DESCRIPTION

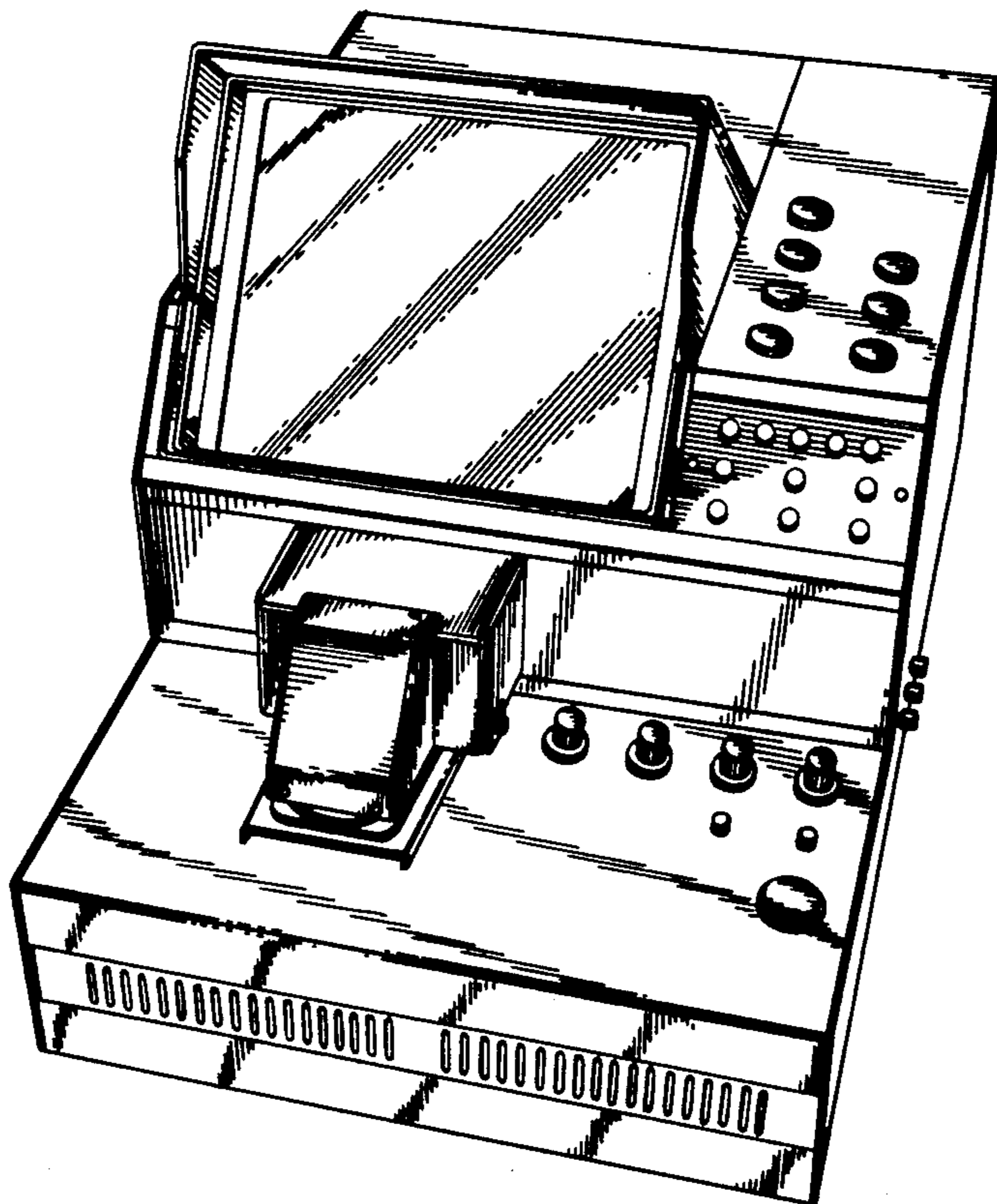

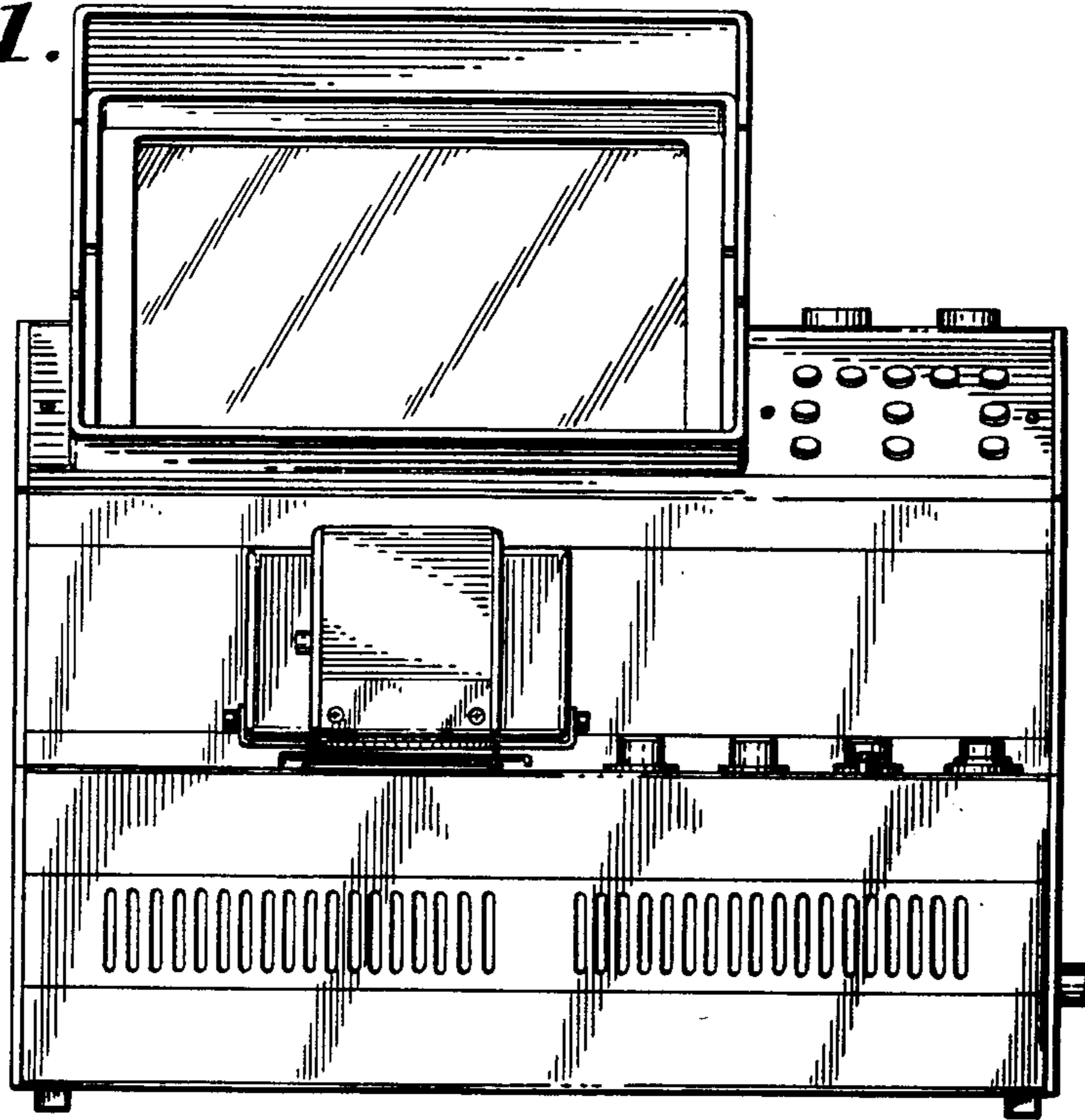

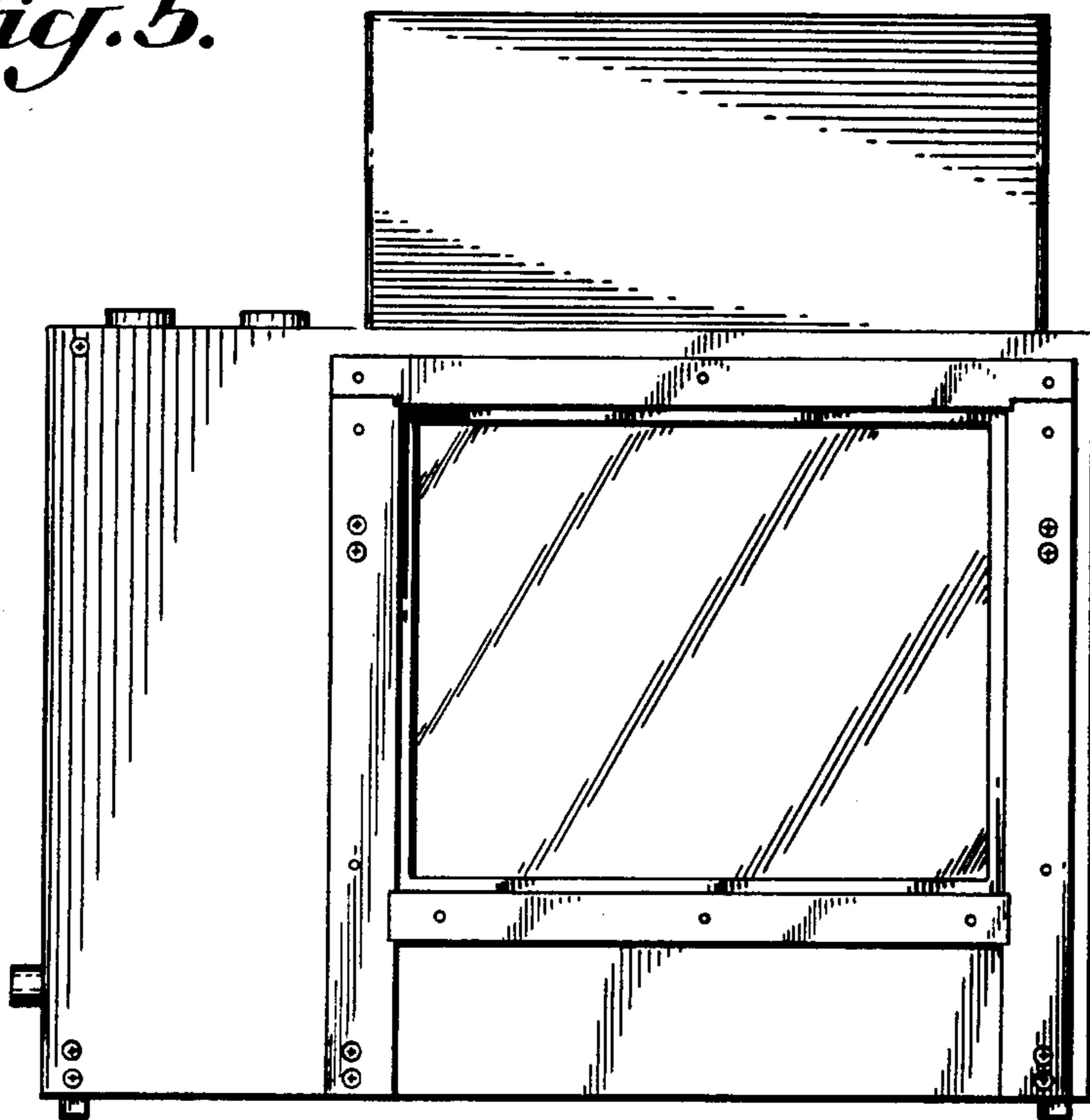

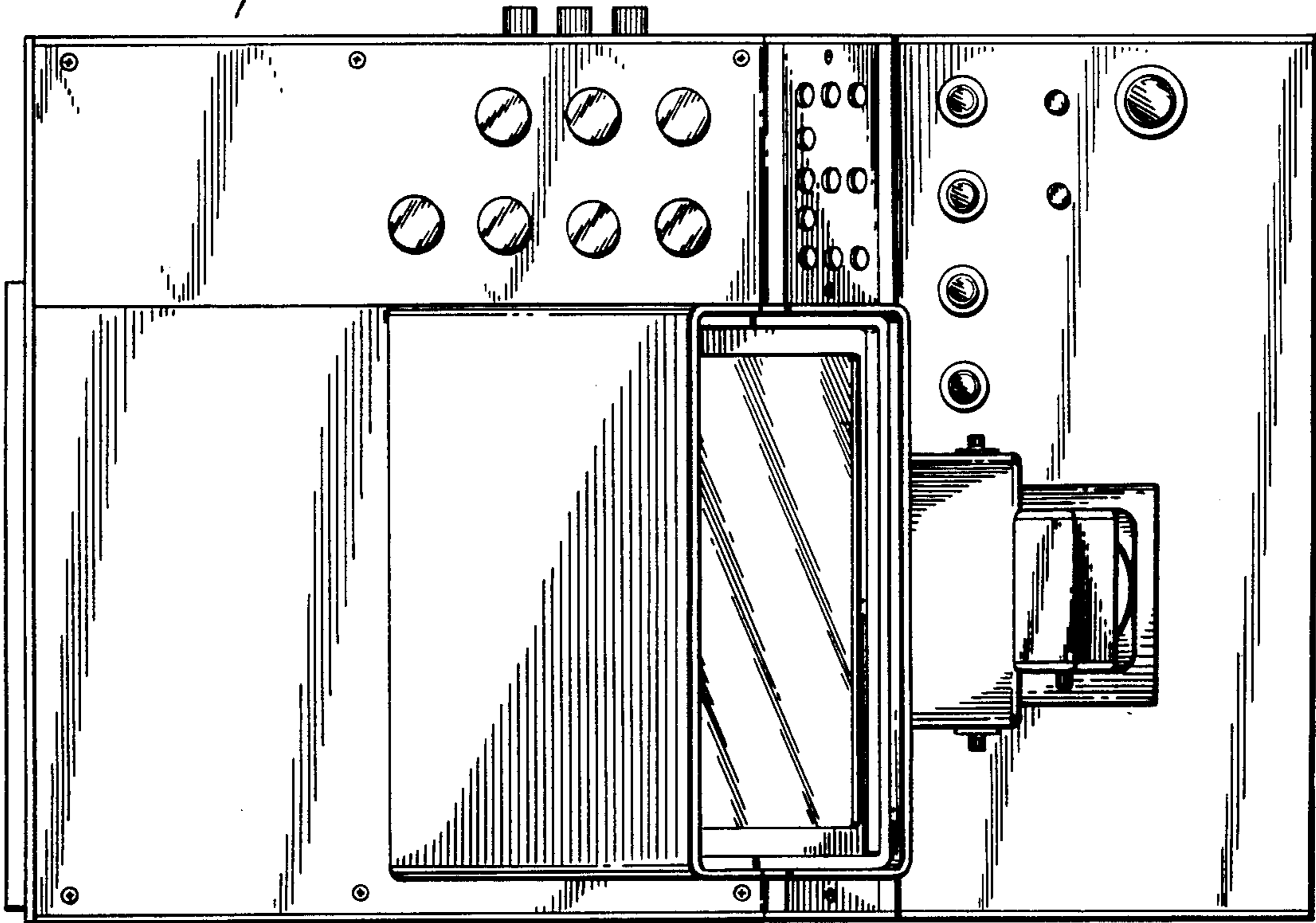

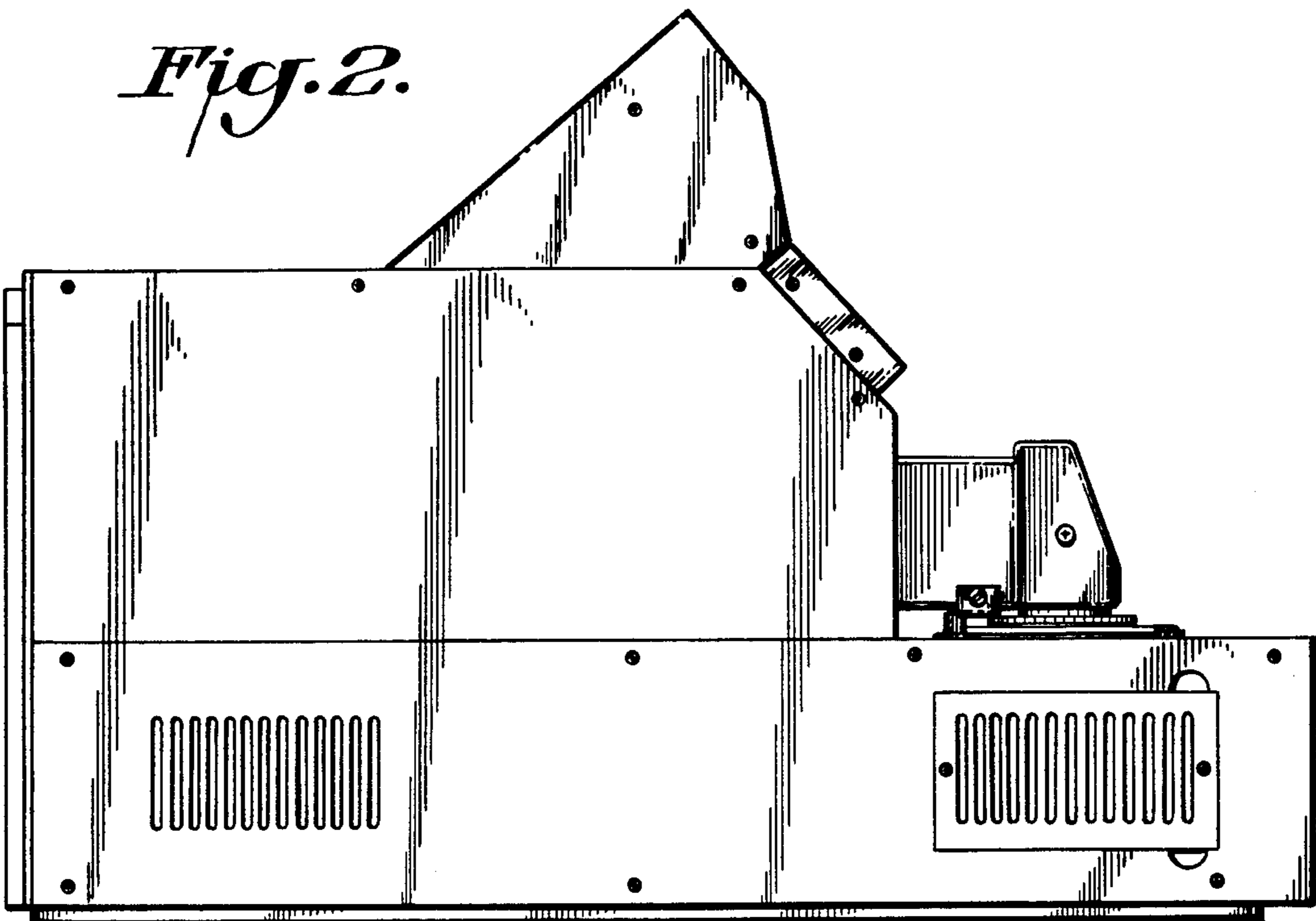

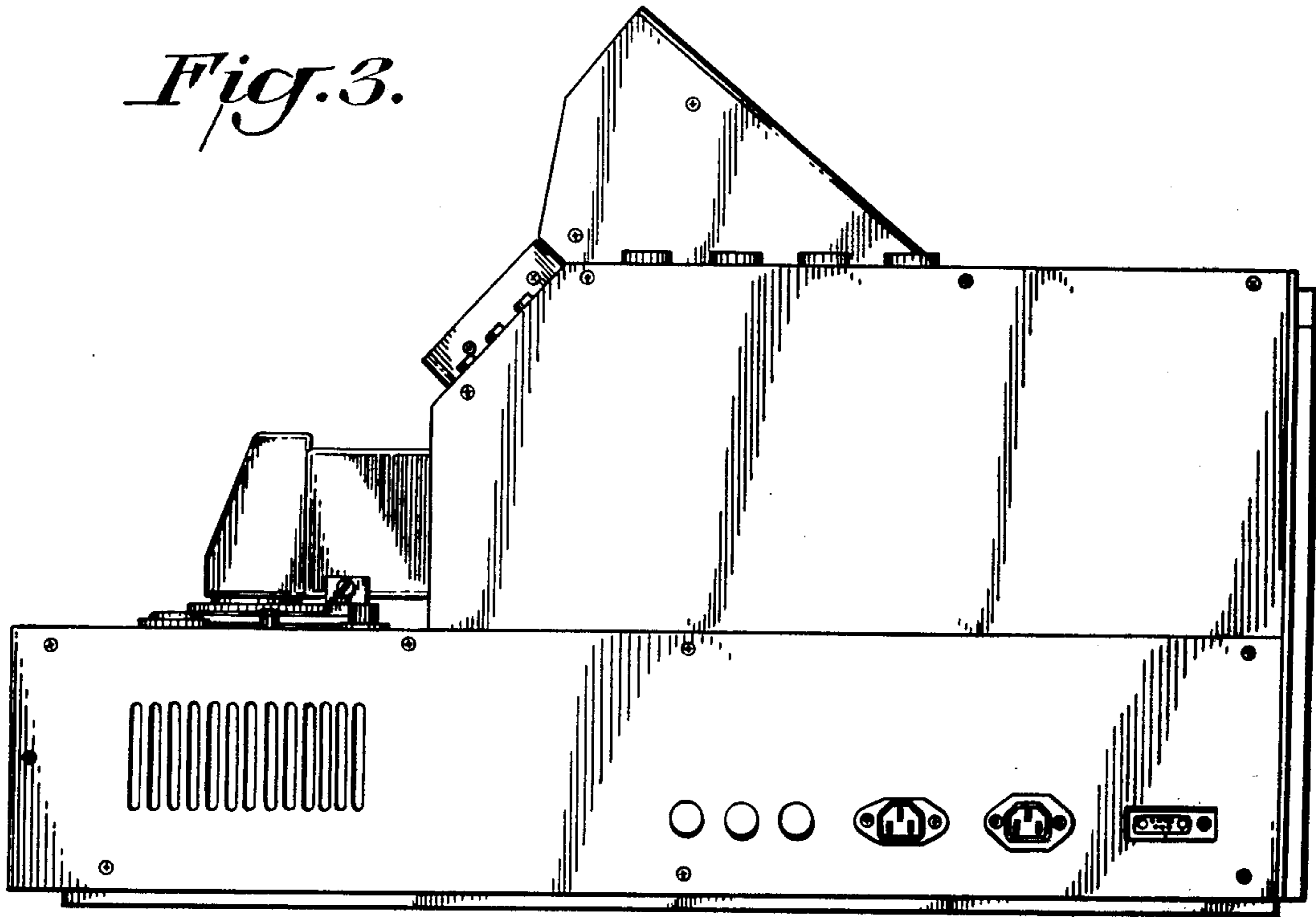

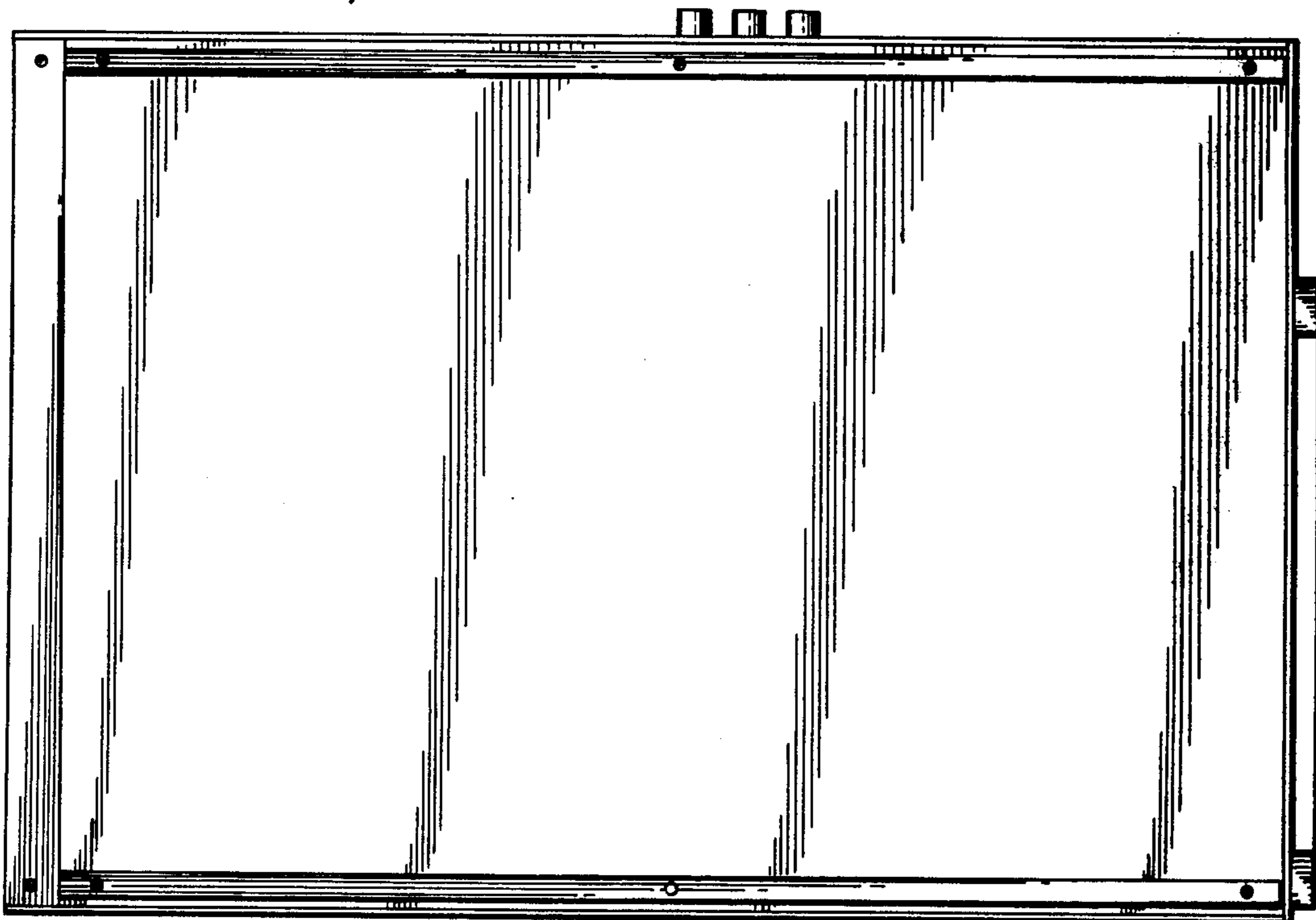
