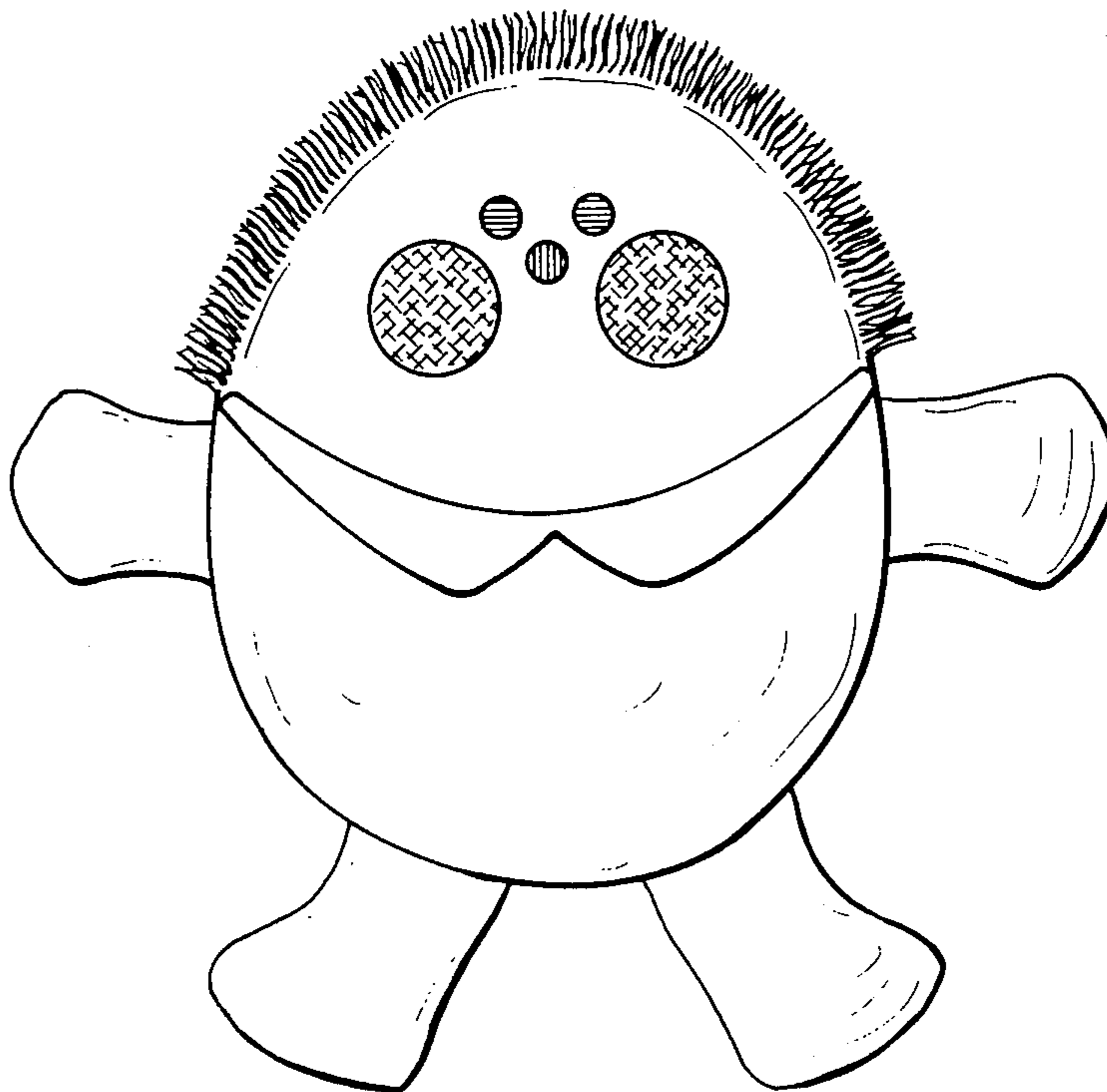

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy figure showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right side being symmetrical to the left side; and
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.



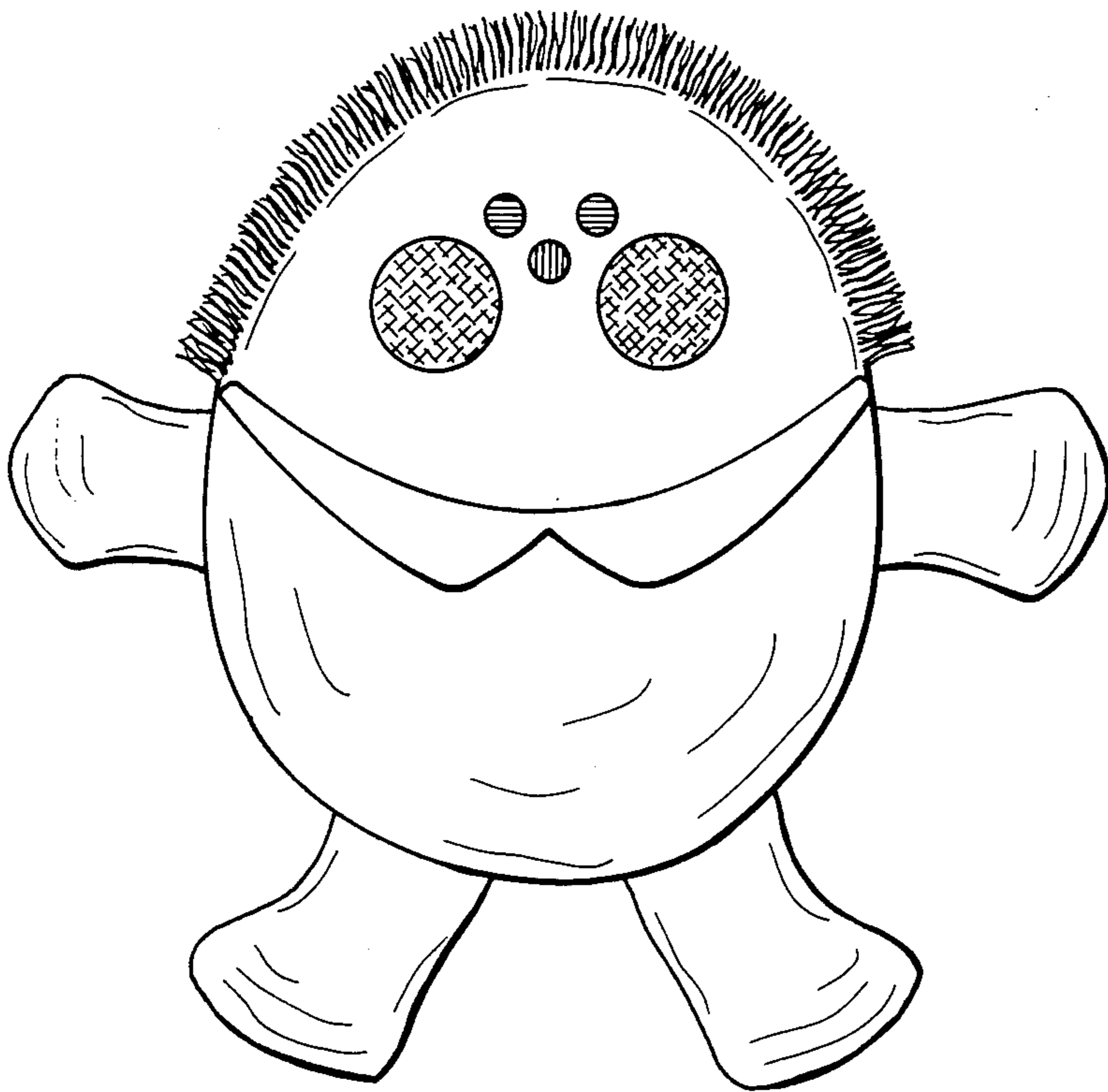

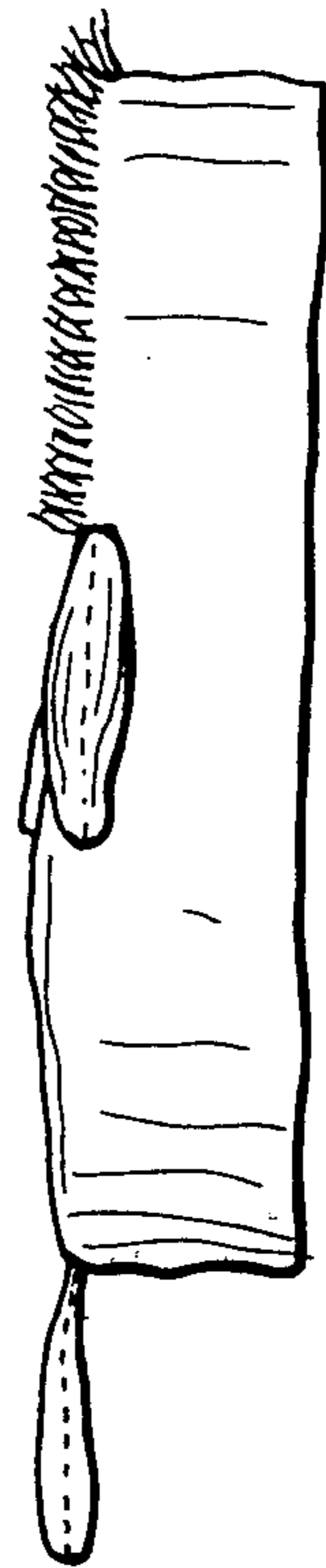

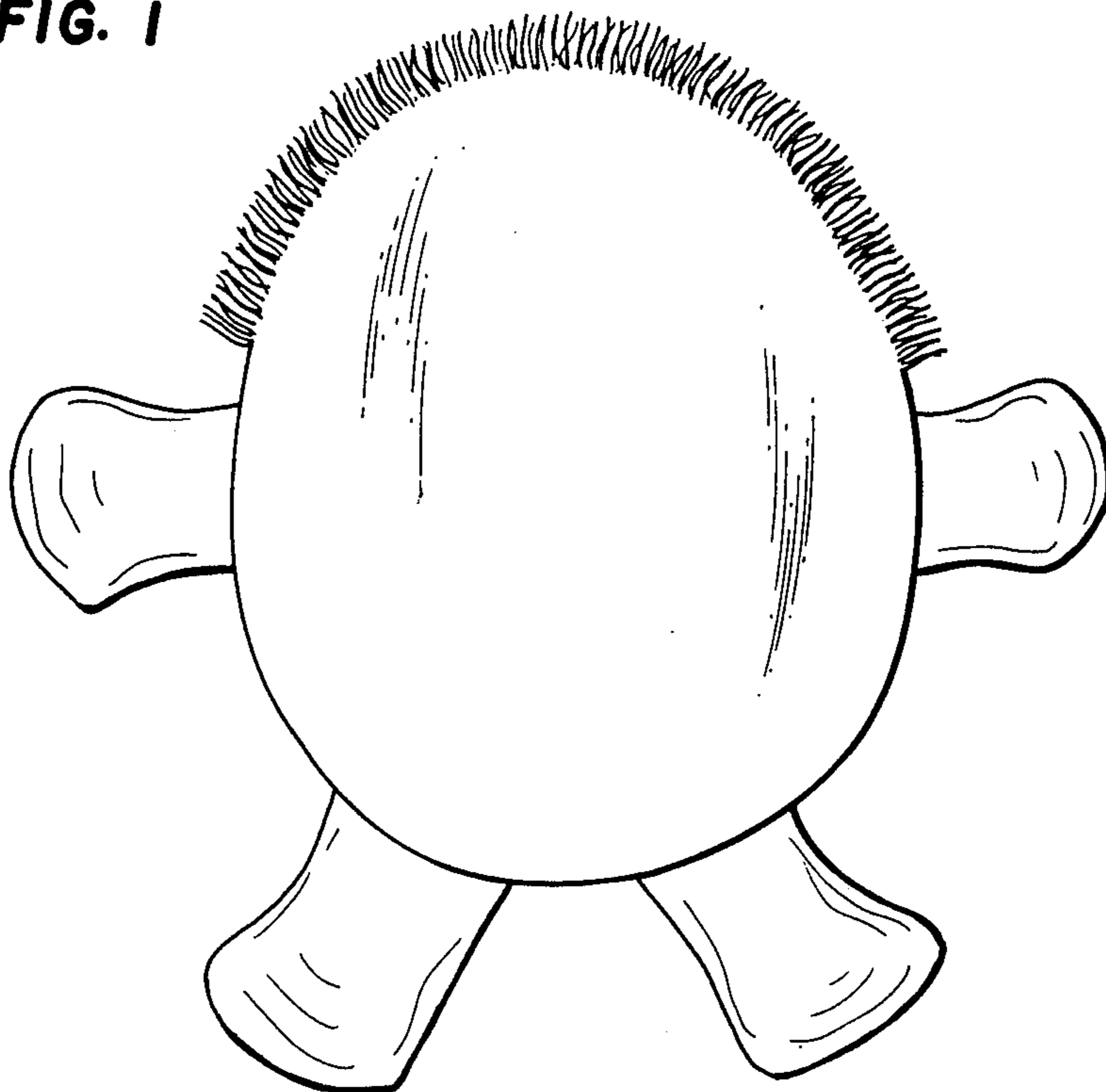
