FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

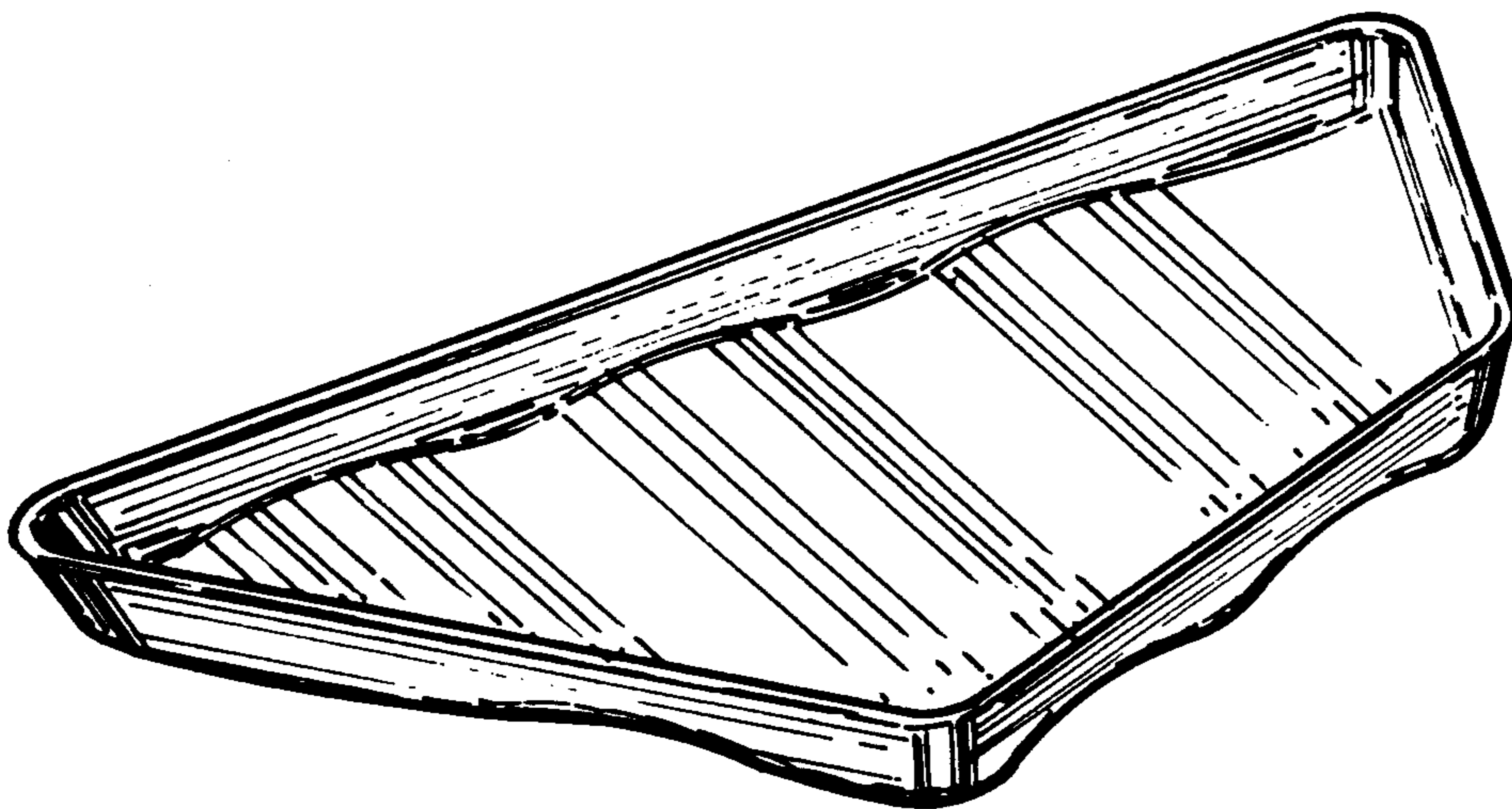
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and

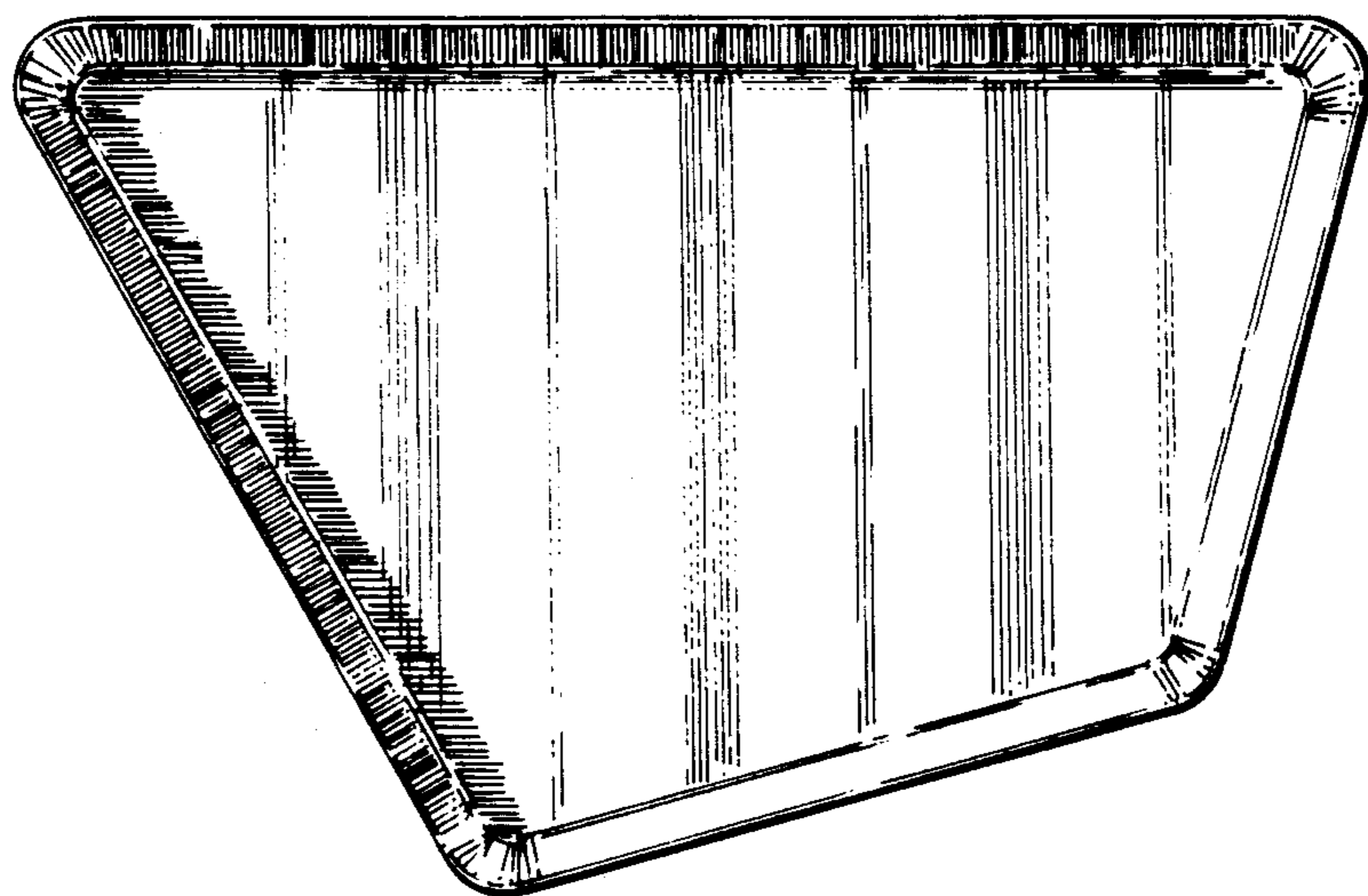

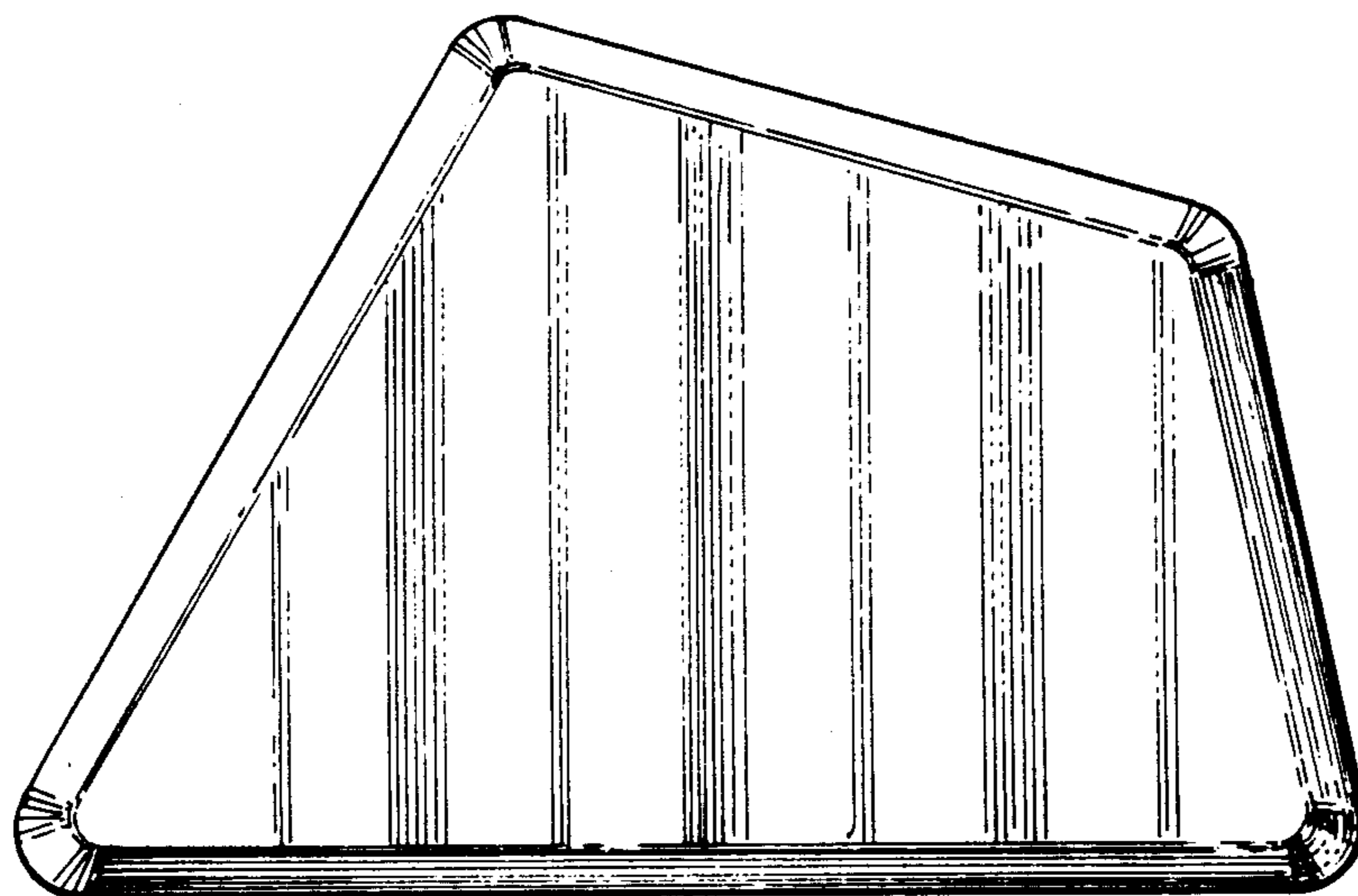

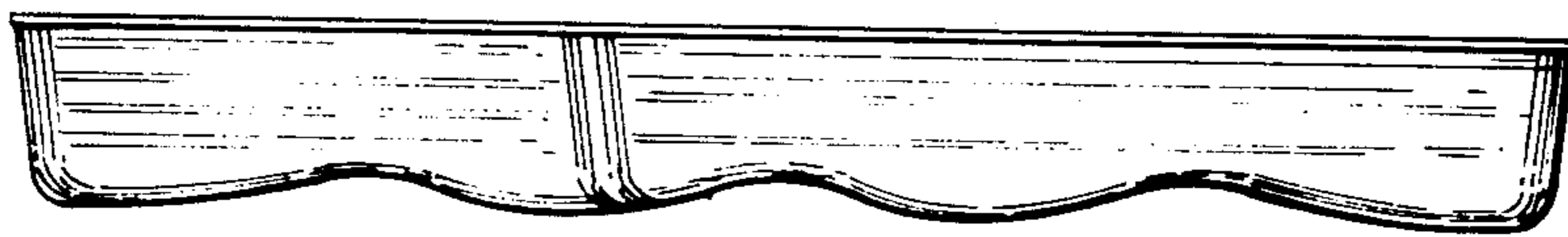

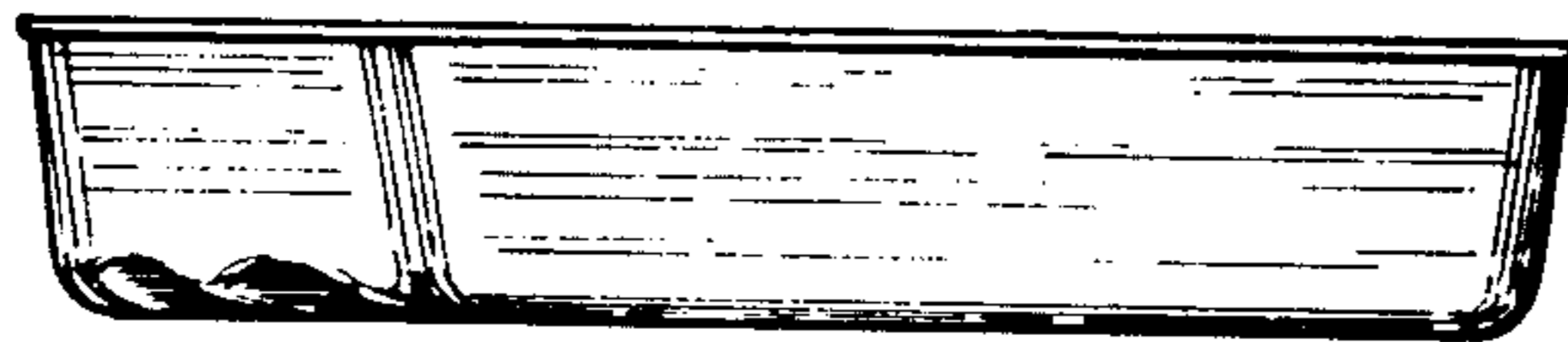

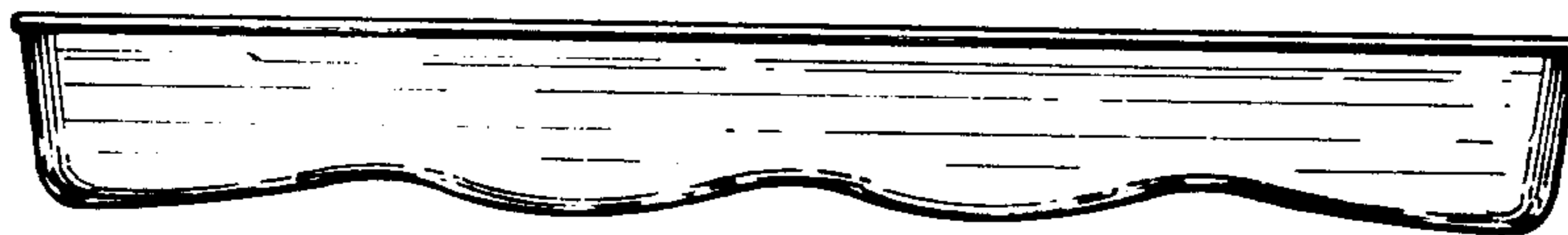

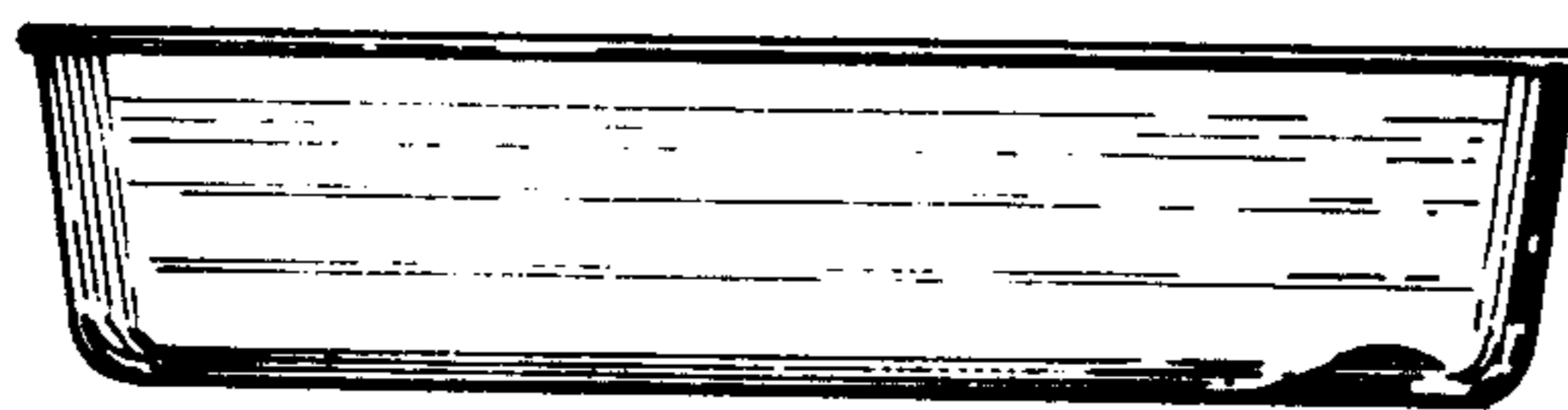

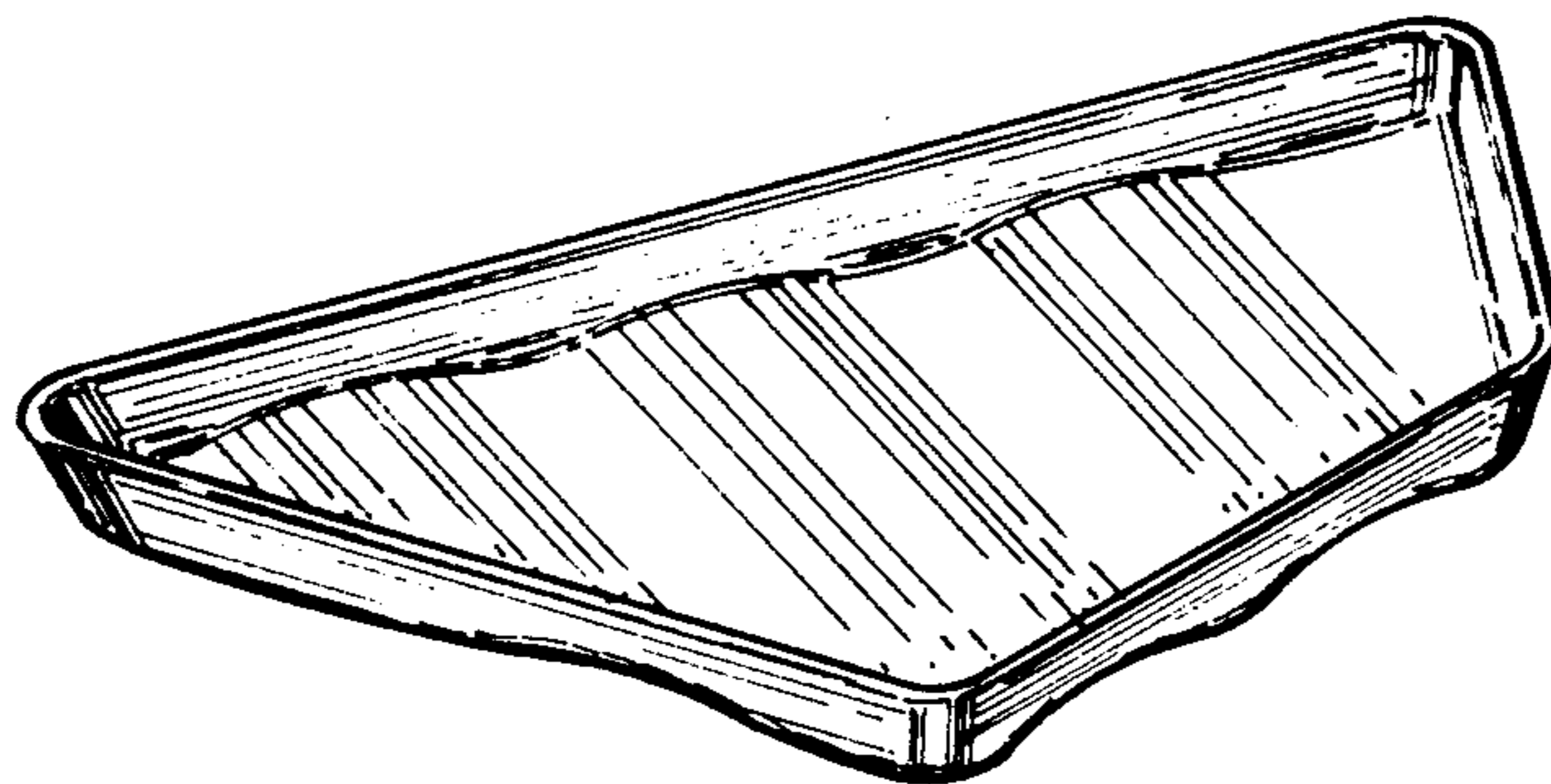
