The ornamental design for a card holder, as shown.

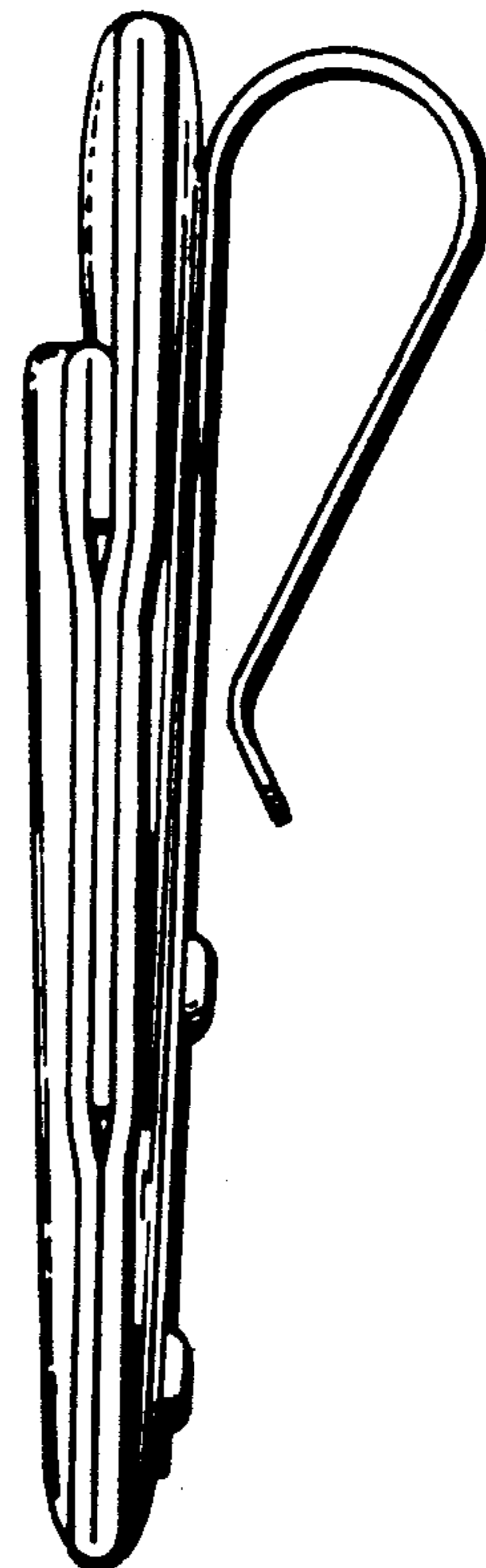
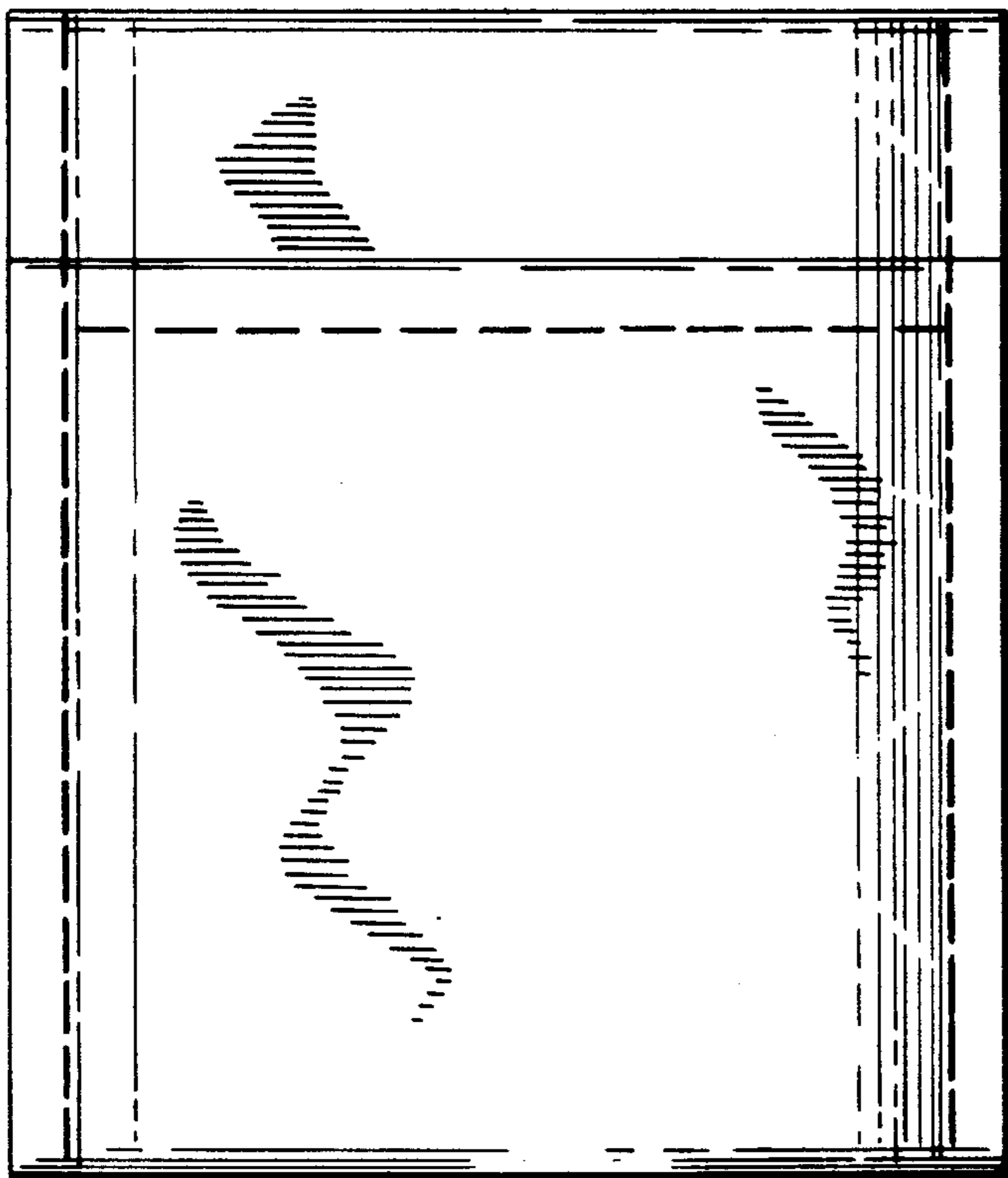
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



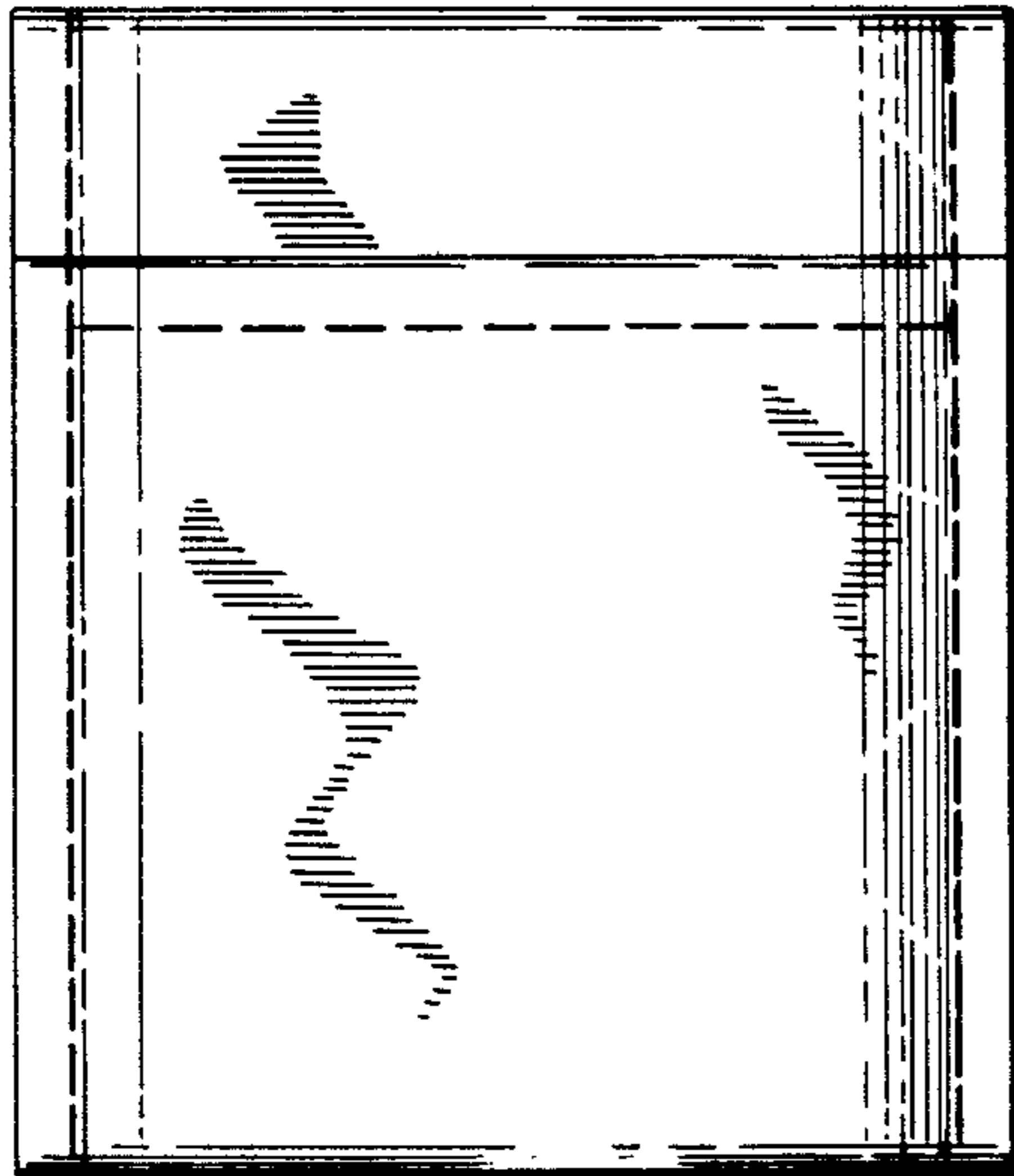

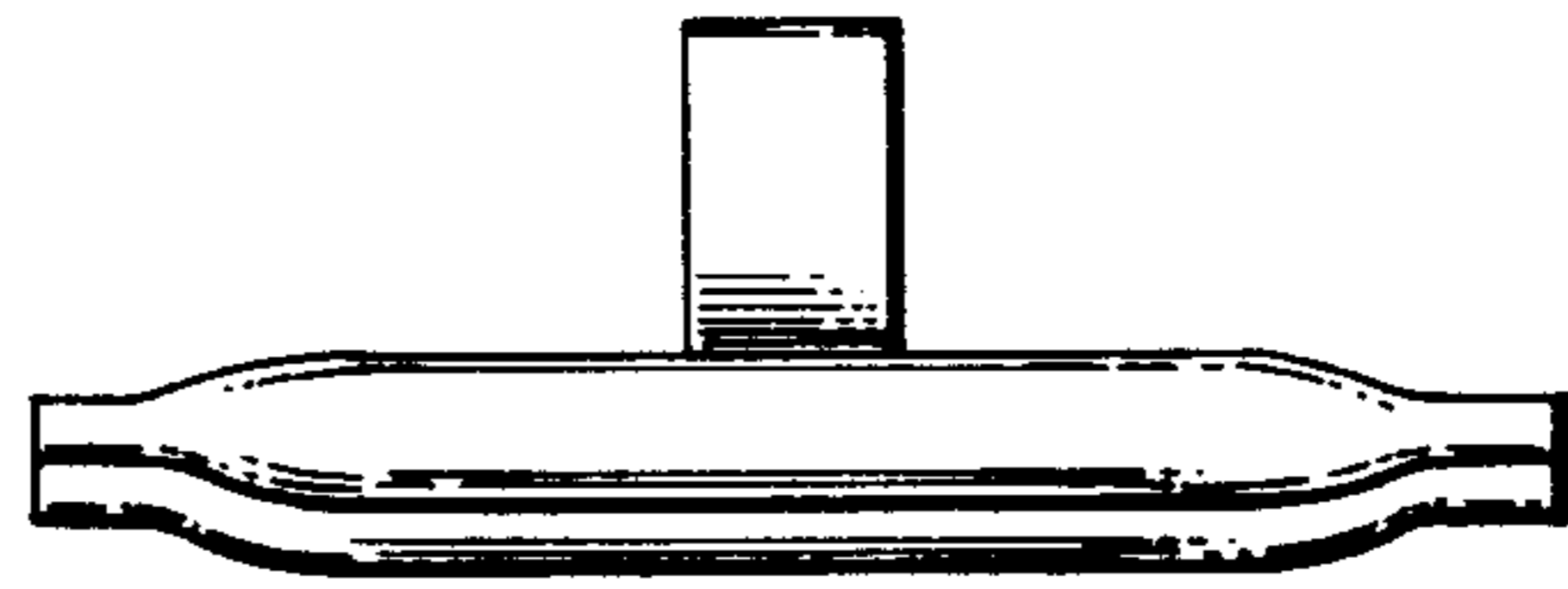

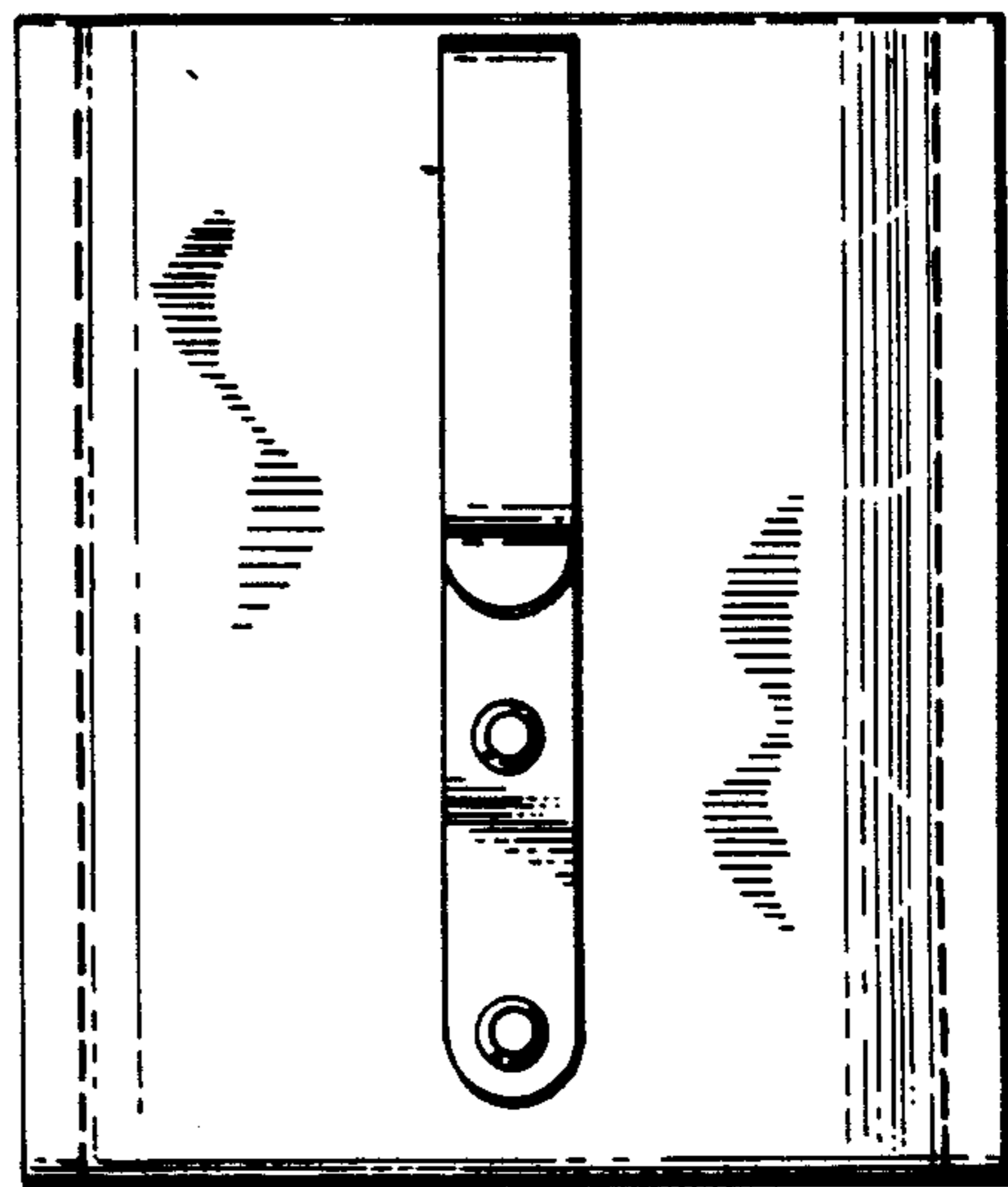
