[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a foldable handle hair dryer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view on a reduced scale of a foldable handle hair dryer showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of the dryer in folded position.

The notched cord convertor, shown completely in FIG. 8, is shown only partially in FIGS. 2 and 3 and has been omitted from FIGS. 1, 4, 5 and 7 for ease of illustration.

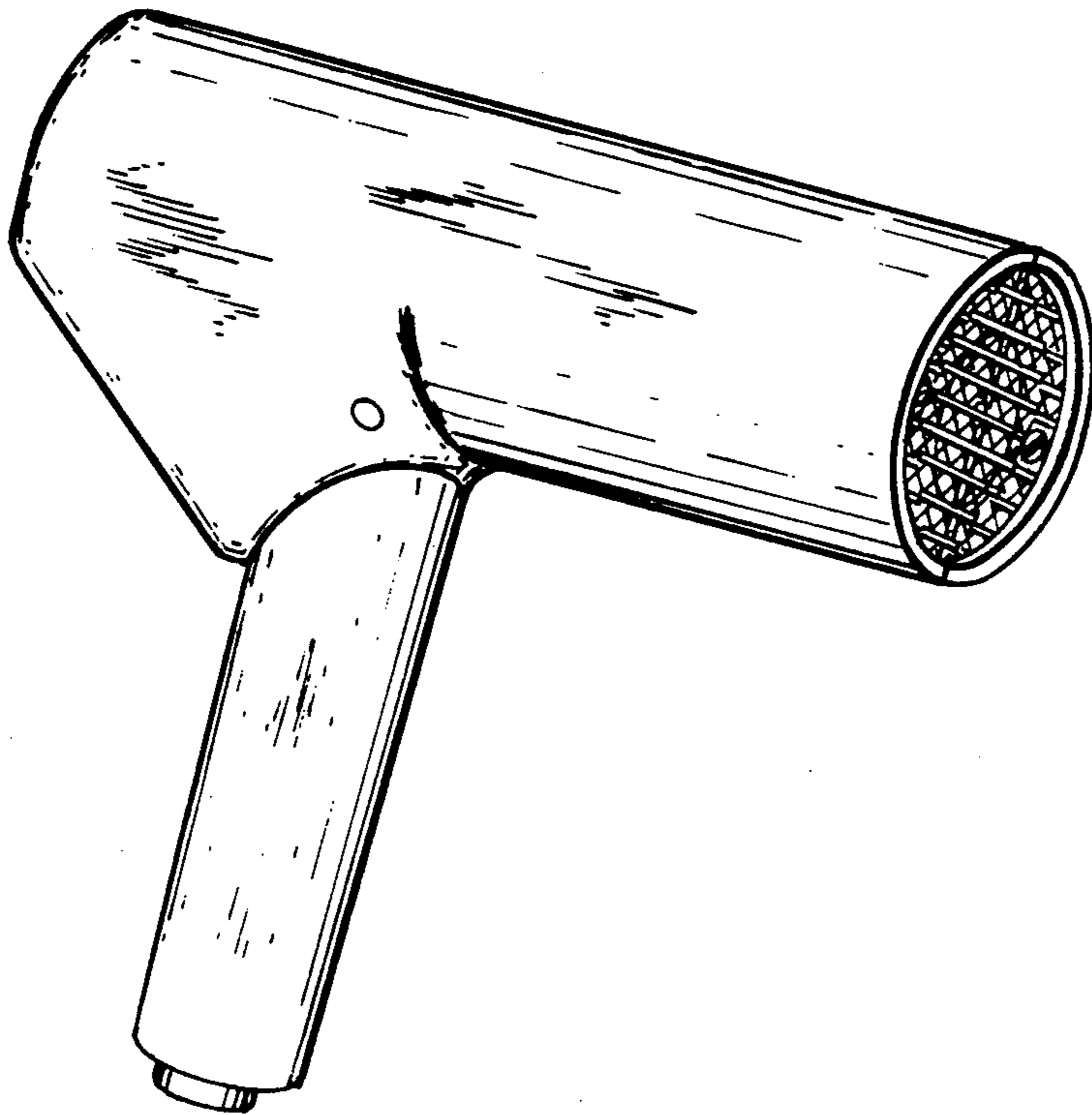

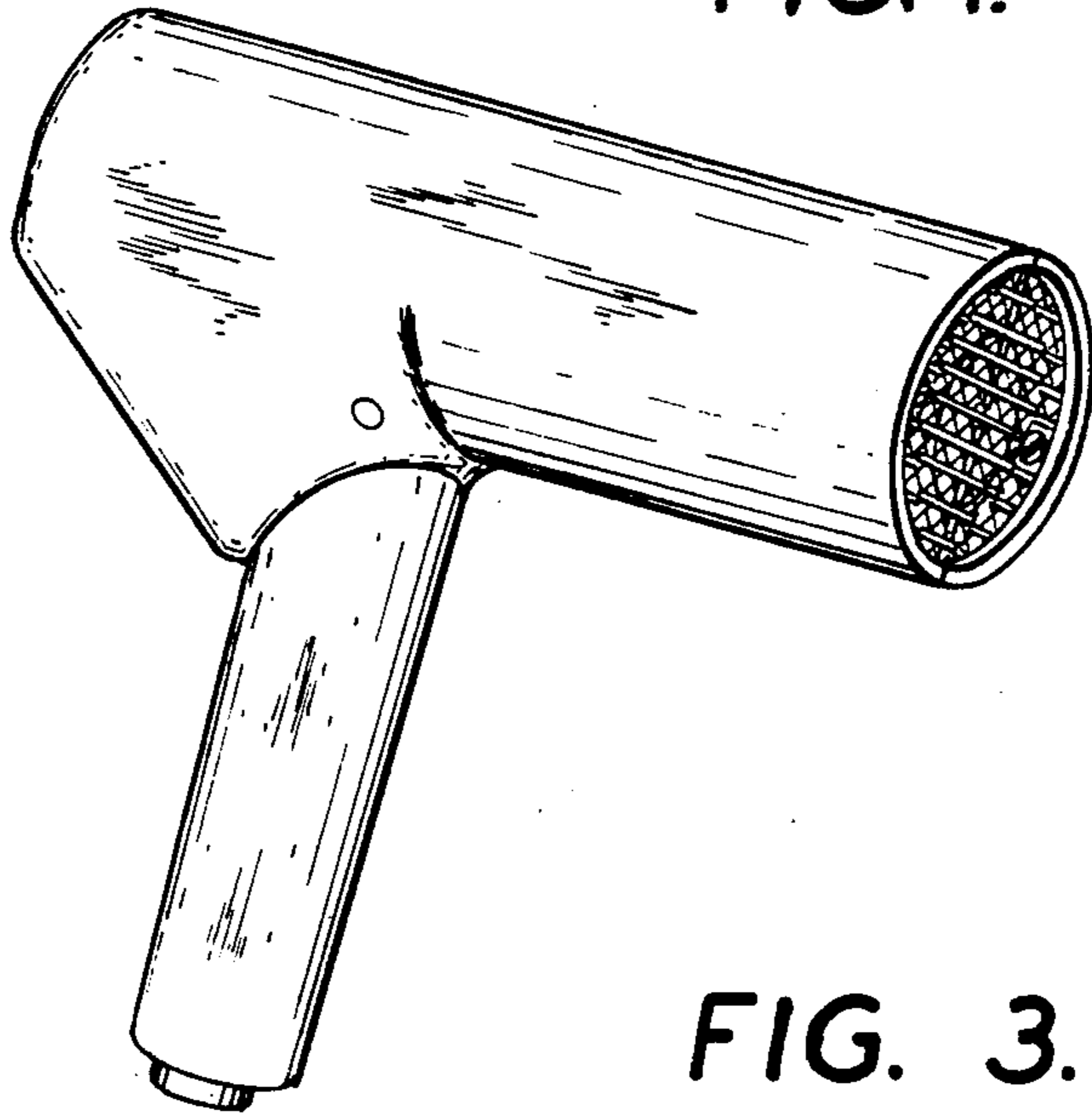

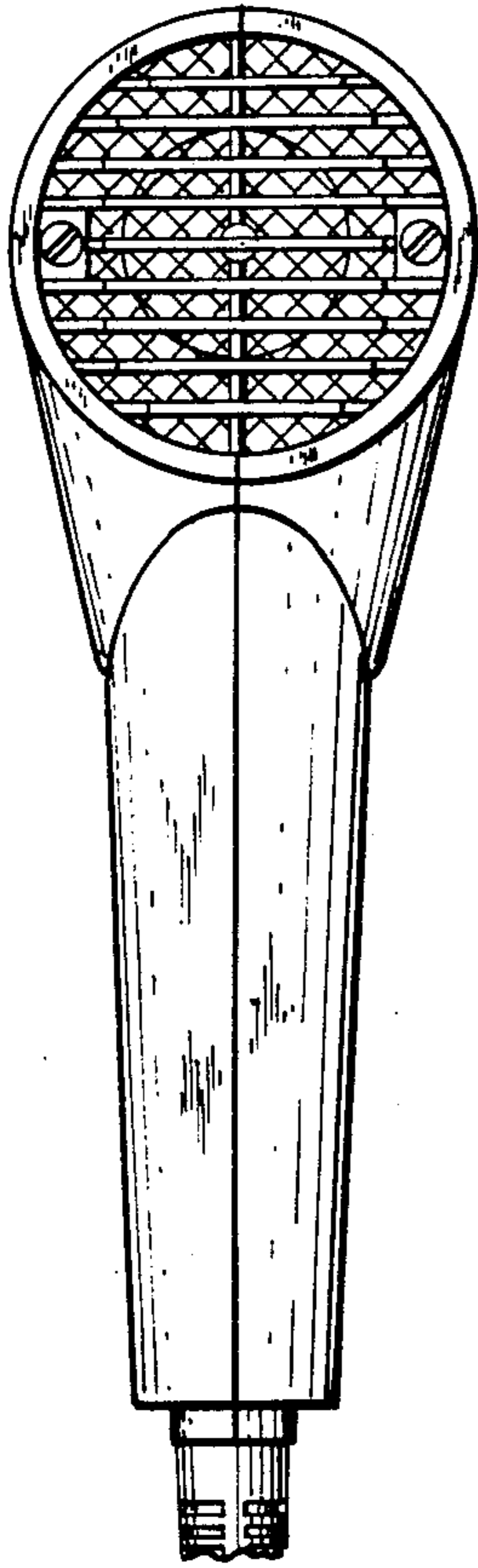

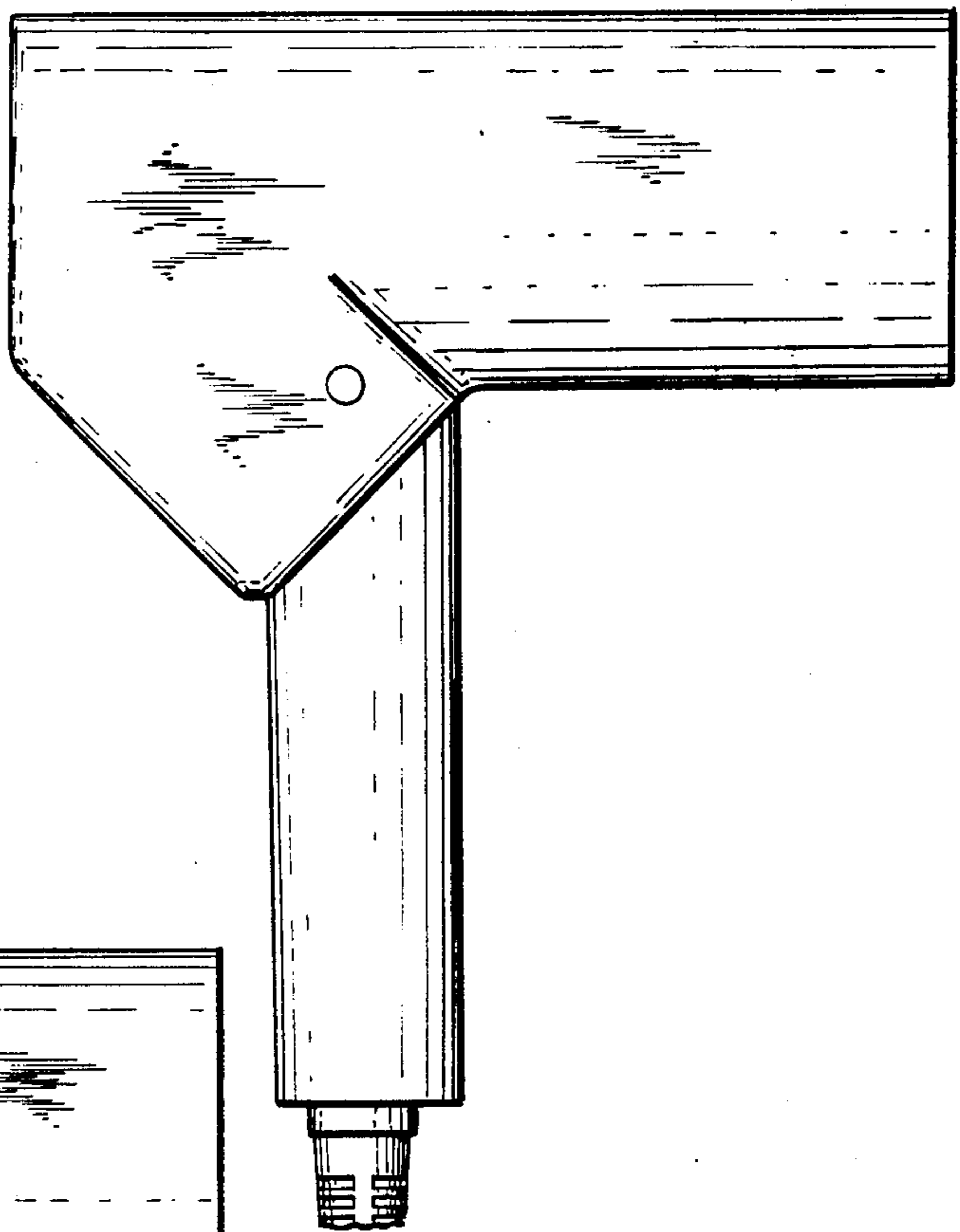
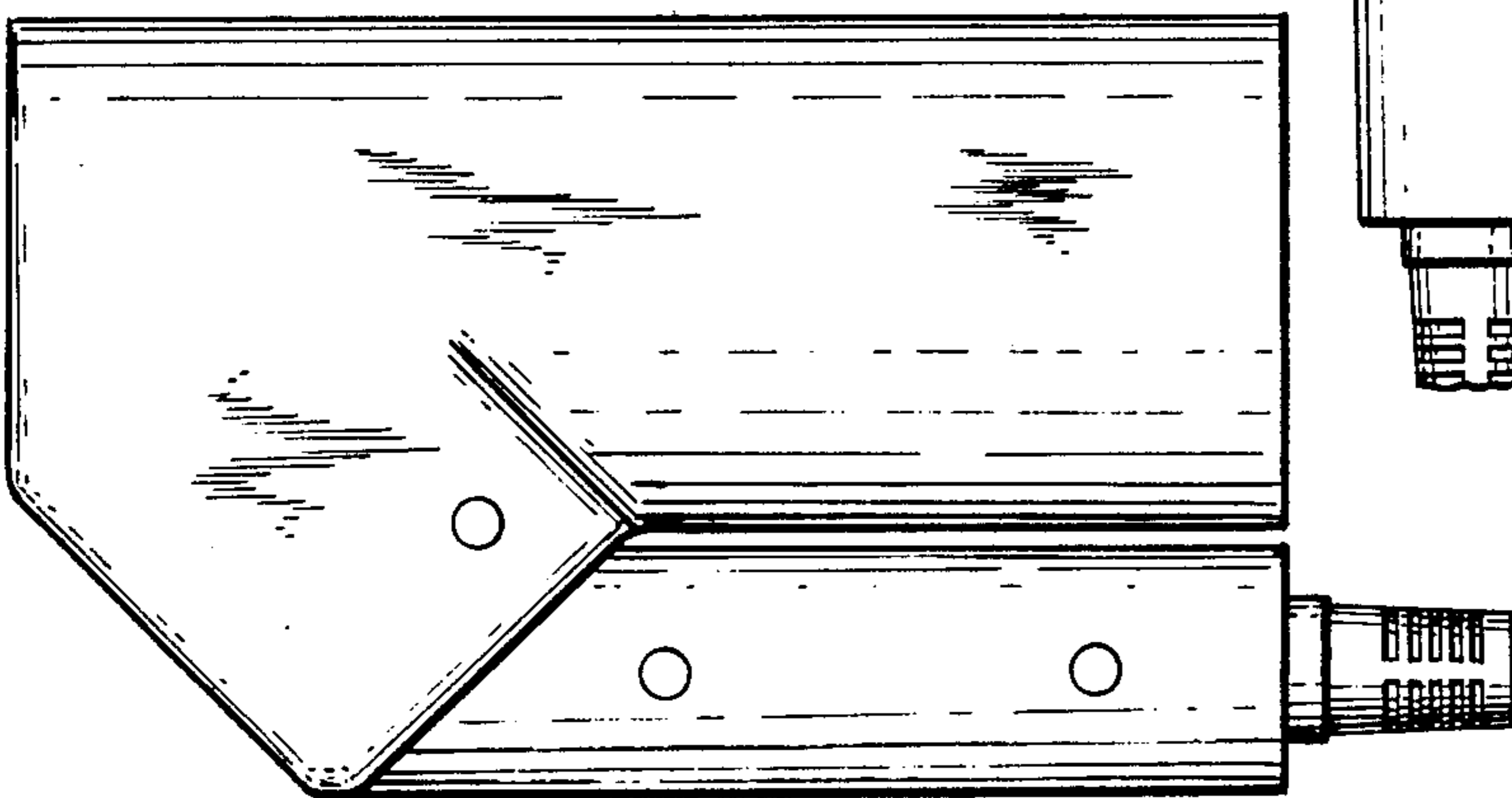
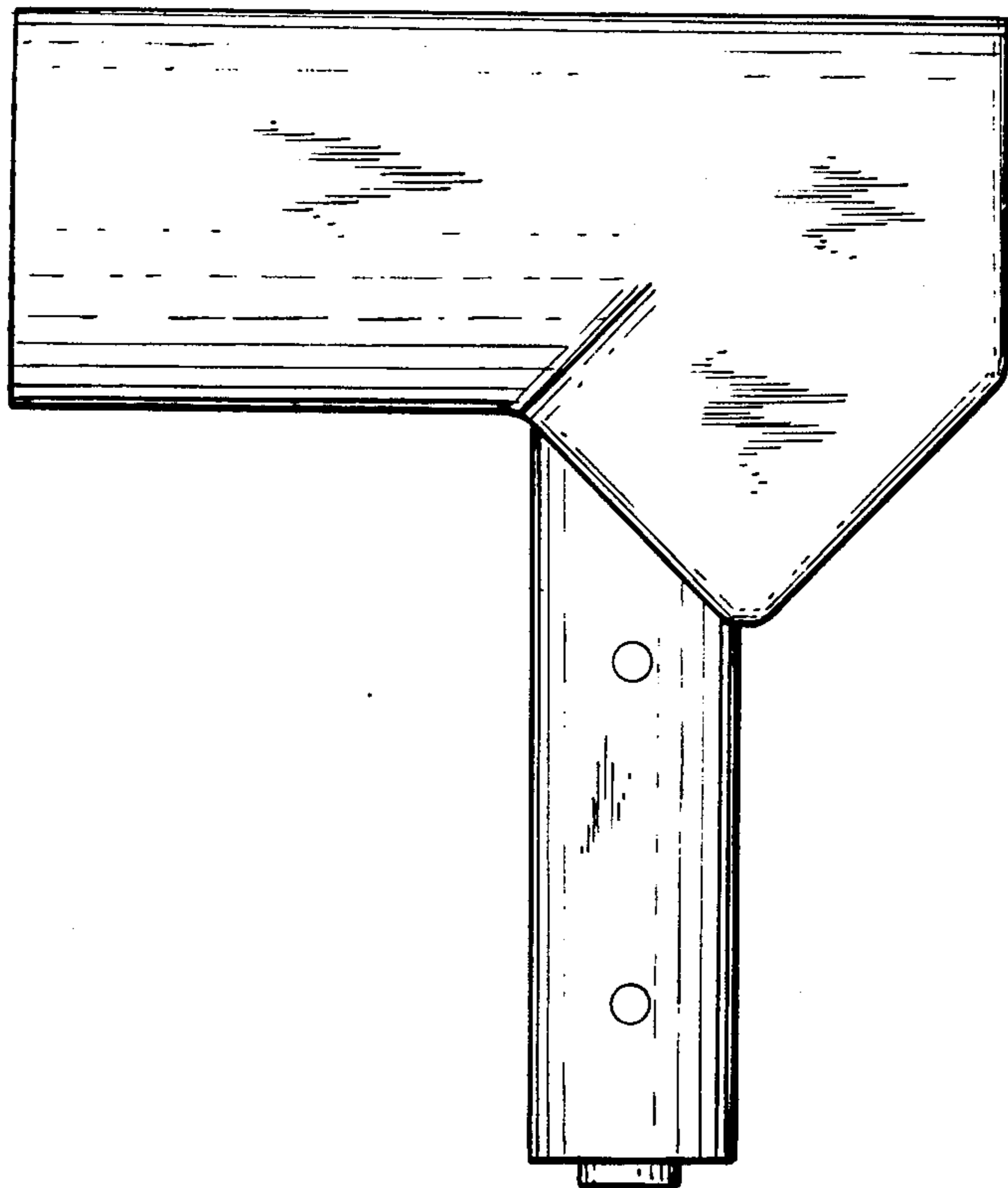


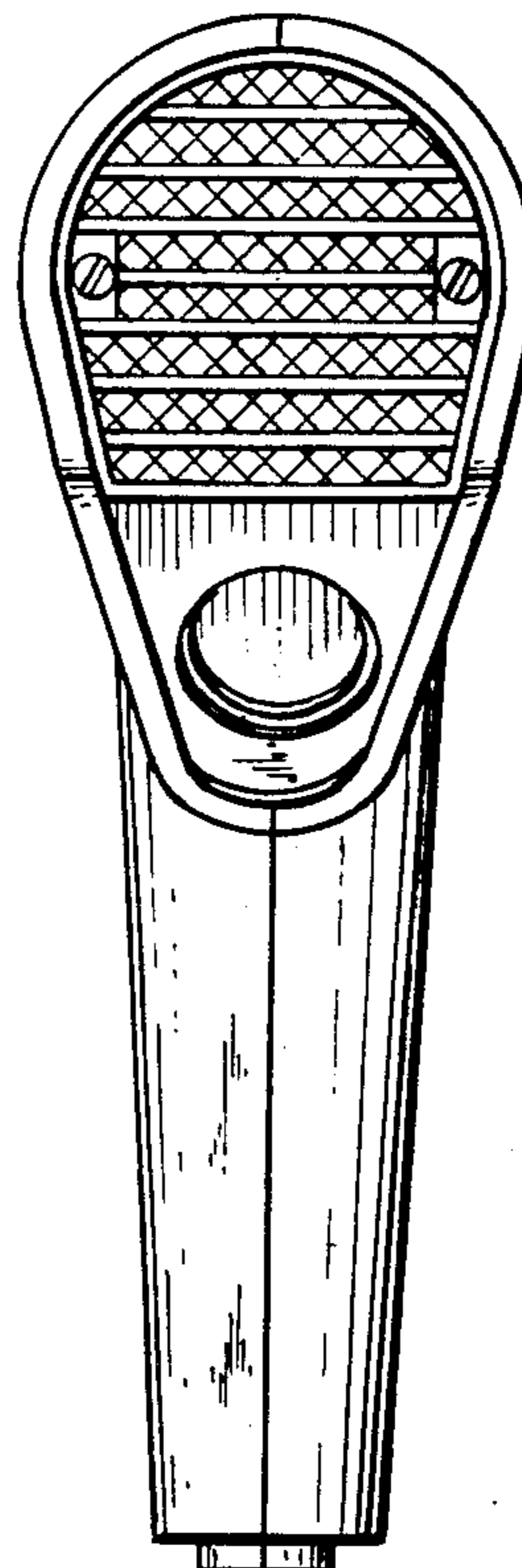

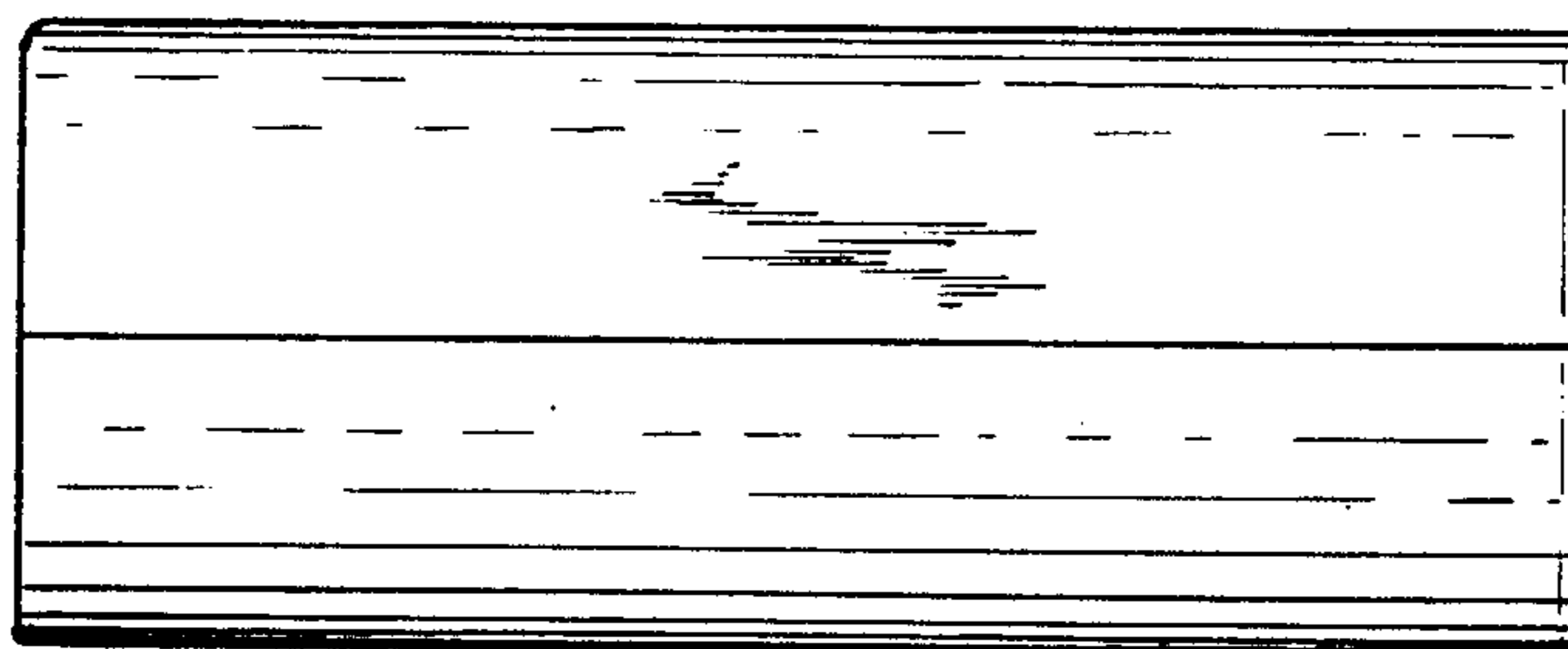
