[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a water treatment dishwashing apparatus, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a water treatment dishwashing apparatus showing our new design;

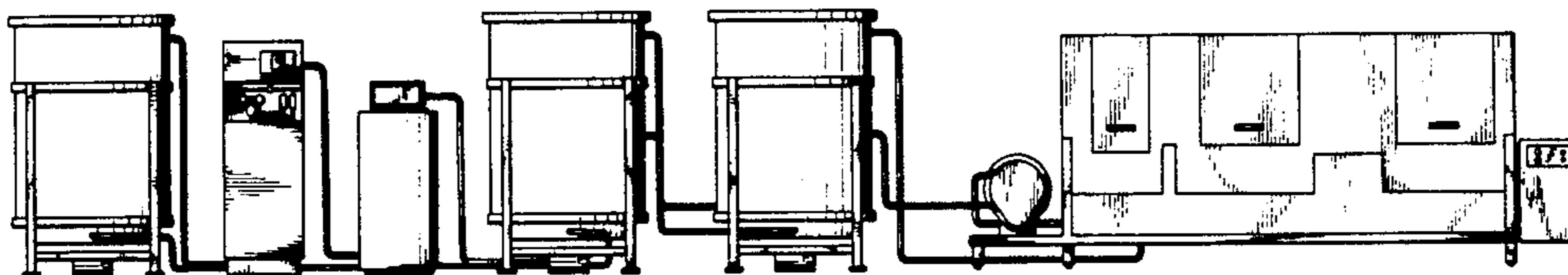
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end elevation view thereof shown on an enlarged scale; and

FIG. 5 is an end elevation view showing the opposite end thereof shown on an enlarged scale.

The bottom of the water treatment dishwashing apparatus is substantially unornamented.



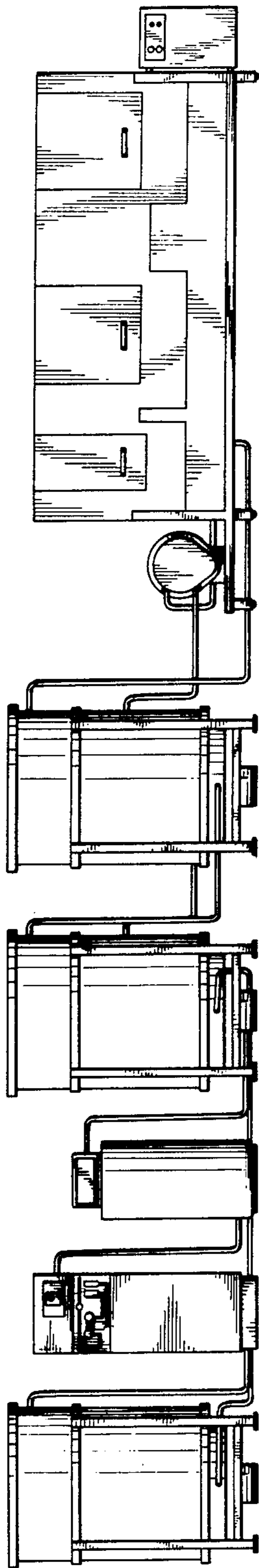

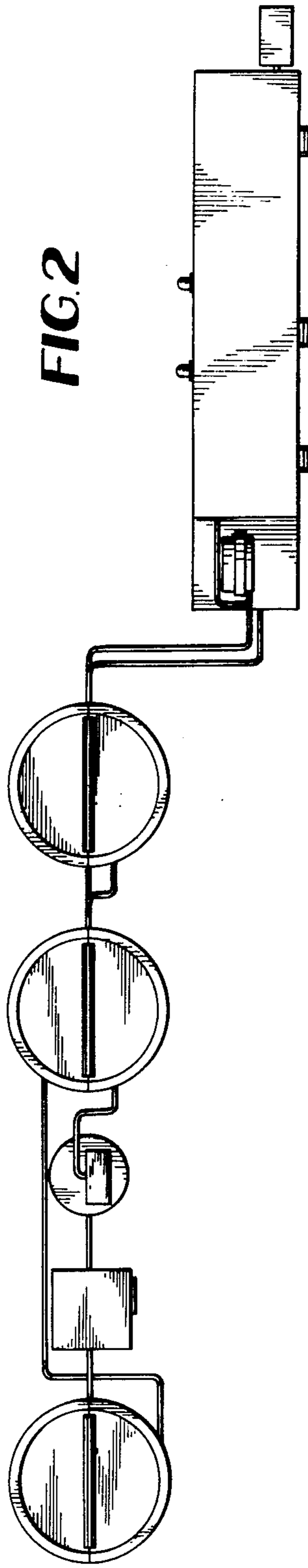

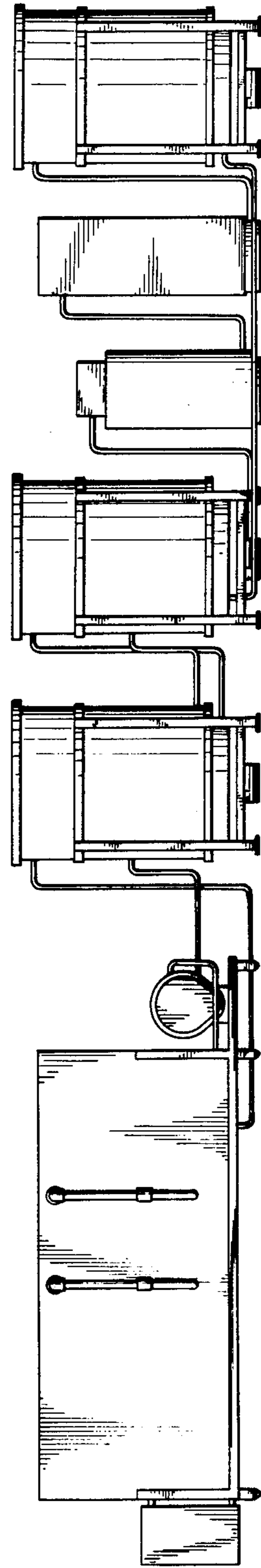

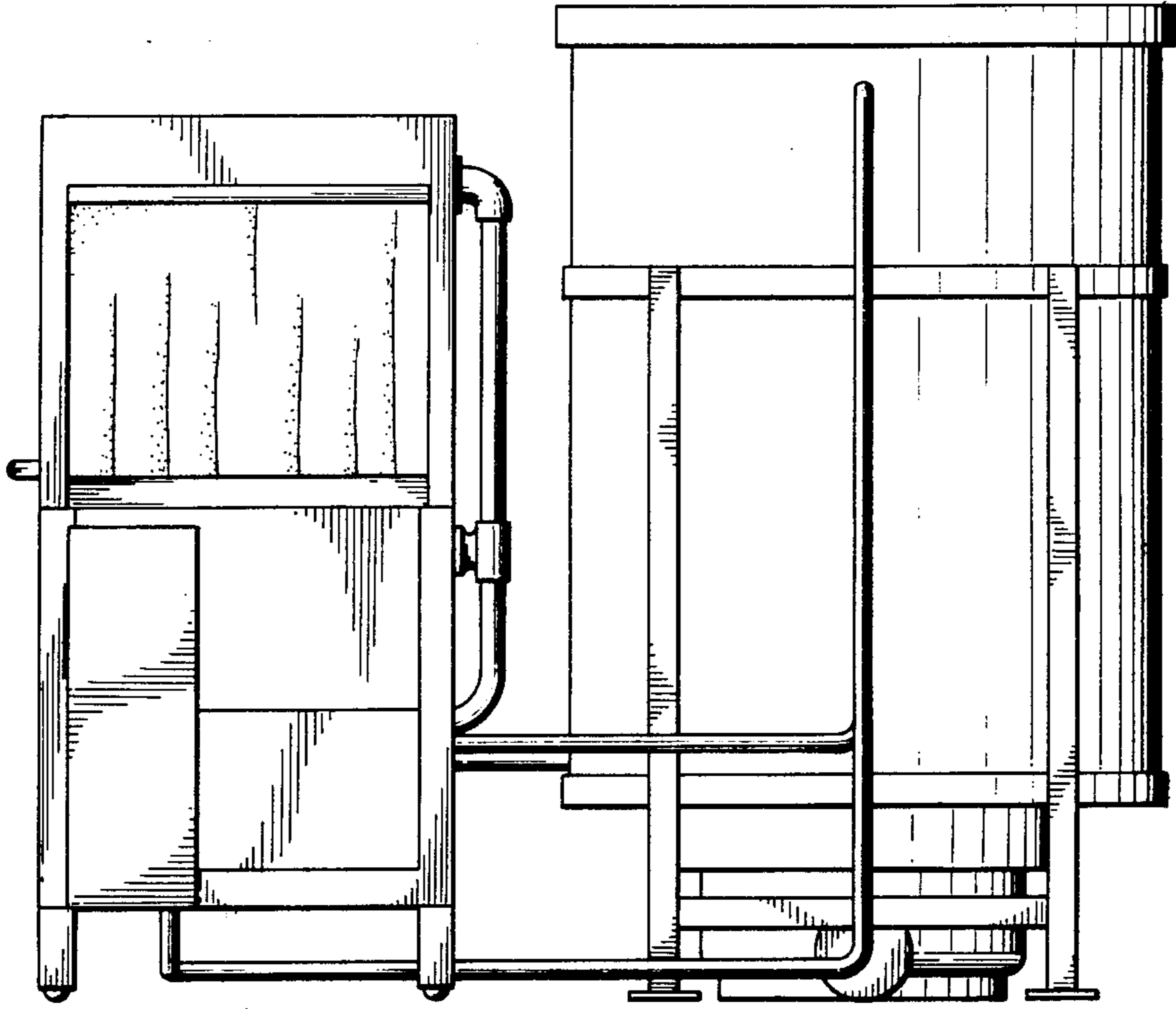
