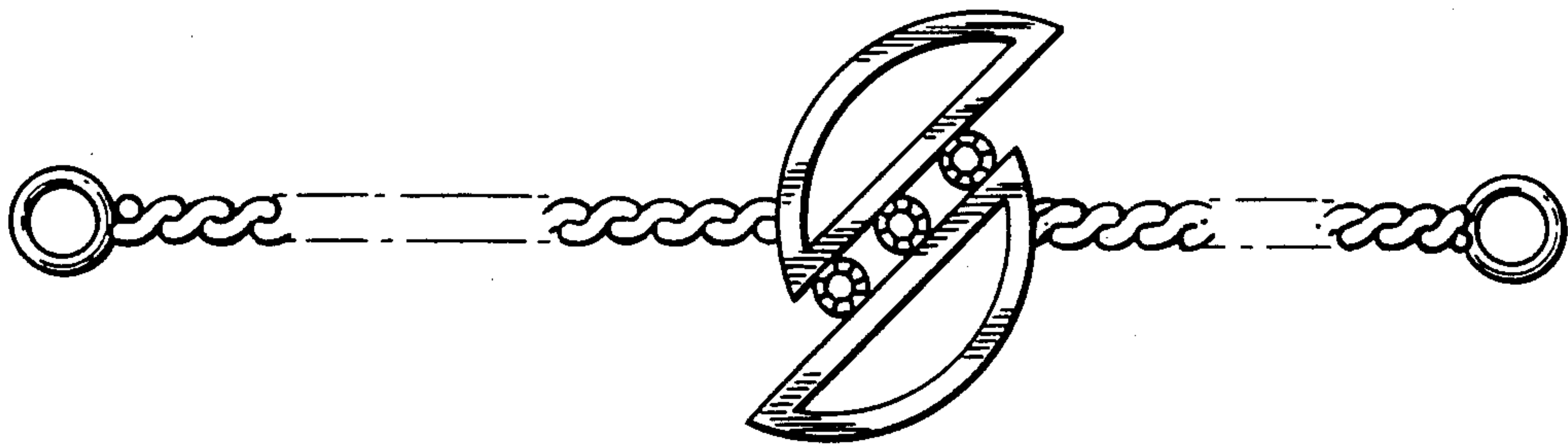

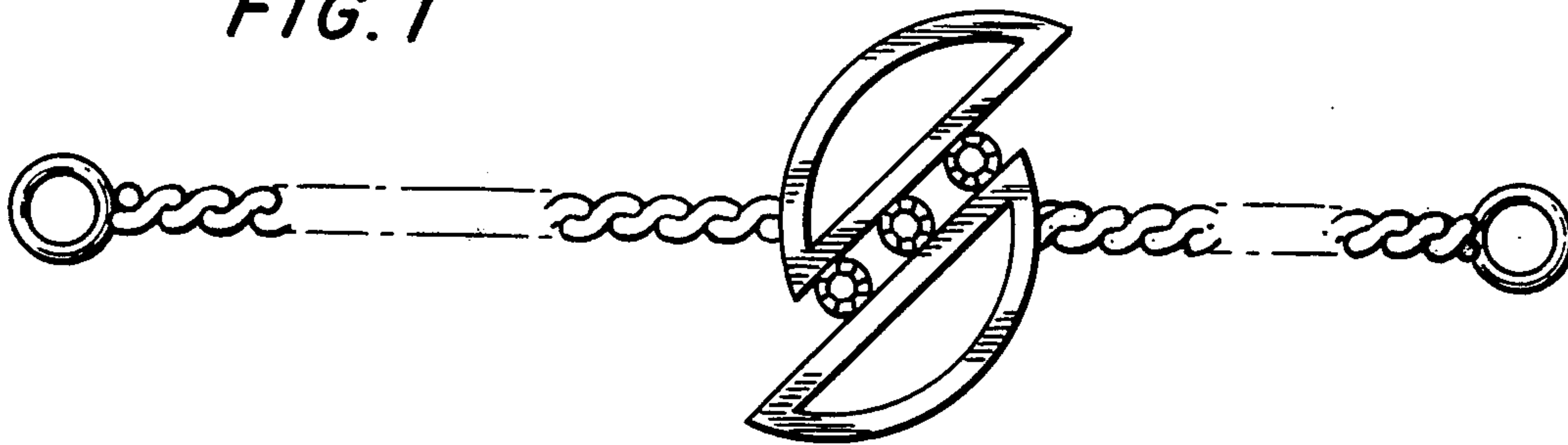
The ornamental design for a necklace or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

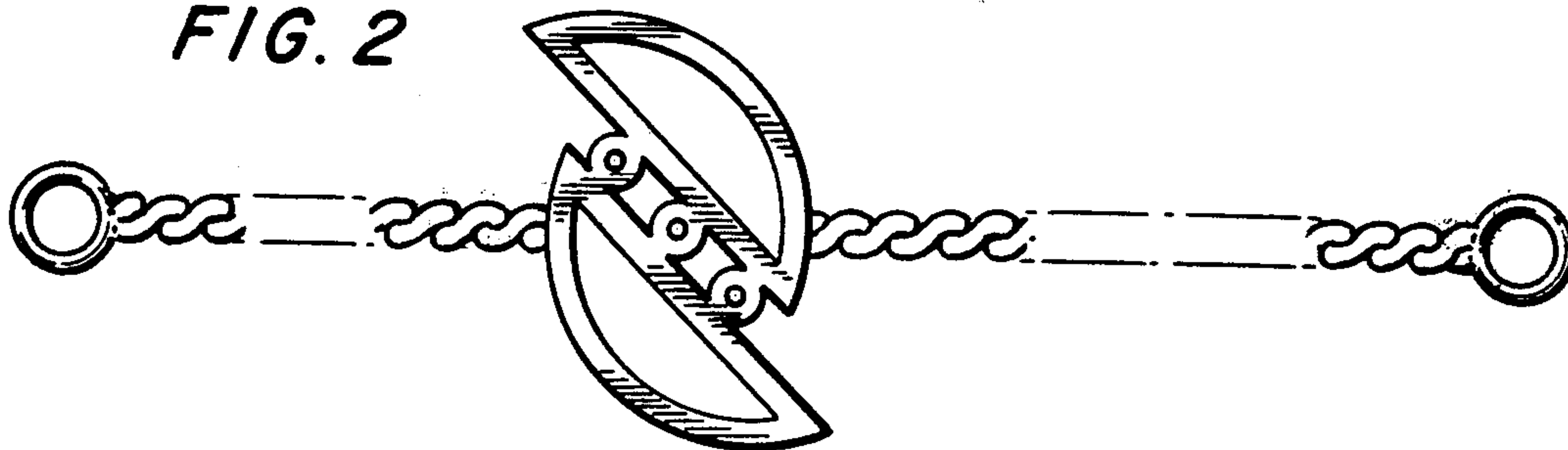
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a necklace or similar article showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
