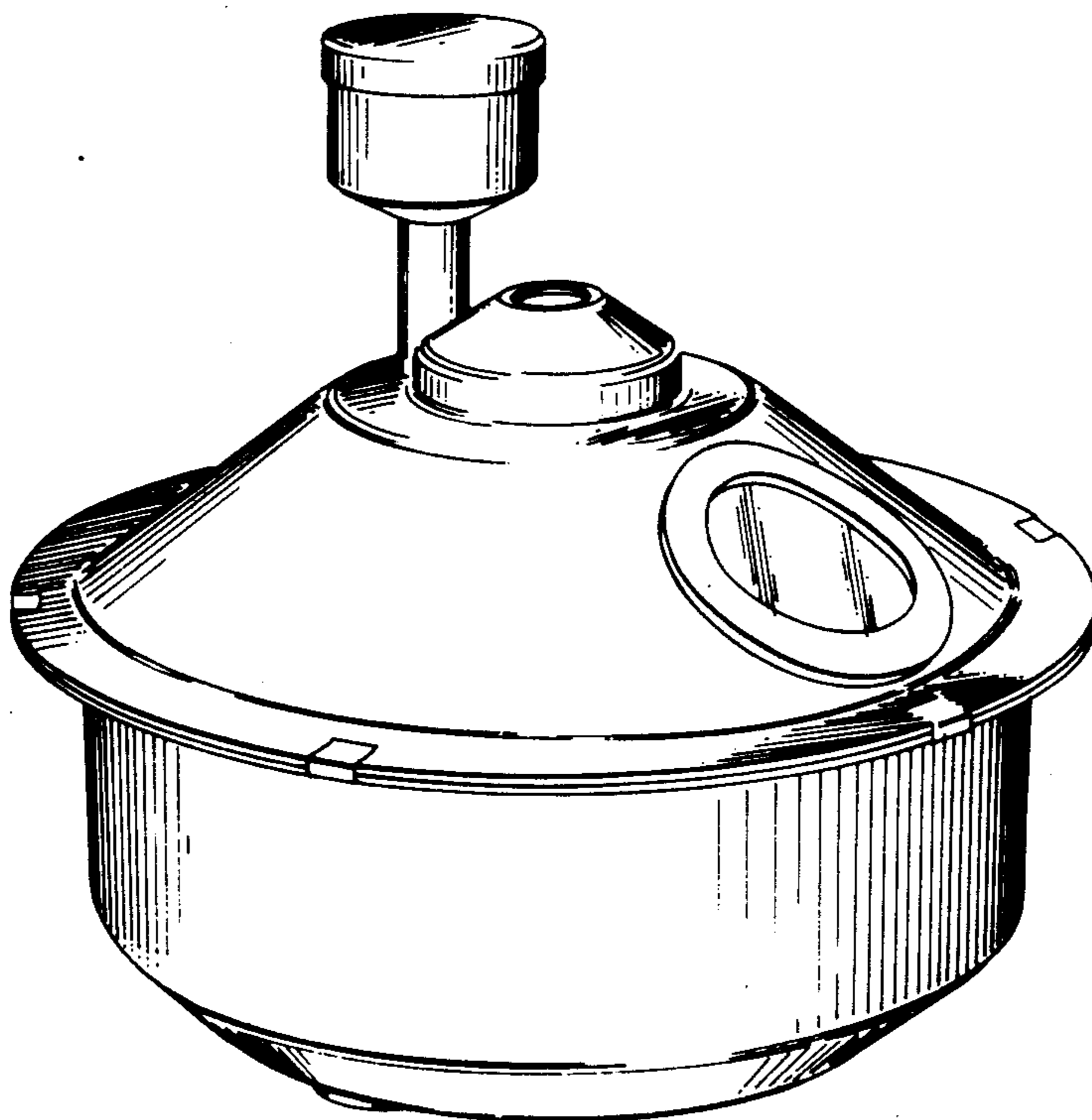

FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the bottom and rear thereof.



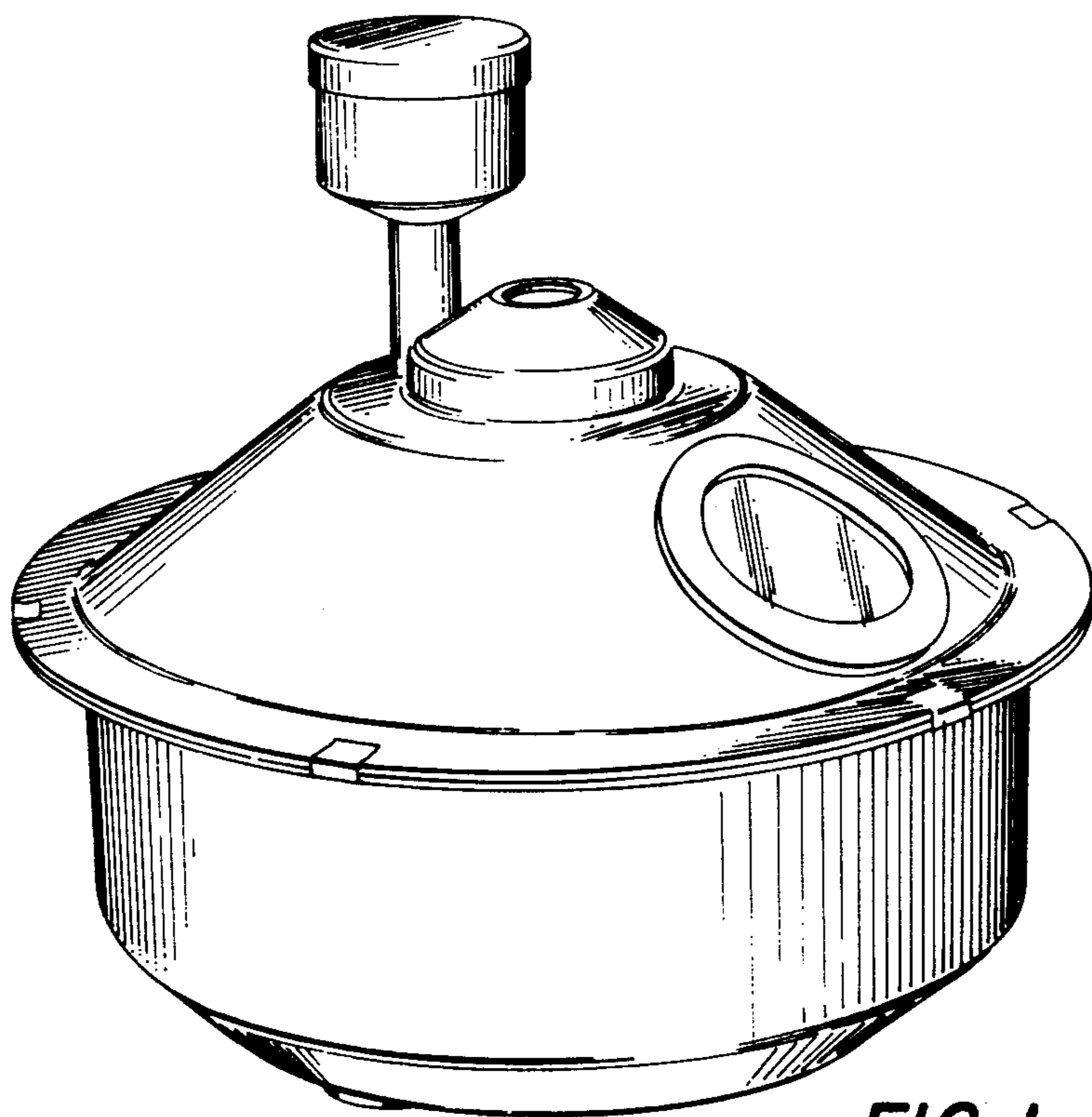

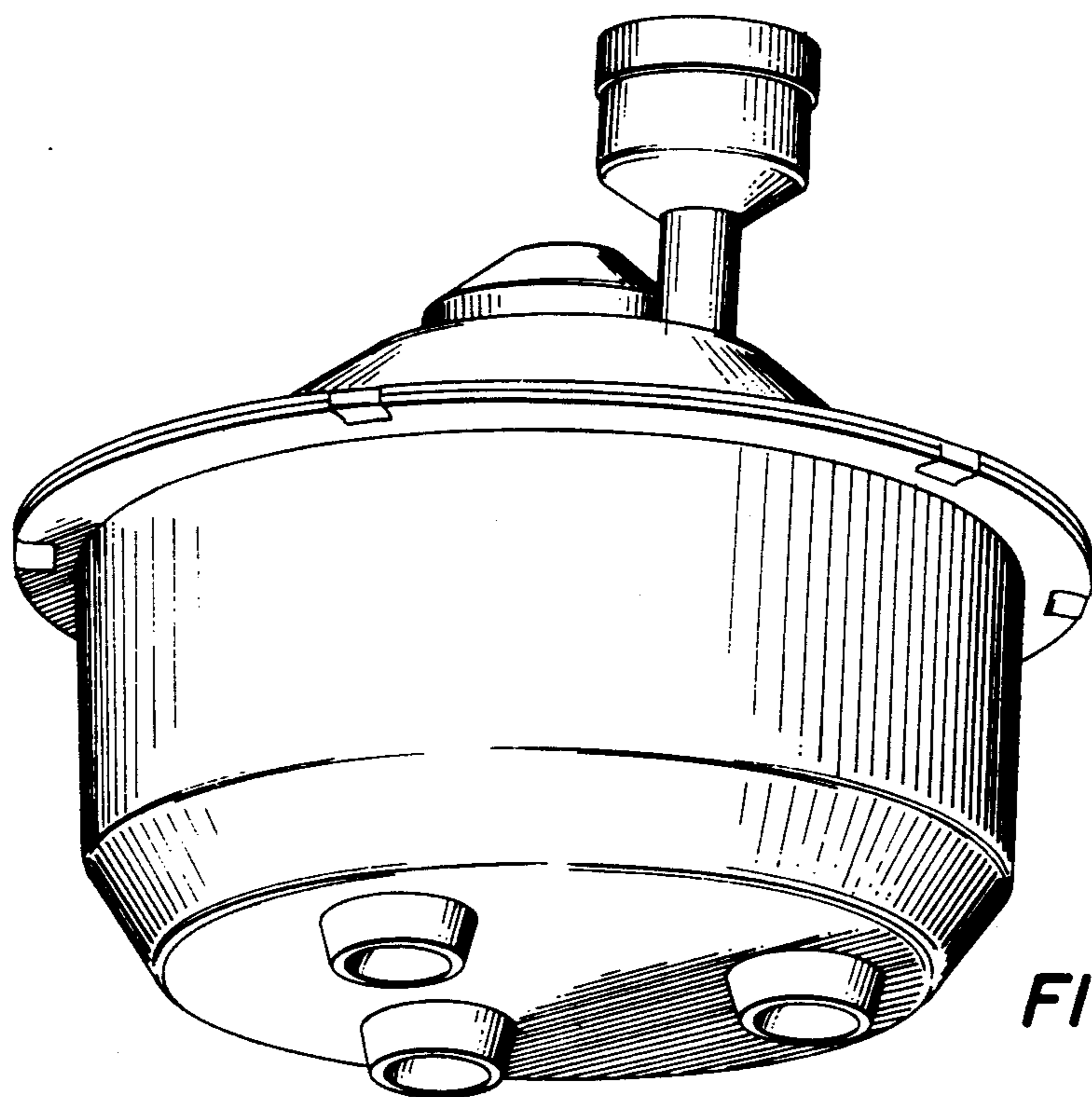
