FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

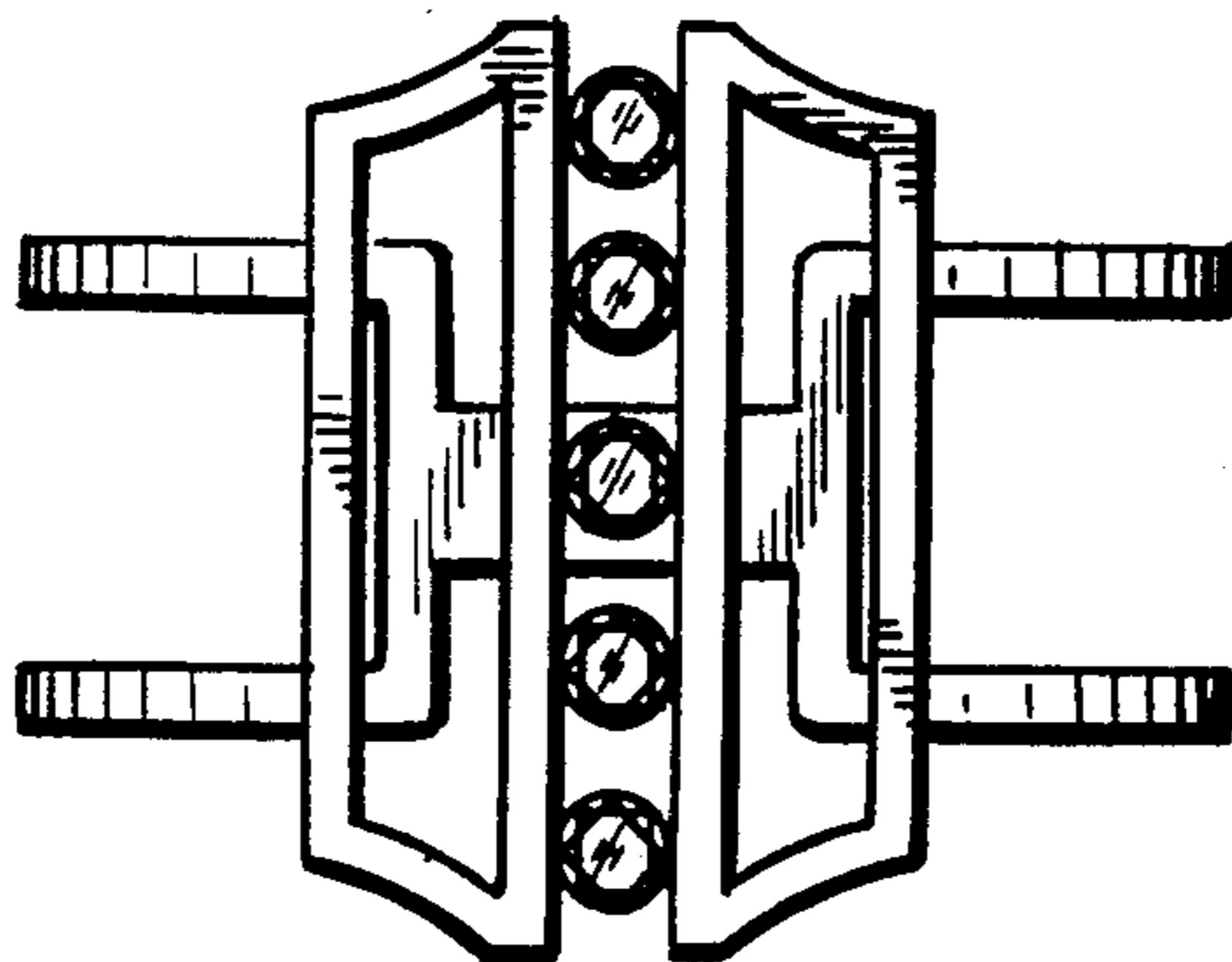
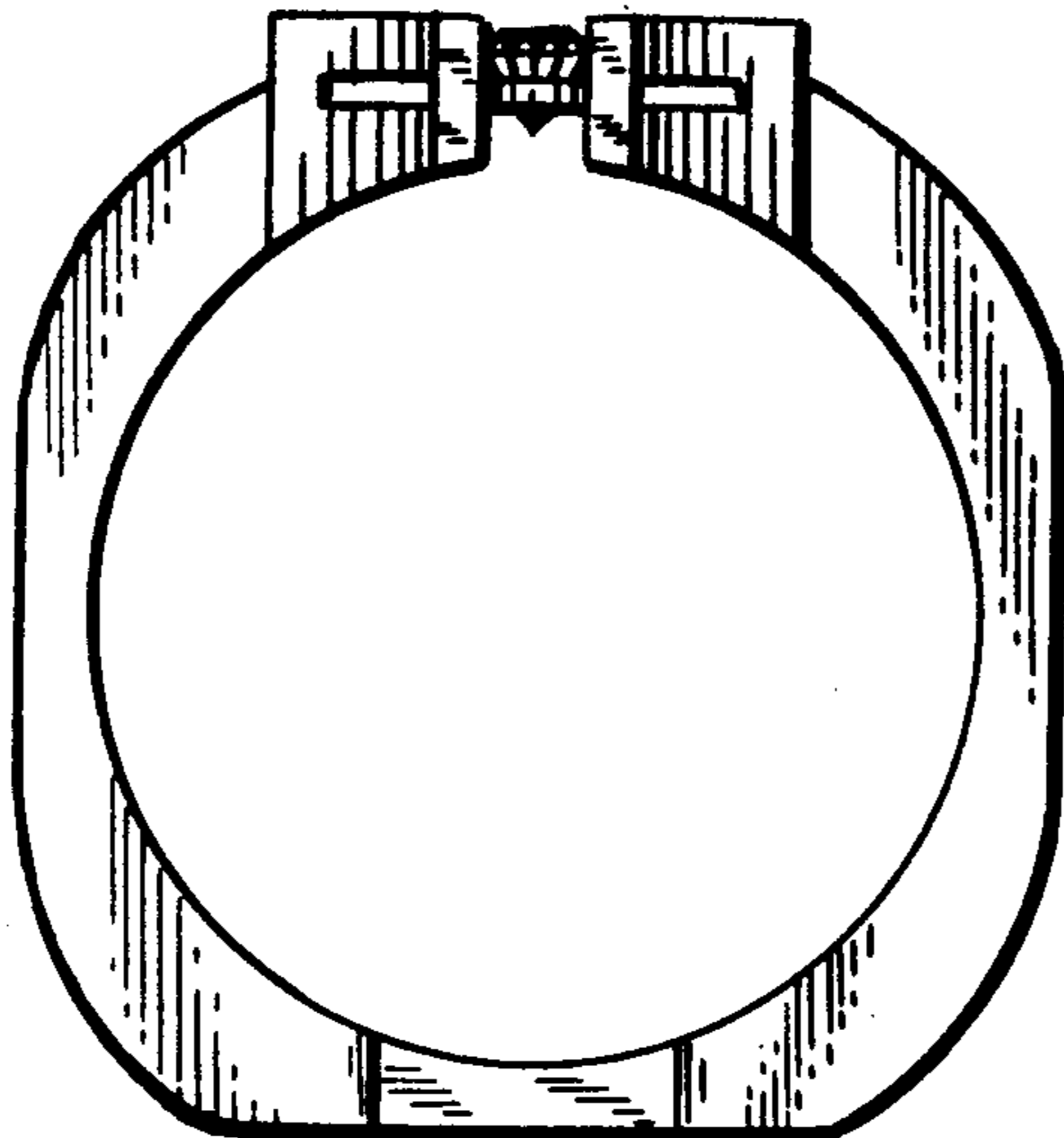
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

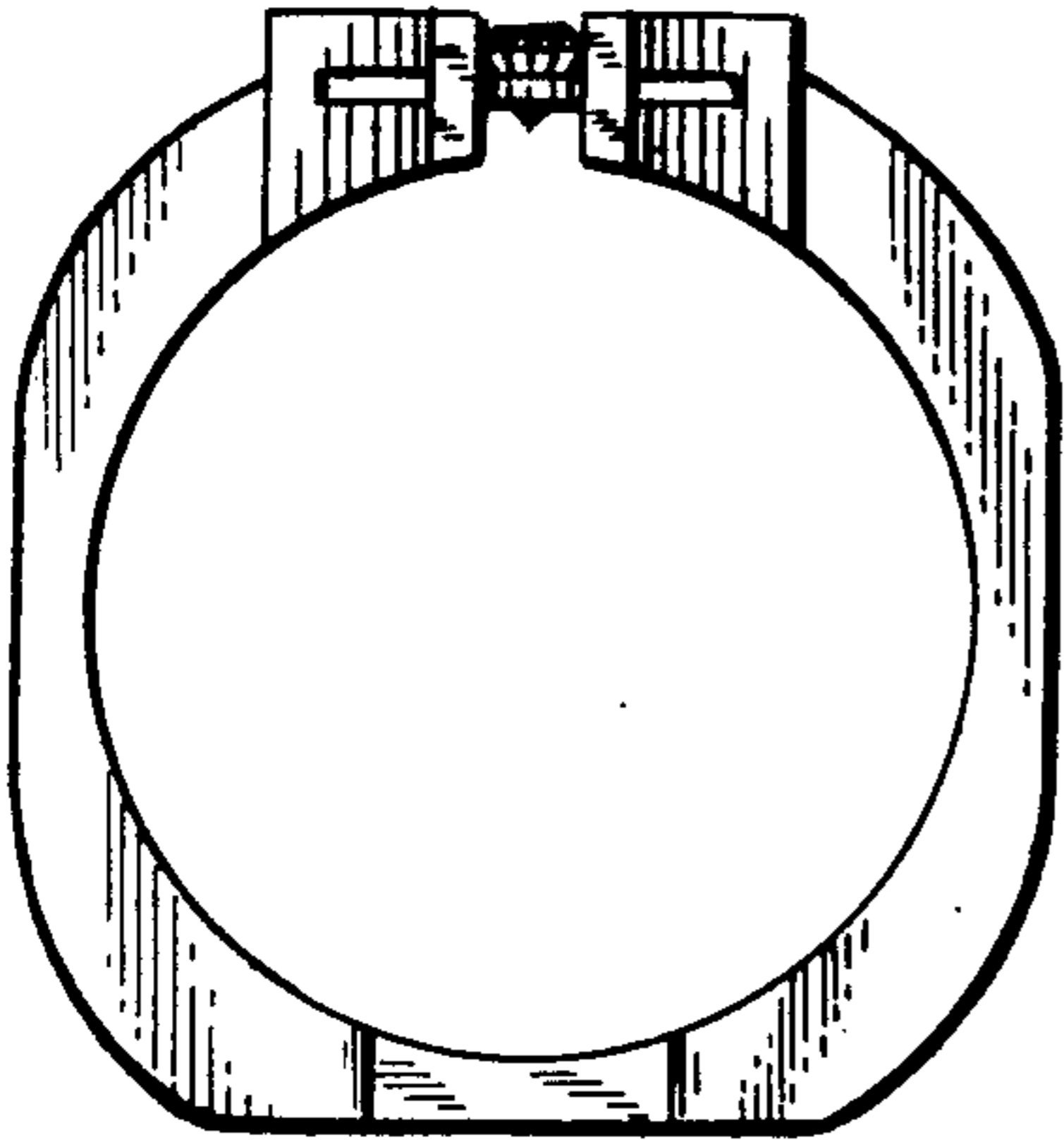

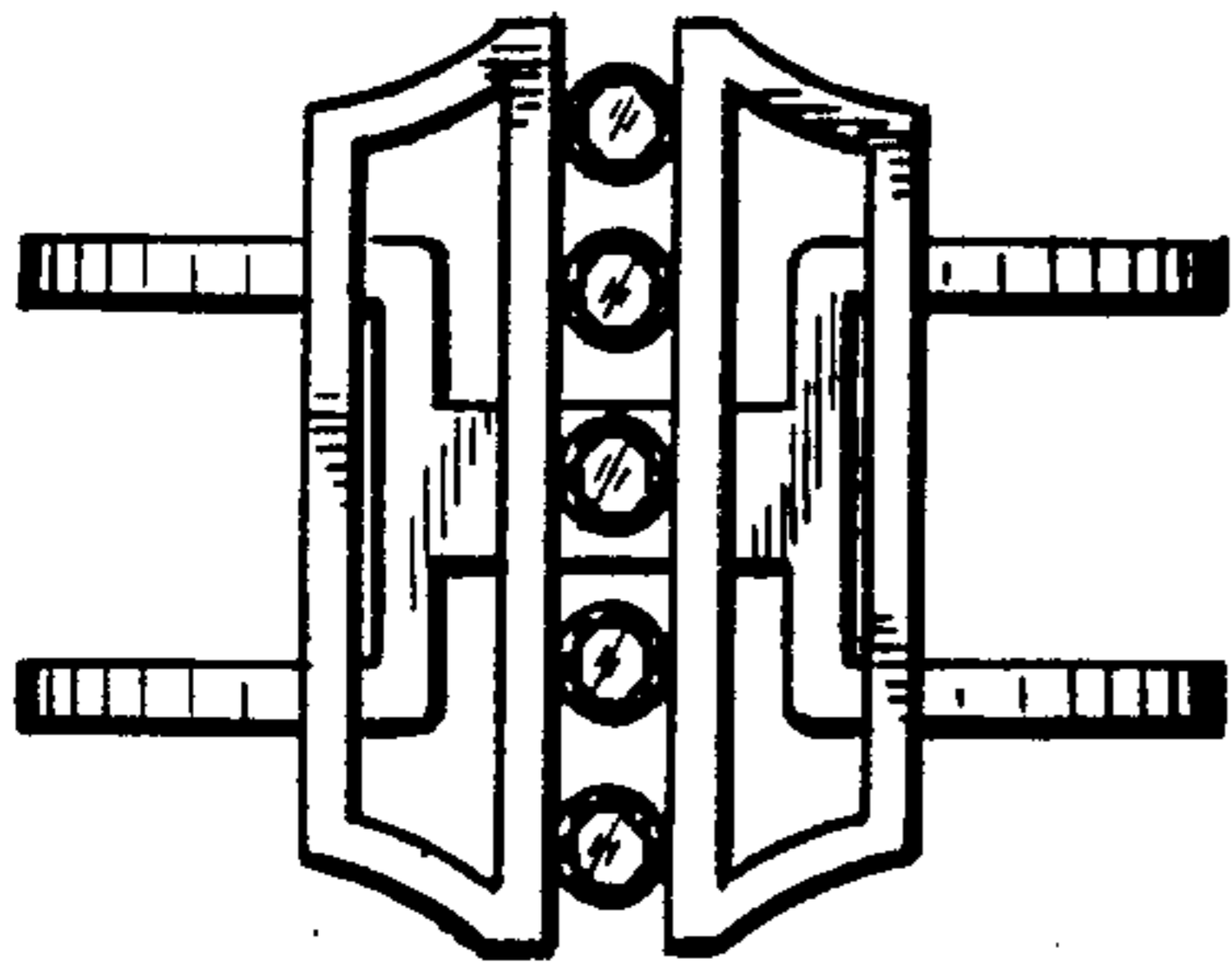

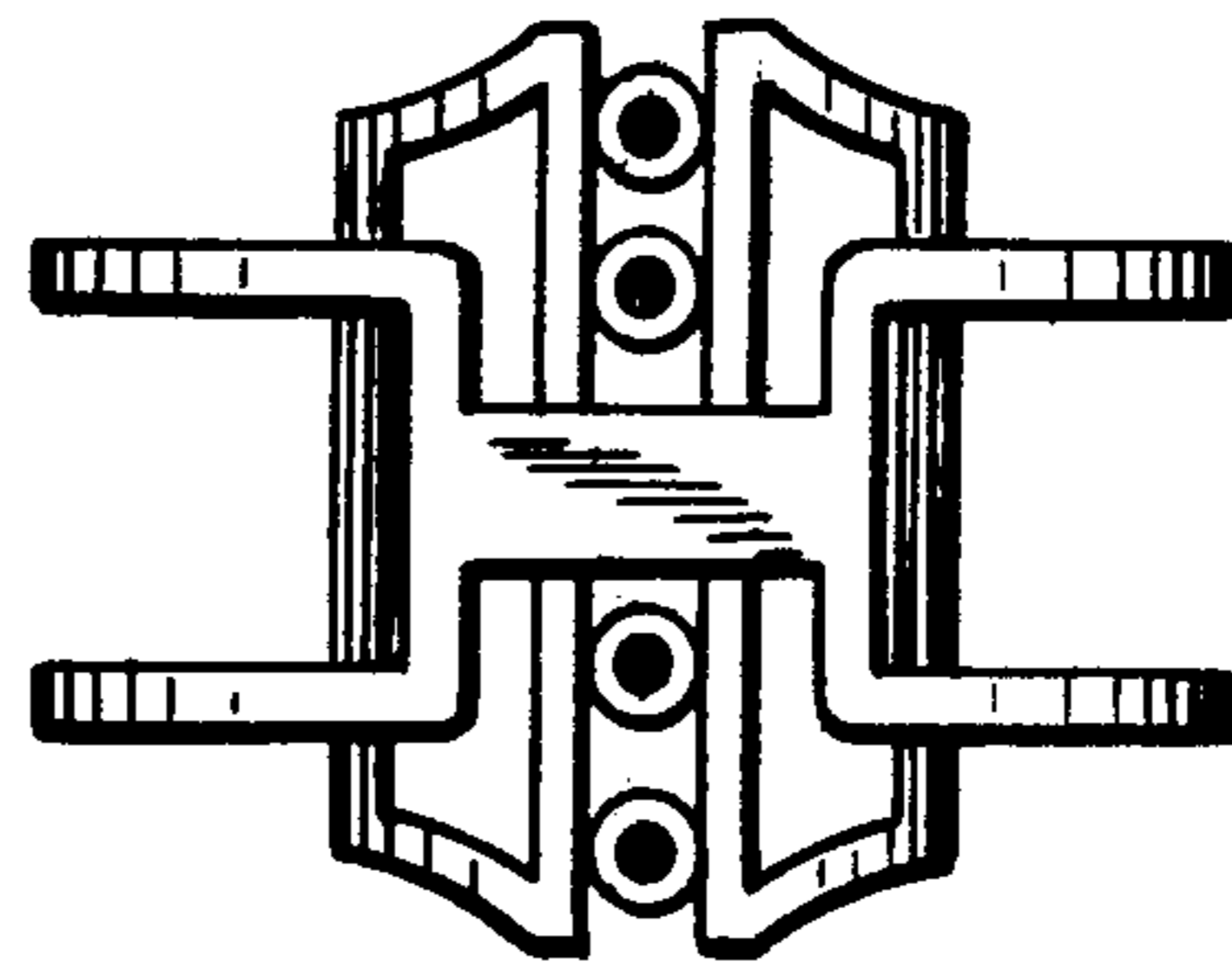

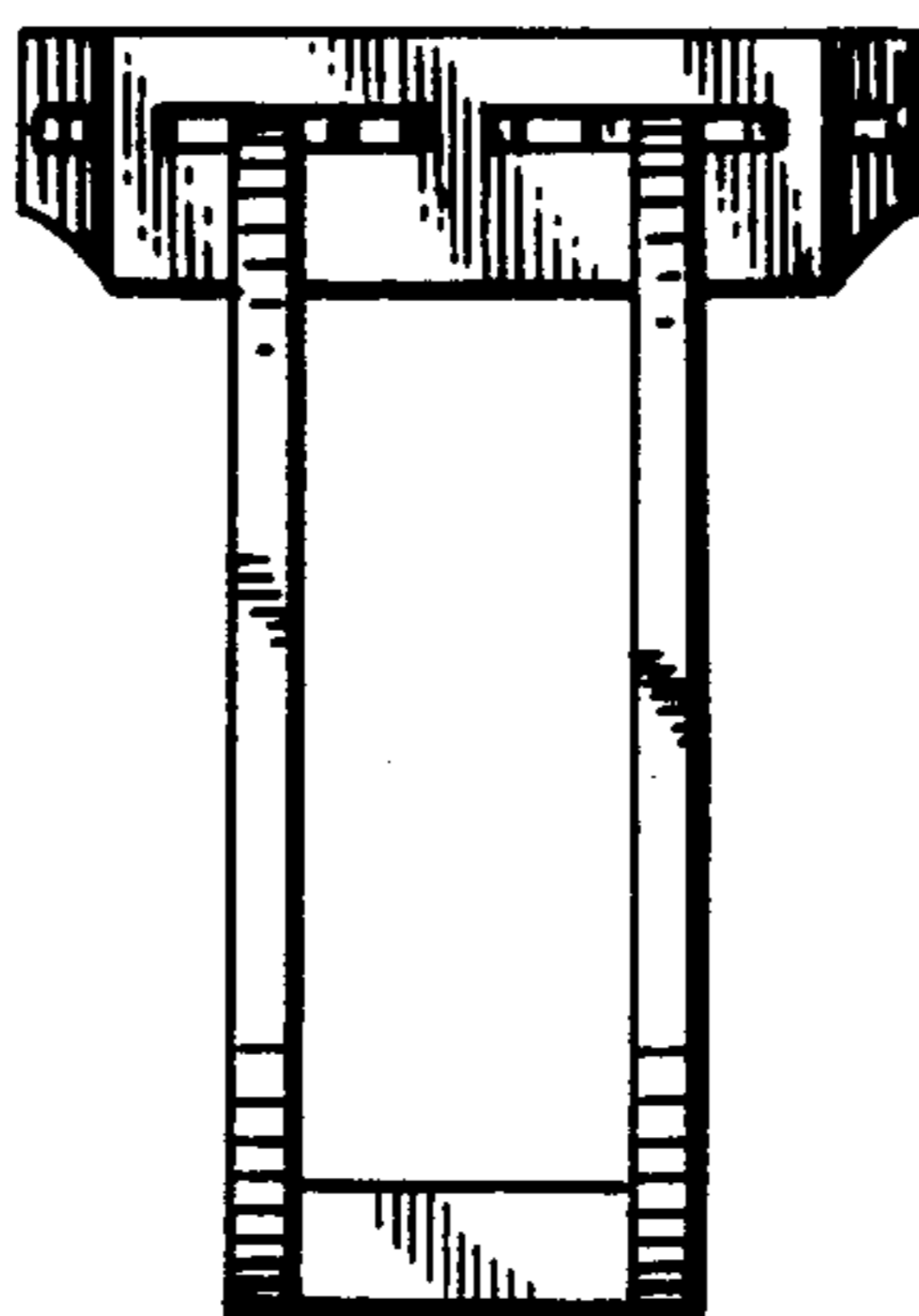
