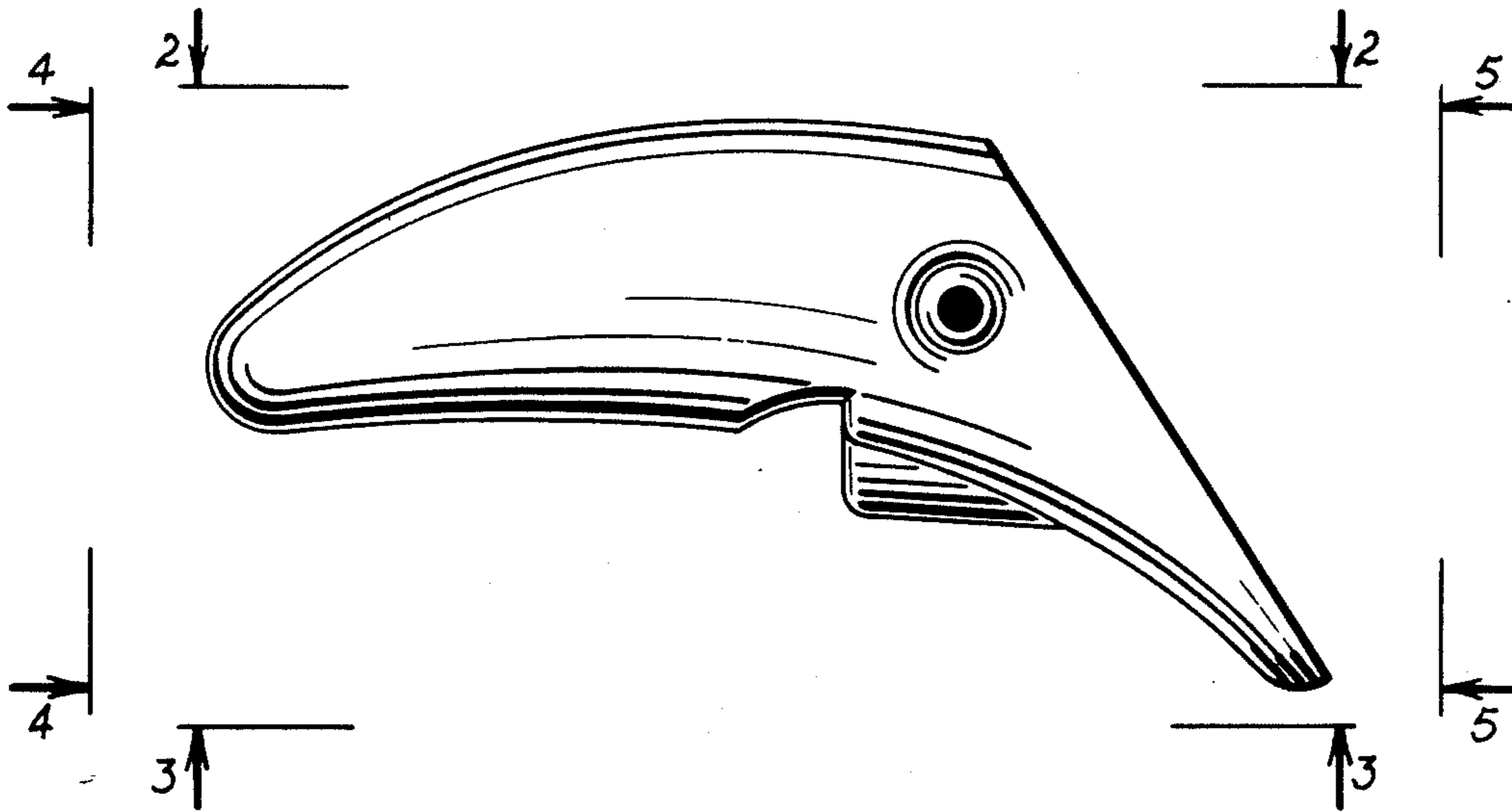

The ornamental design of a fishing plug, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fishing plug showing my new design, the opposite side of the design being identical to the side shown;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view taken on the line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is an end view taken on the line 4—4 of FIG. 1;

 FIG. 5 is an end view taken on the line 5—5 of FIG. 1.



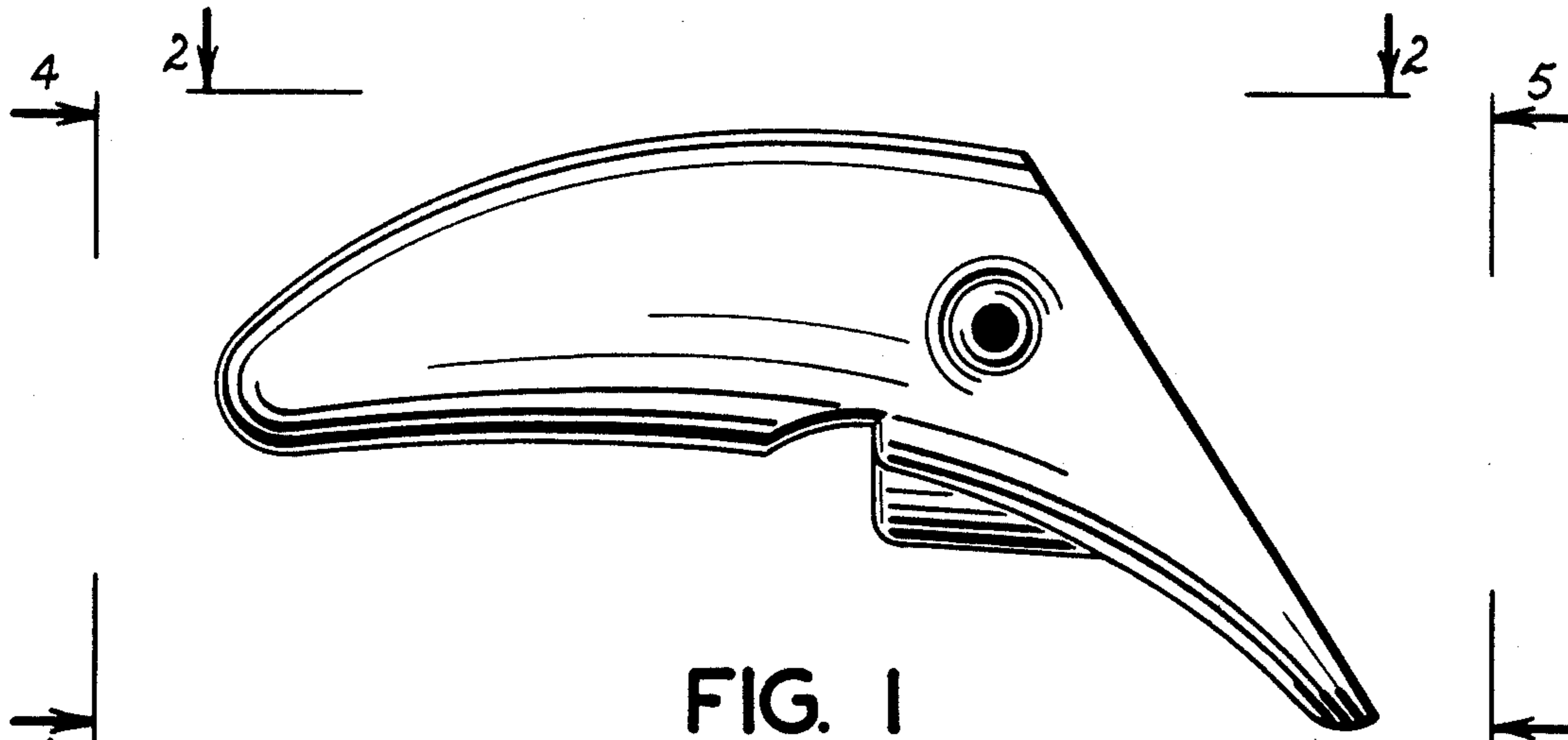

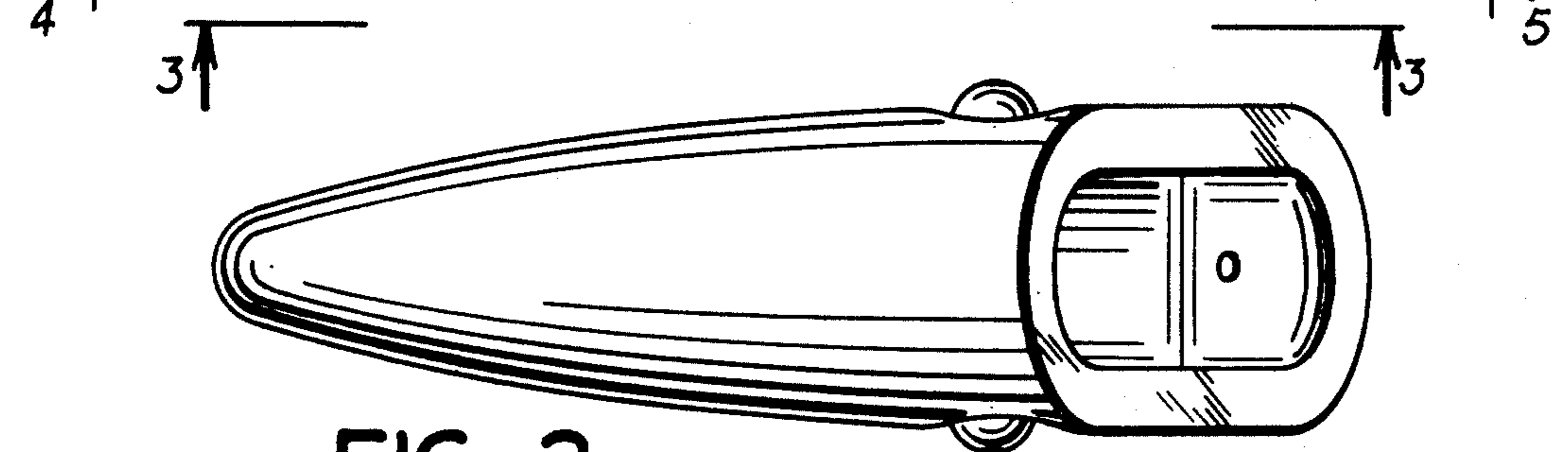

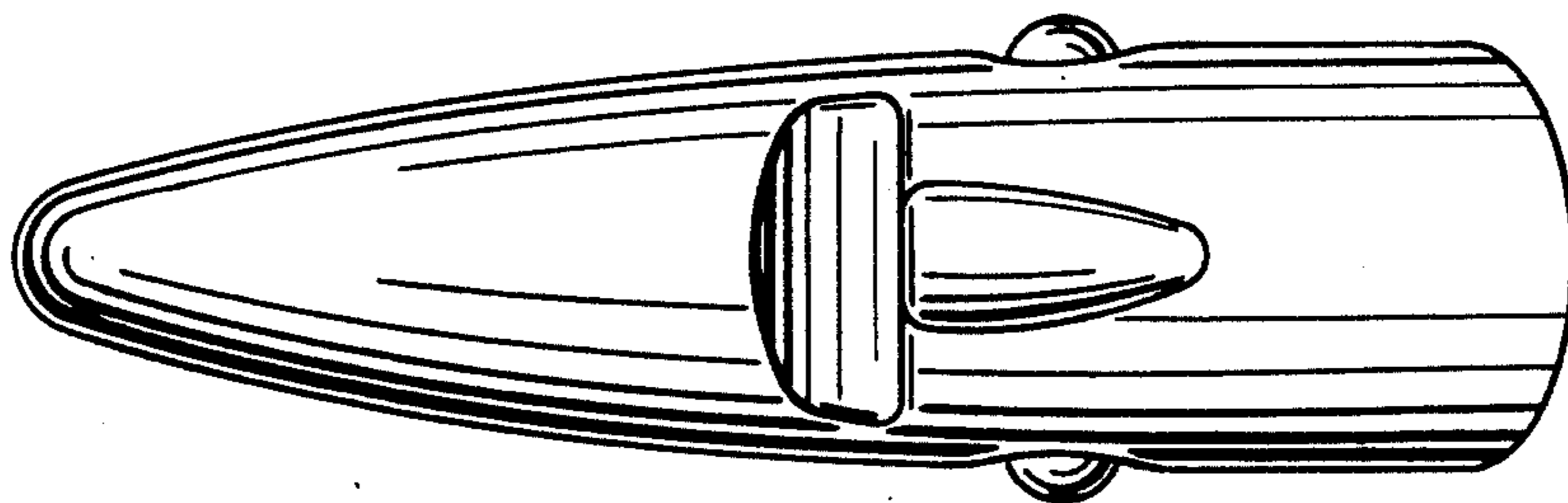

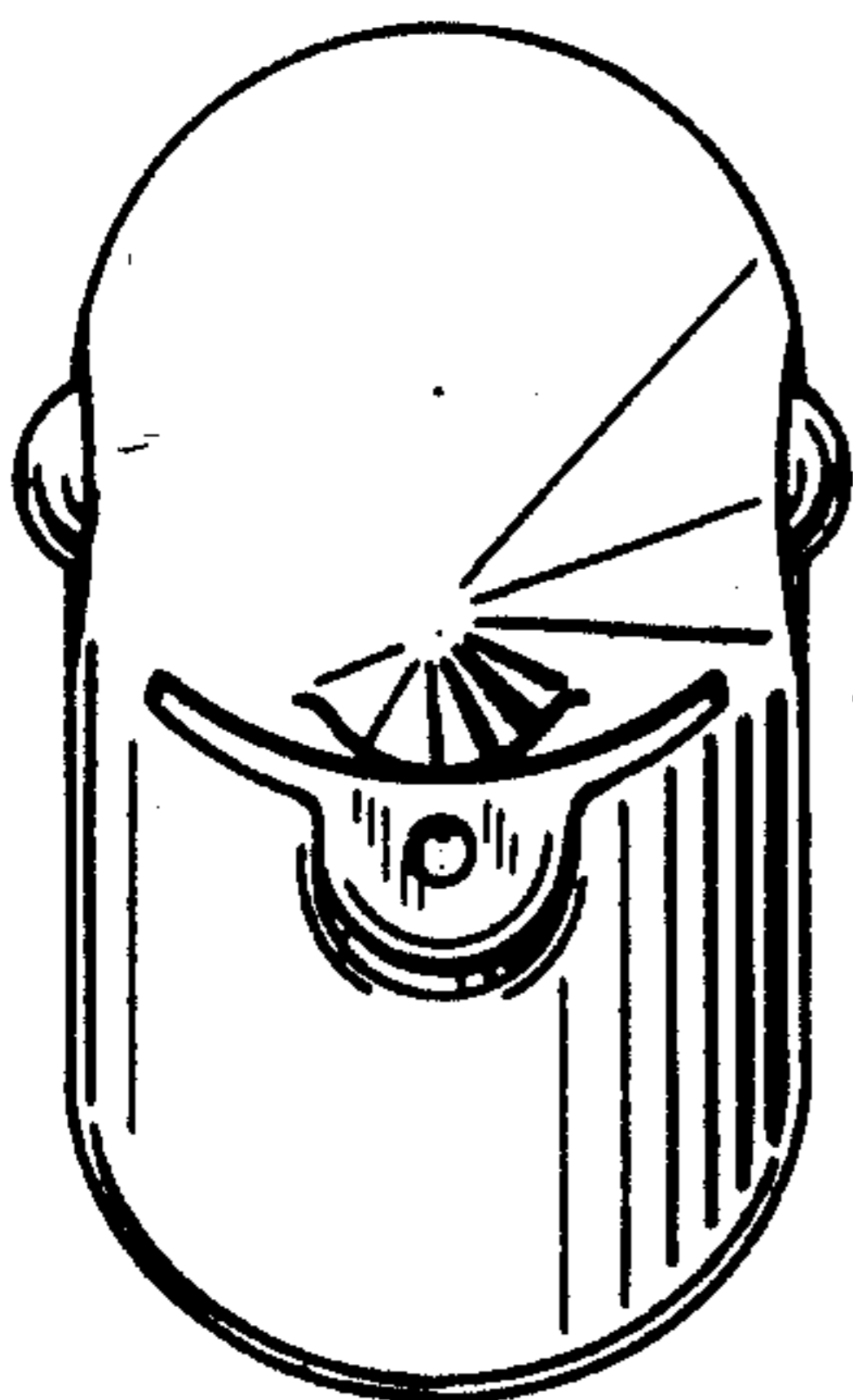

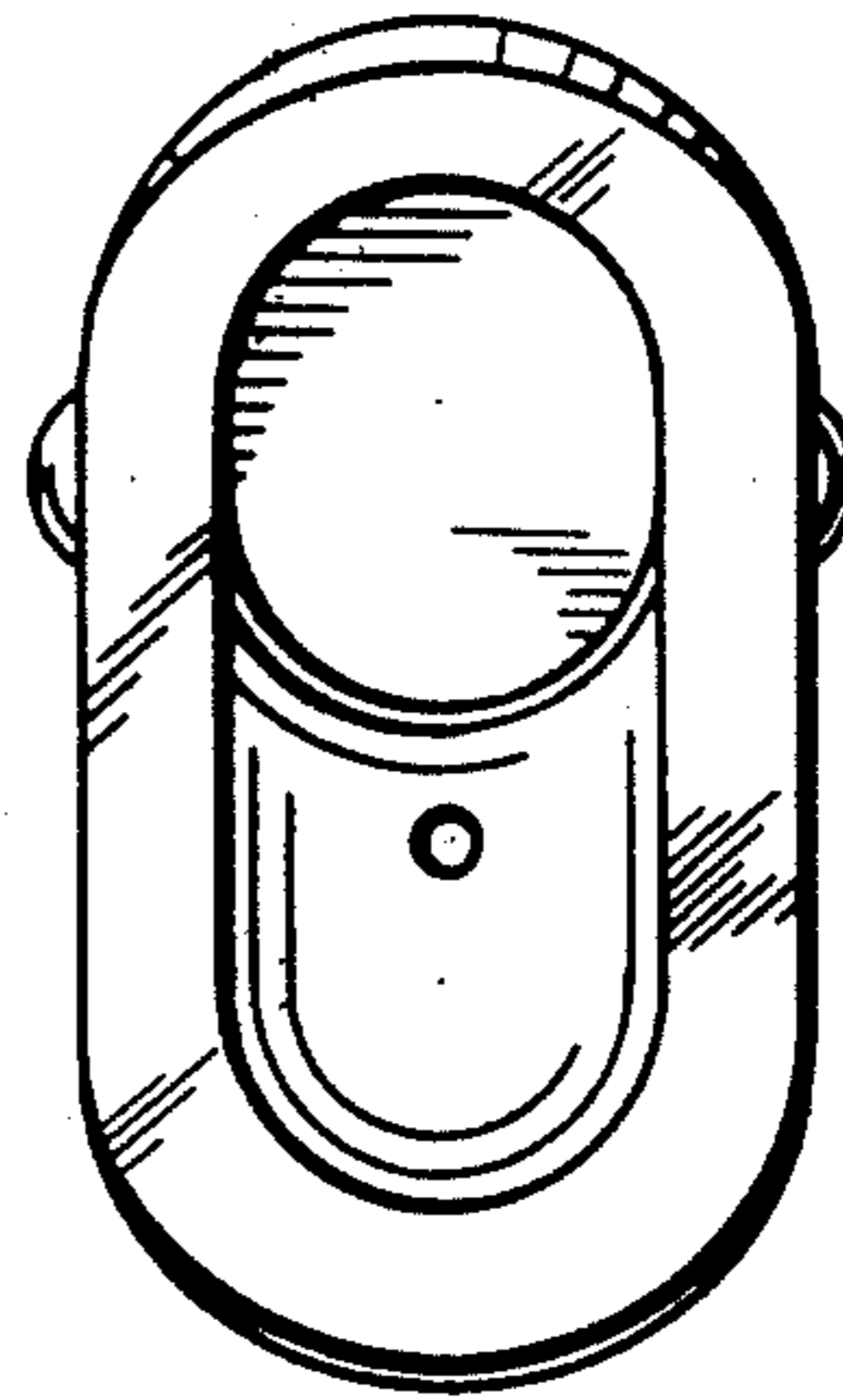
