The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

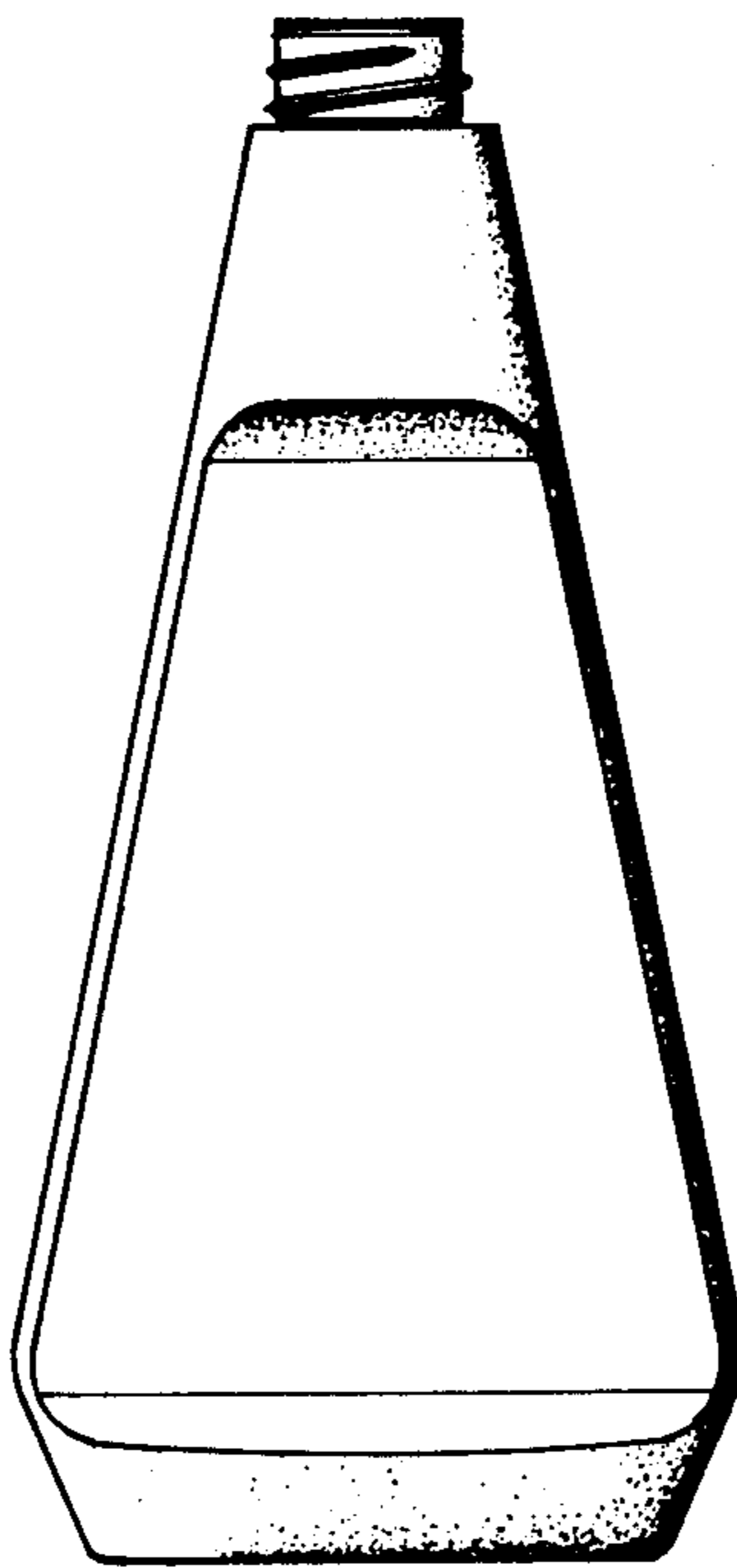
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle incorporating my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

My new design is symmetrical front to back and side to side. The sides not shown are mirror images of the sides shown.



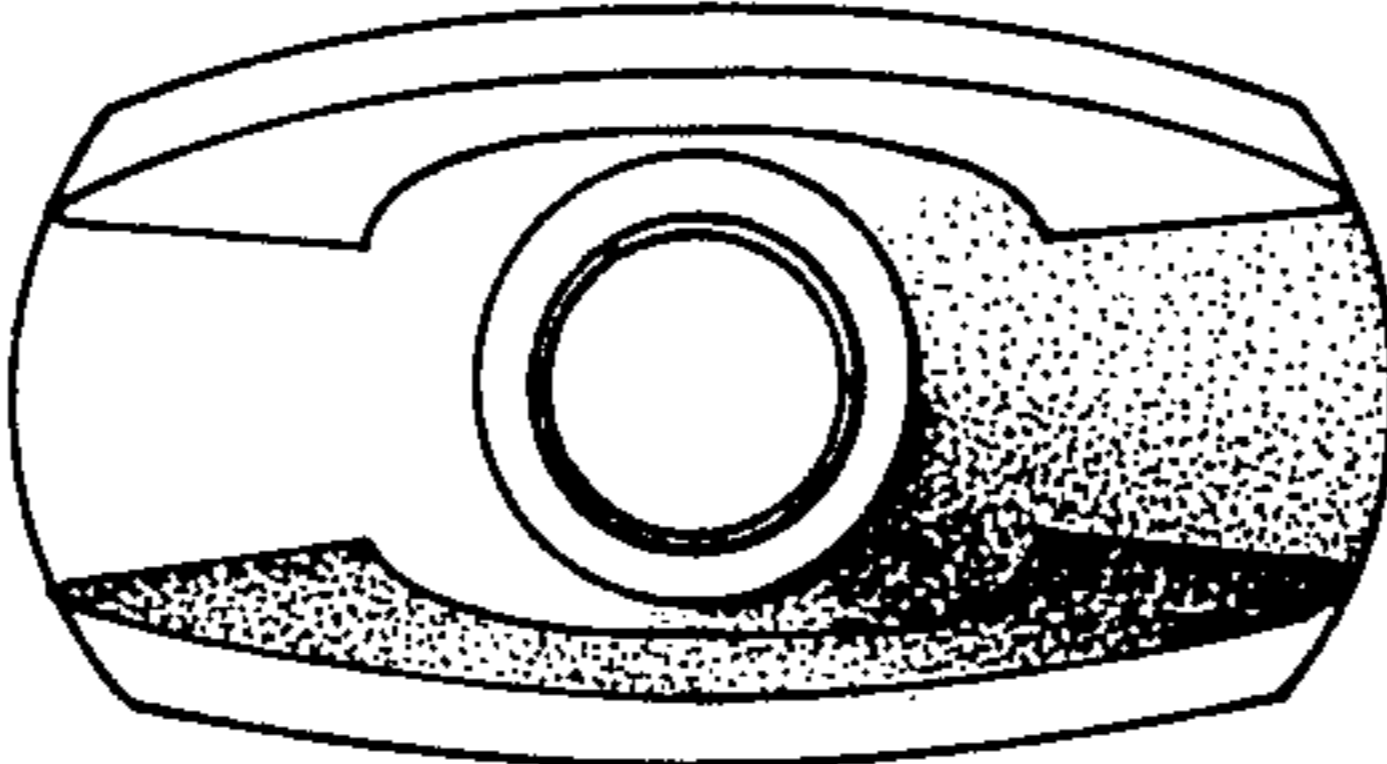

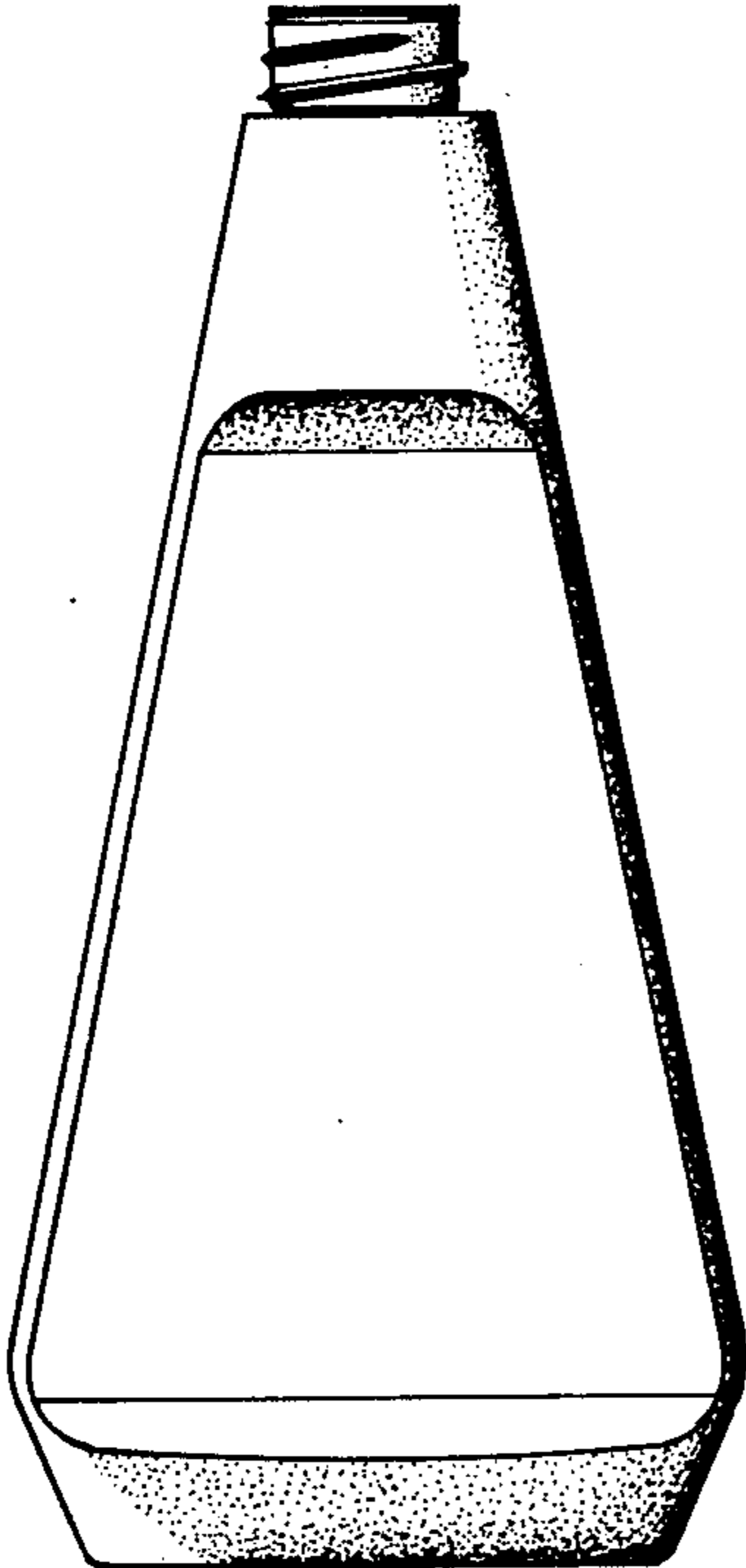

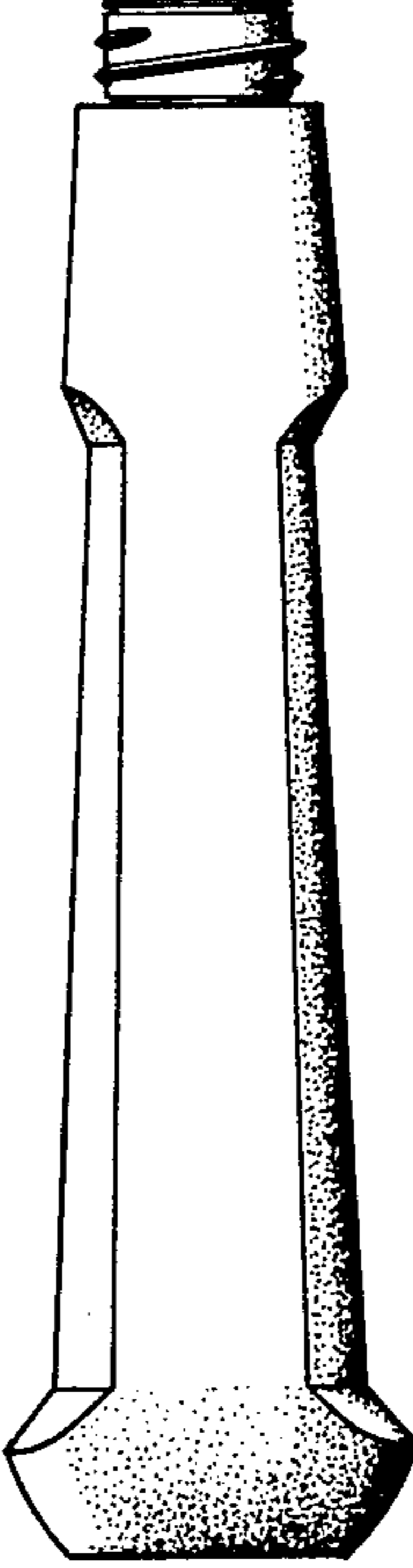
