[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clock, substantially as  
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a clock showing my new  
design in which the numerals are arranged in vertical  
columns, the rear being substantially plain and unorna-  
mented;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the clock in FIG. 1  
showing the right side and top, the left side and bottom  
being mirror images of the right side and top respec-  
tively, and

FIG. 3 is a front elevation of another embodiment of my  
clock in which the numerals are arranged in horizontal  
rows, the rear being substantially plain and unorna-  
mented, the sides being substantially identical to the top  
and bottom of the clock in FIGS. 1 and 2, and the top  
and bottom being substantially identical to the sides of  
the clock in FIGS. 1 and 2.





