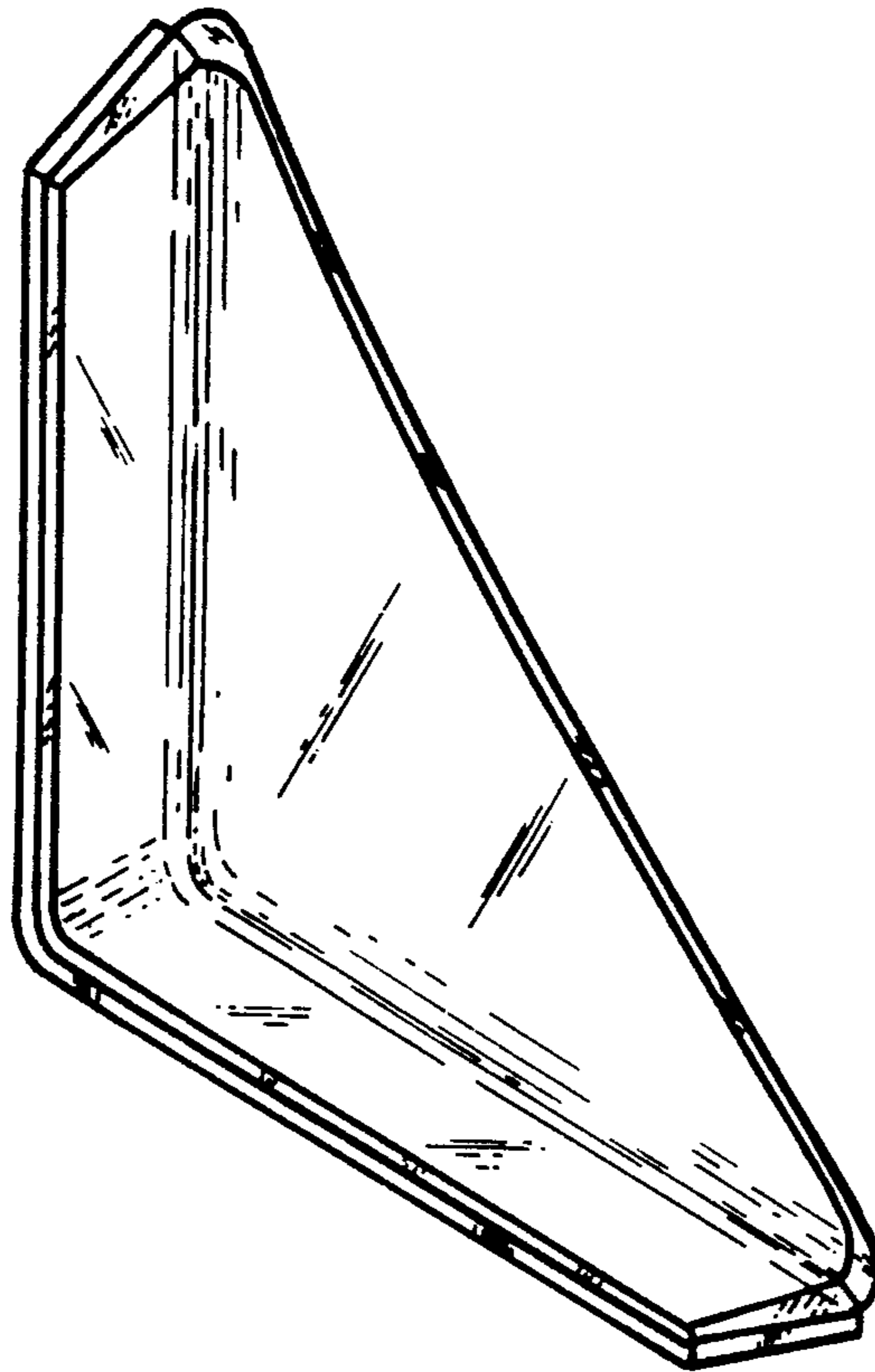
DESCRIPTION

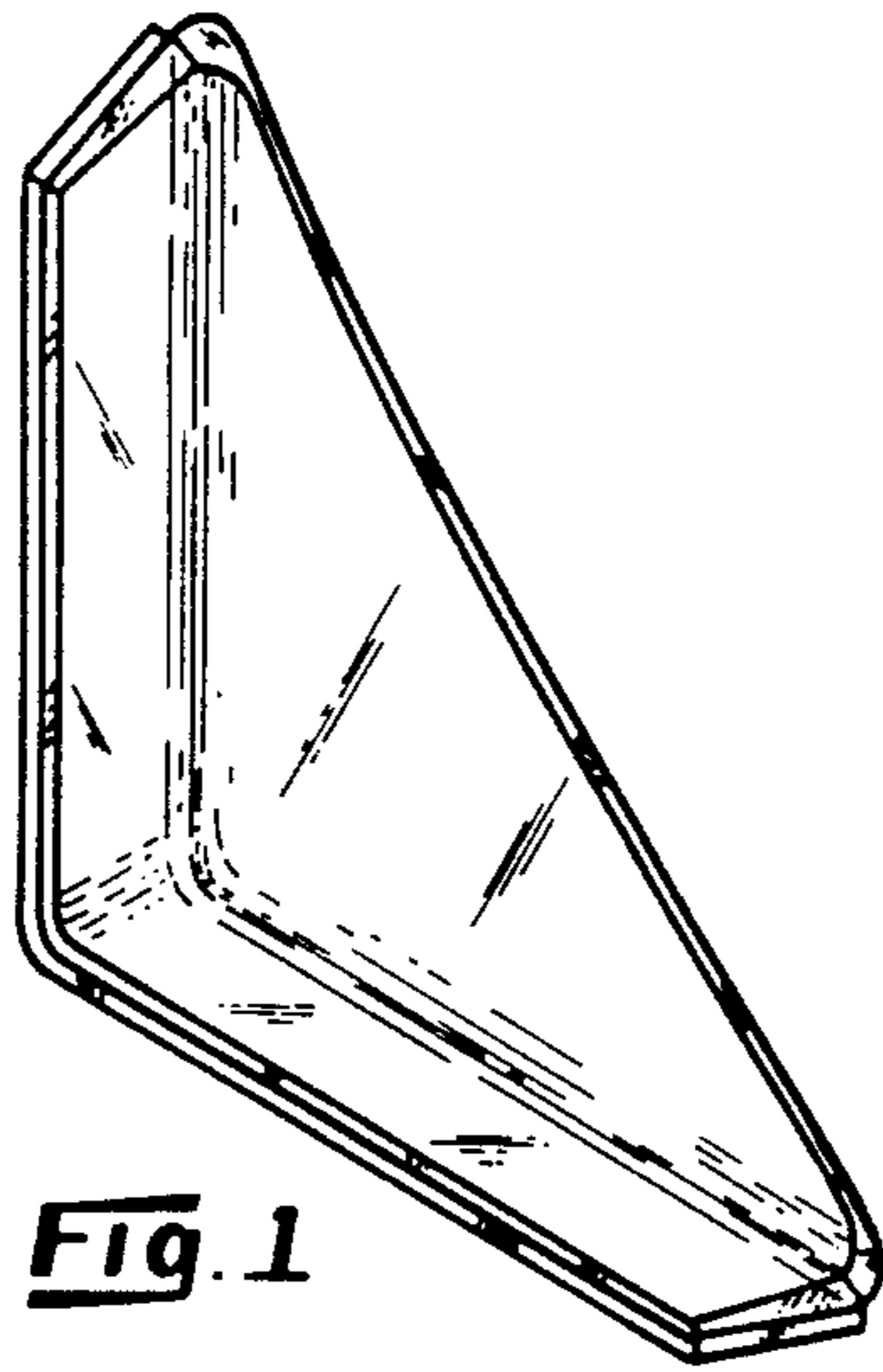

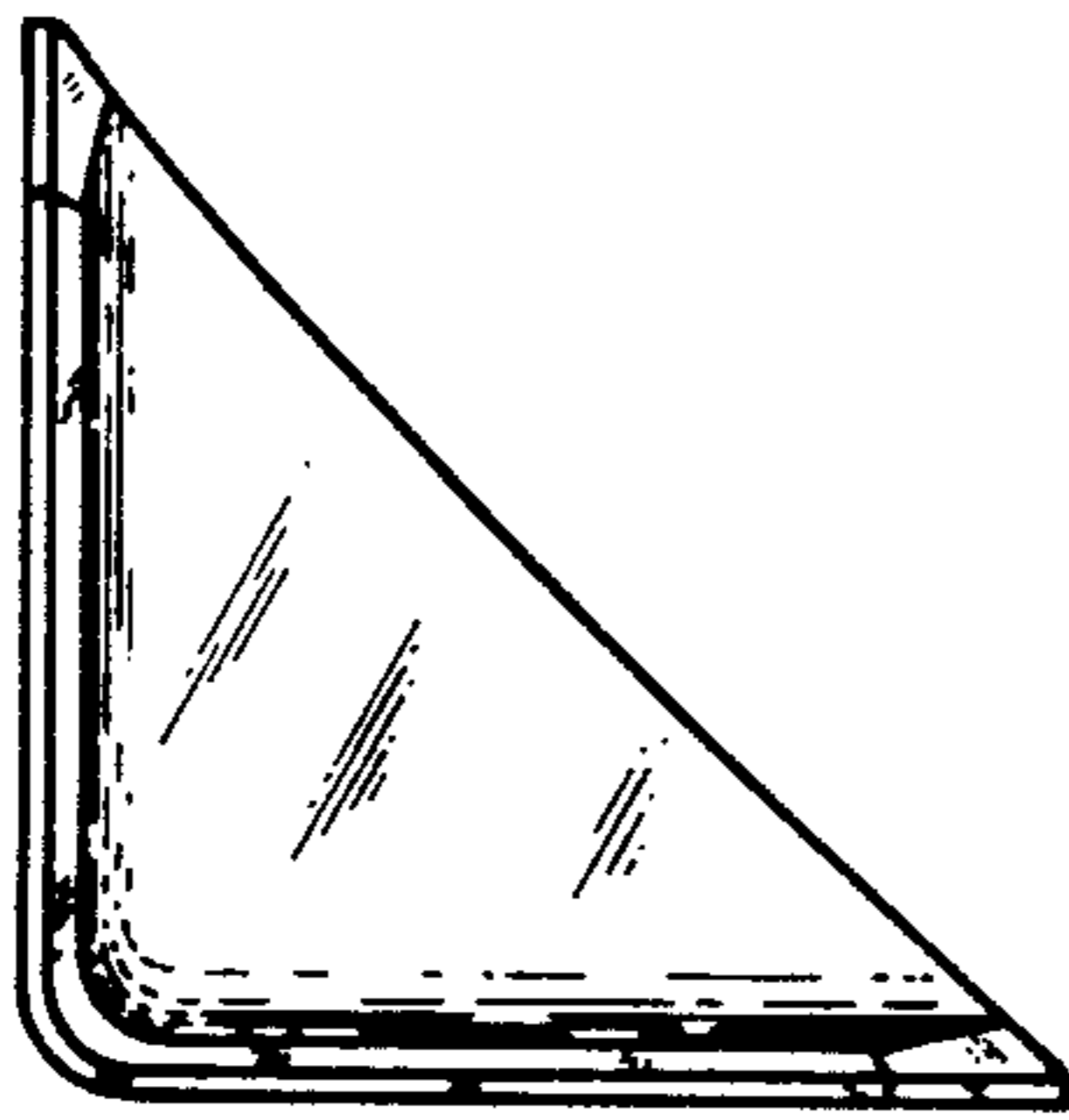

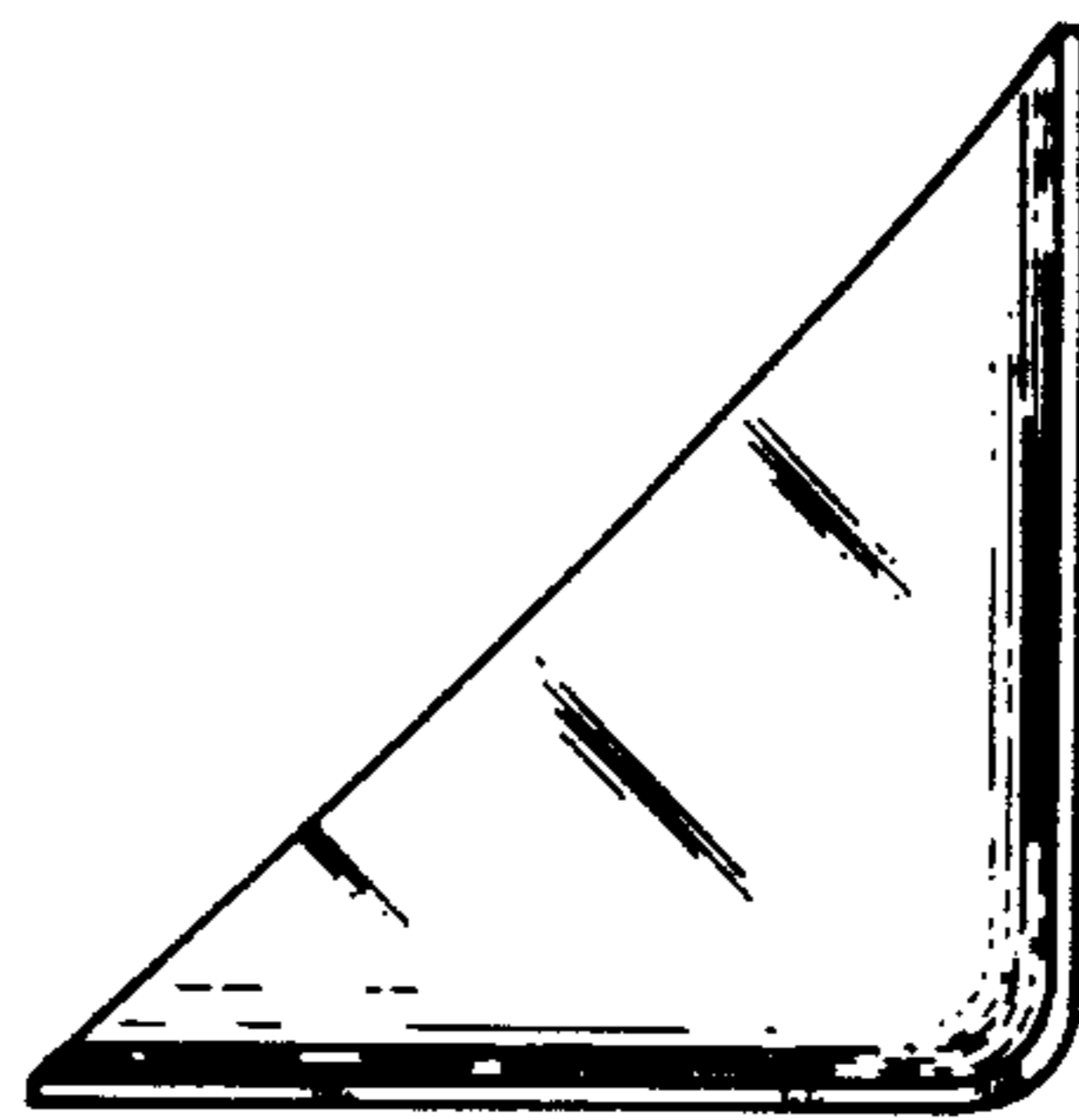

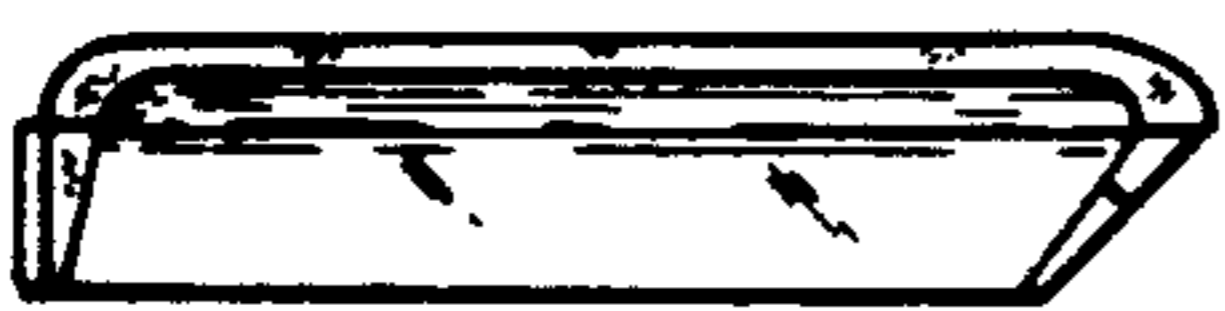

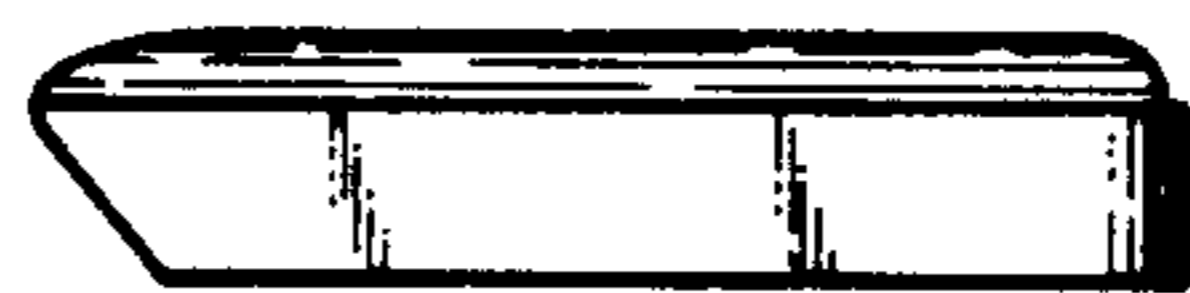
