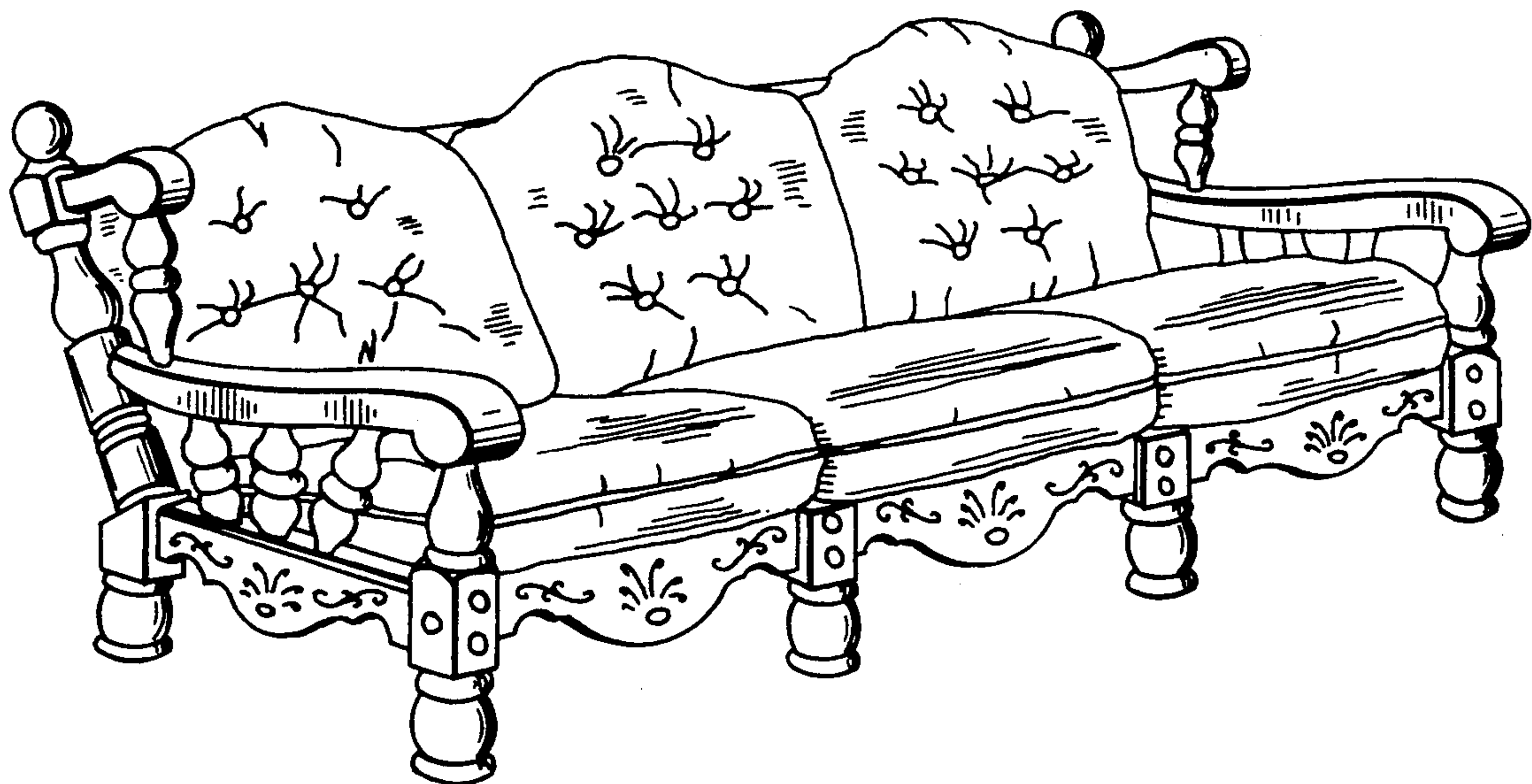

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a seat or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat or similar article showing the design in the form of a sofa;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of the design shown in the form of a loveseat; and
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the design in the form of an armchair.
The side of the seat not shown is a mirror image of the side shown.



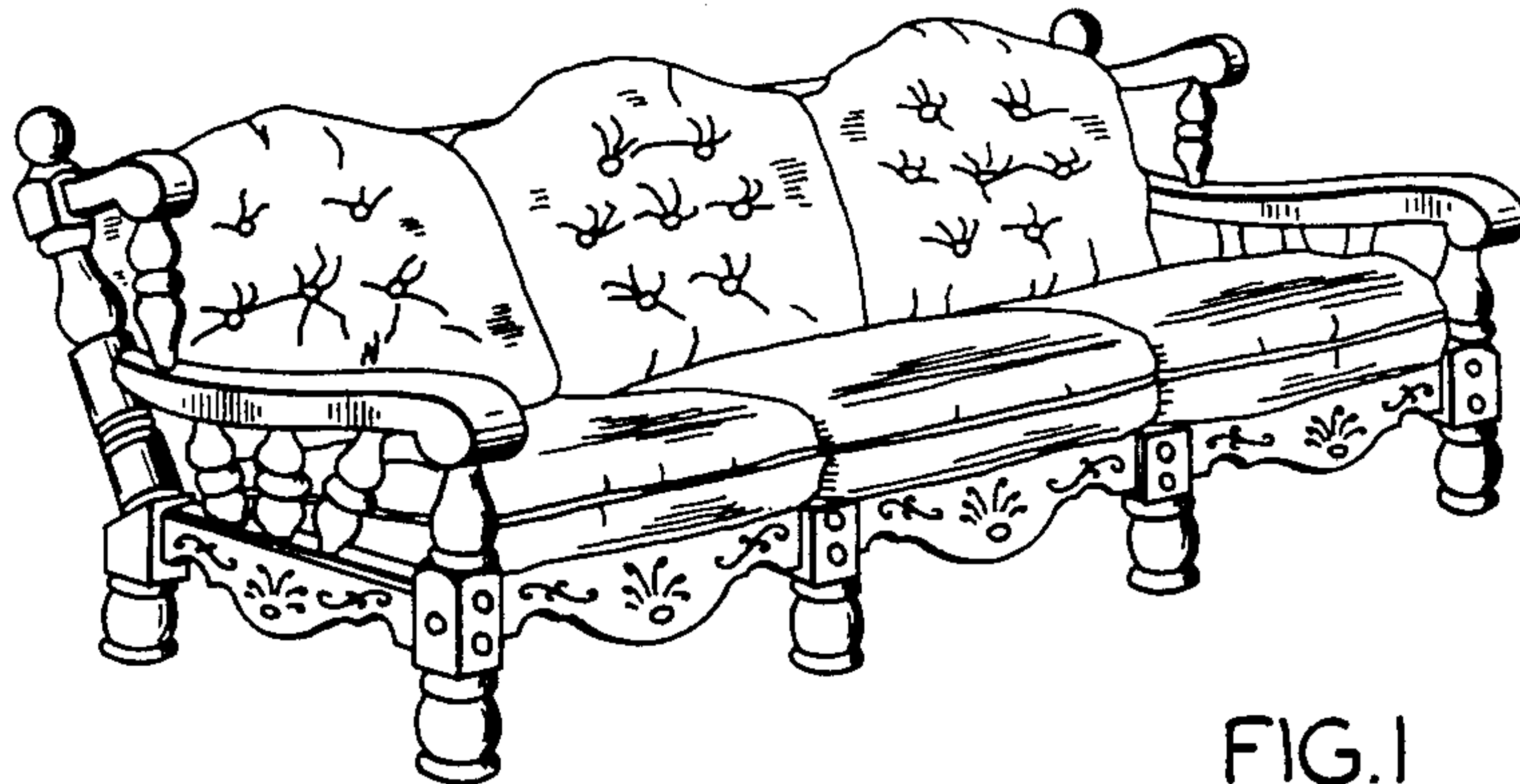

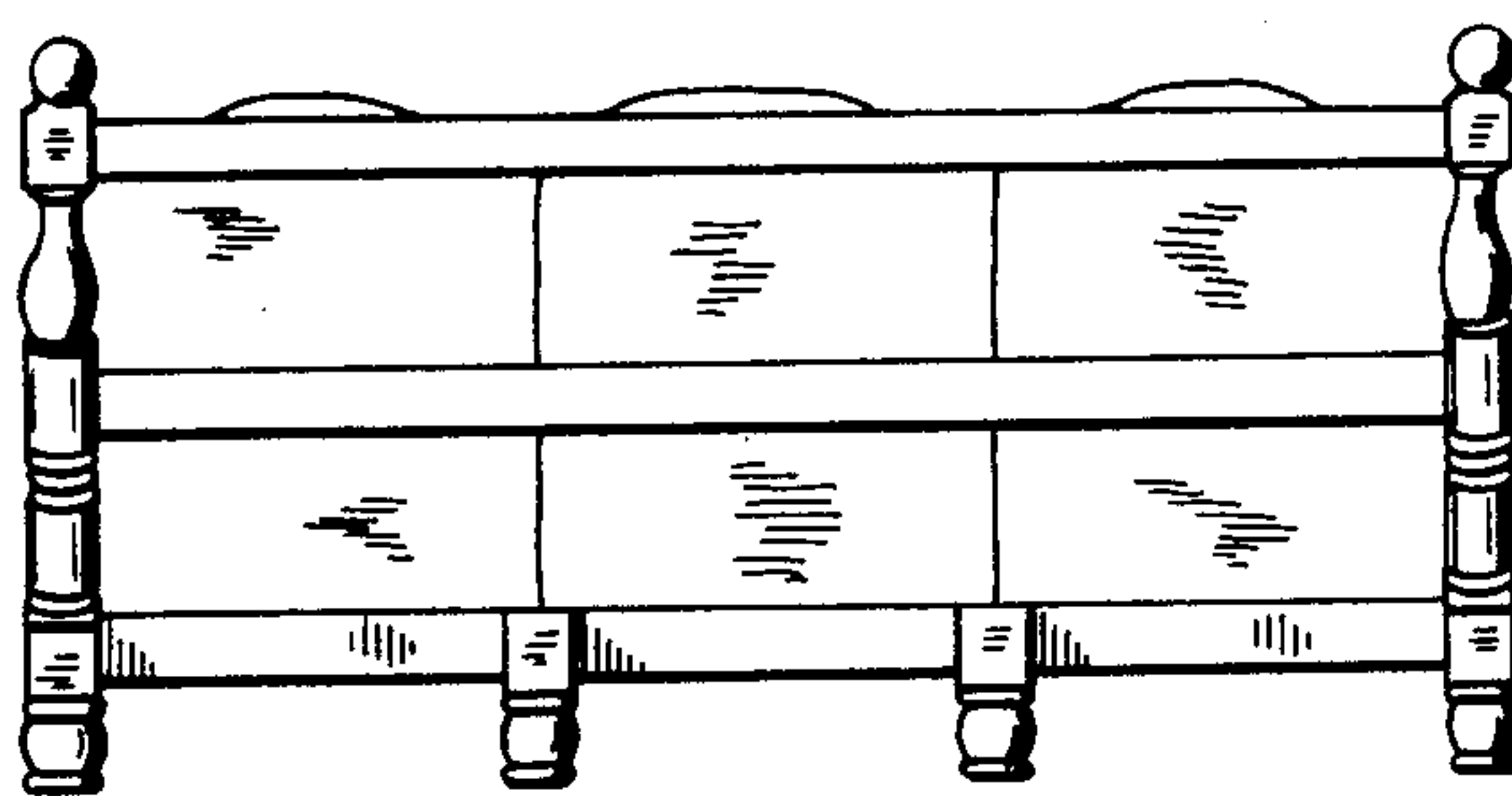

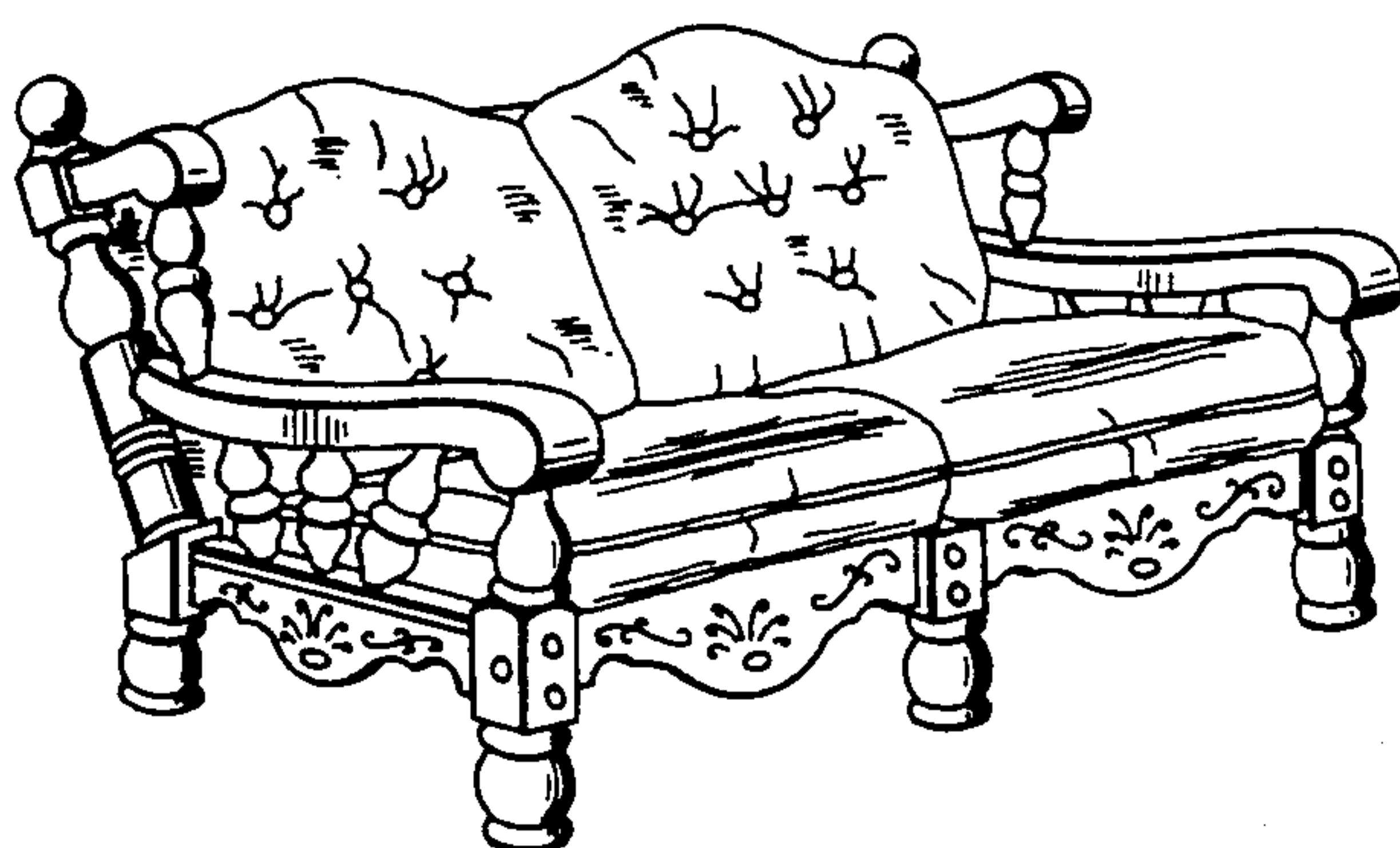

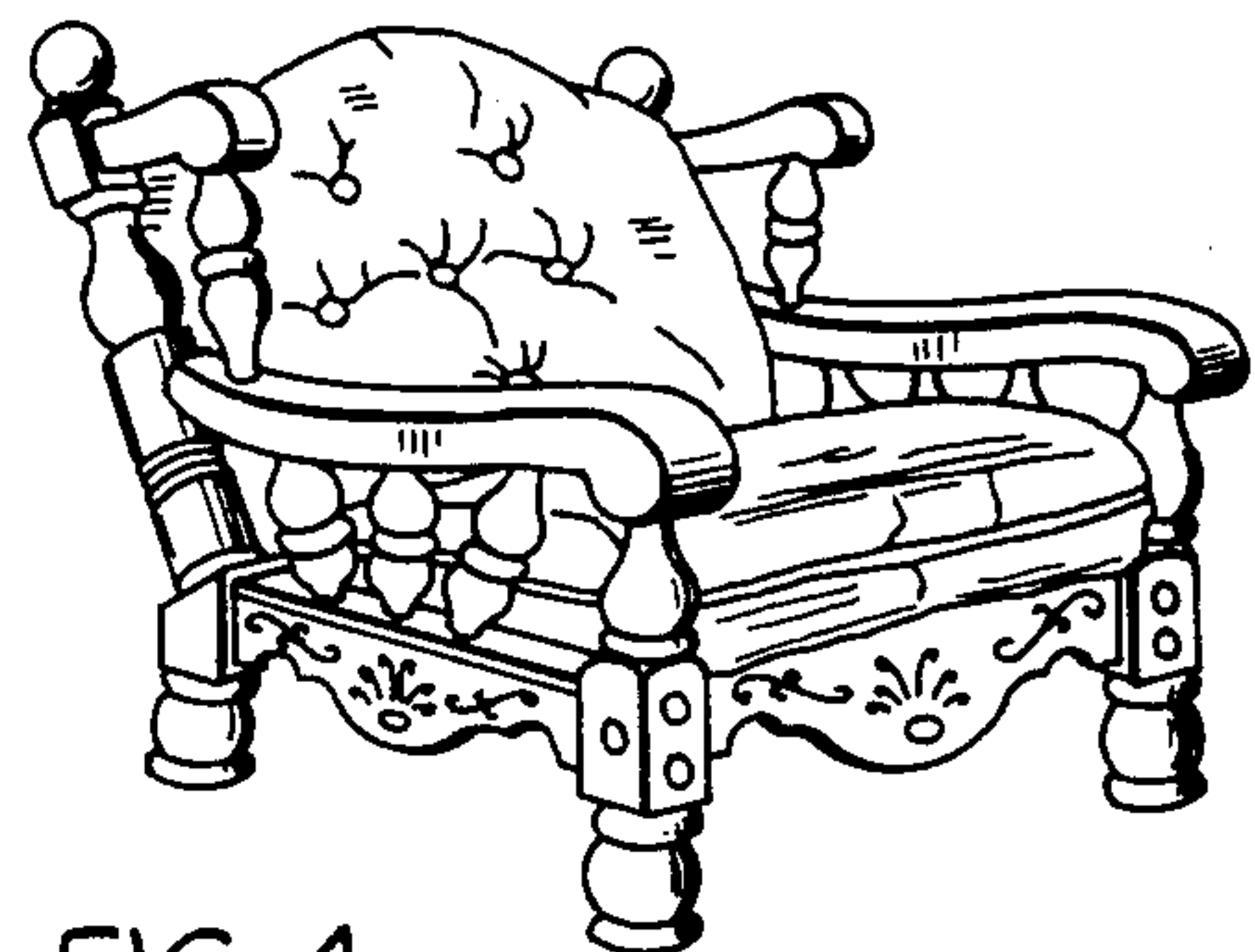
