[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined gas station canopy and pumps therefor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the gas station and pumps showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the pump hose and nozzle and readout therefor,

FIG. 3 is a side view of the pump hose and nozzle and readout therefor,

FIG. 4 is a rear view of the pump hose and nozzle and readout therefor,

FIG. 5 is a front view of the readout;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the readout; and

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of another embodiment of a readout.

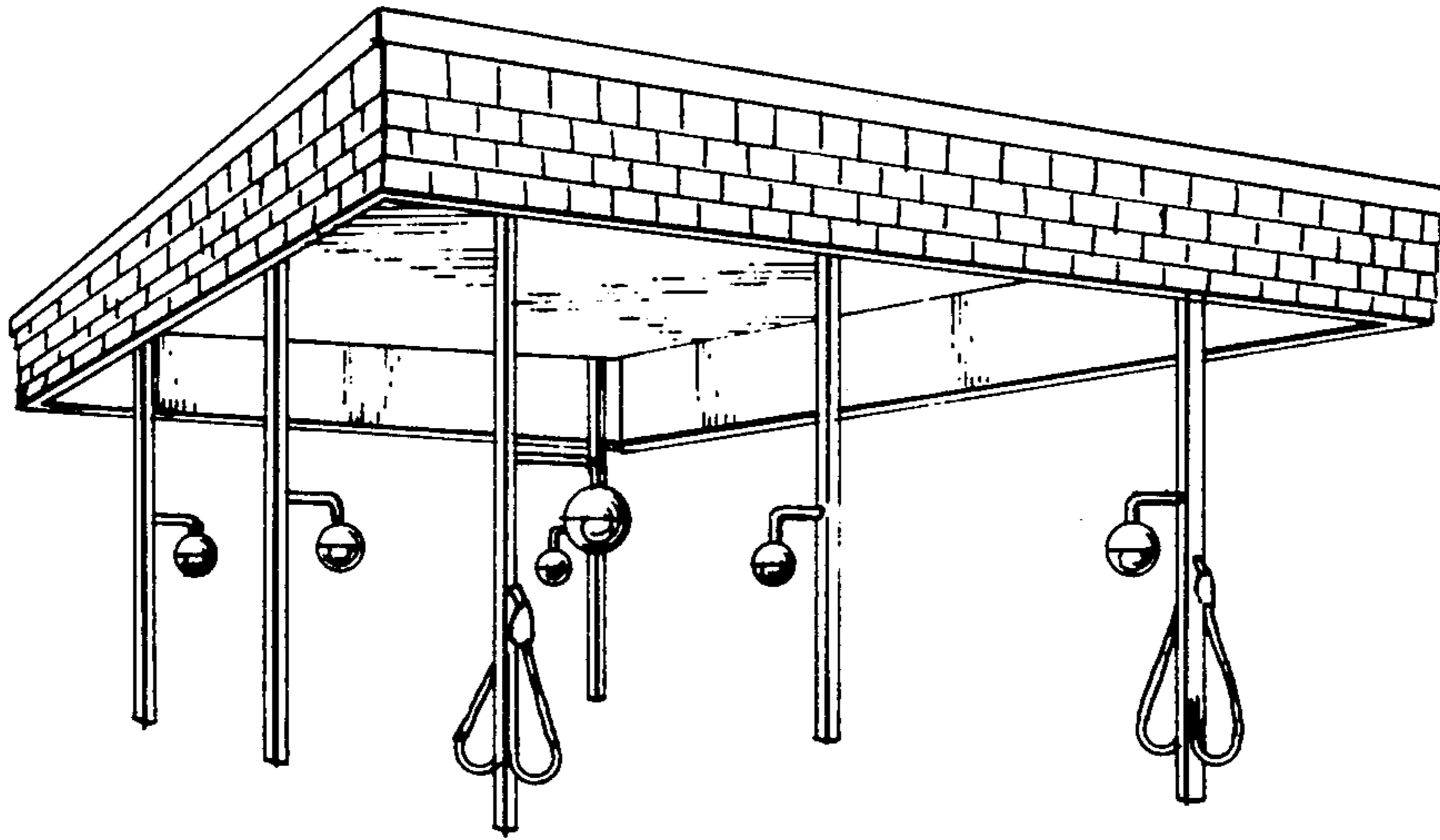

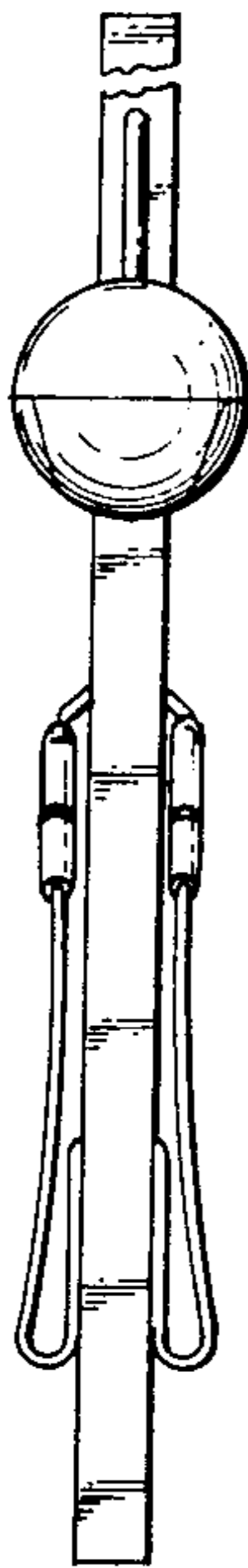
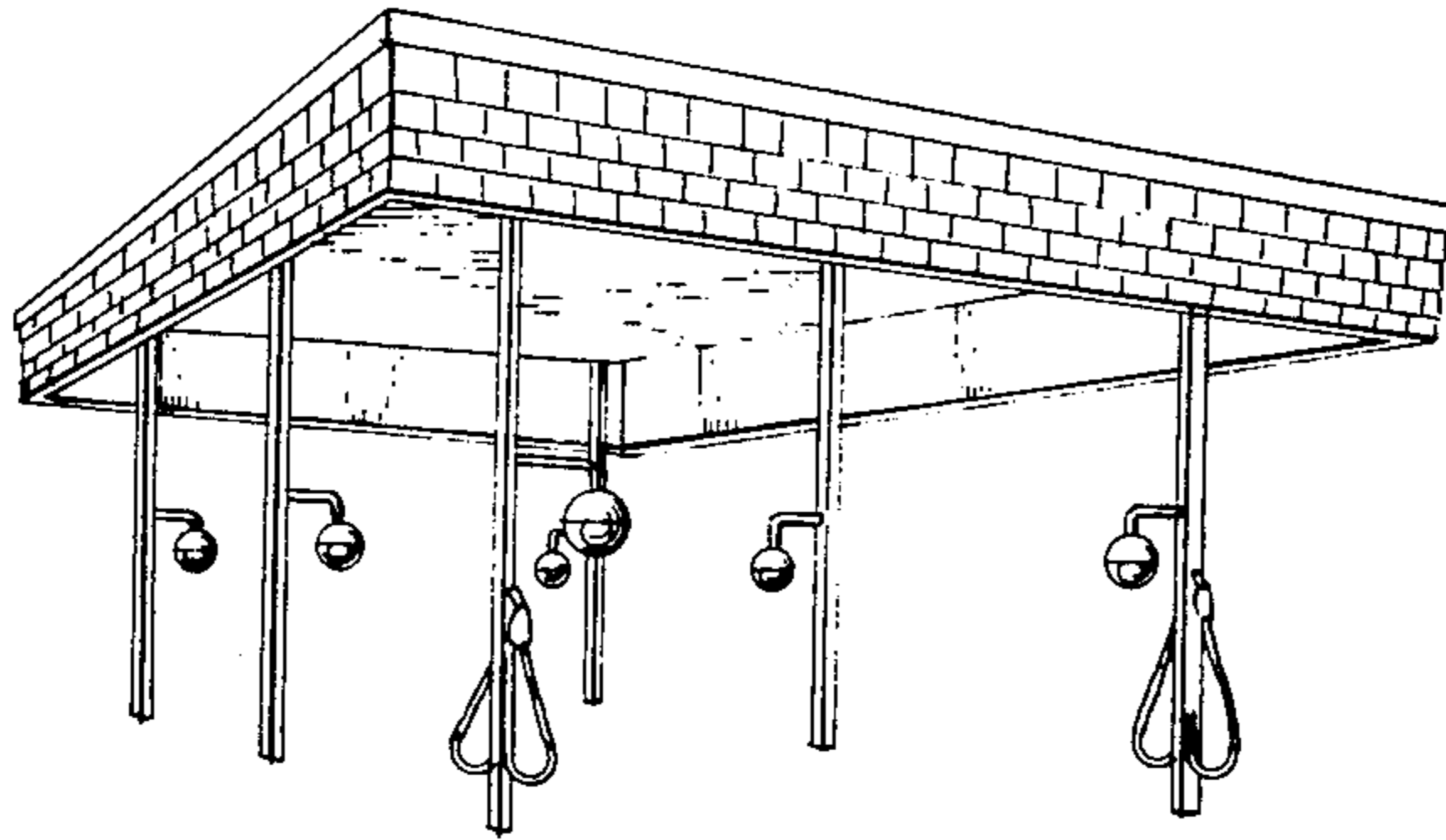

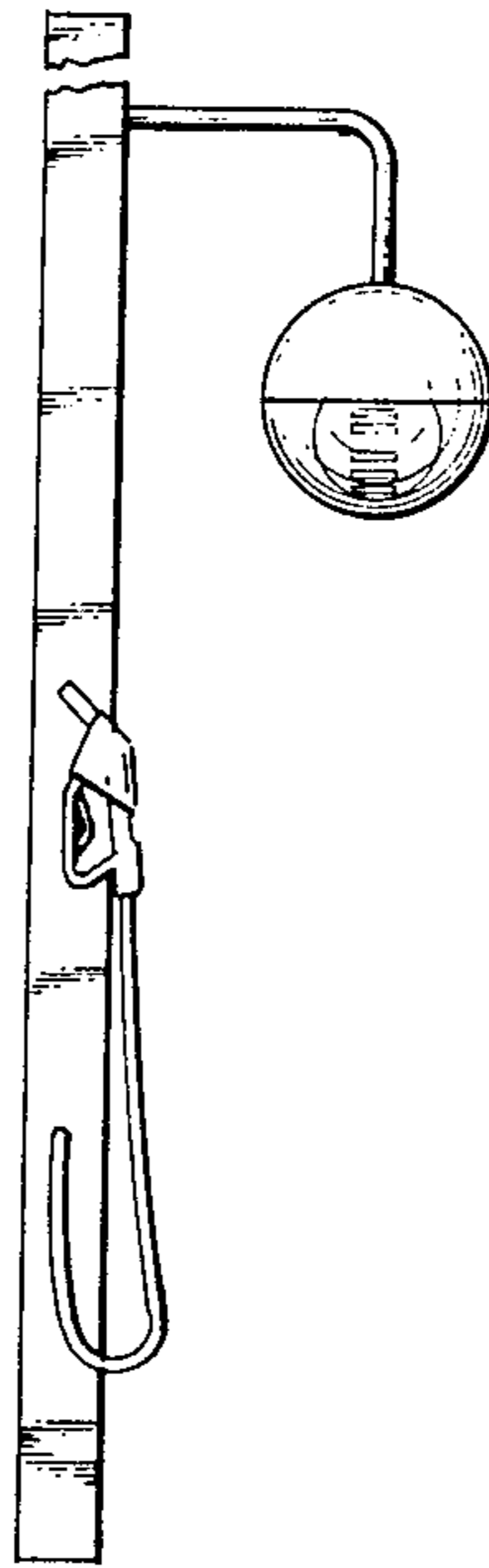

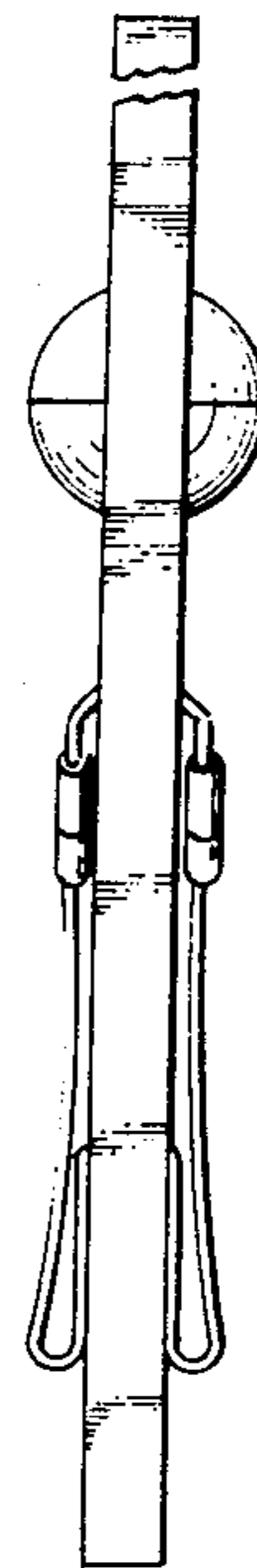

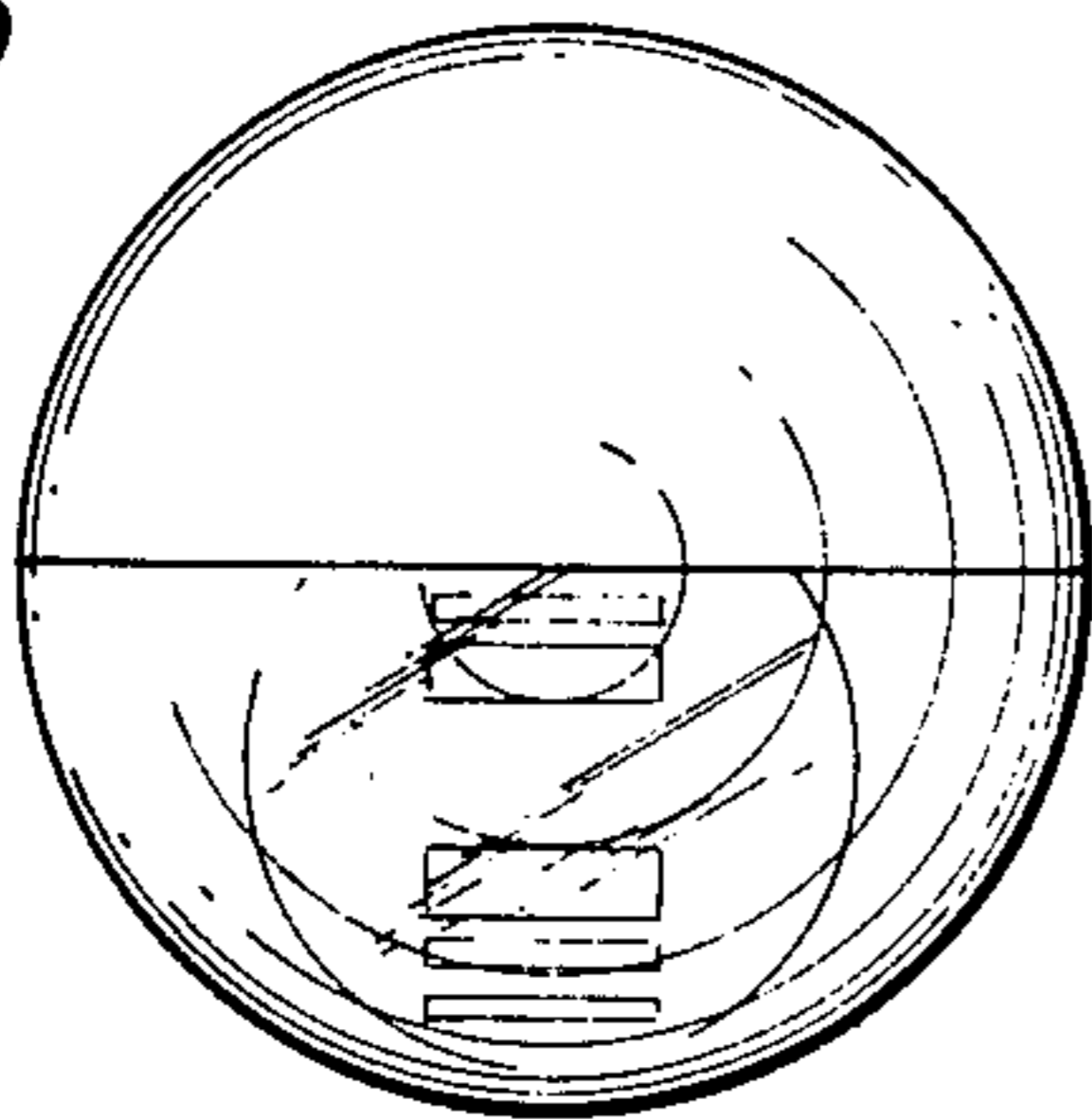

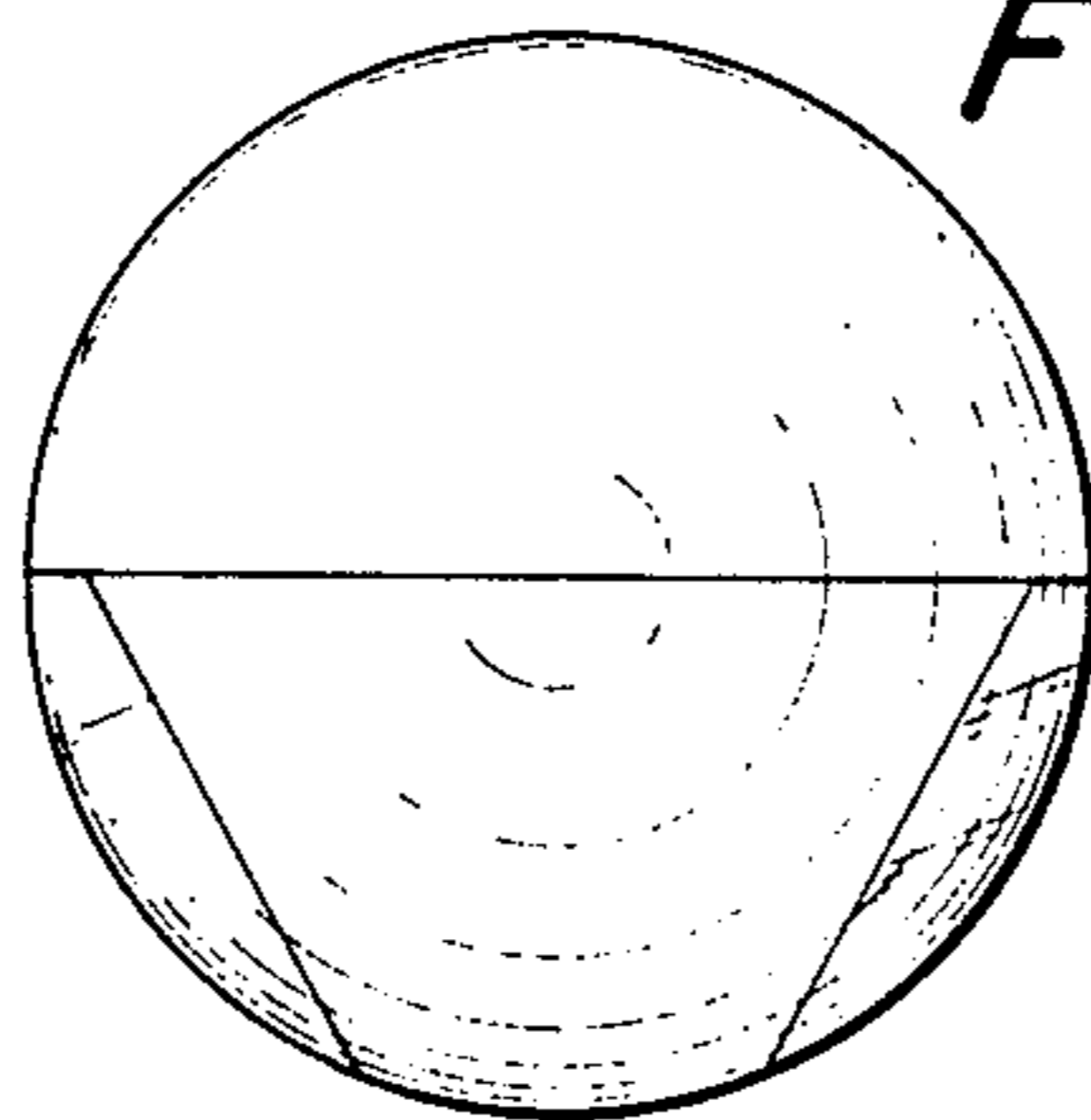
