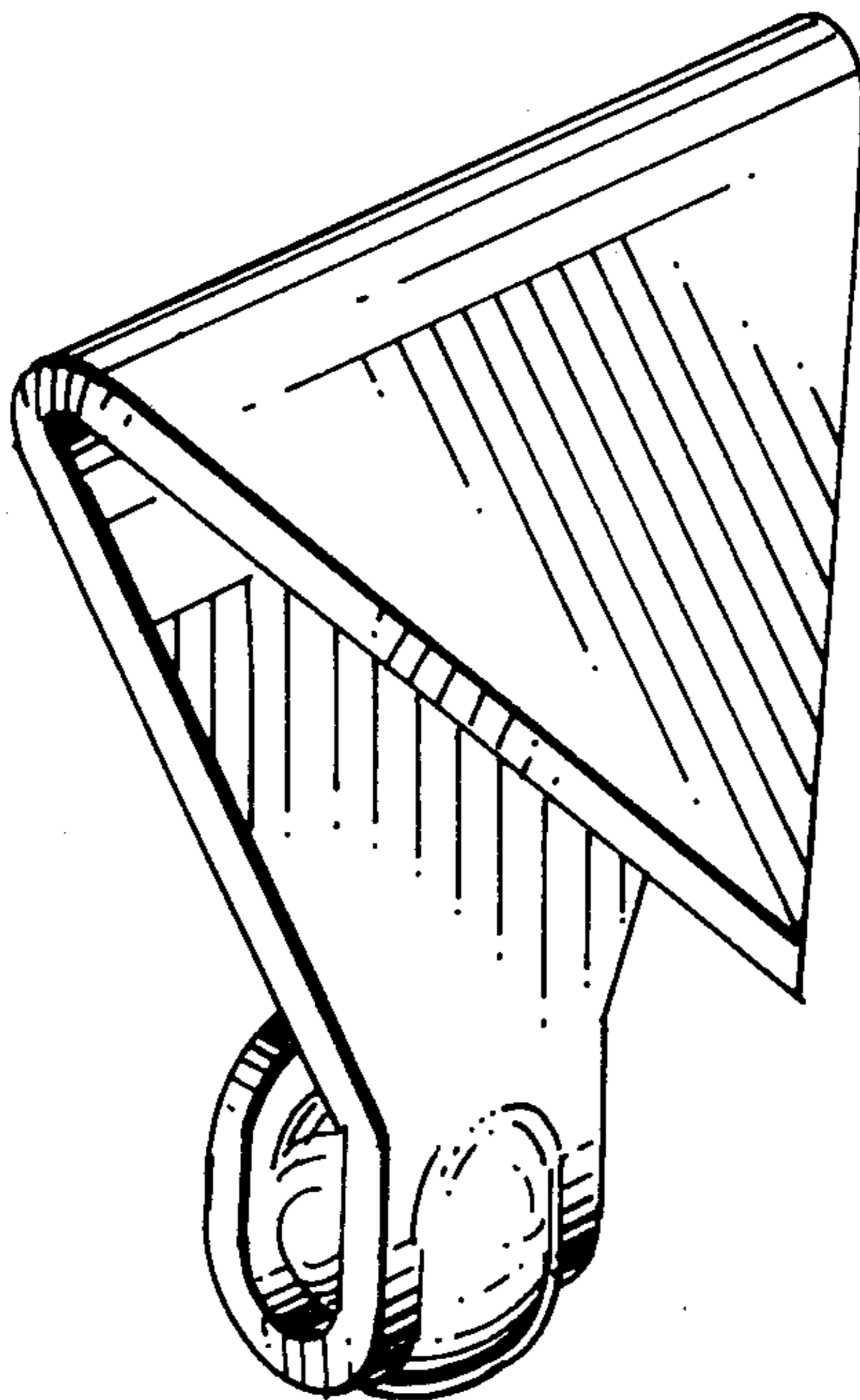

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a one piece wall bracket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the back and one end of a one piece wall bracket embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the front and other end of the wall bracket shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top view of the wall bracket shown in FIGS. 1 and 2; FIG. 4 is a view of the back of the wall bracket shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is an end view of the wall bracket shown in FIG. 1; and FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the wall bracket shown in FIG. 1.



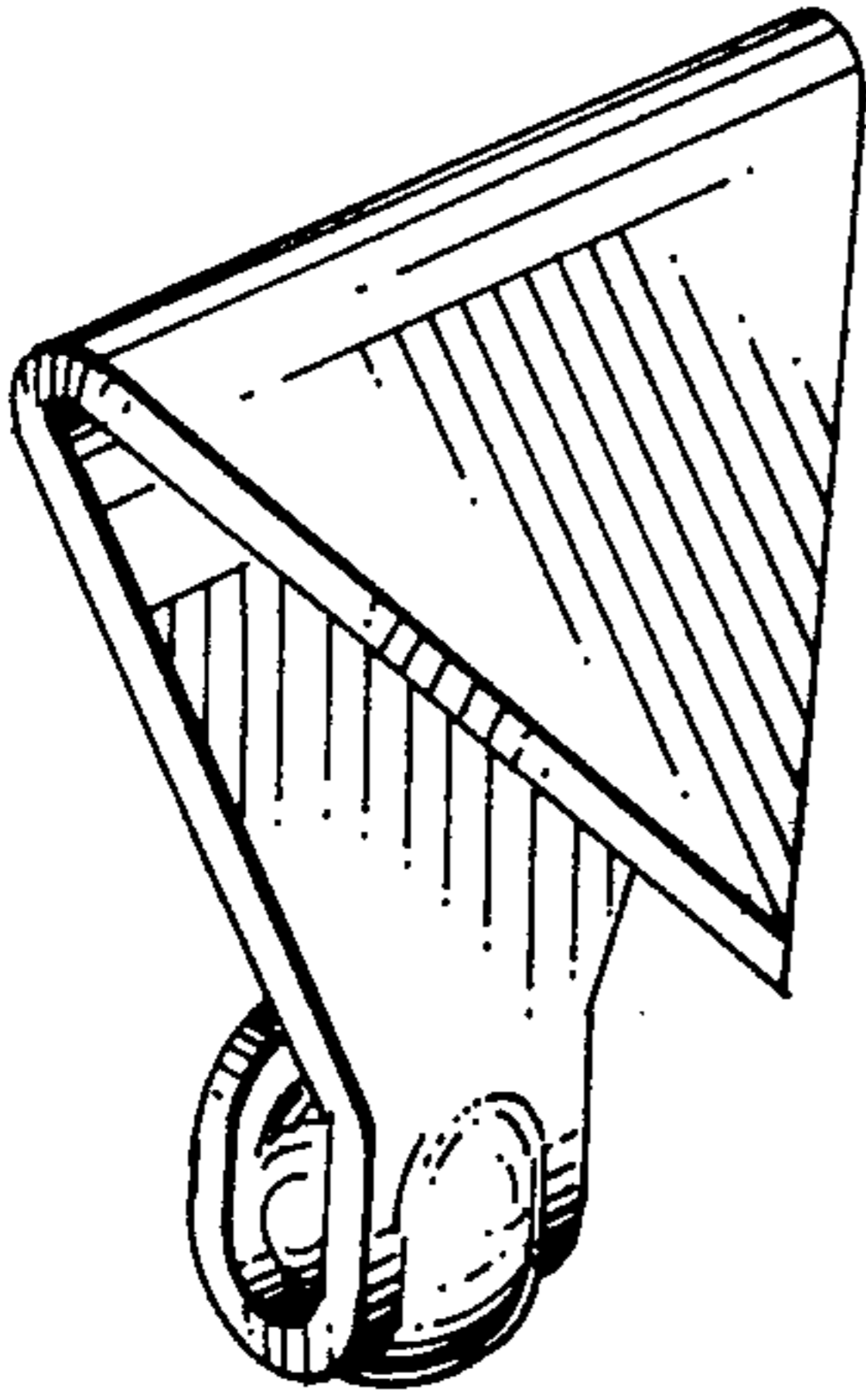

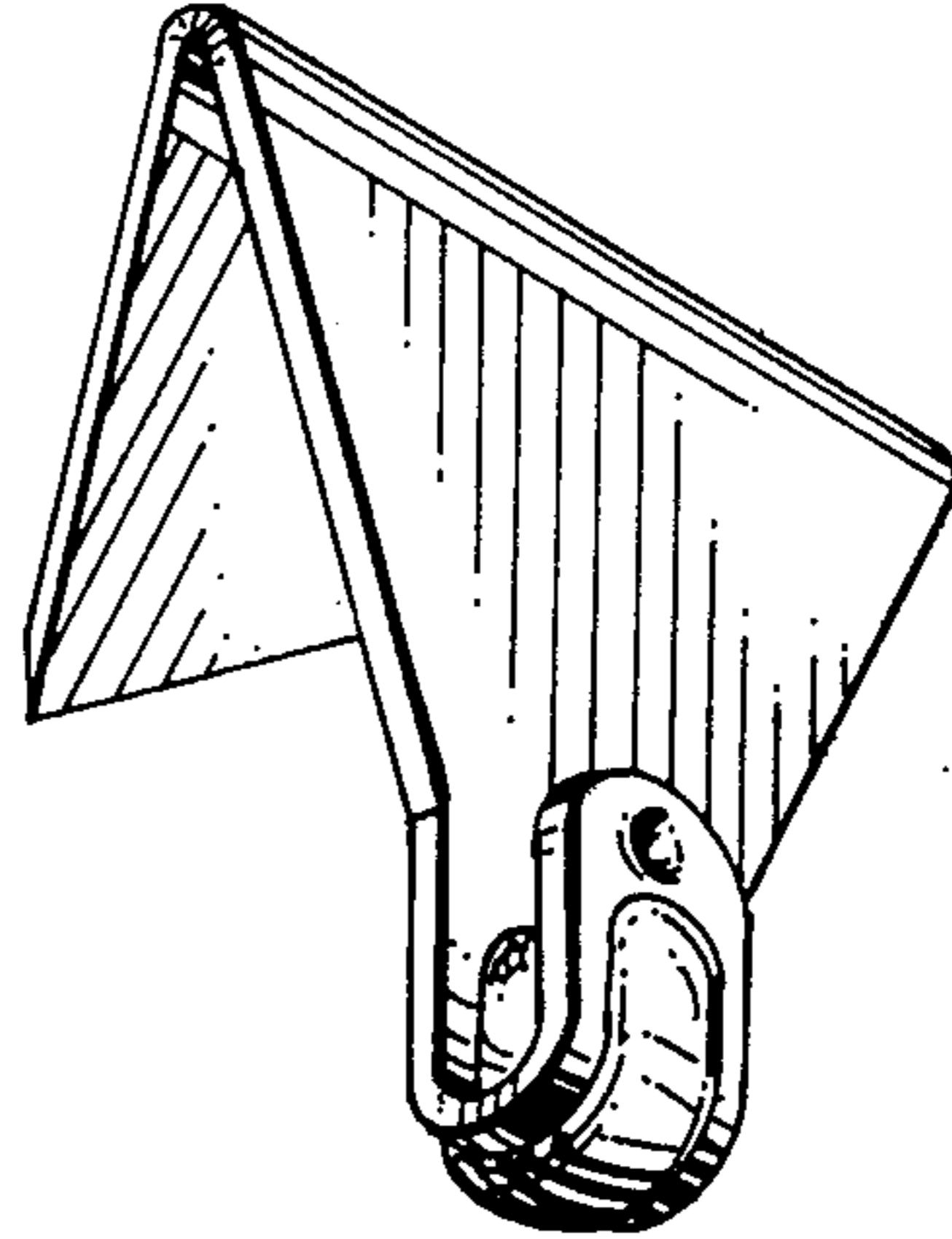

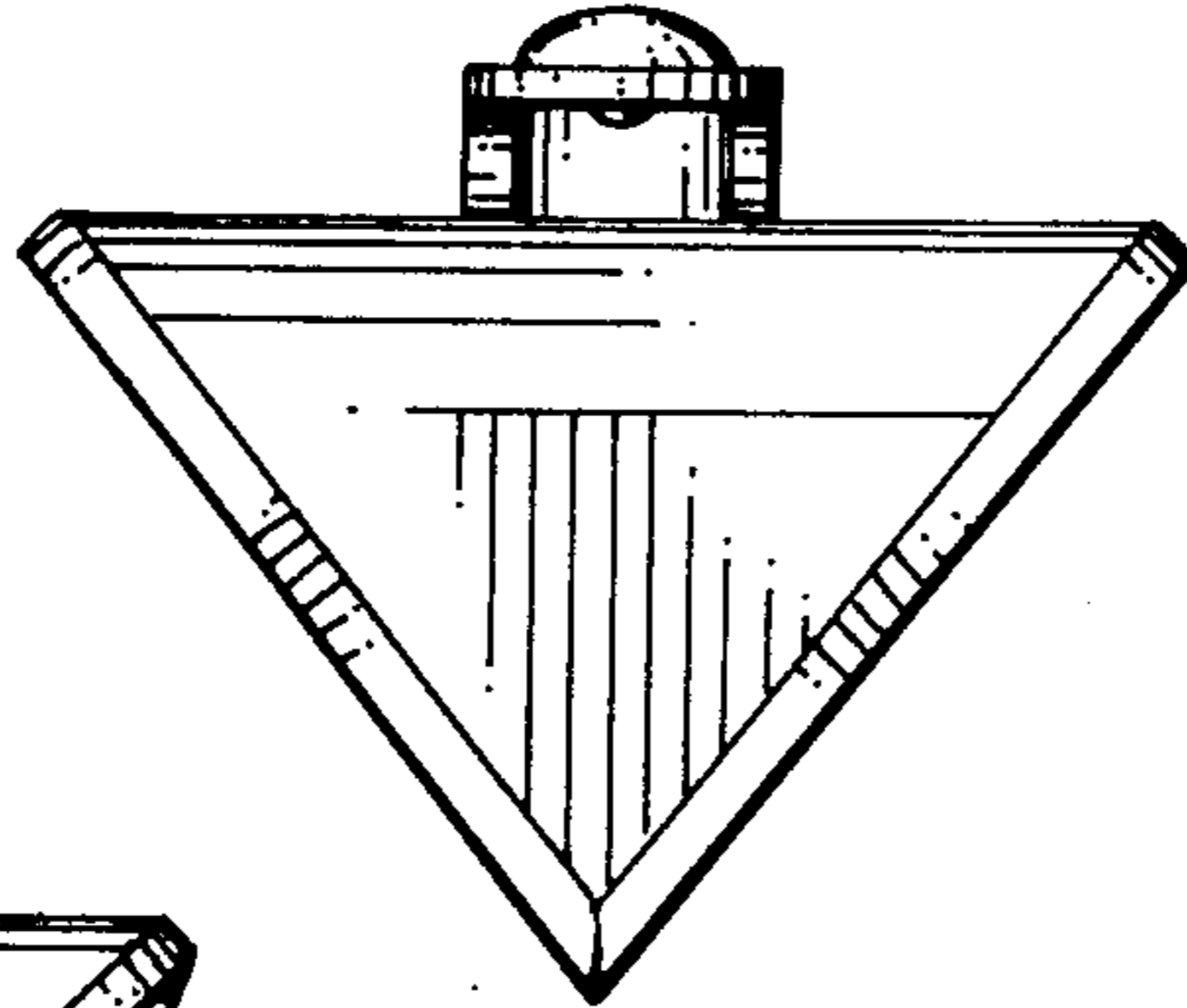

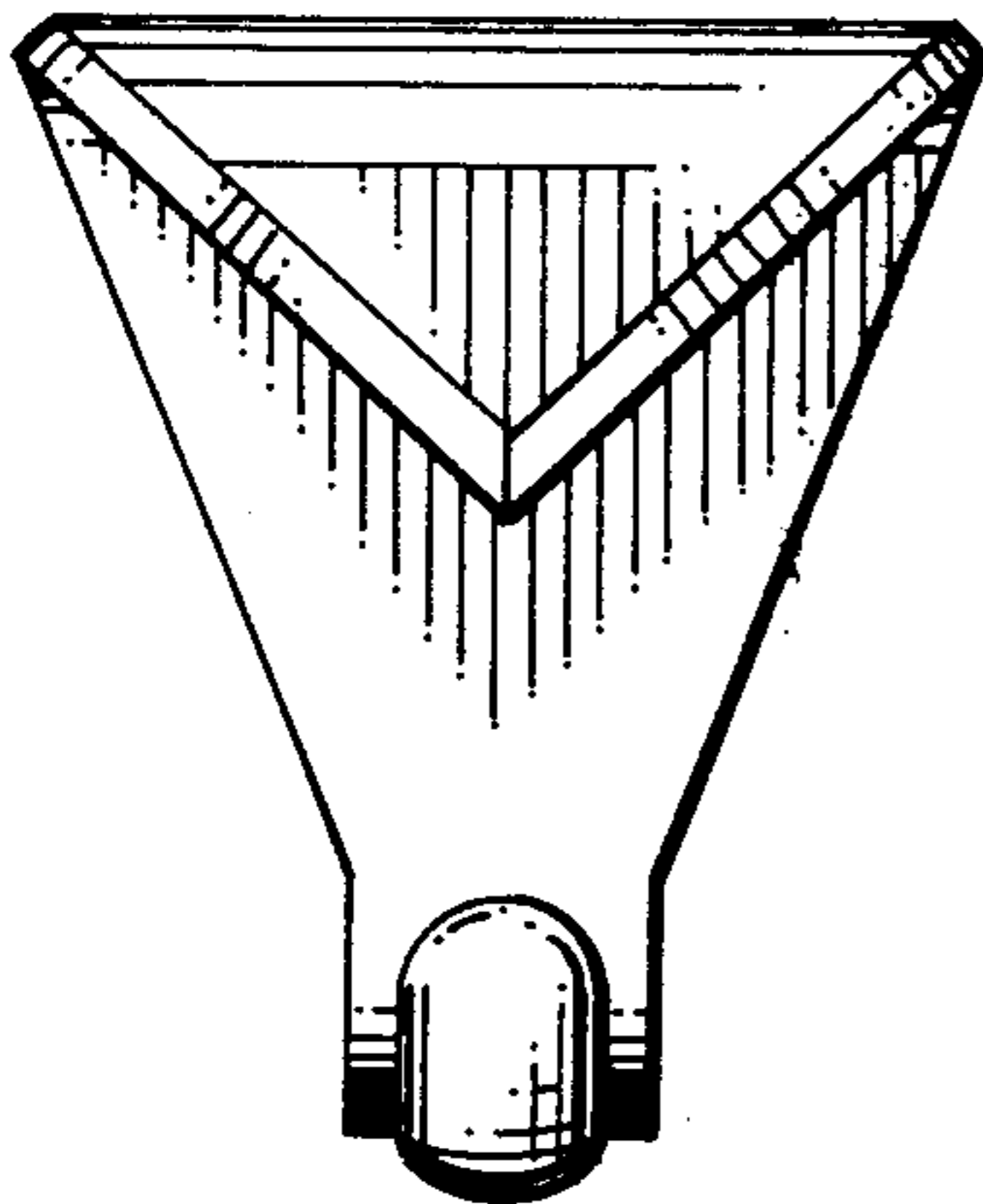

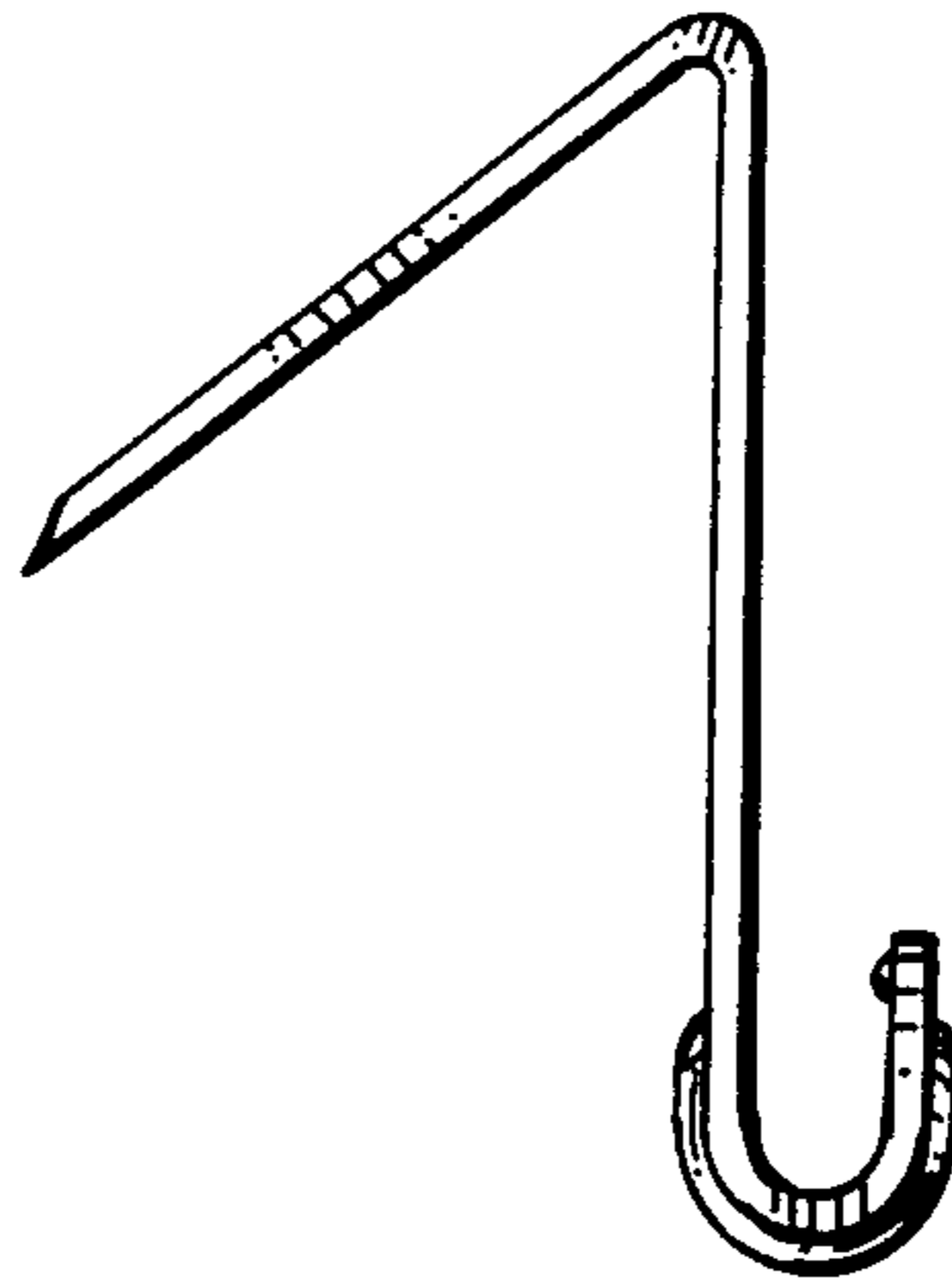

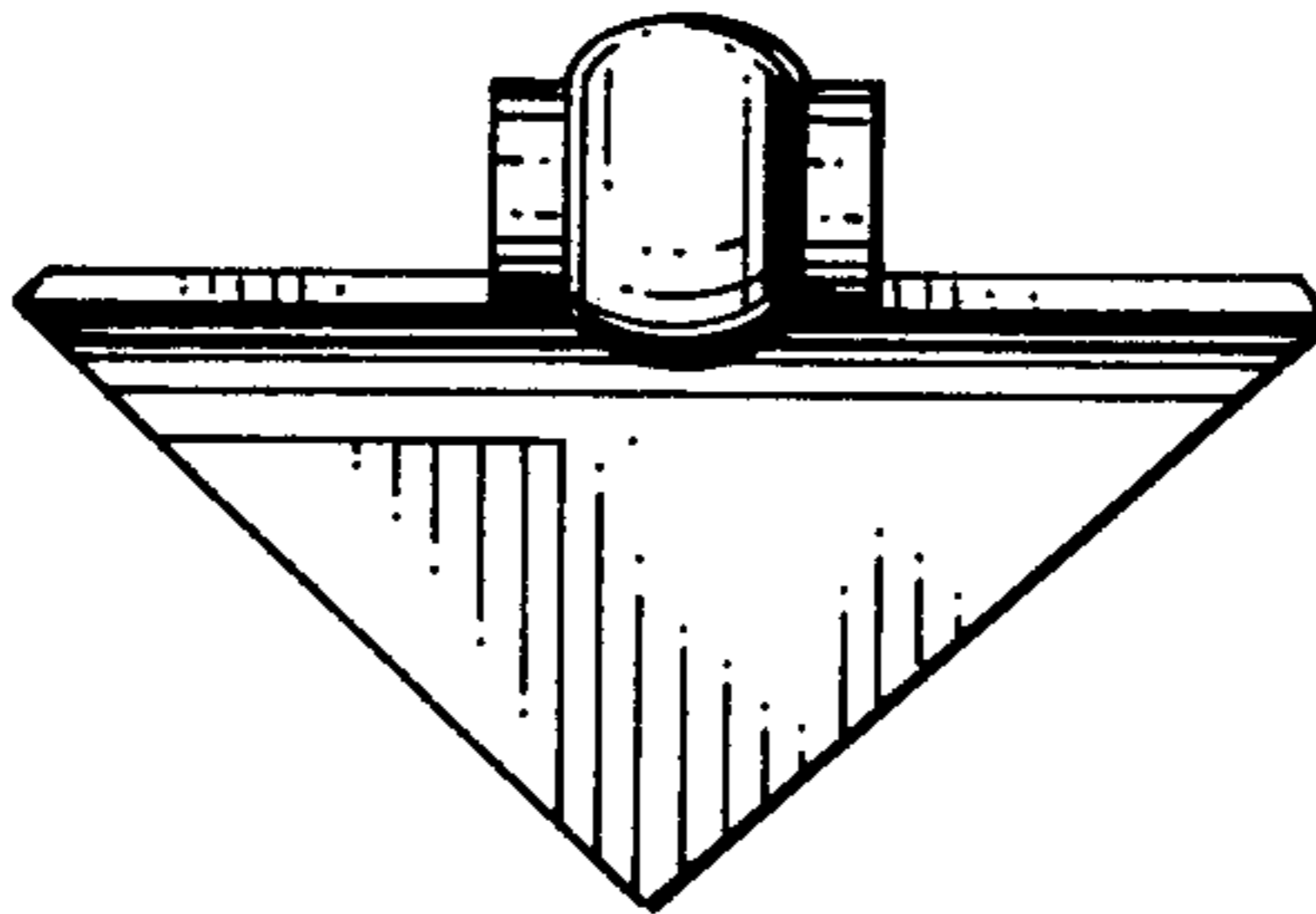
