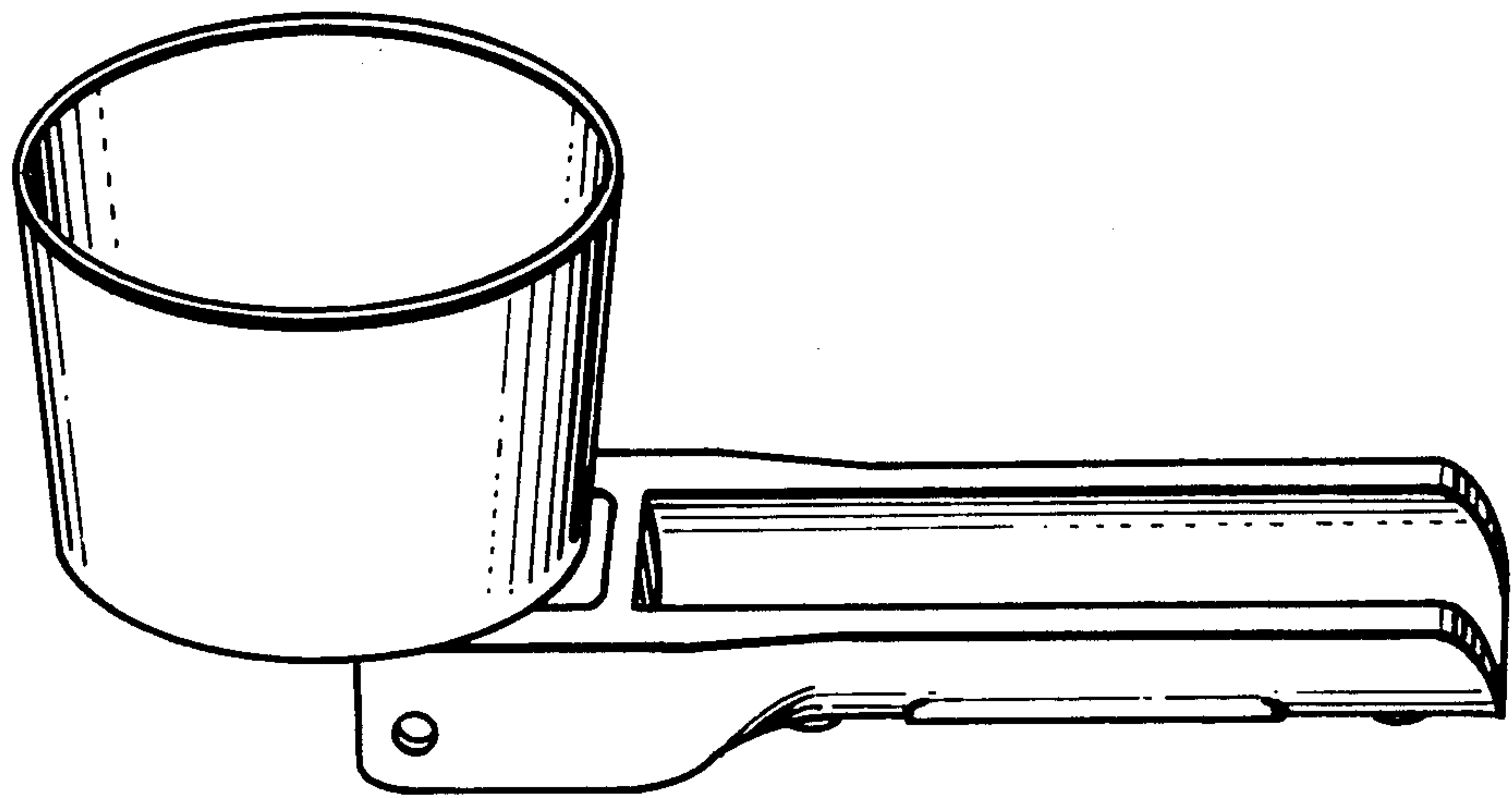

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pickup scoop for cleaning swimming pools, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pickup scoop for cleaning swimming pools showing my new design. FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a view in side elevation thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a front elevation view thereof.



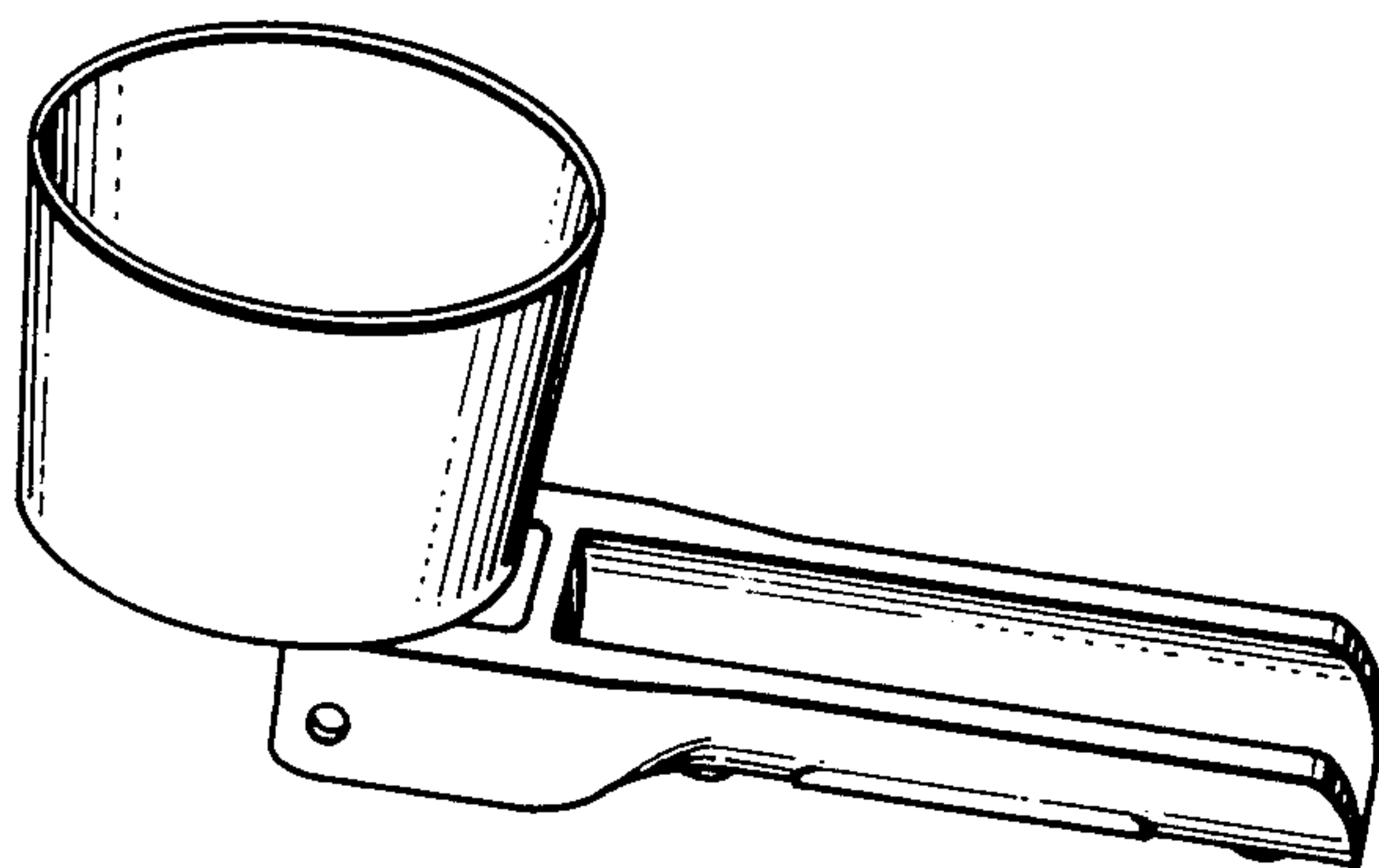

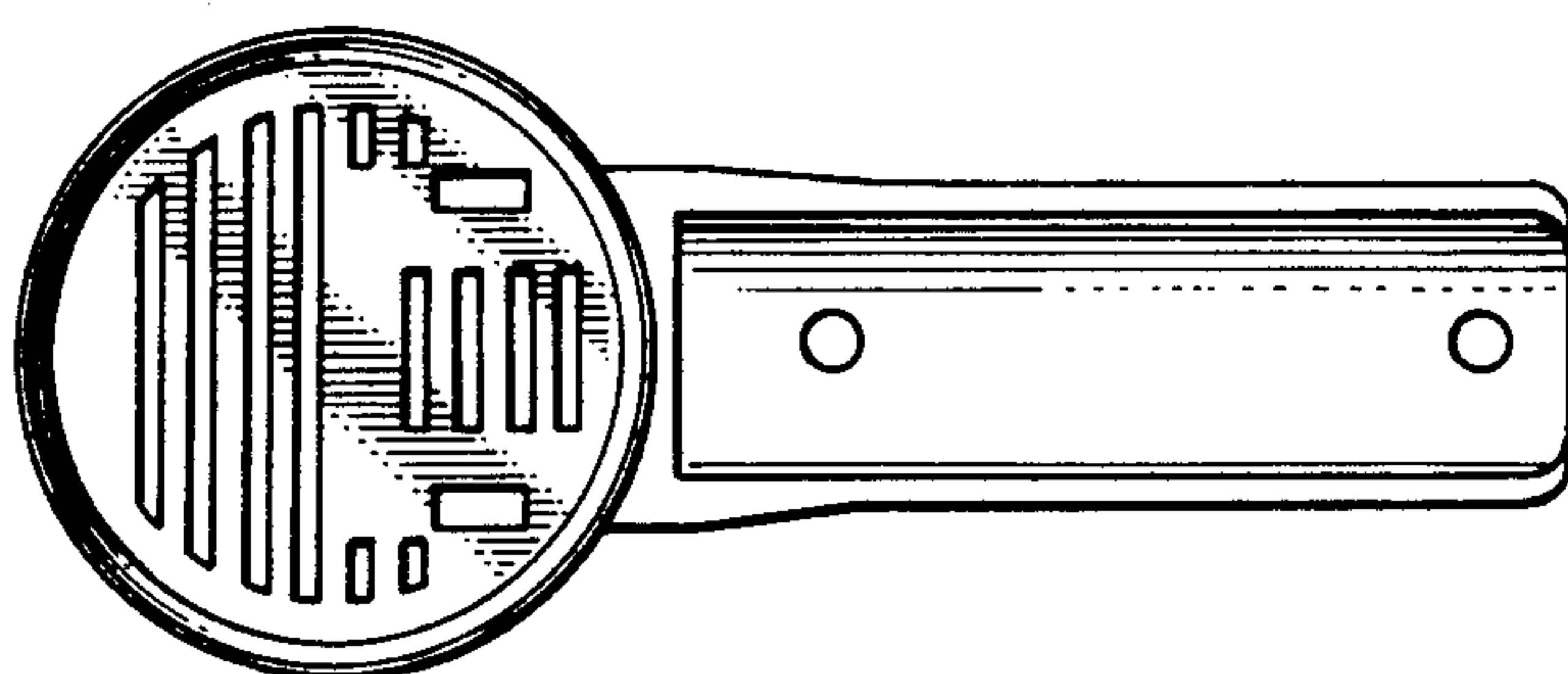

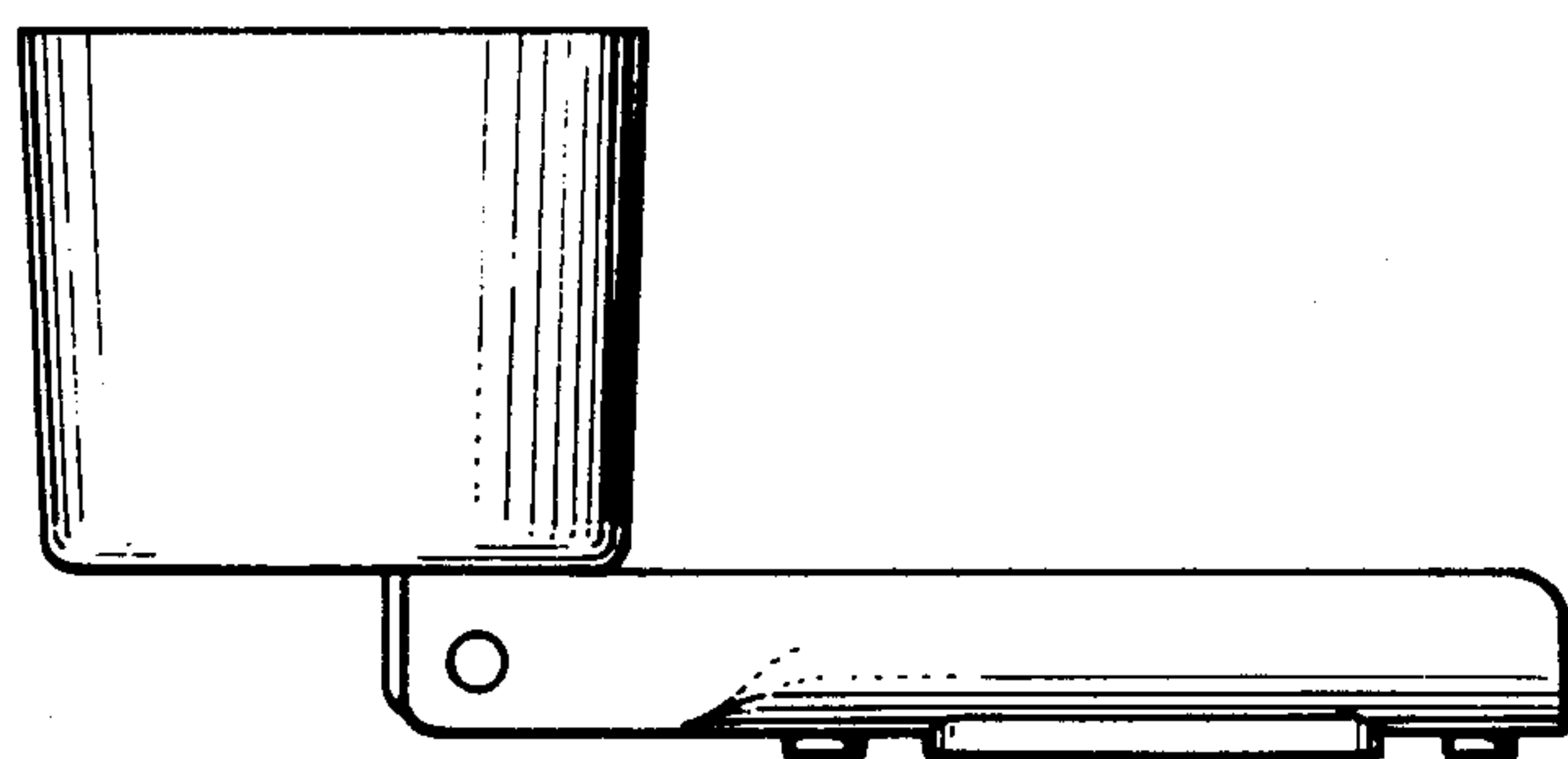

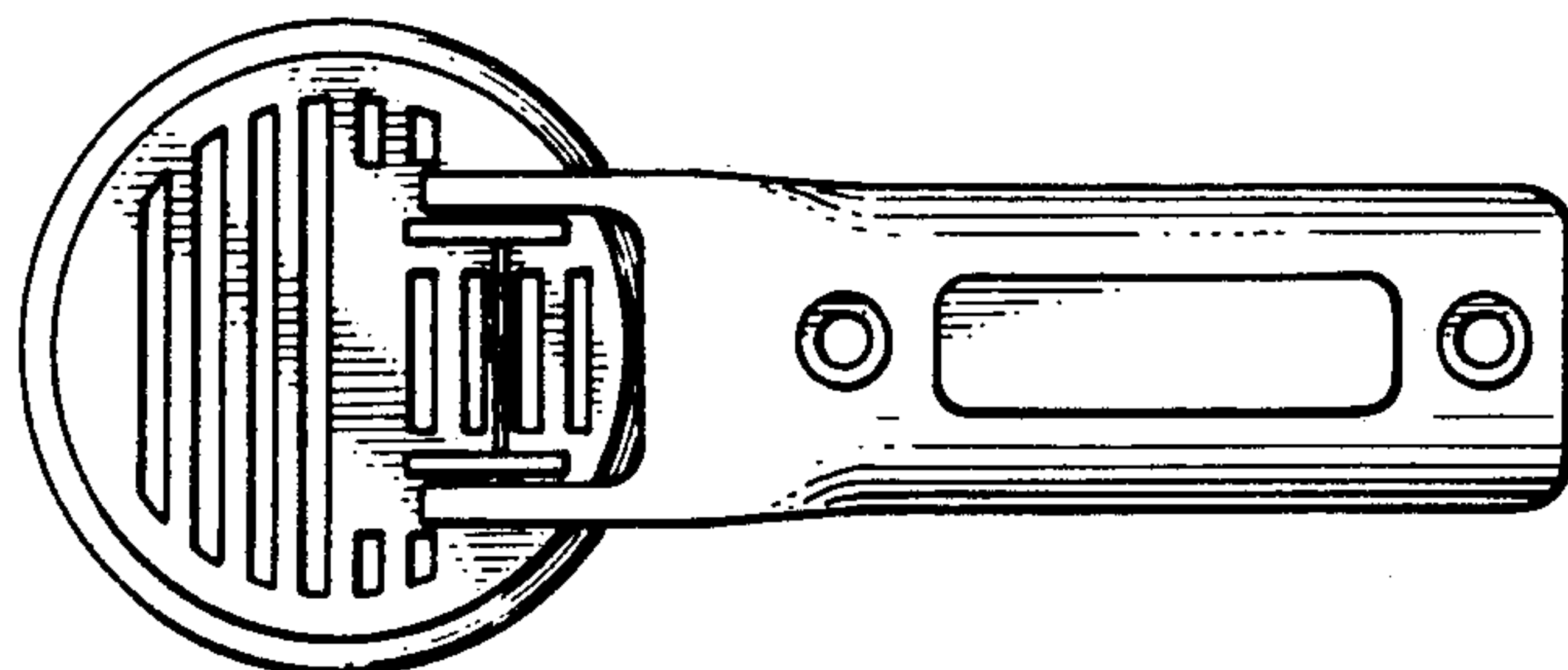

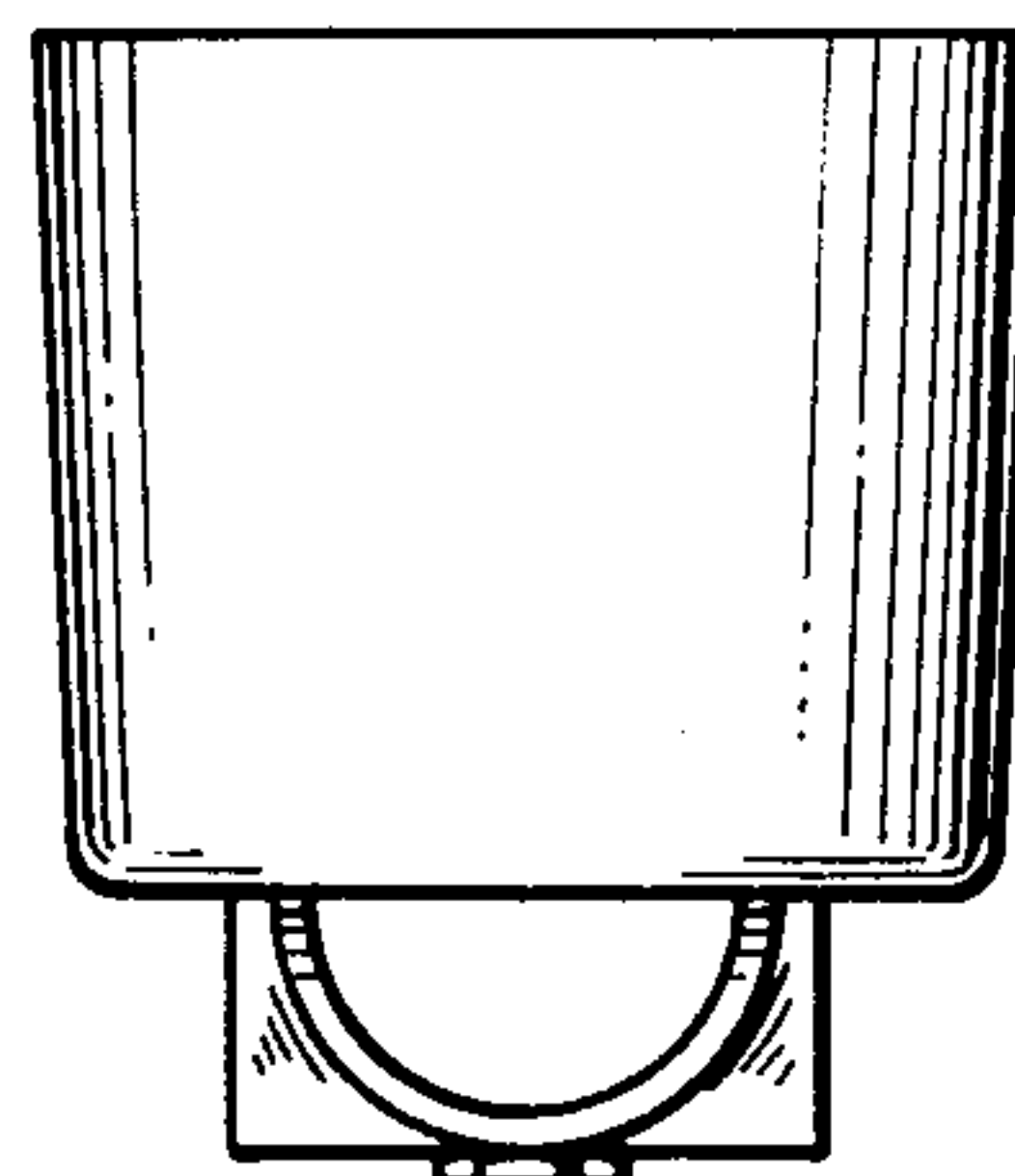

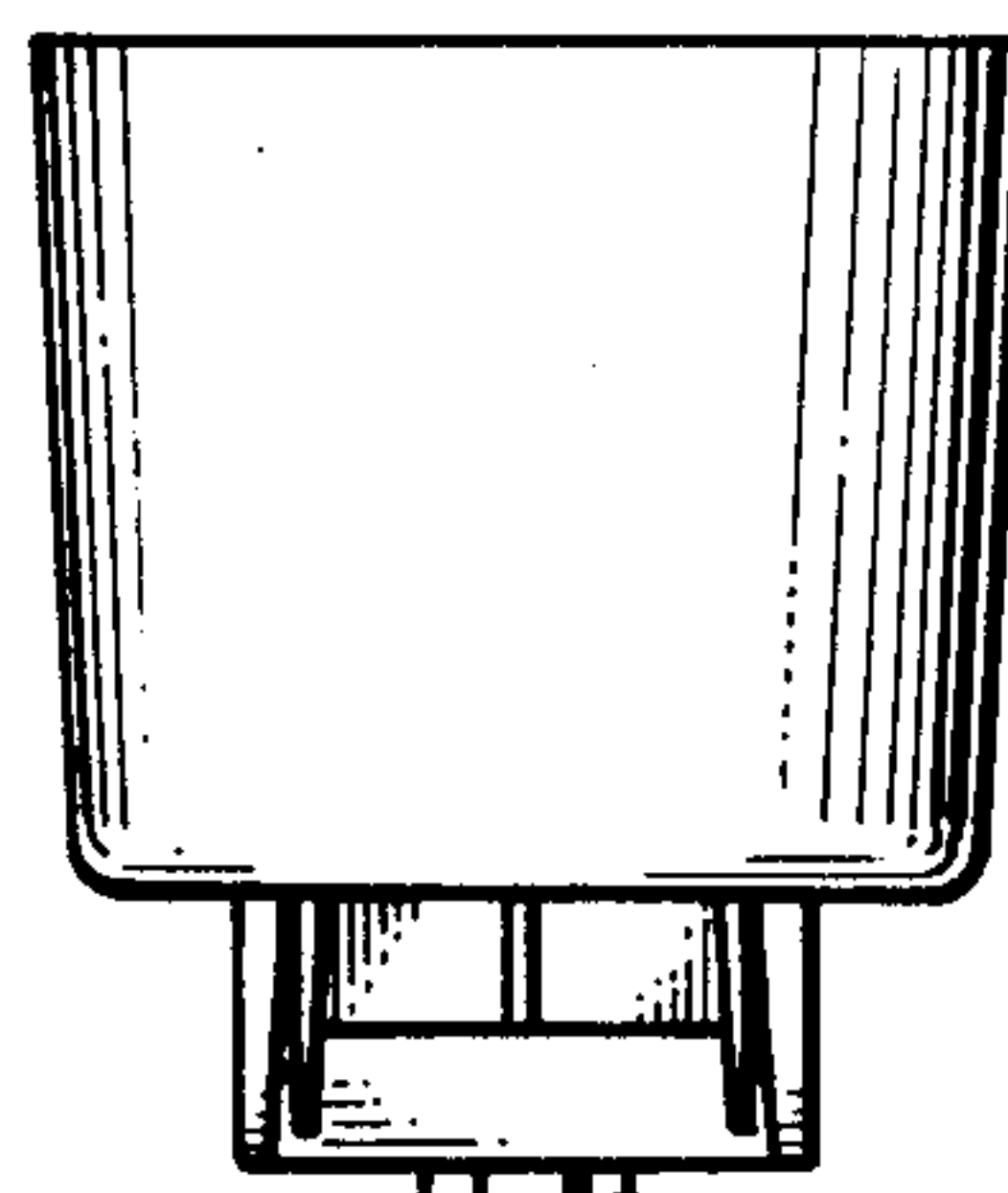
