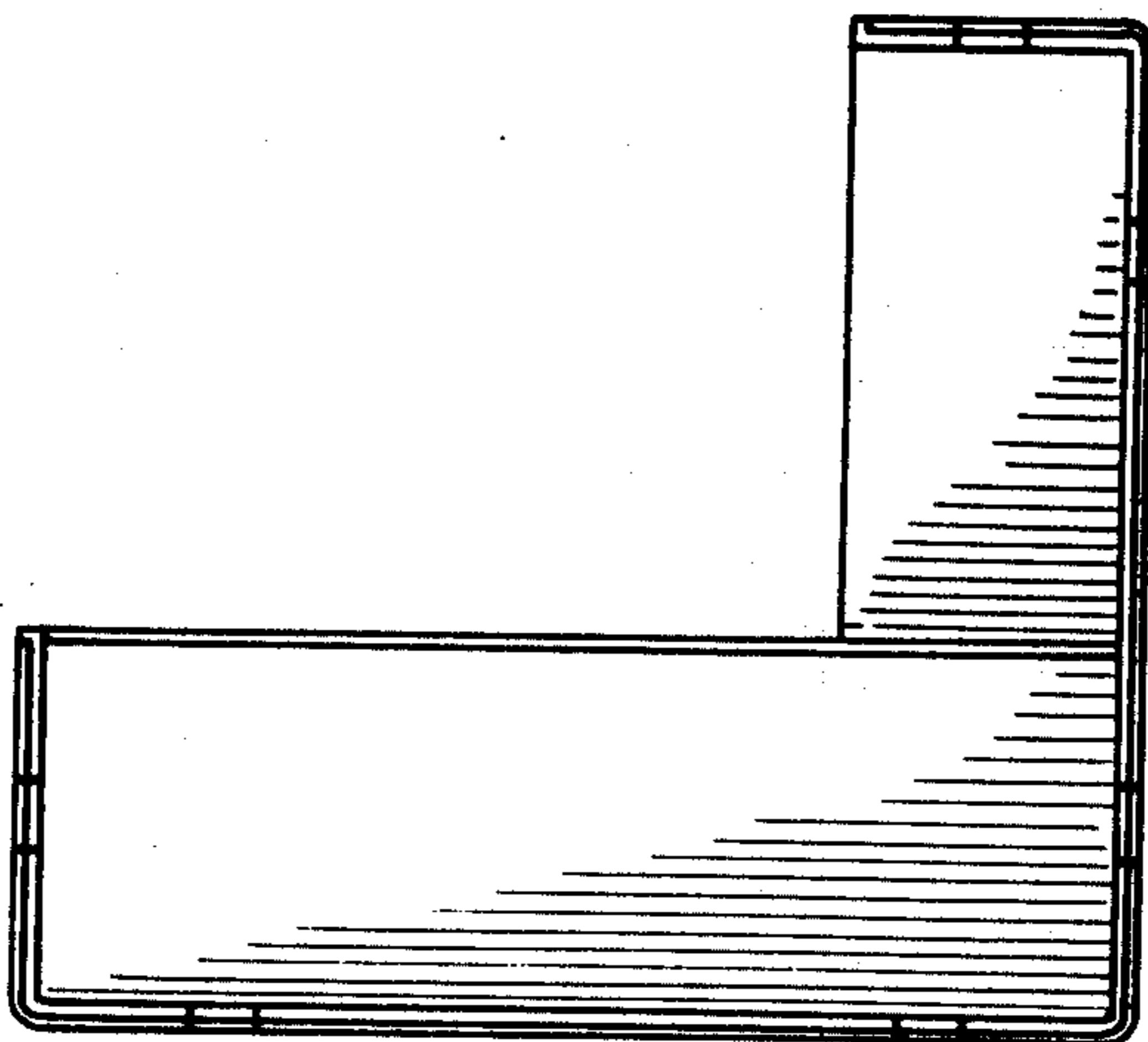
