FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 1.

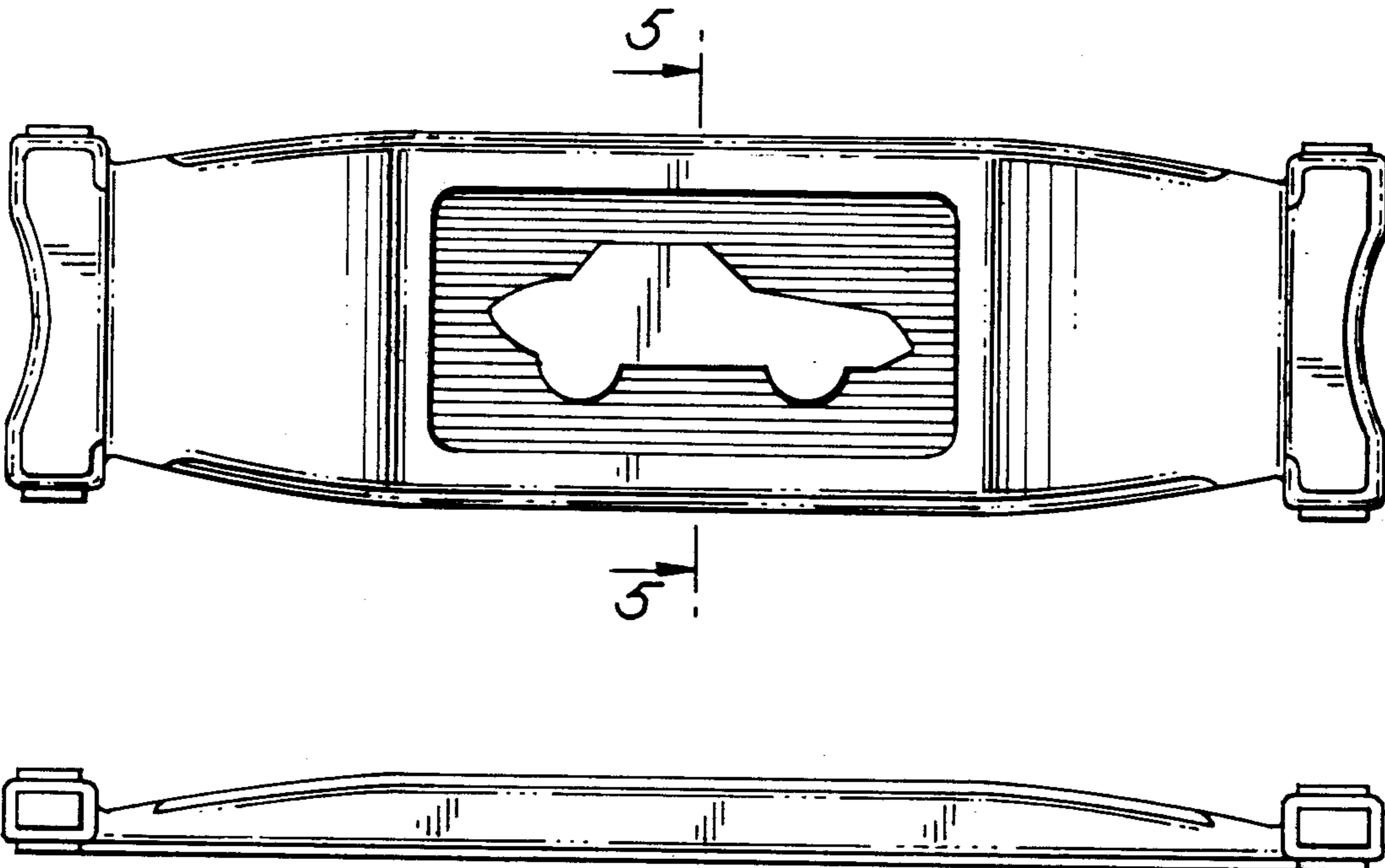

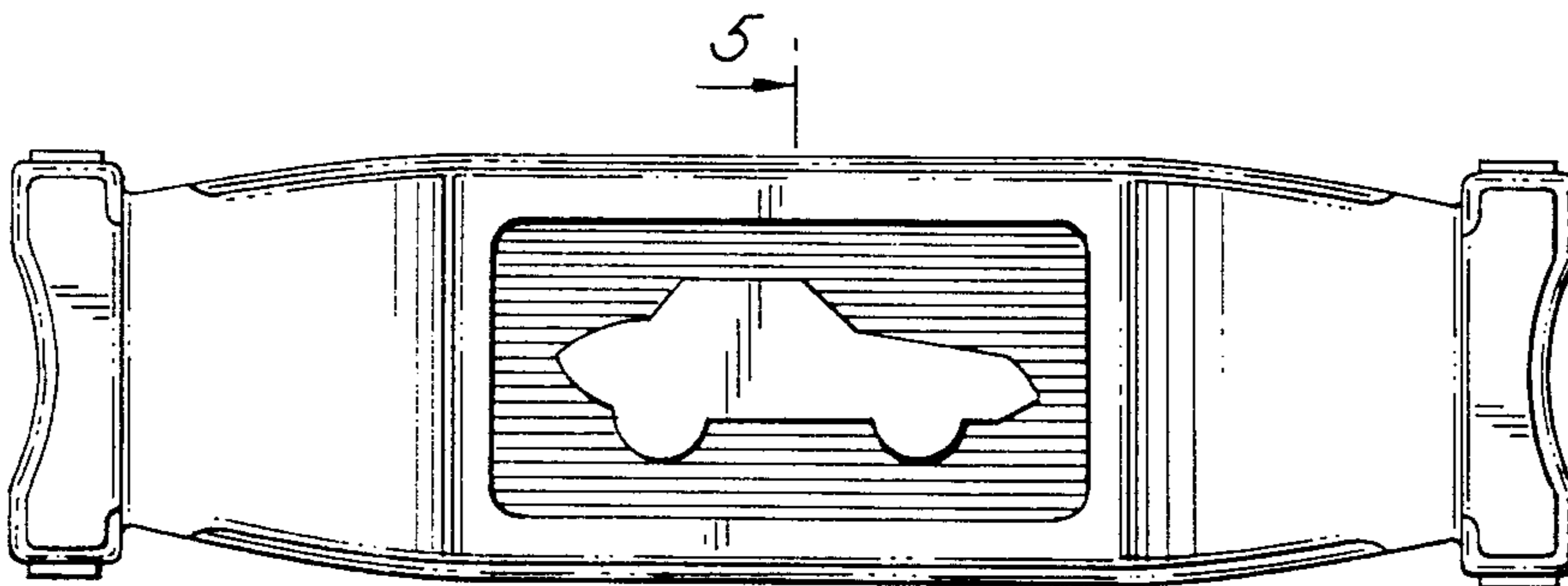

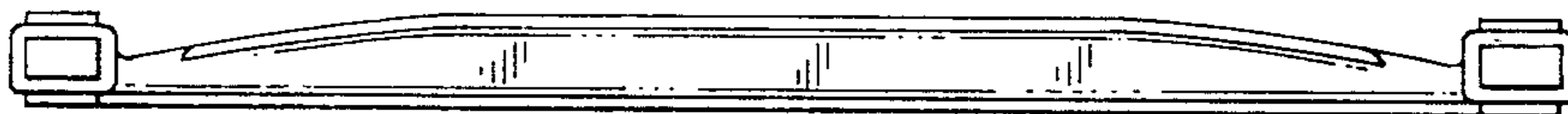

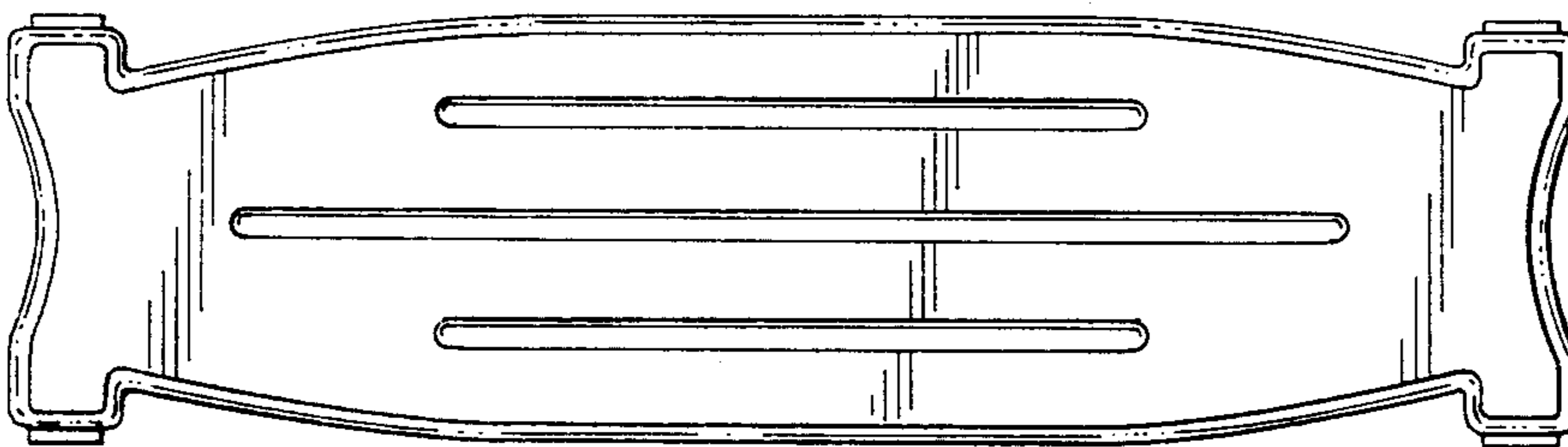

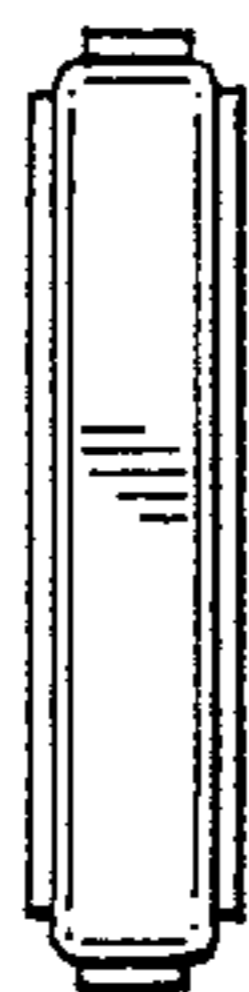
