The ornamental design for a night stand, as shown and described.

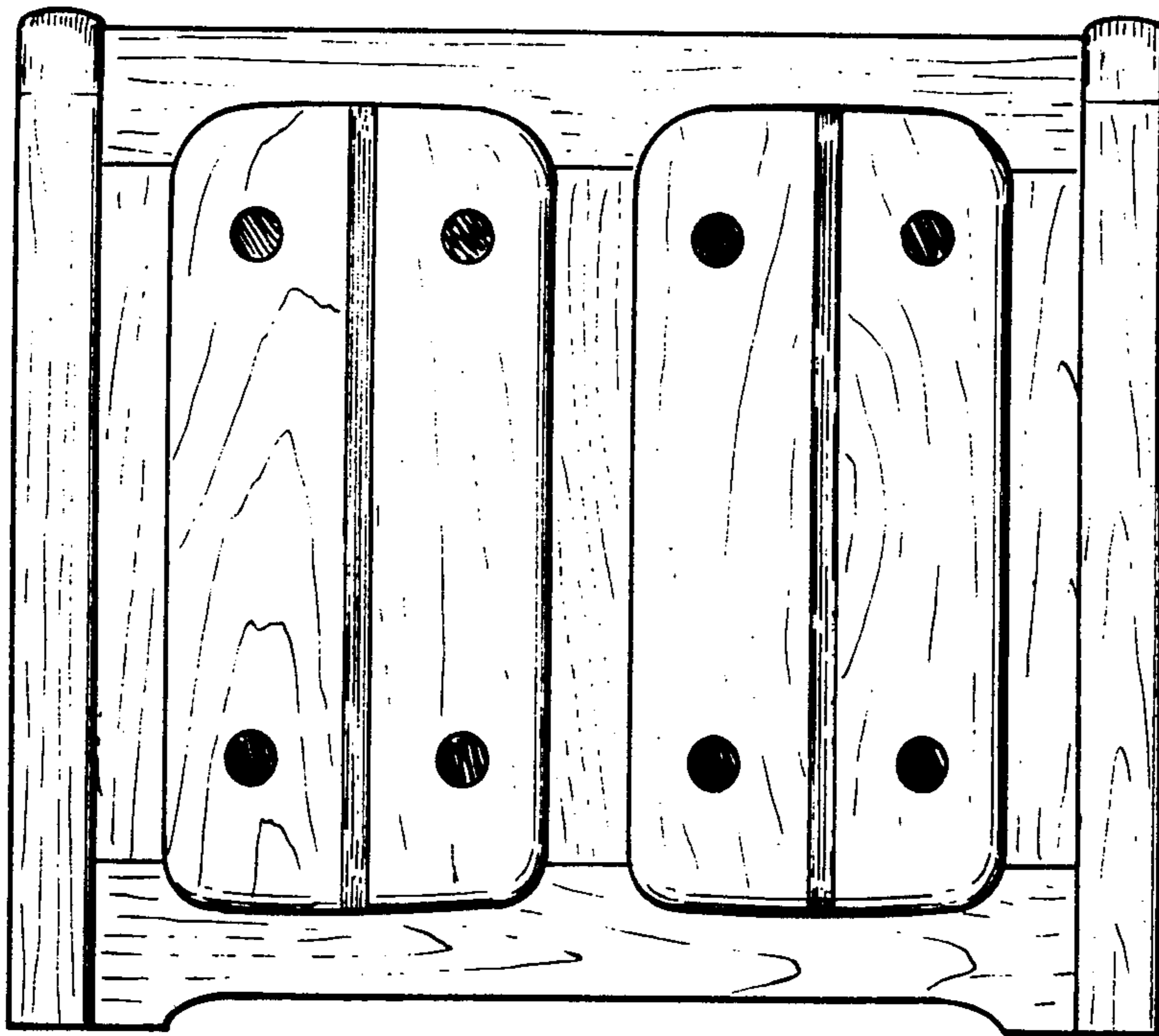
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a night stand embodying my invention;

FIG. 2 is a top view of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 3 is a right side view of FIG. 1.

The side of the night stand not shown is like the side shown while the rear is conventionally flat and unornamented.



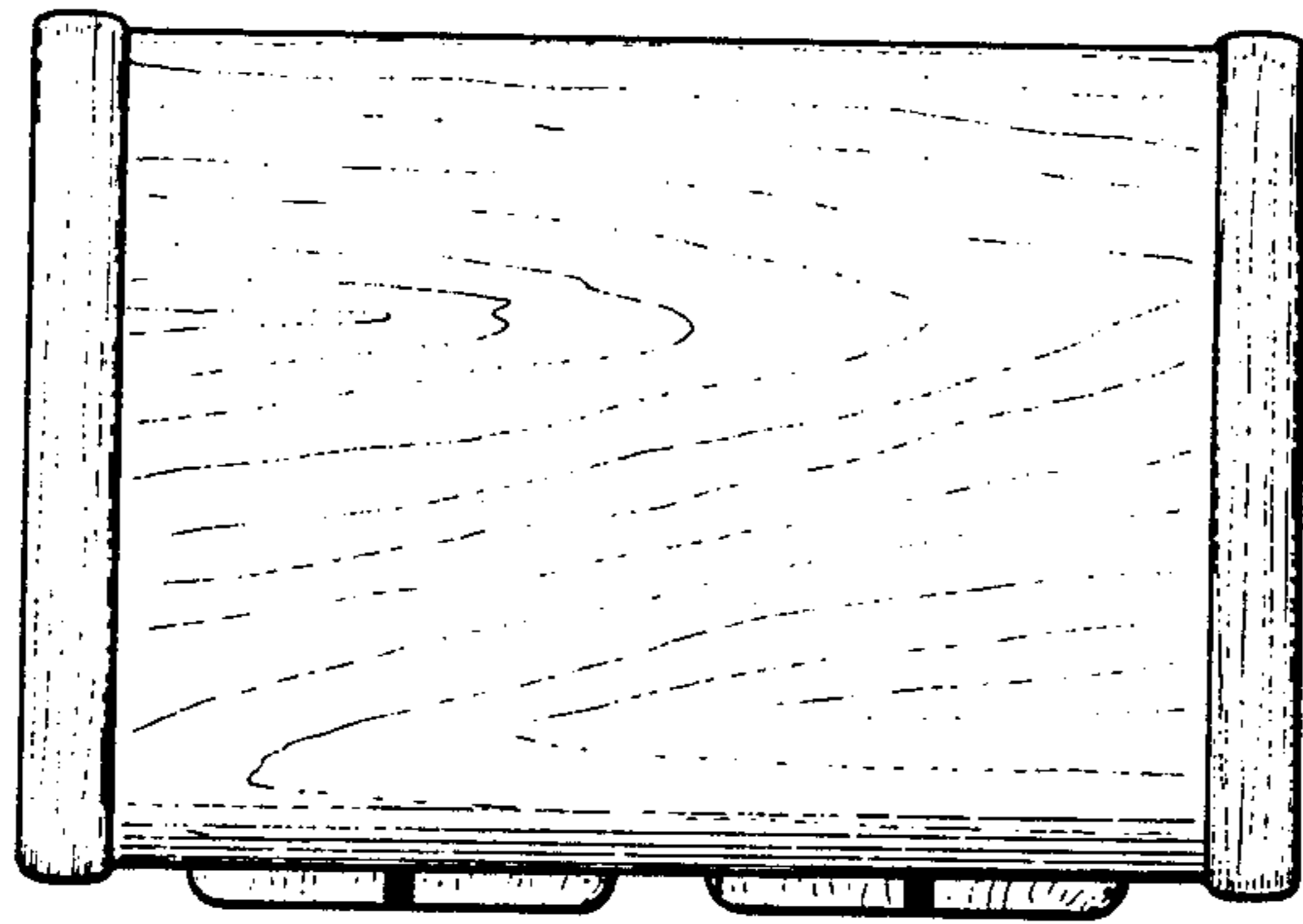

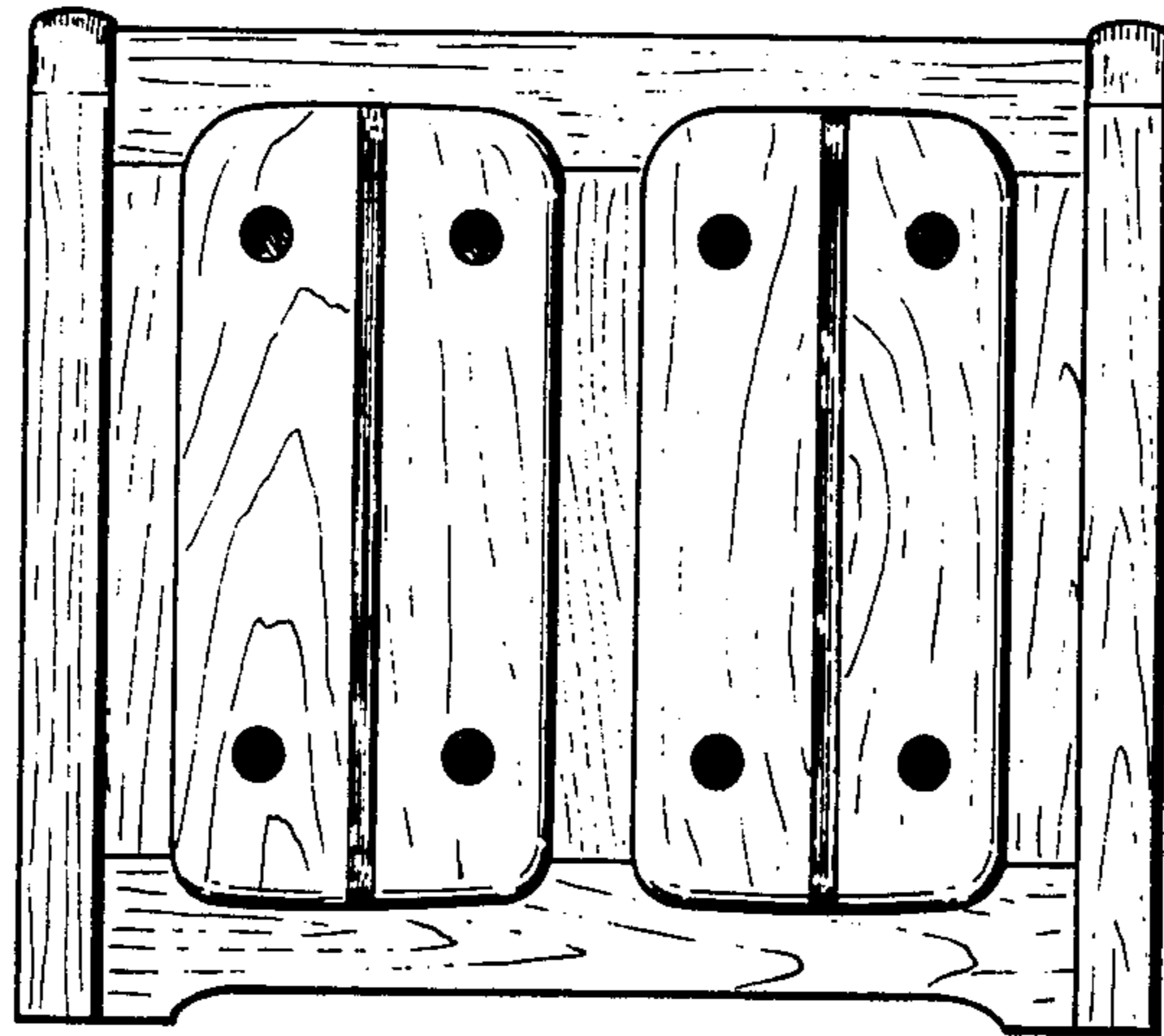

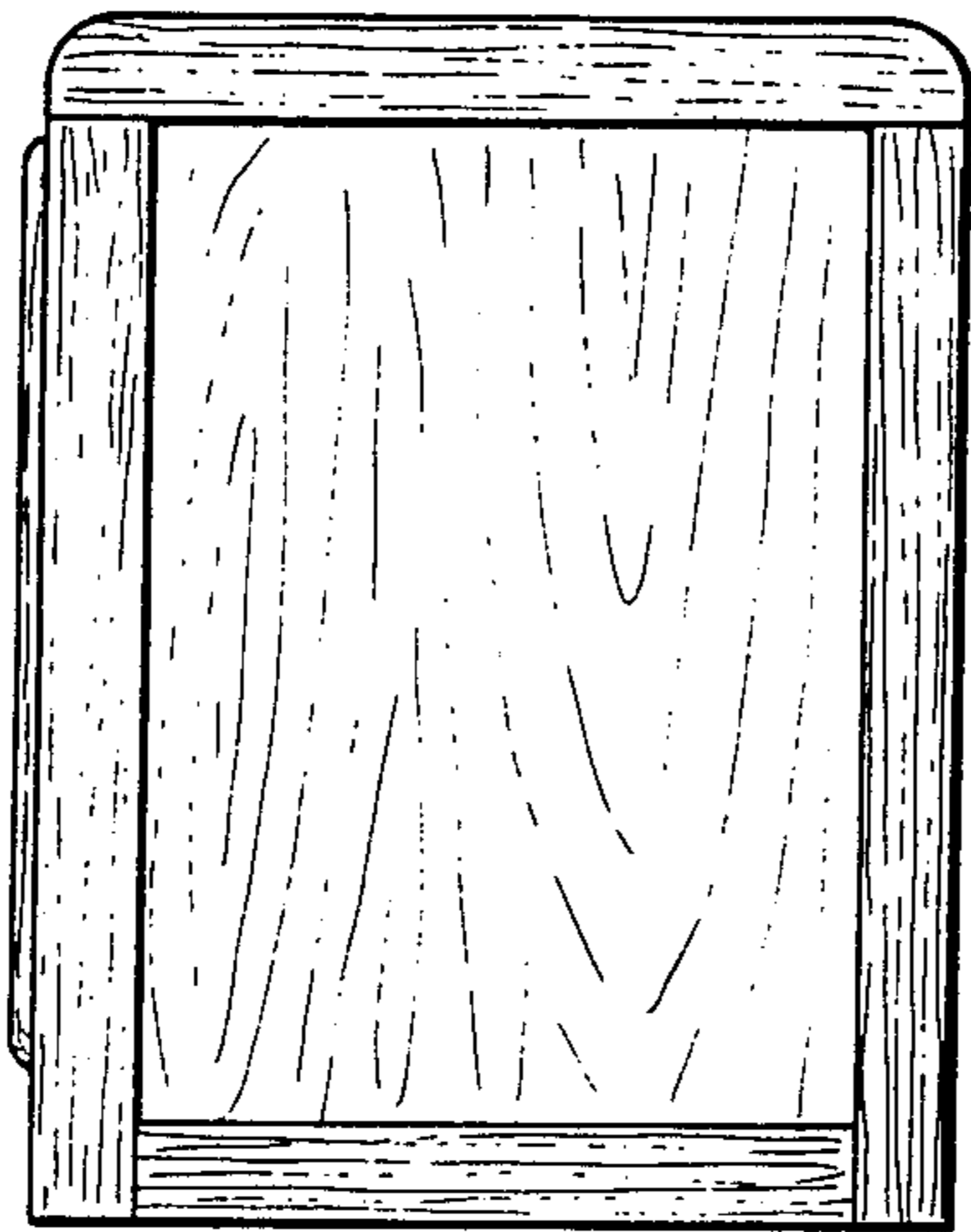
