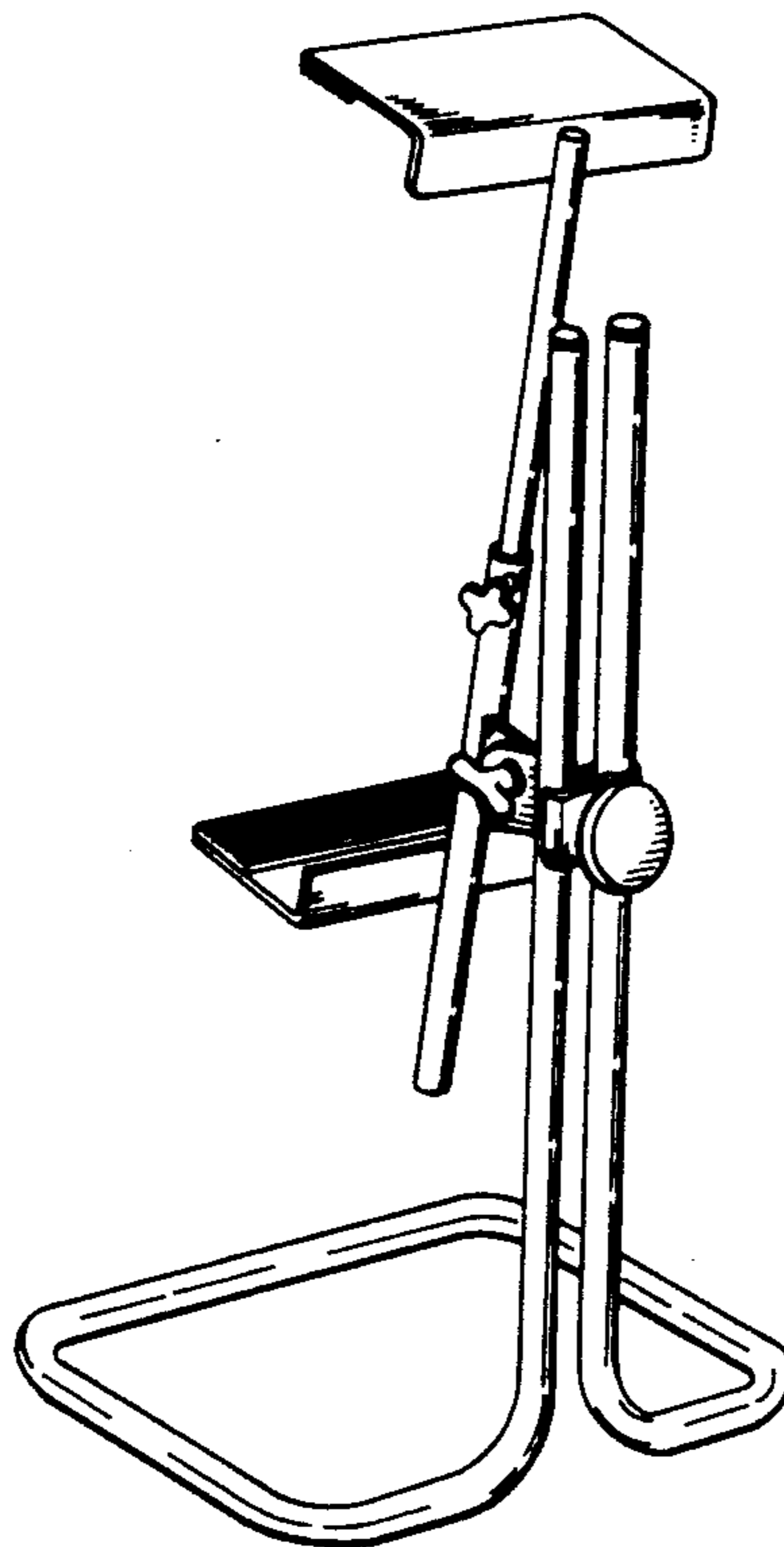
**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a support stand for a loudspeaker, substantially as shown.

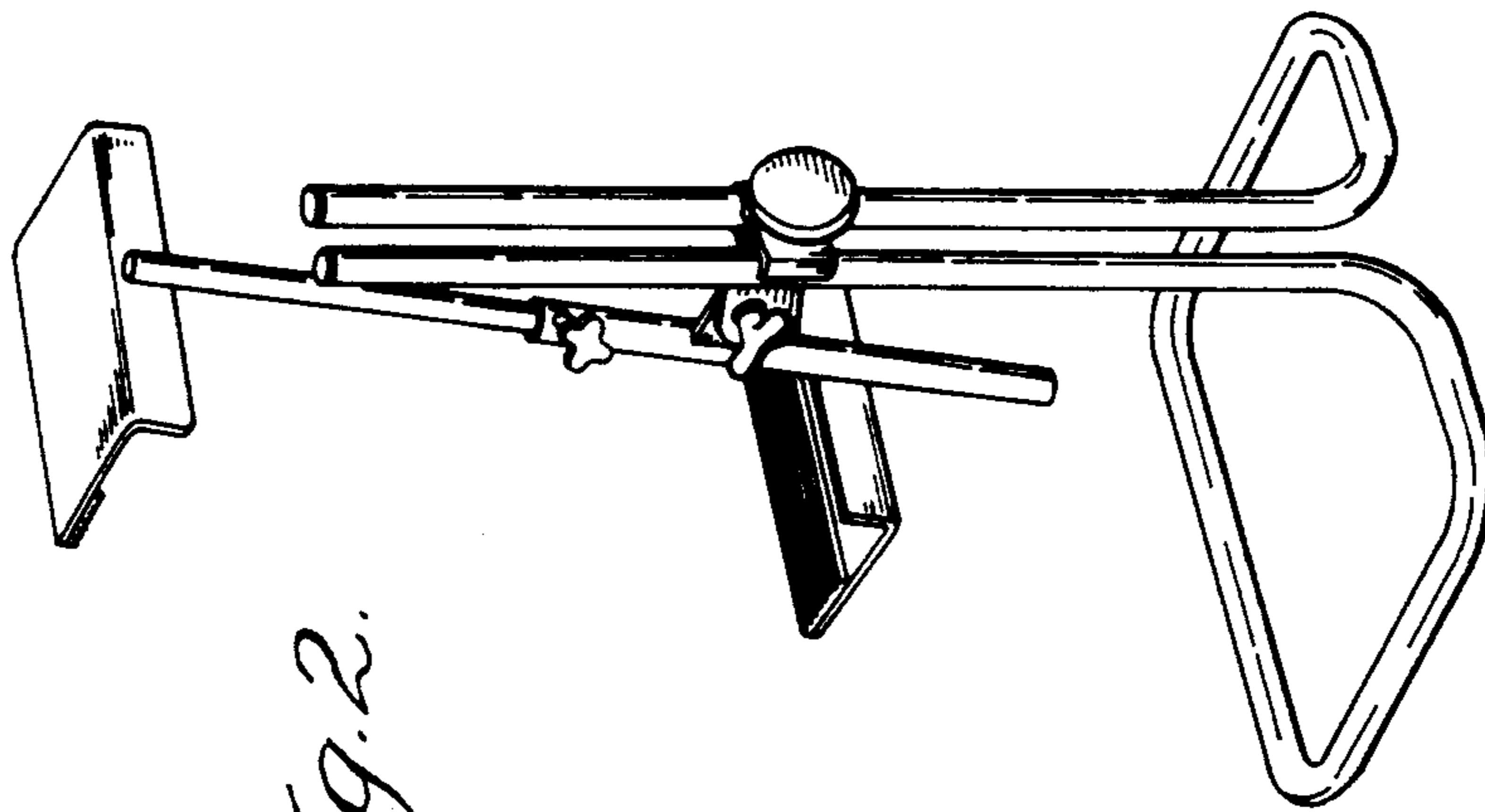
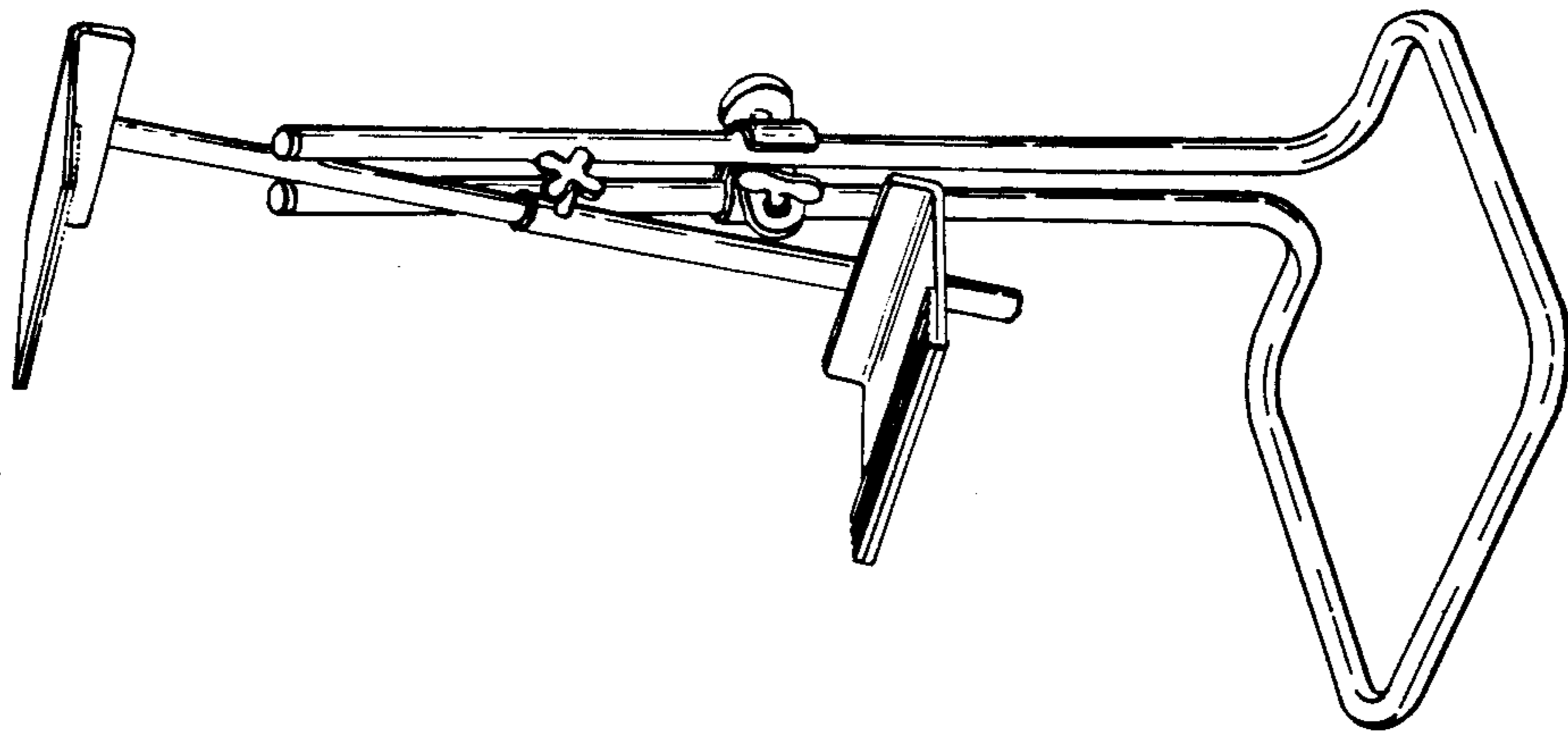
**DESCRIPTION**
