The ornamental design for a lunch pail or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

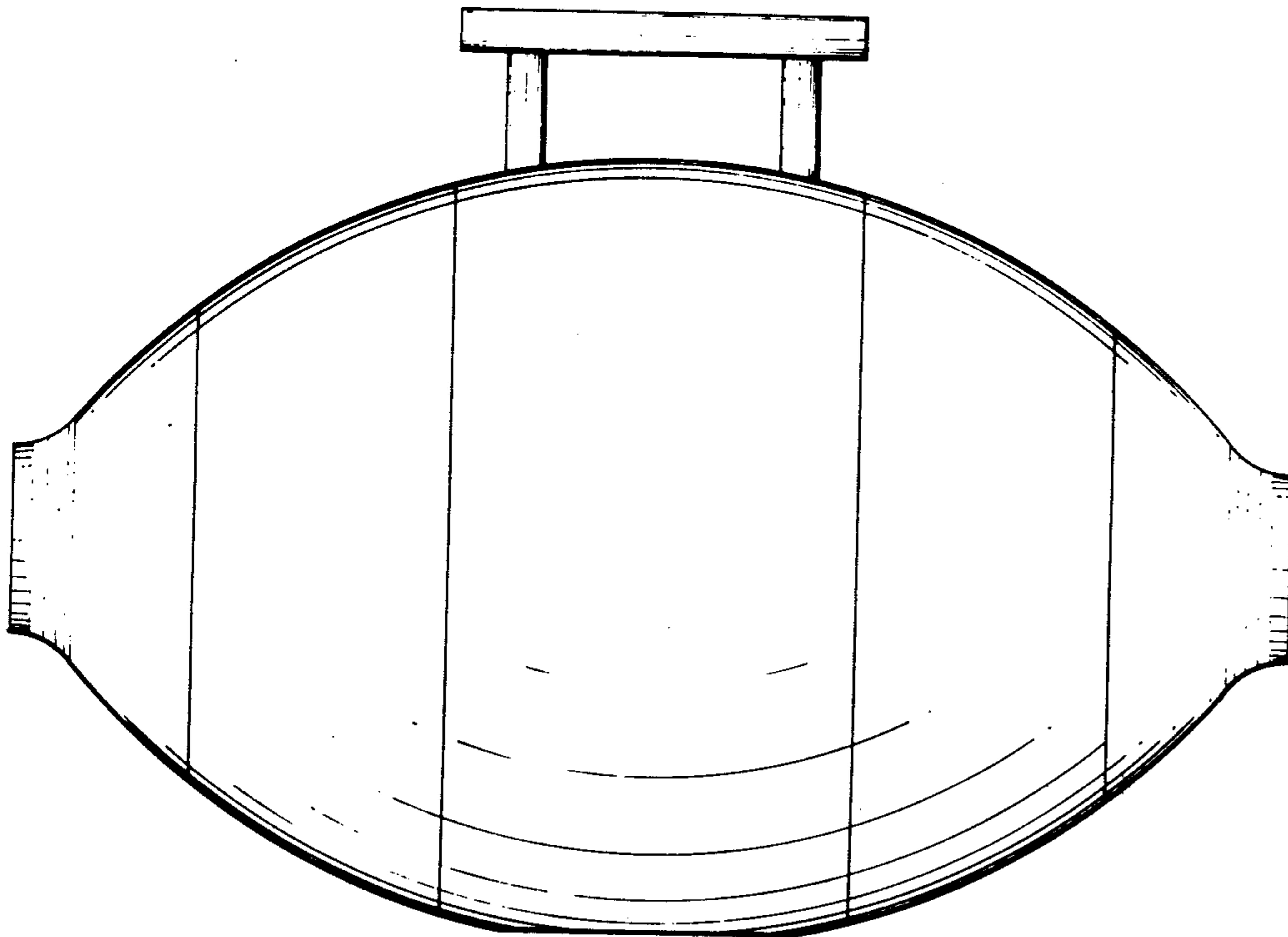
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a lunch pail or similar article showing my new design, both sides being identical.

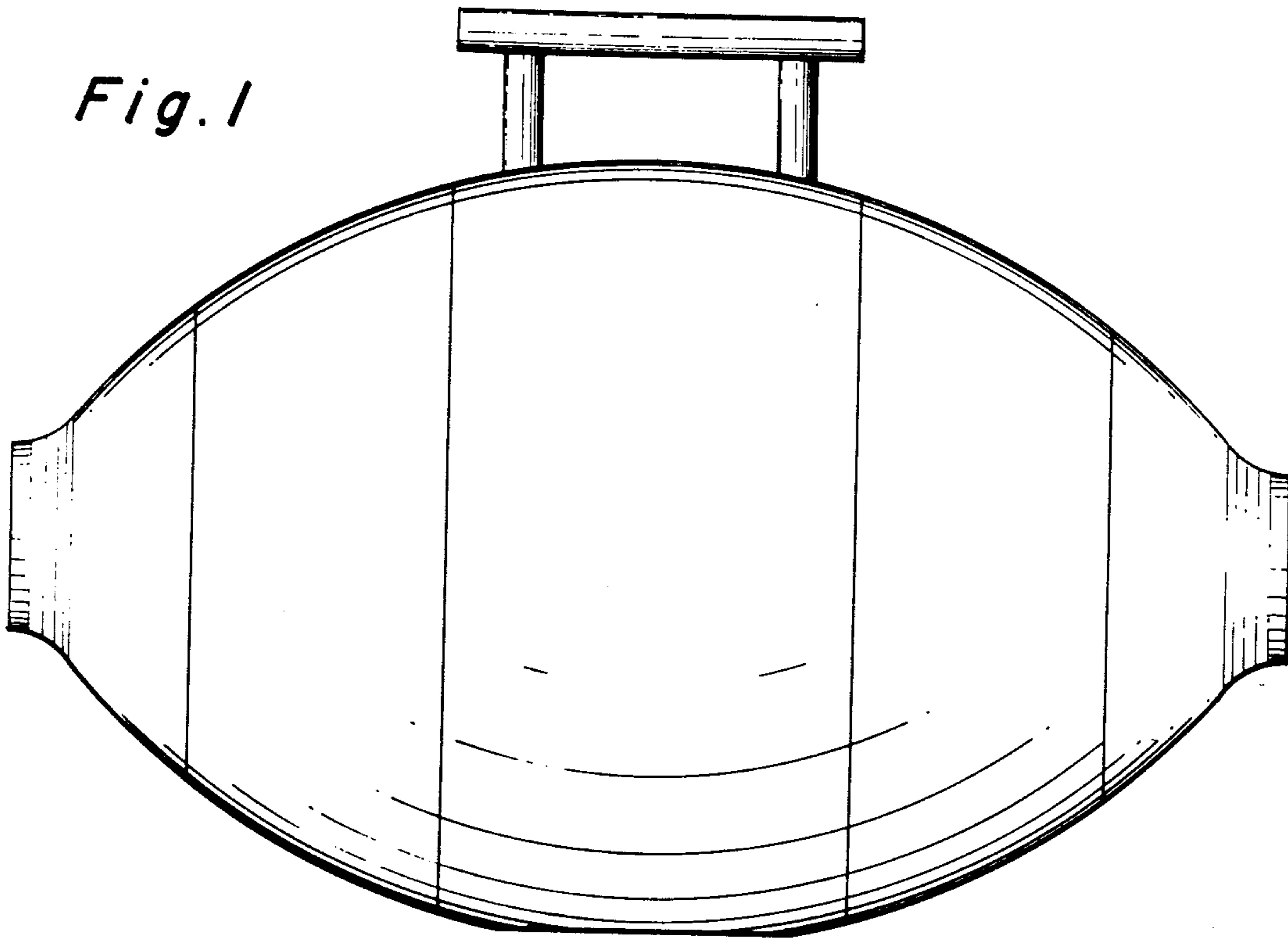
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.

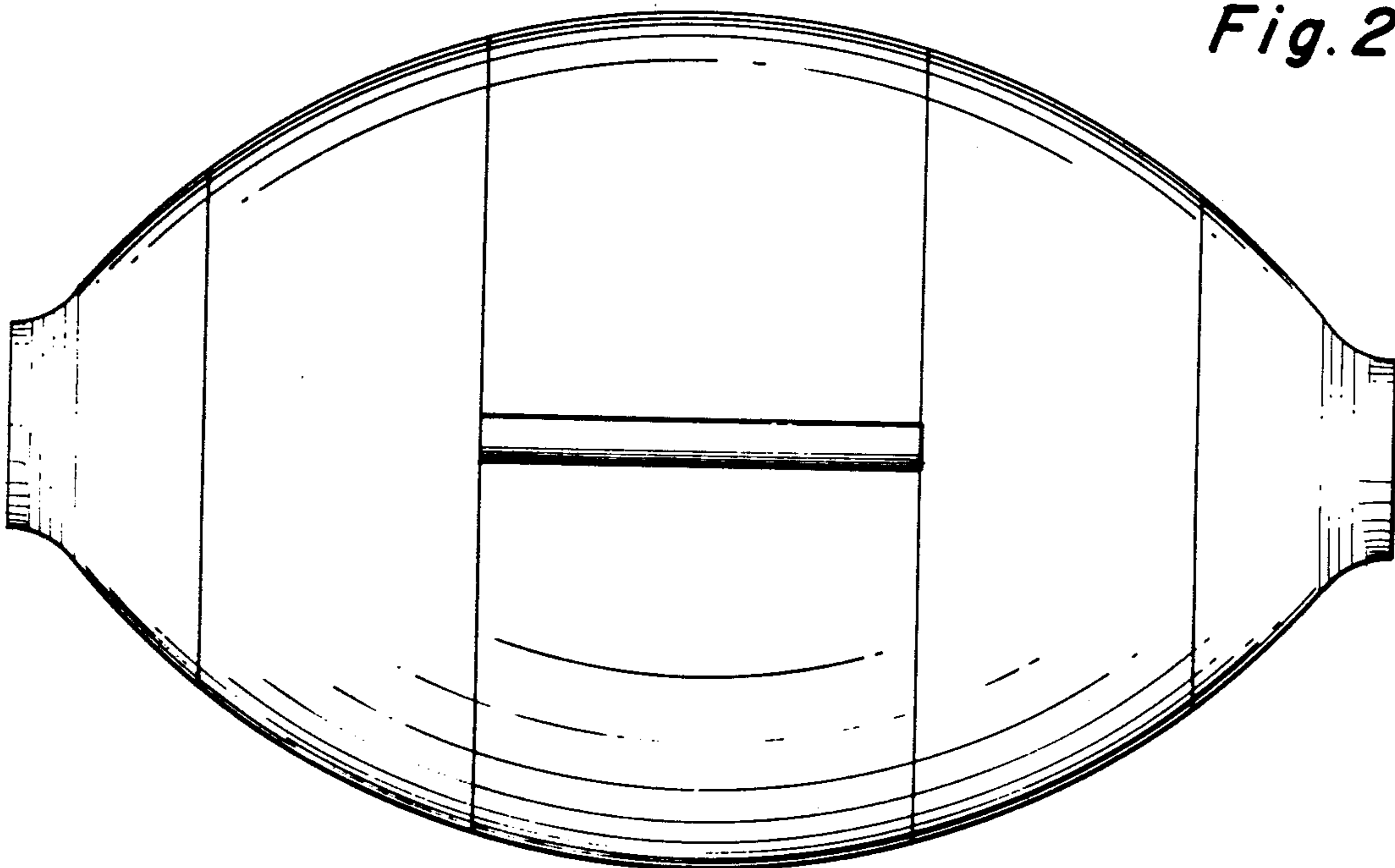
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, both ends being identical.



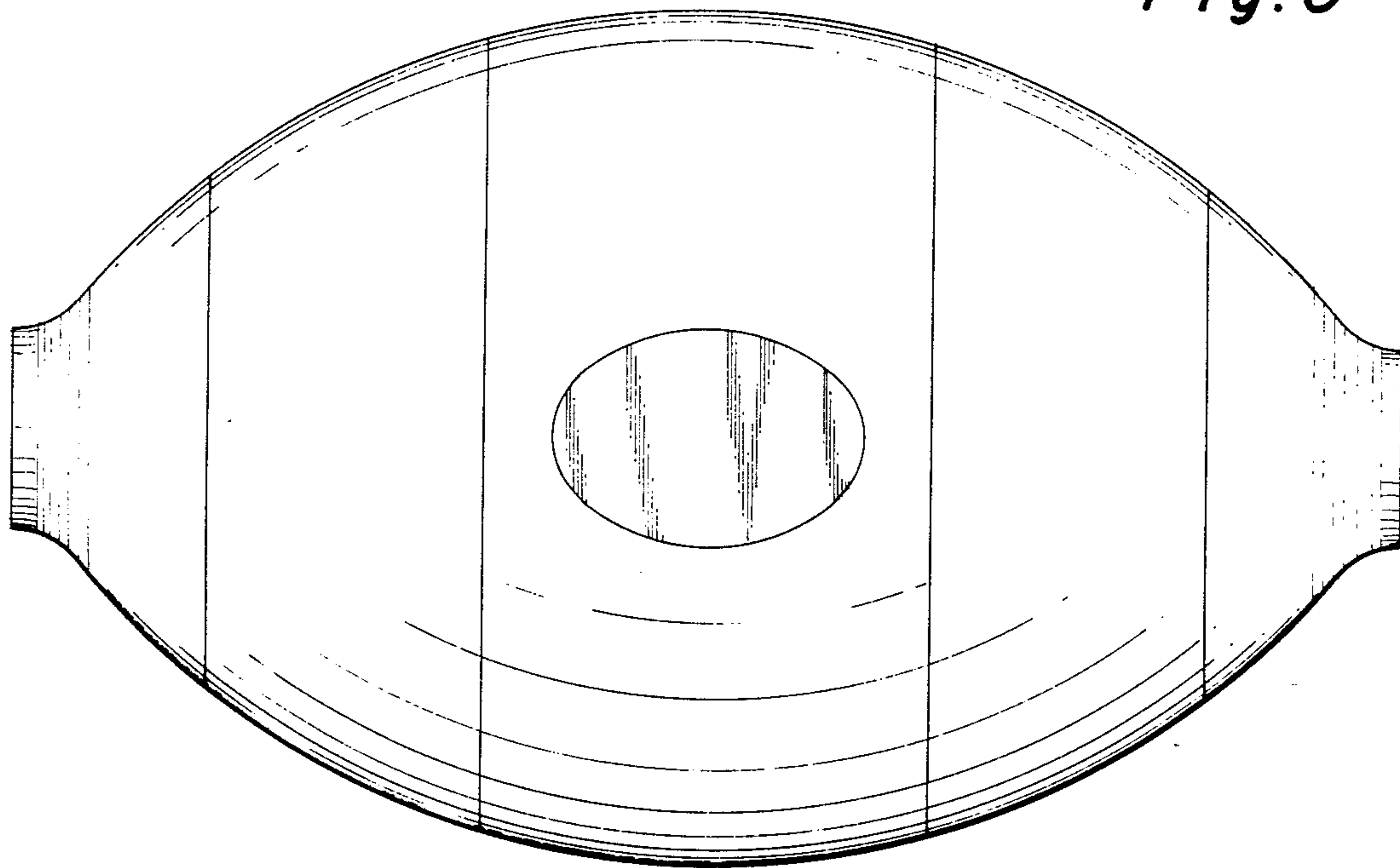
