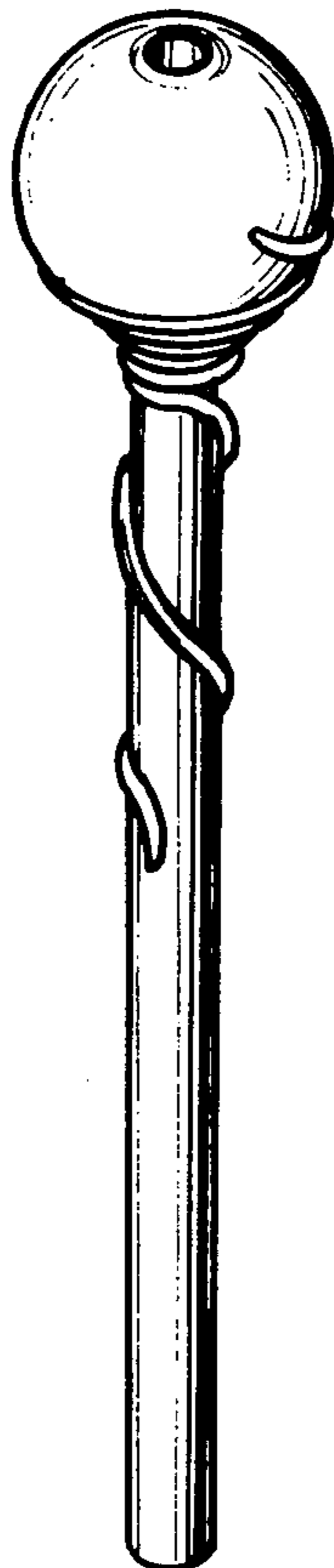

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an inhaler, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 3.



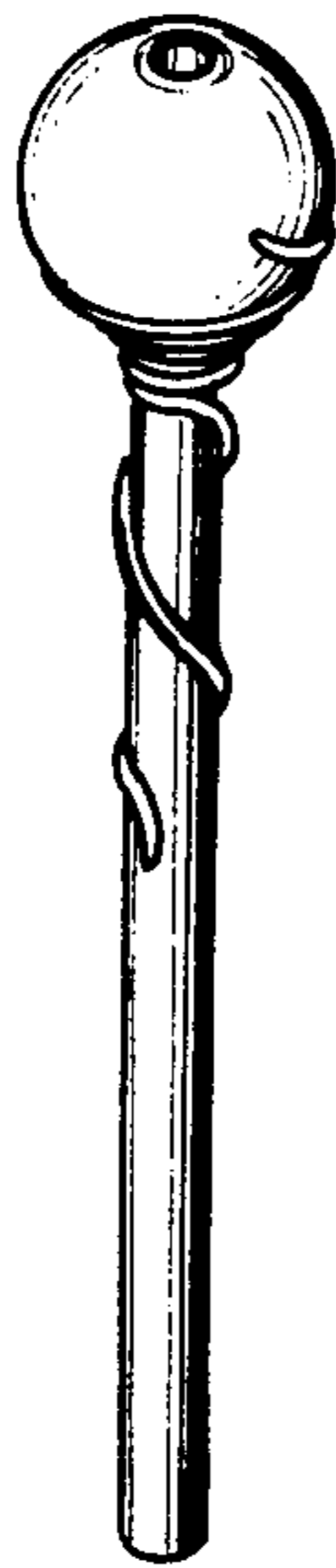

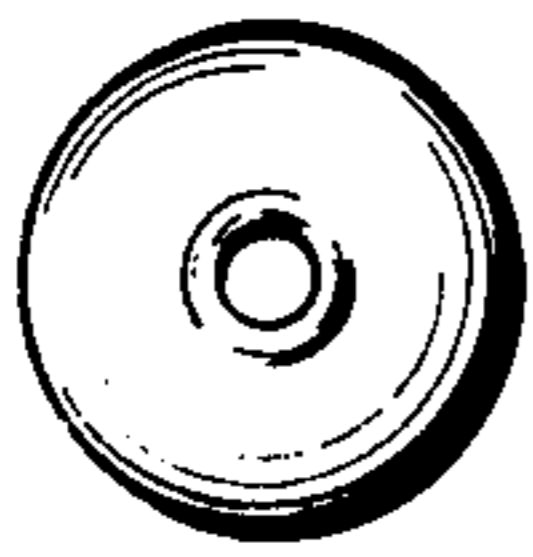

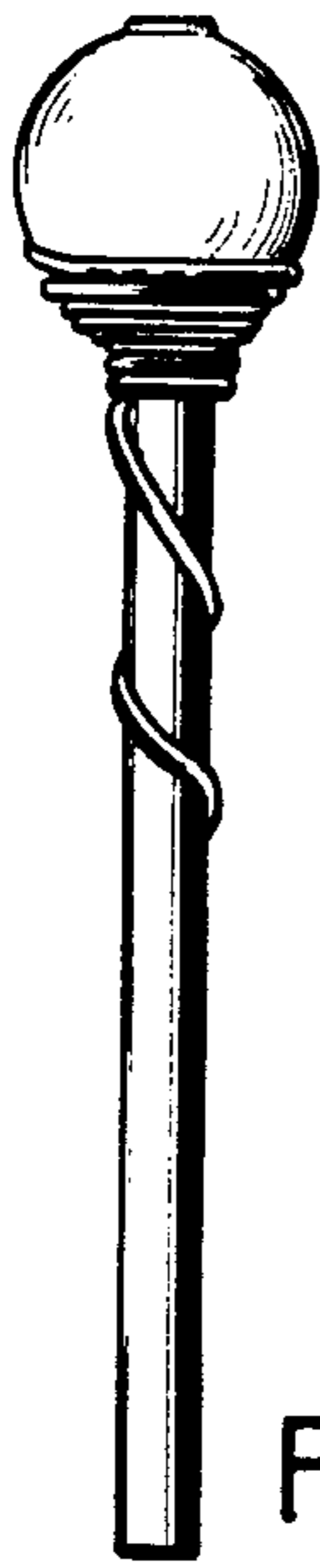

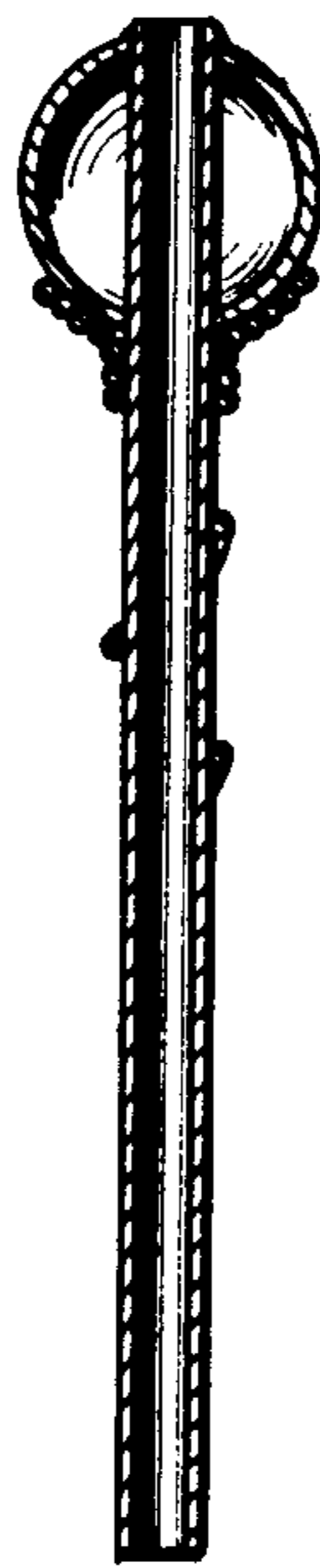
