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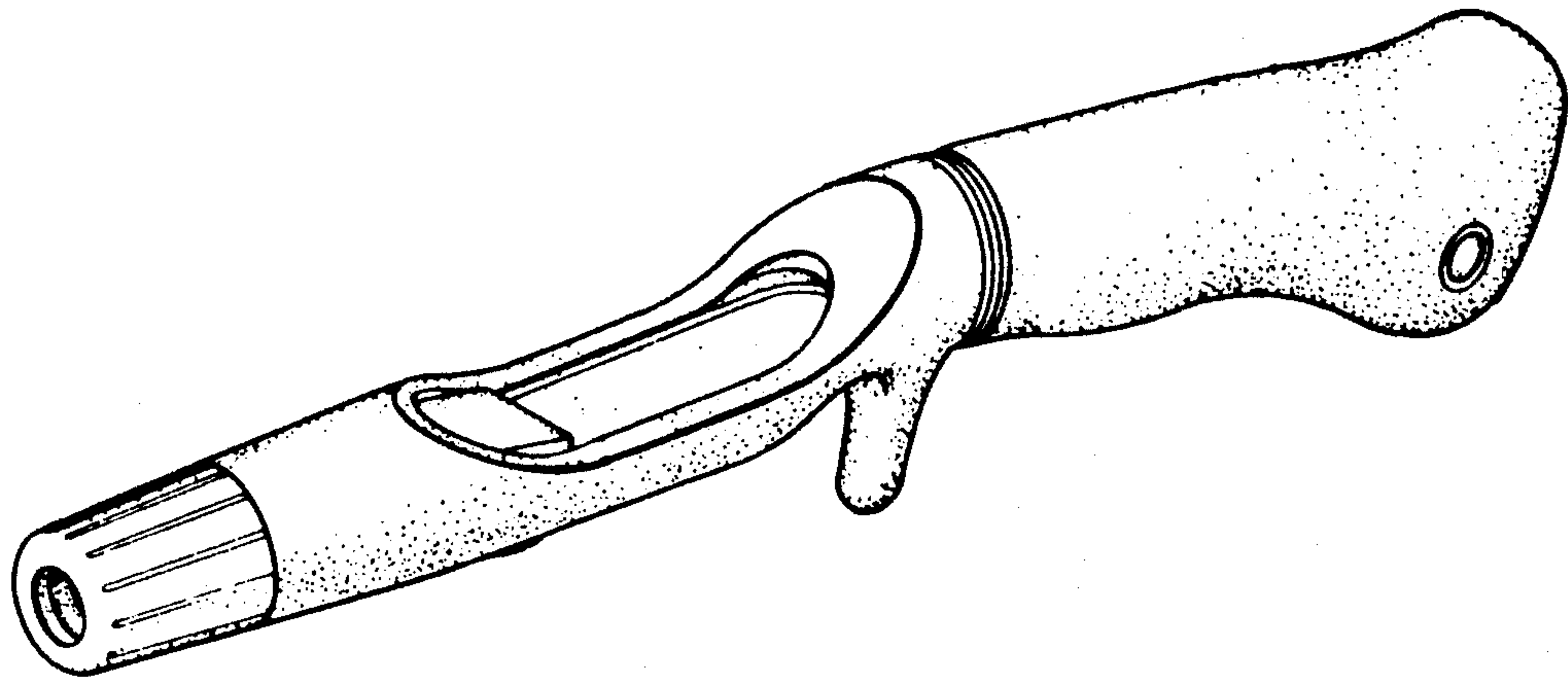

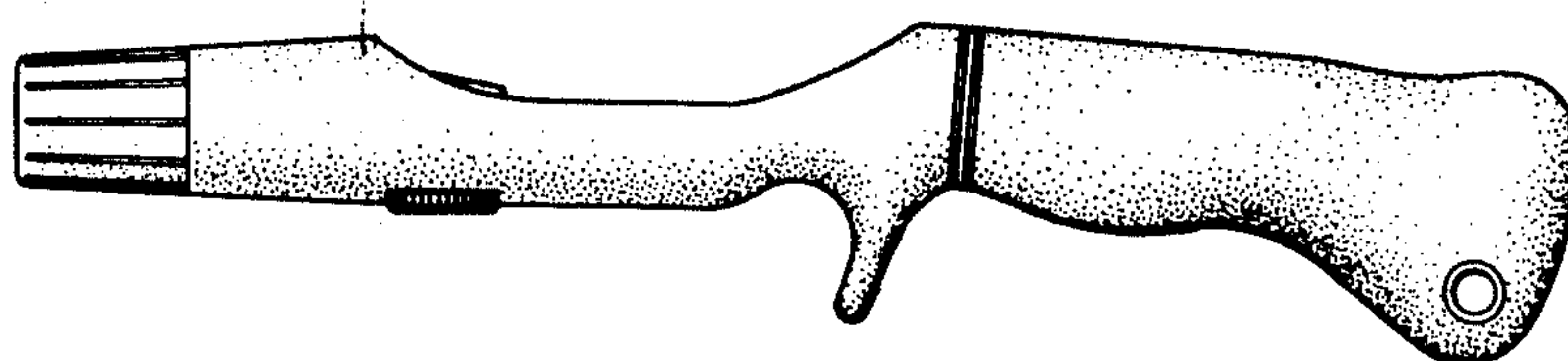
The ornamental design for a handle for fishing rod assembly, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

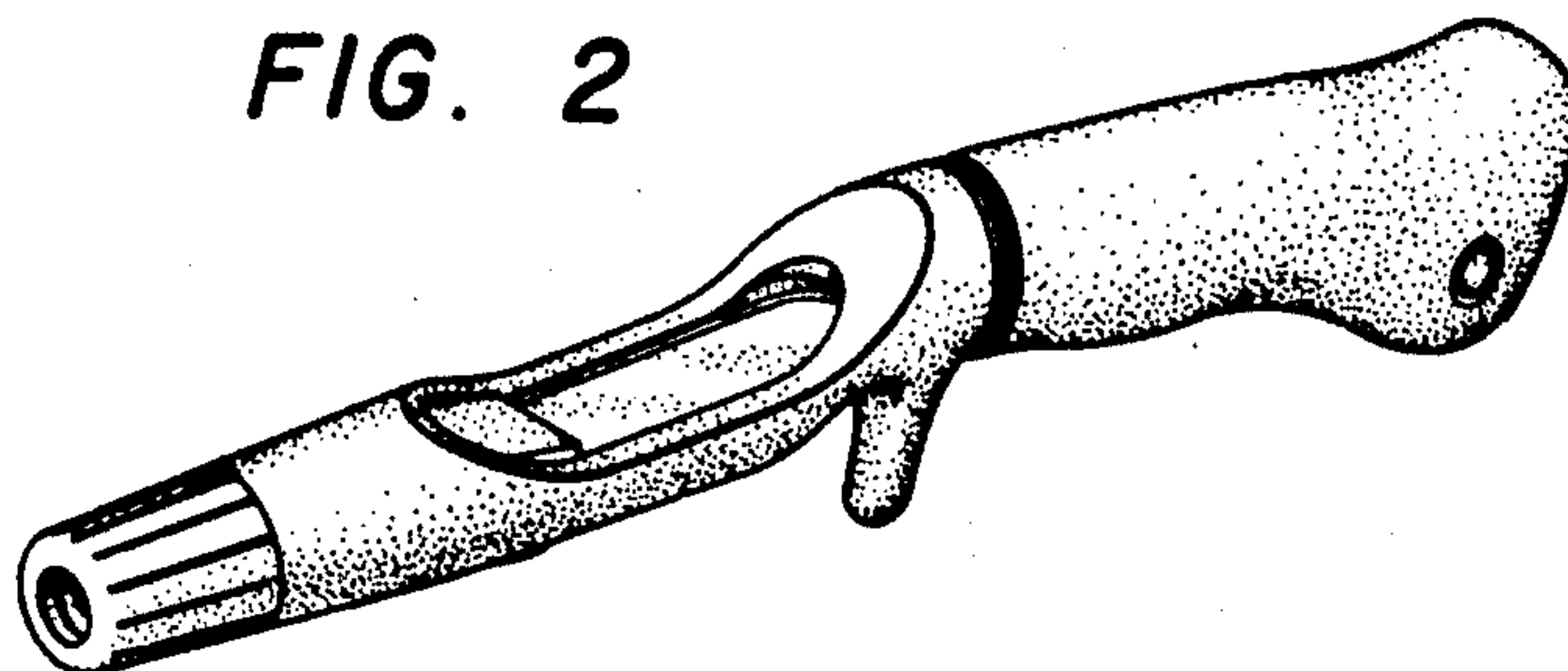
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of one side of a handle for fishing rod assembly embodying my new design;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view.



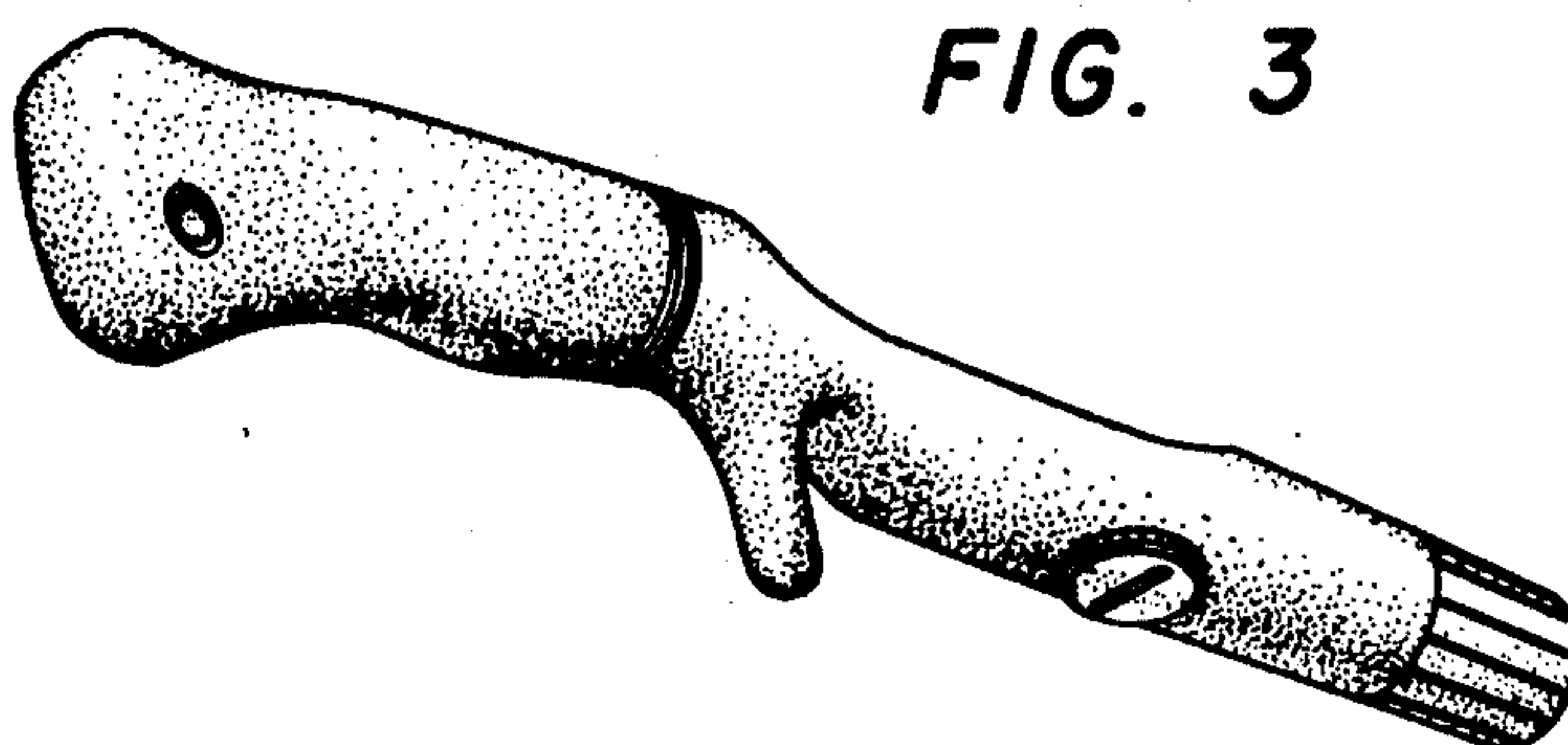
