The ornamental design for a lightweight trench box, as shown.

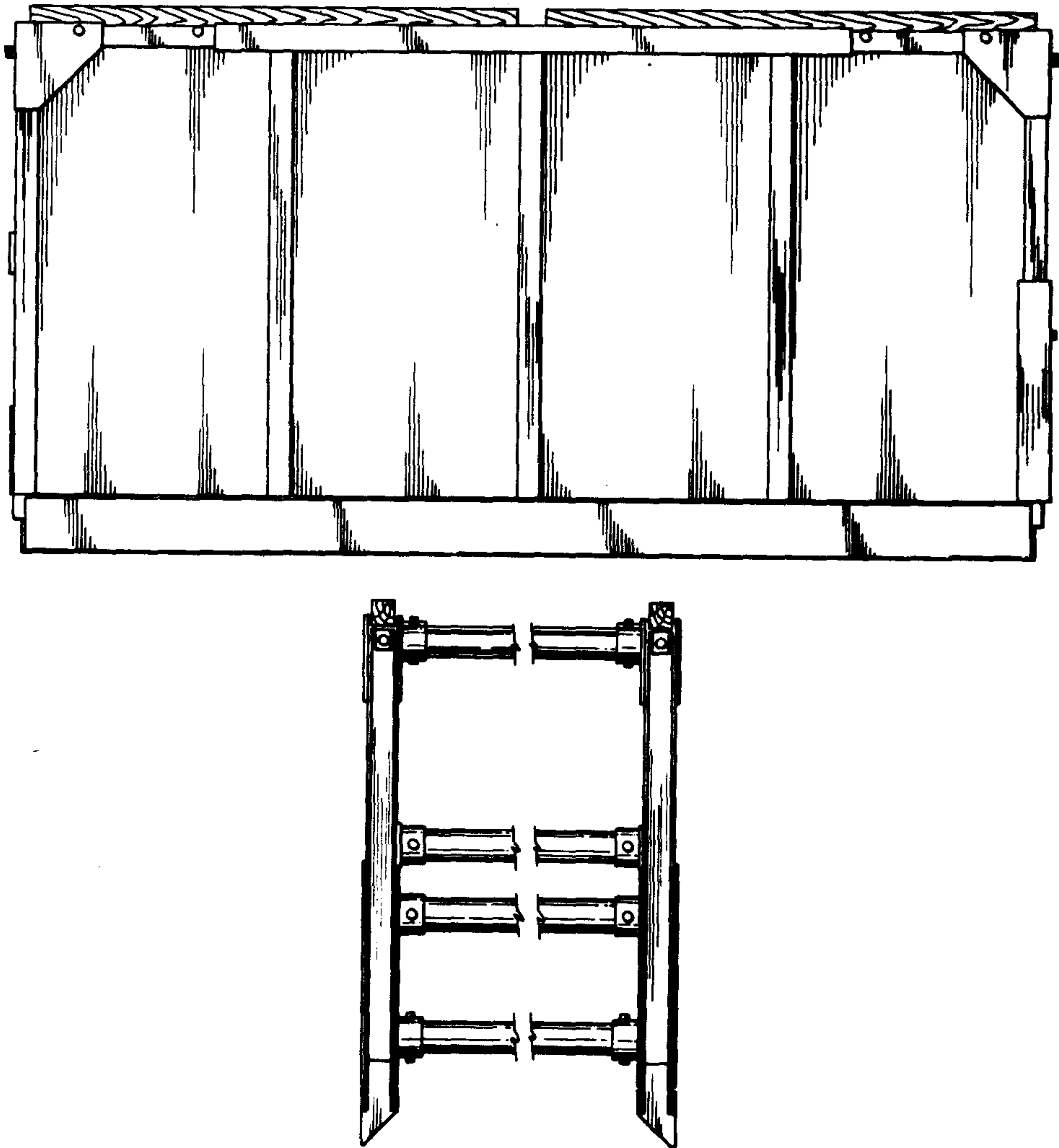
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a lightweight trench box constructed in accordance with the teachings of this invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the invention;

FIG. 4 is an end view of the invention looking from the right (as viewed in FIG. 1).



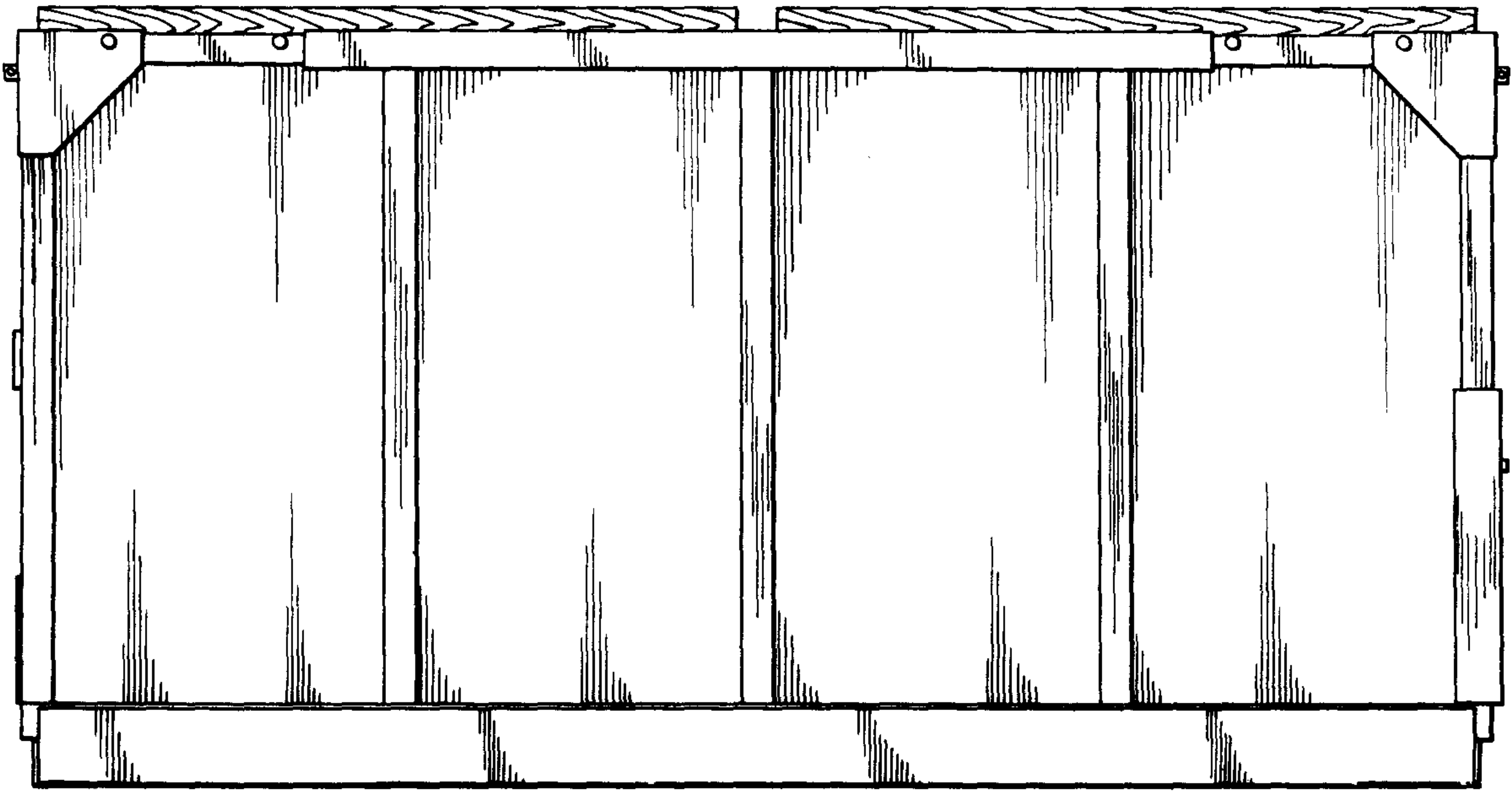

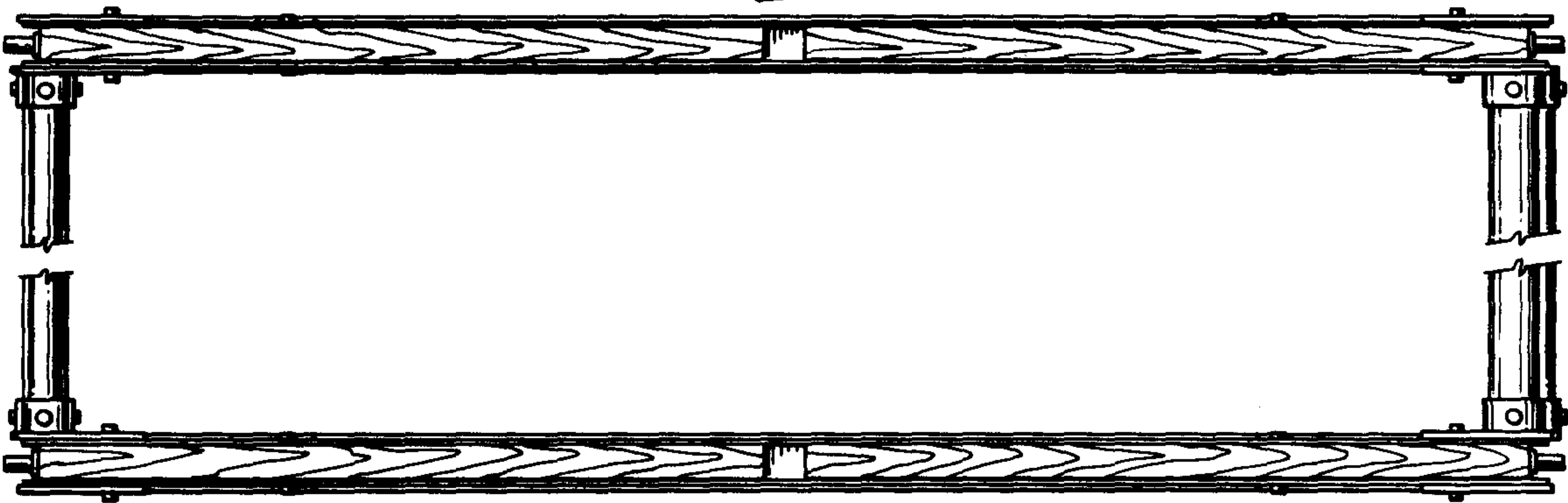

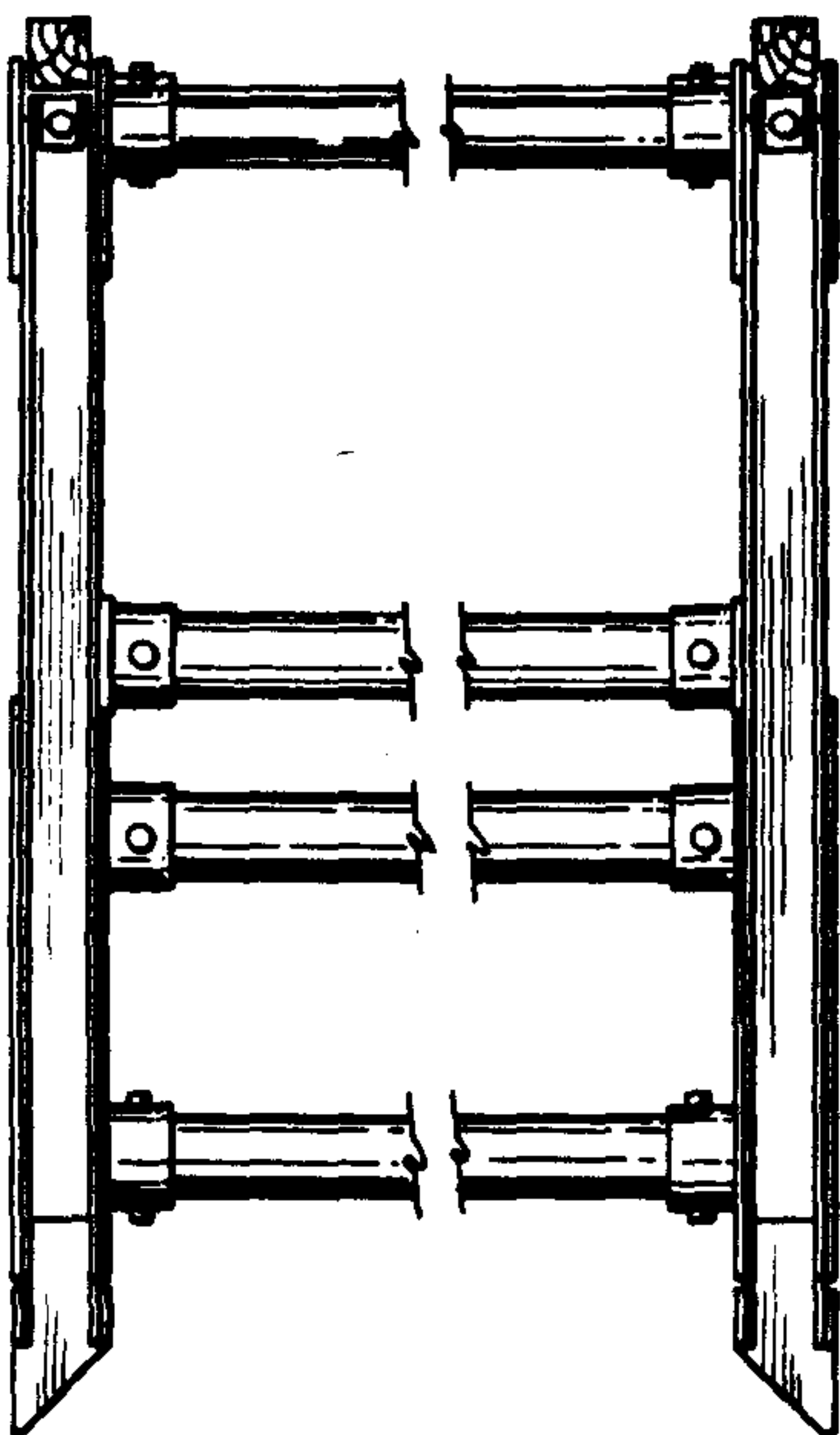

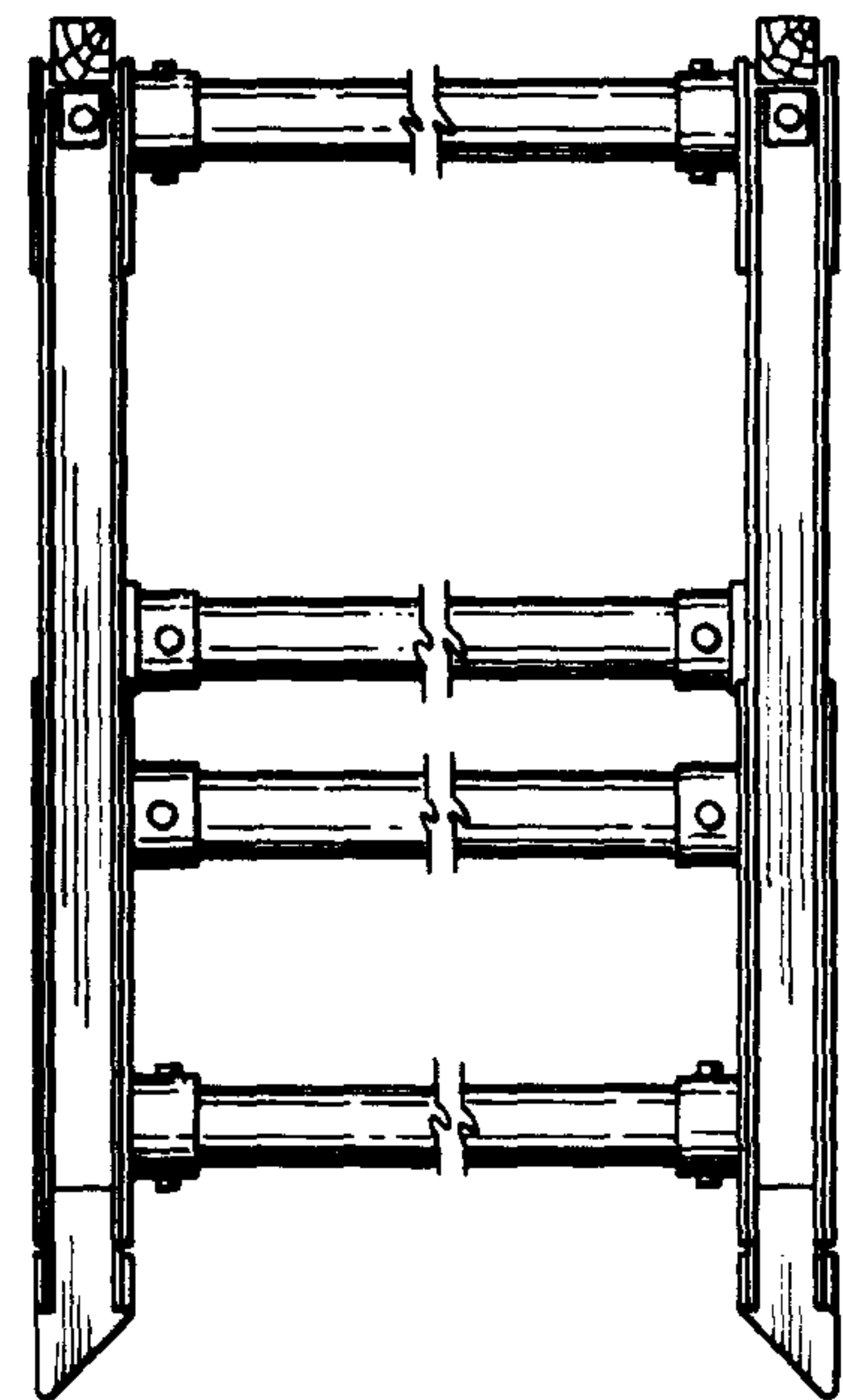
