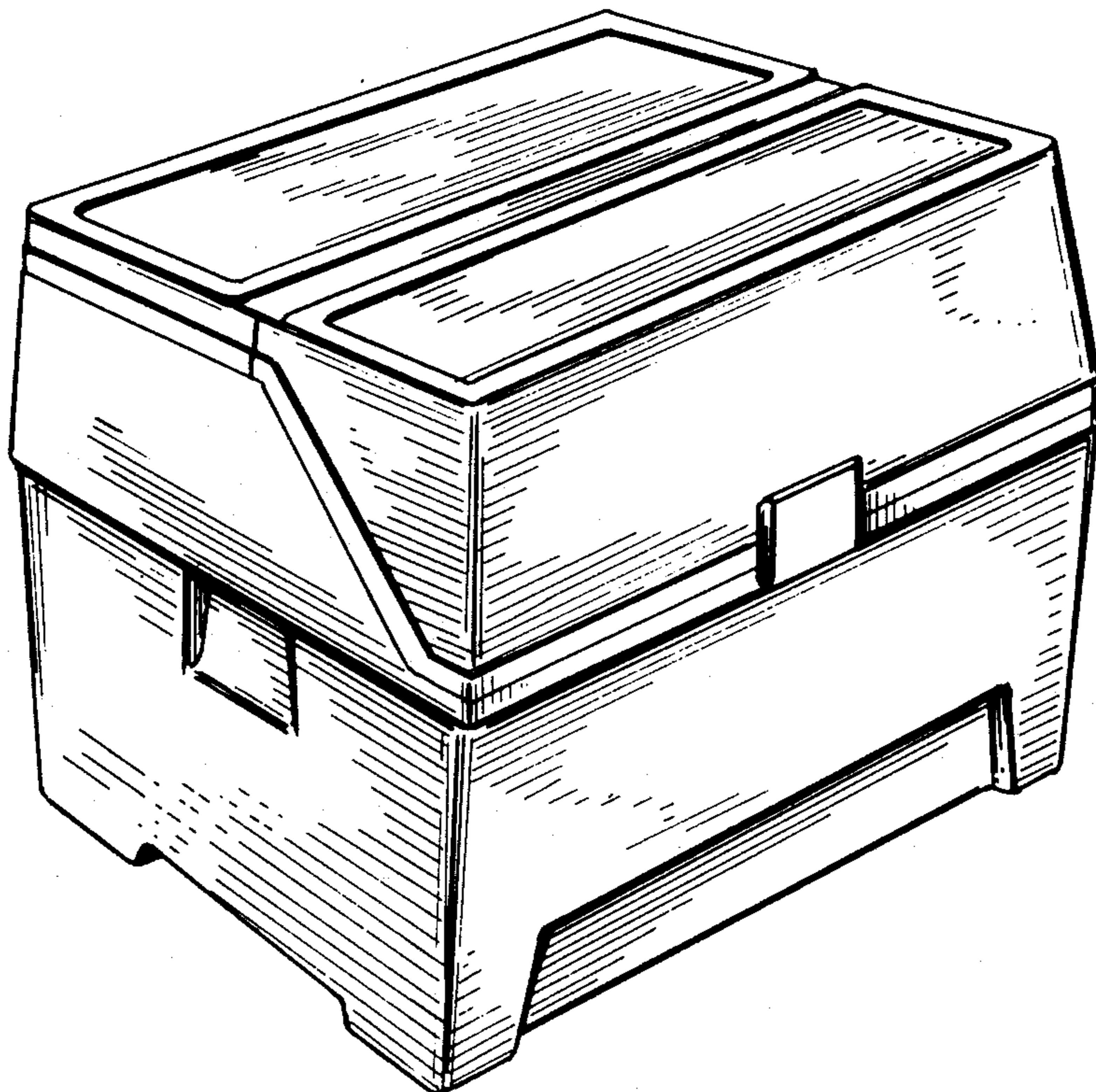

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a portable insulated food chest or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a portable insulated food chest or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; FIGS. 3, 4 and 5 are respectively front, side and rear elevational views thereof on an enlarged scale; The bottom is plane and unornamented.



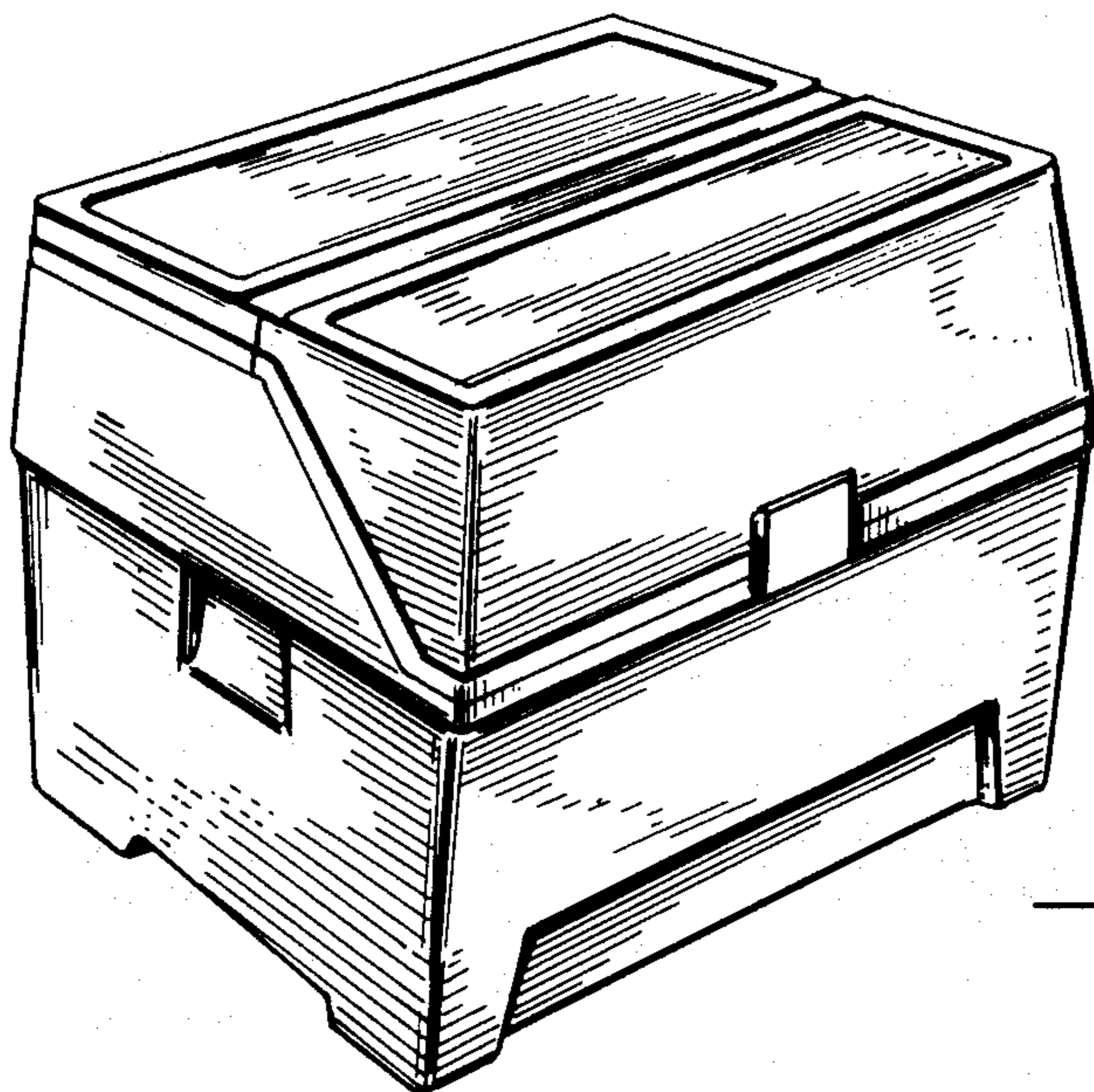

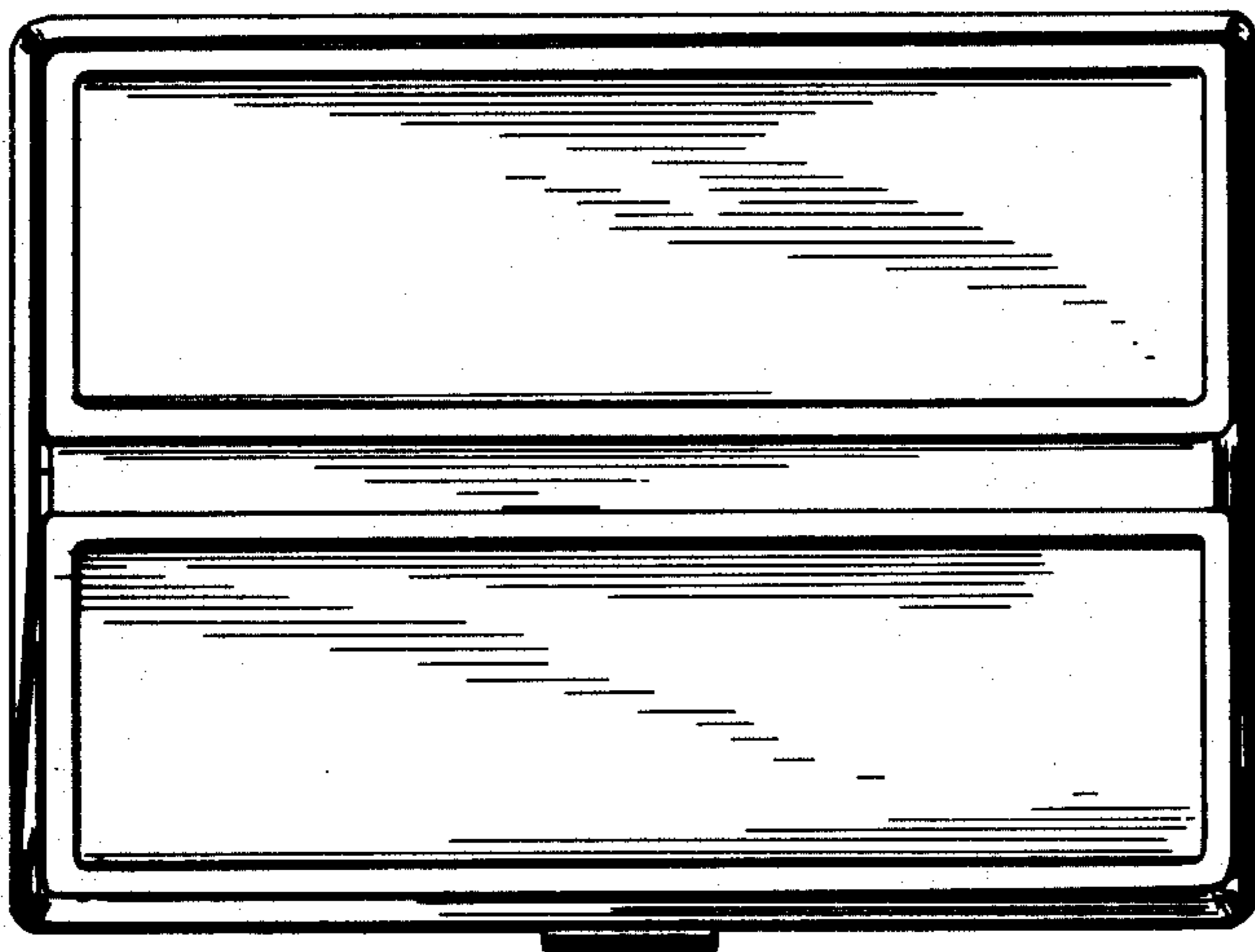

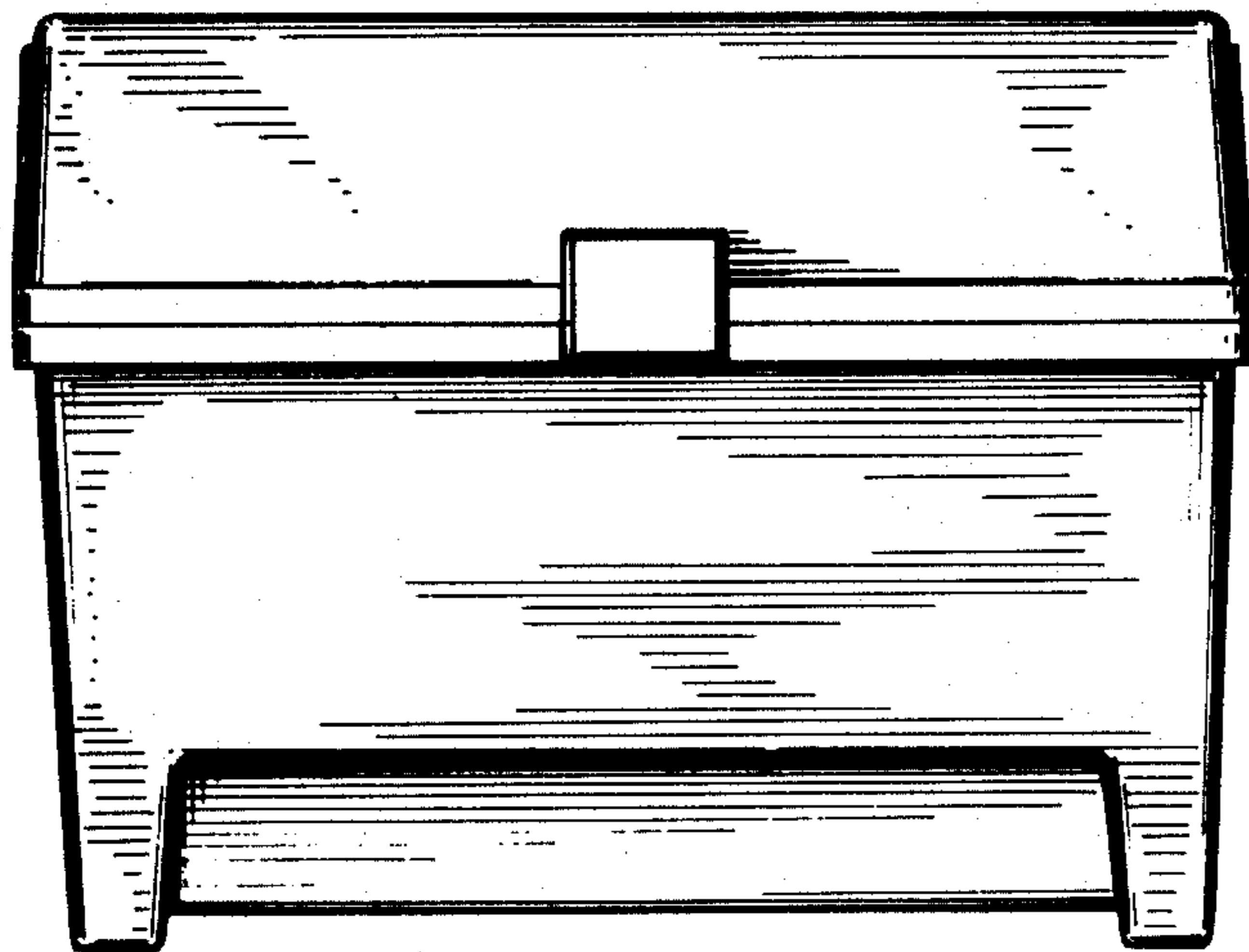

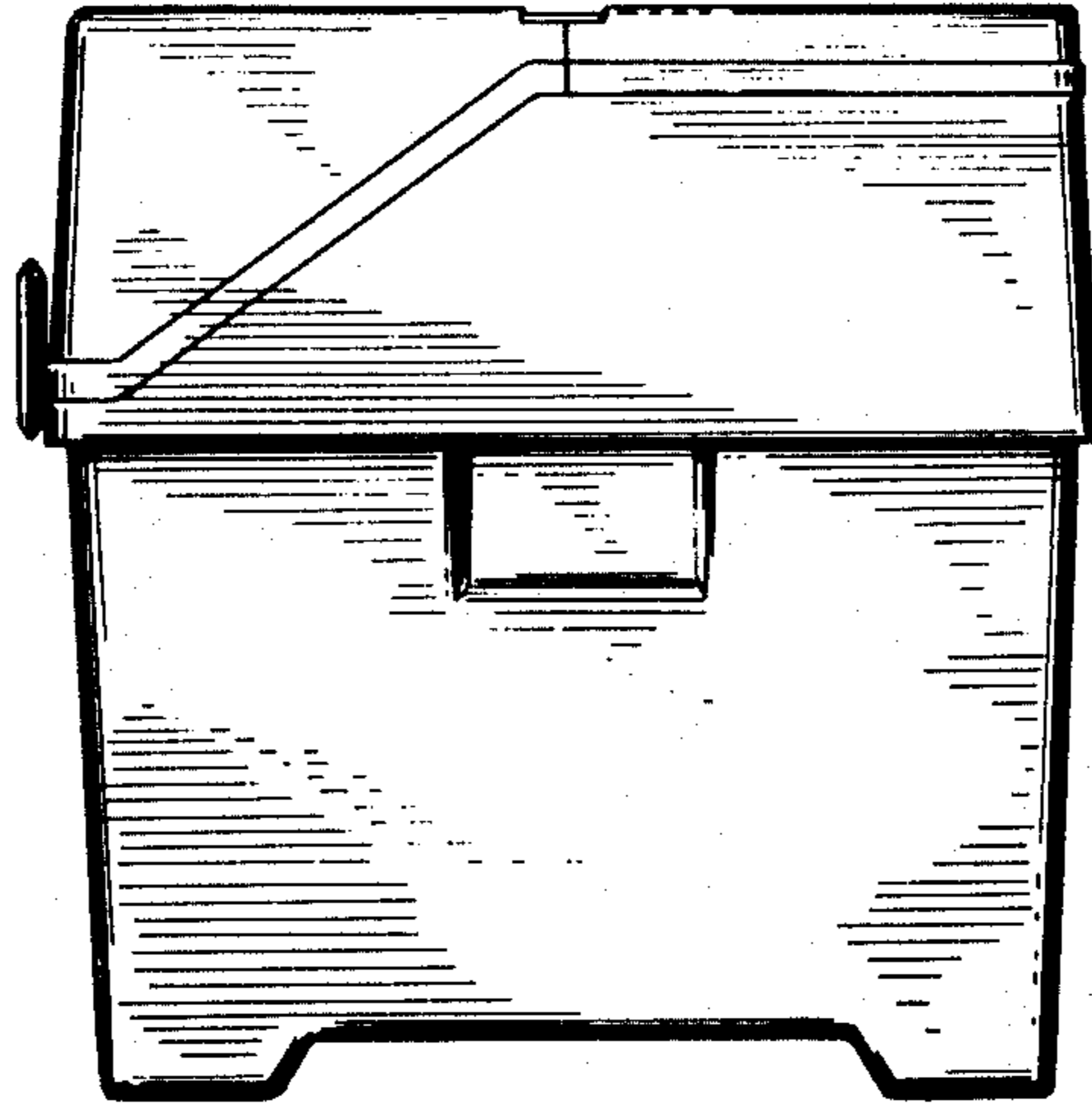

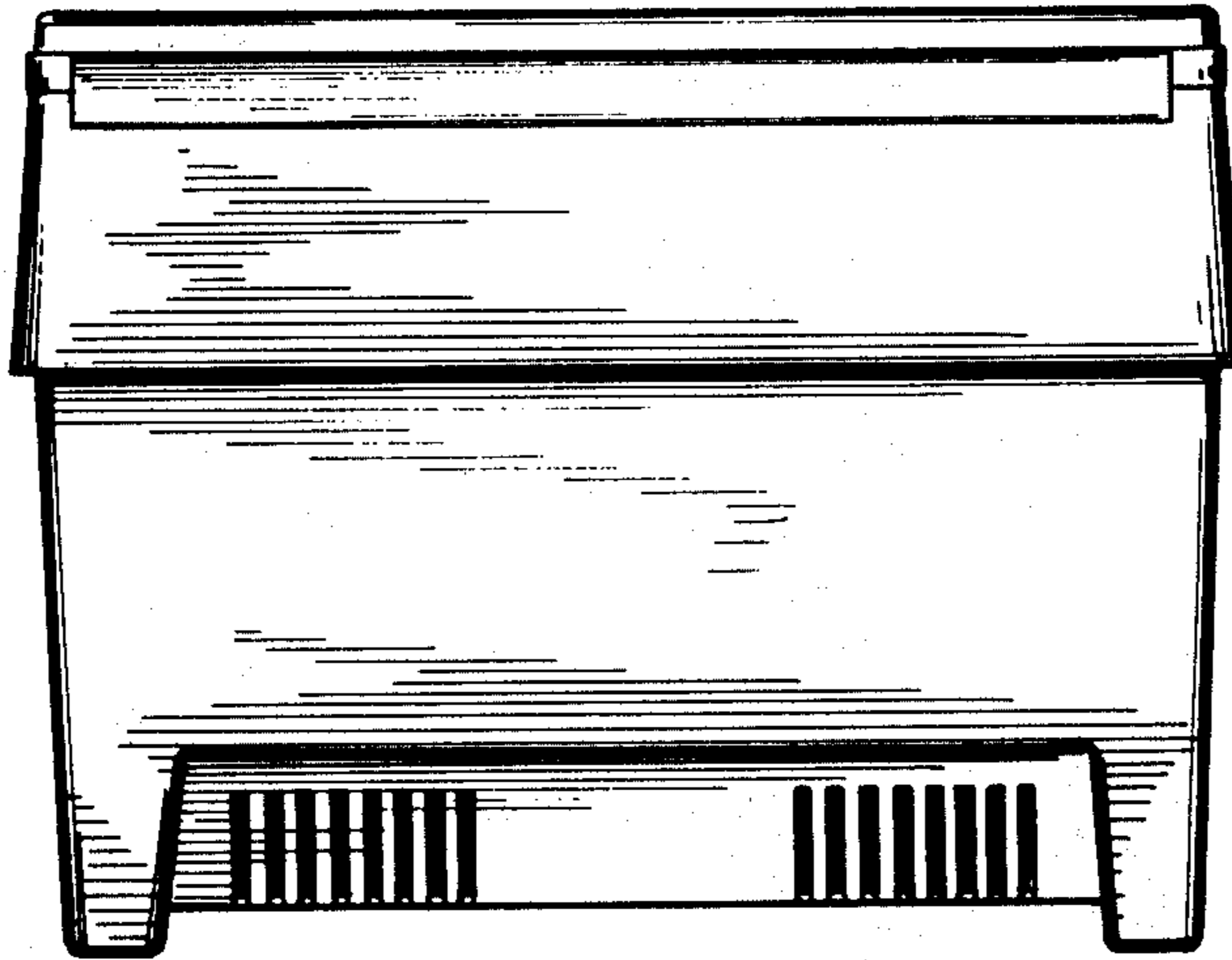
