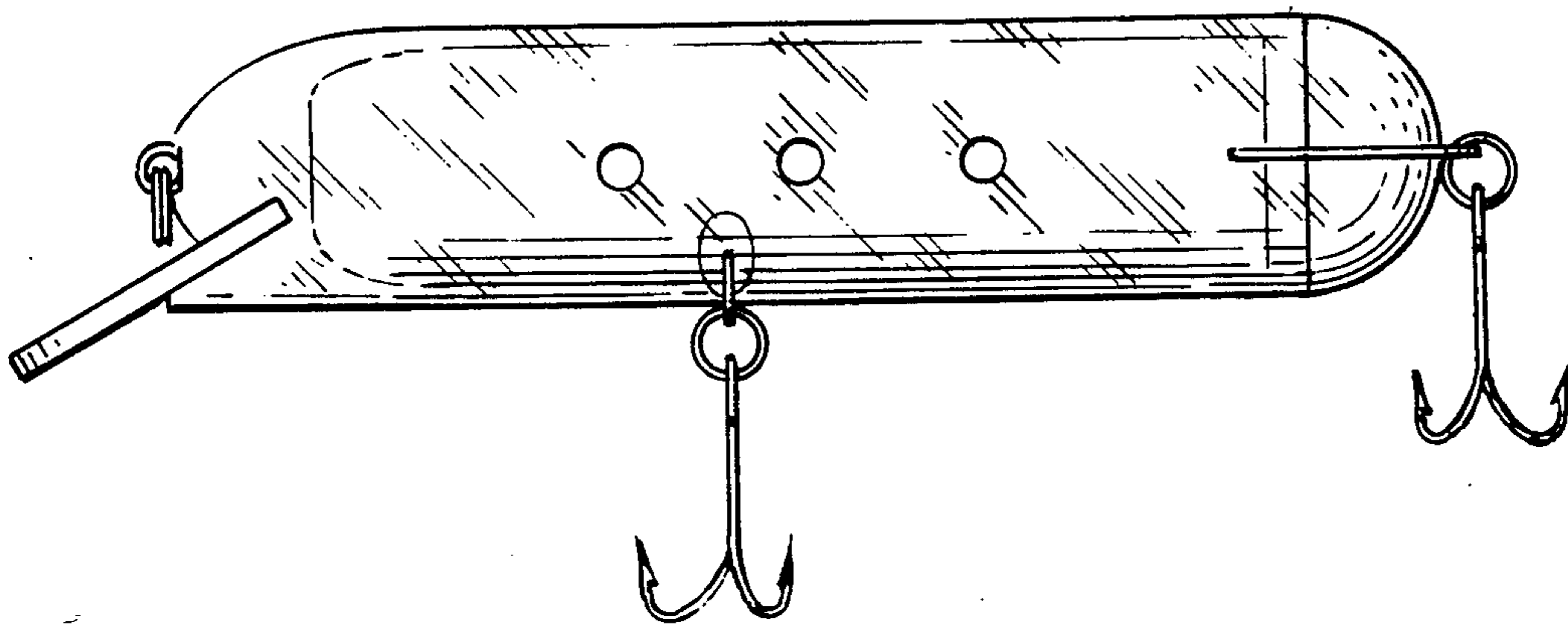

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hollow transparent fishing lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a hollow transparent fishing lure illustrating my design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear end view.



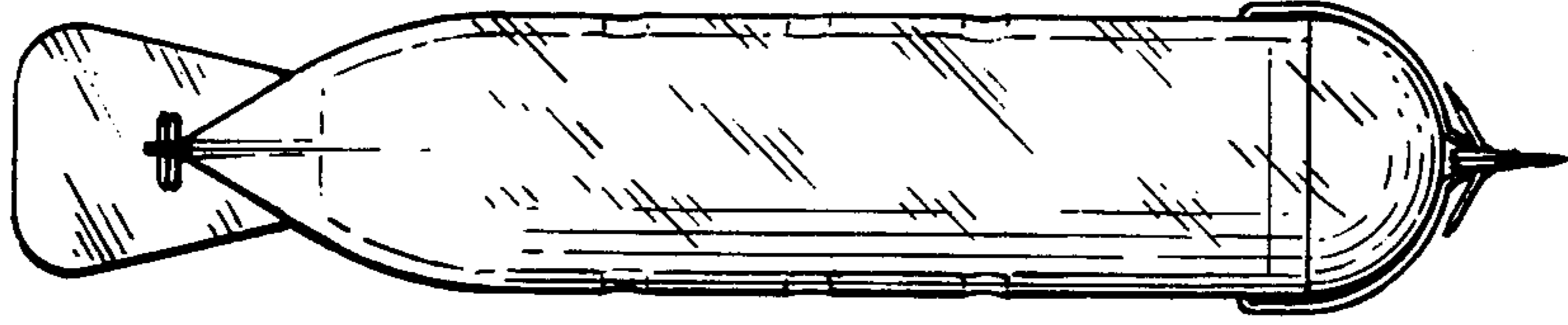

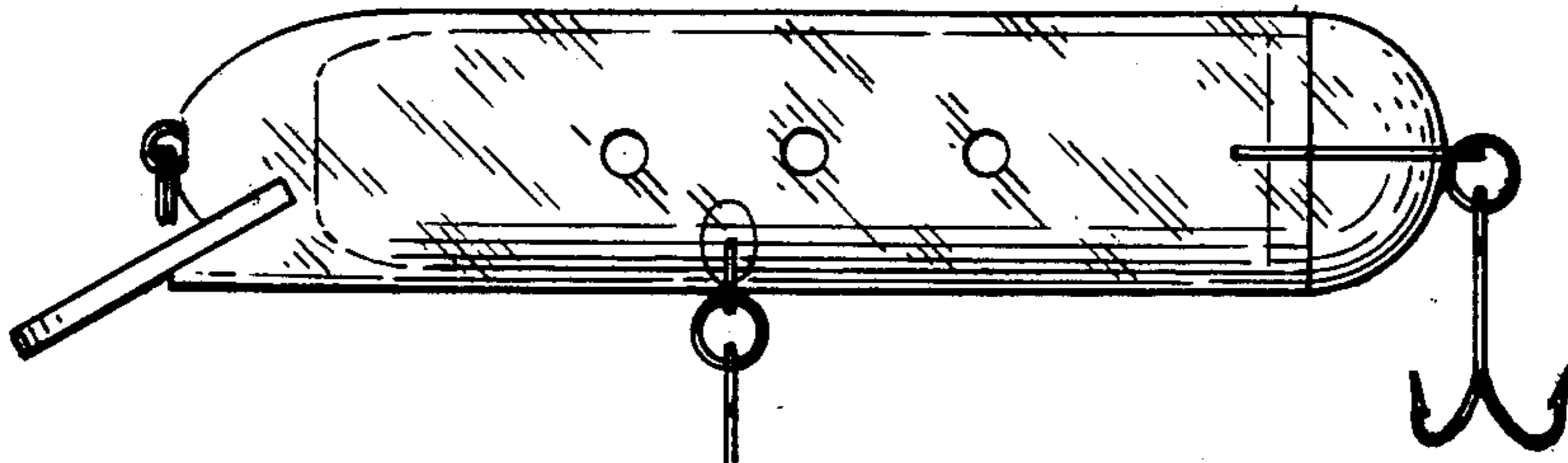

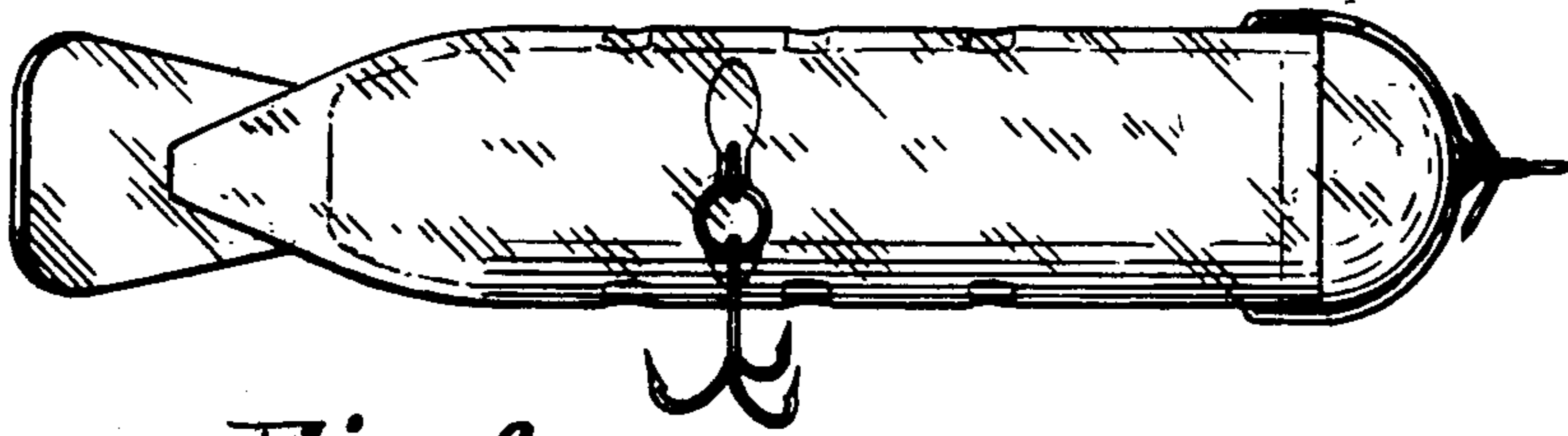

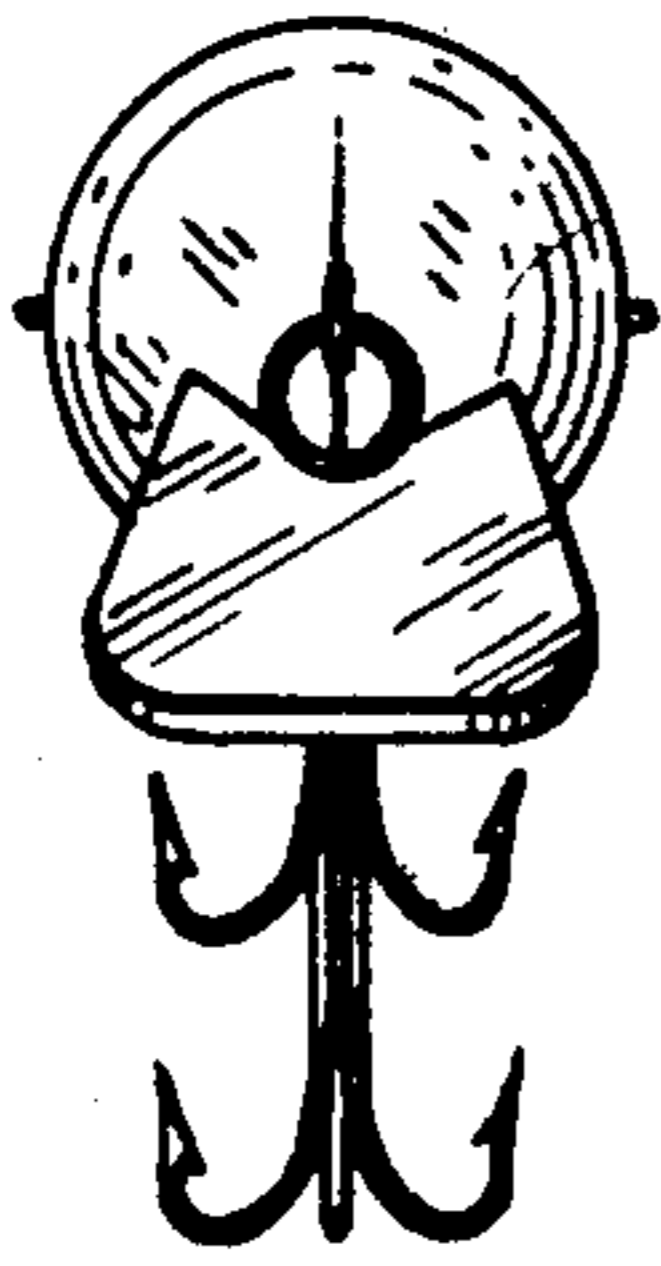

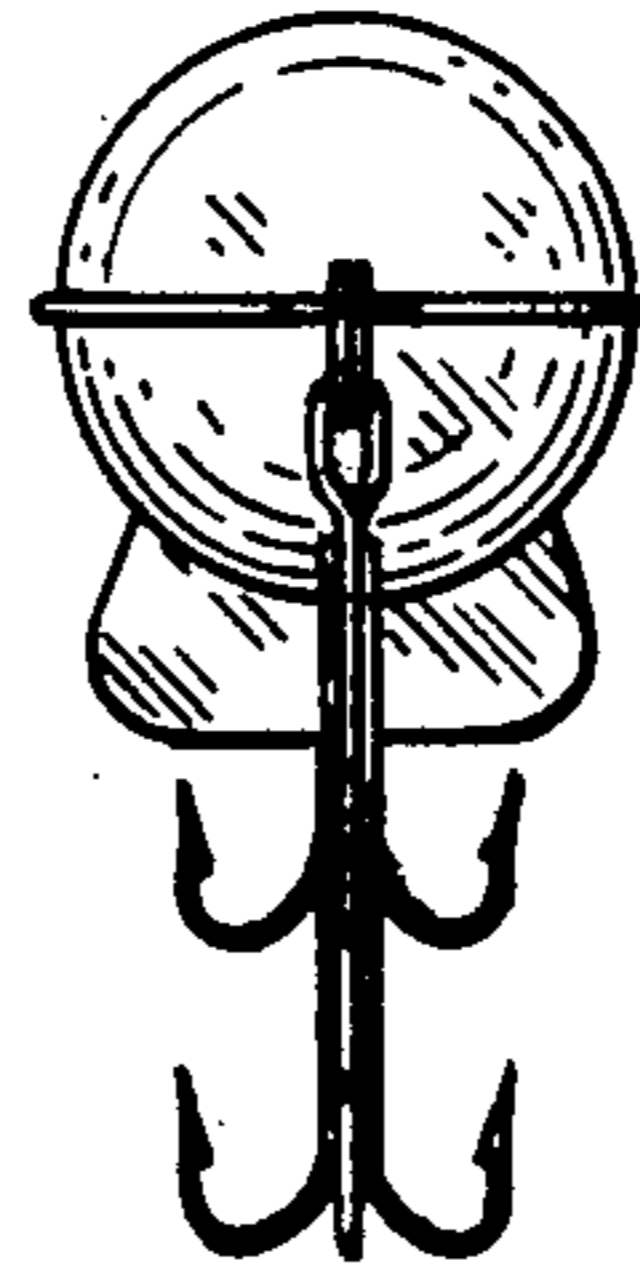
