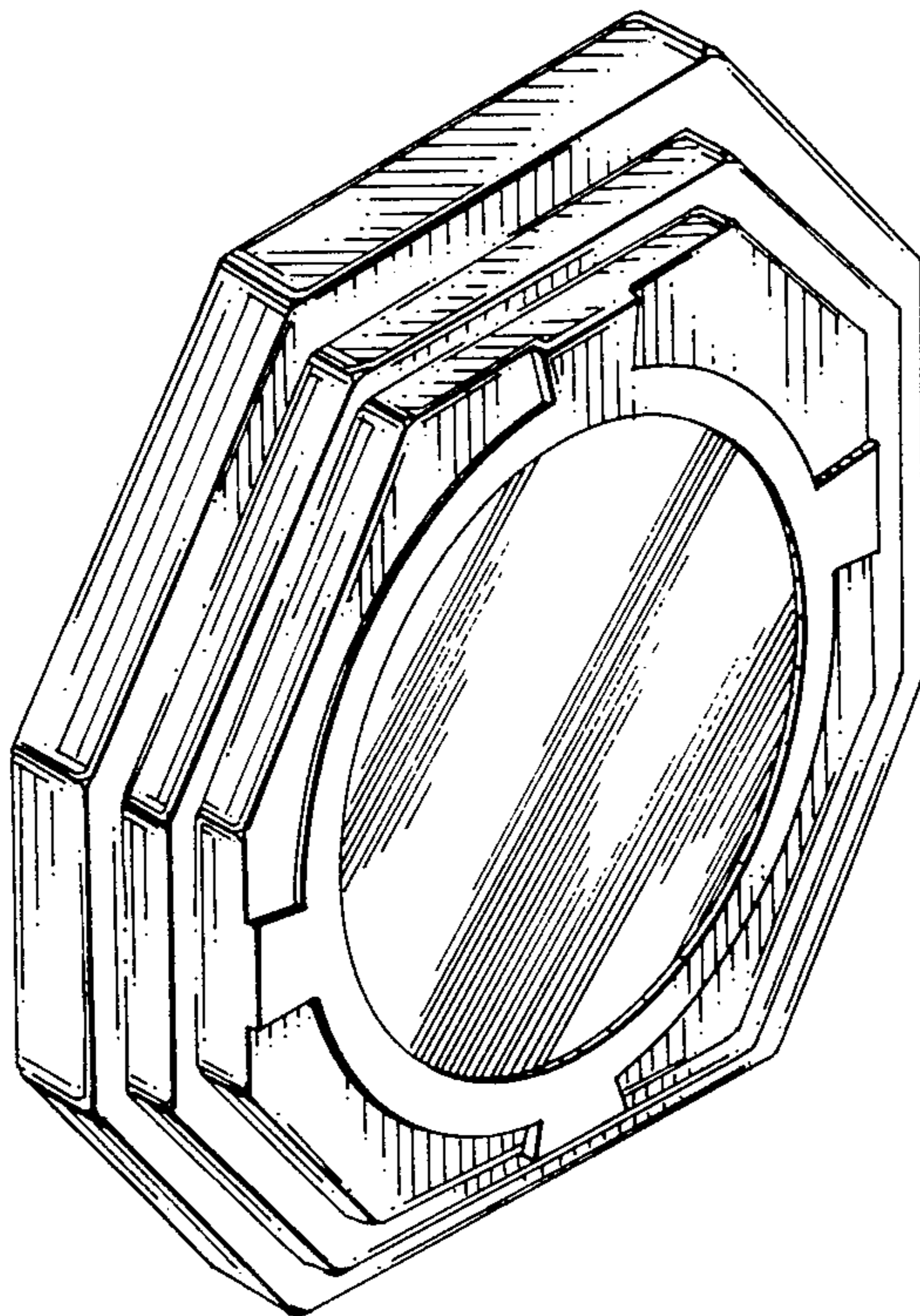
The ornamental design for an entertainment lighting display unit, as shown and described.

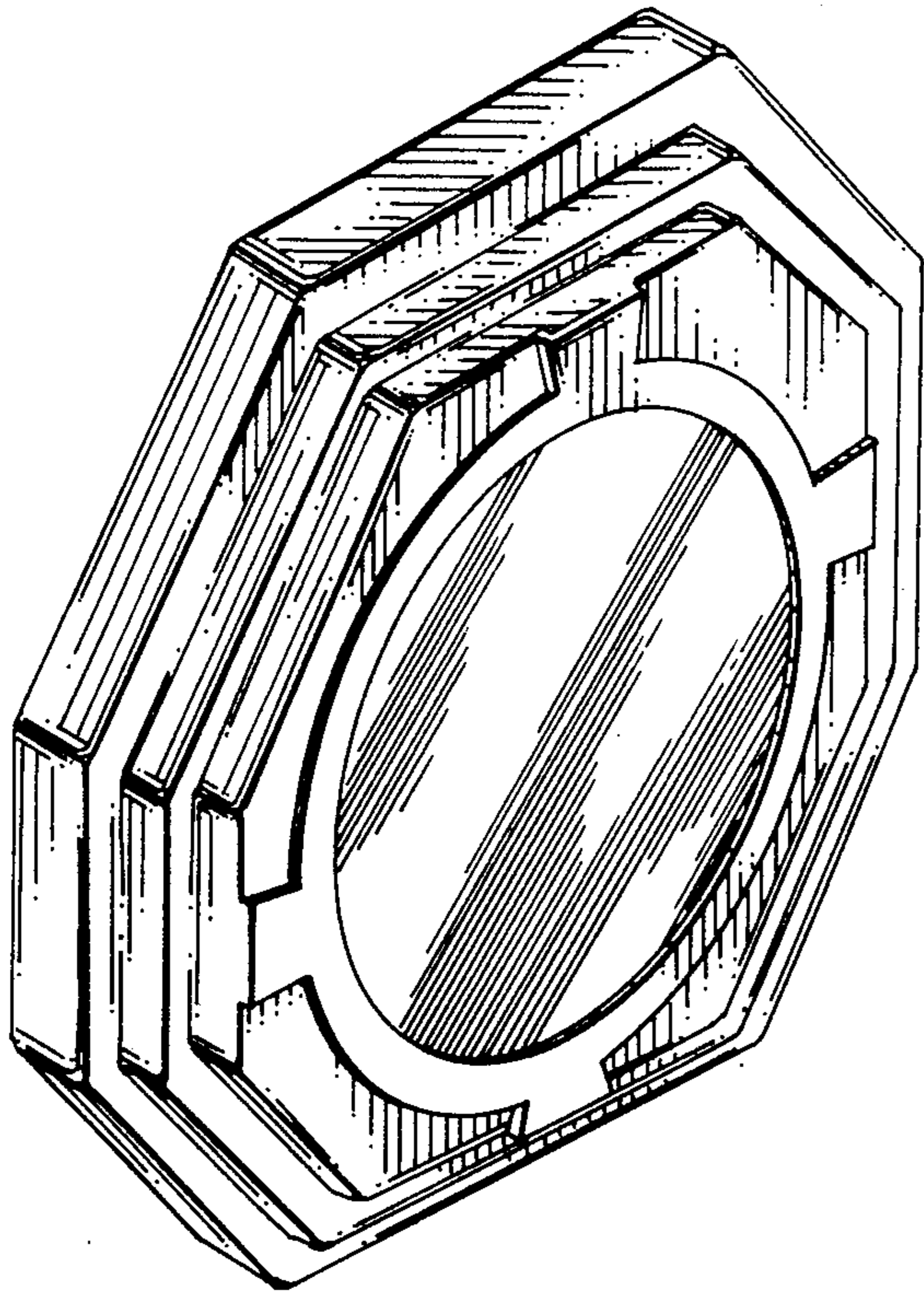
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left-side perspective view of an entertainment lighting display unit showing my new design, the front center being shaded with oblique lines to indicate translucency;

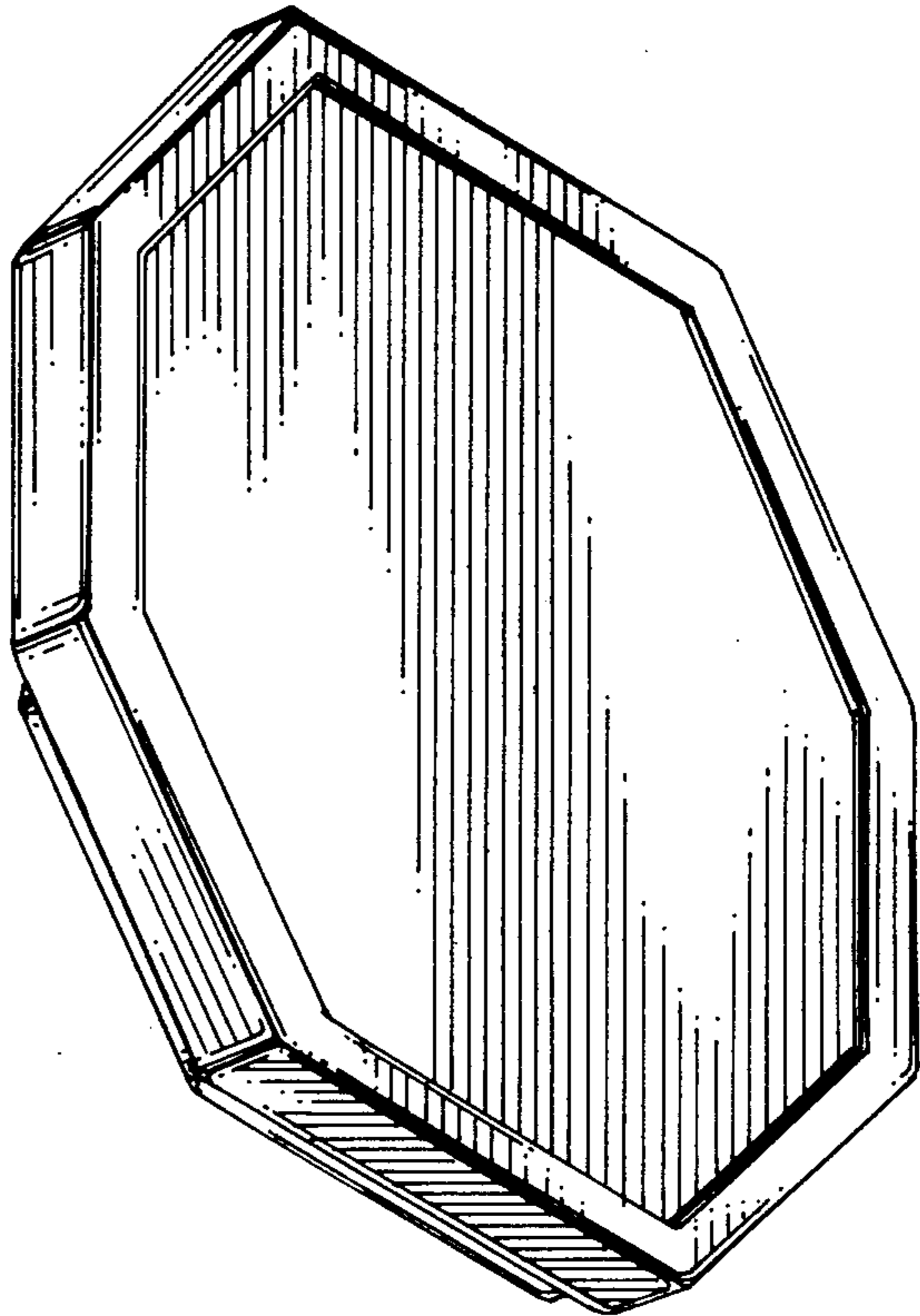
FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, right-side perspective view thereof; and
