[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a marker for horticultural items, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a marker for horticultural items showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof; and FIG. 5 is a cross-section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 4.

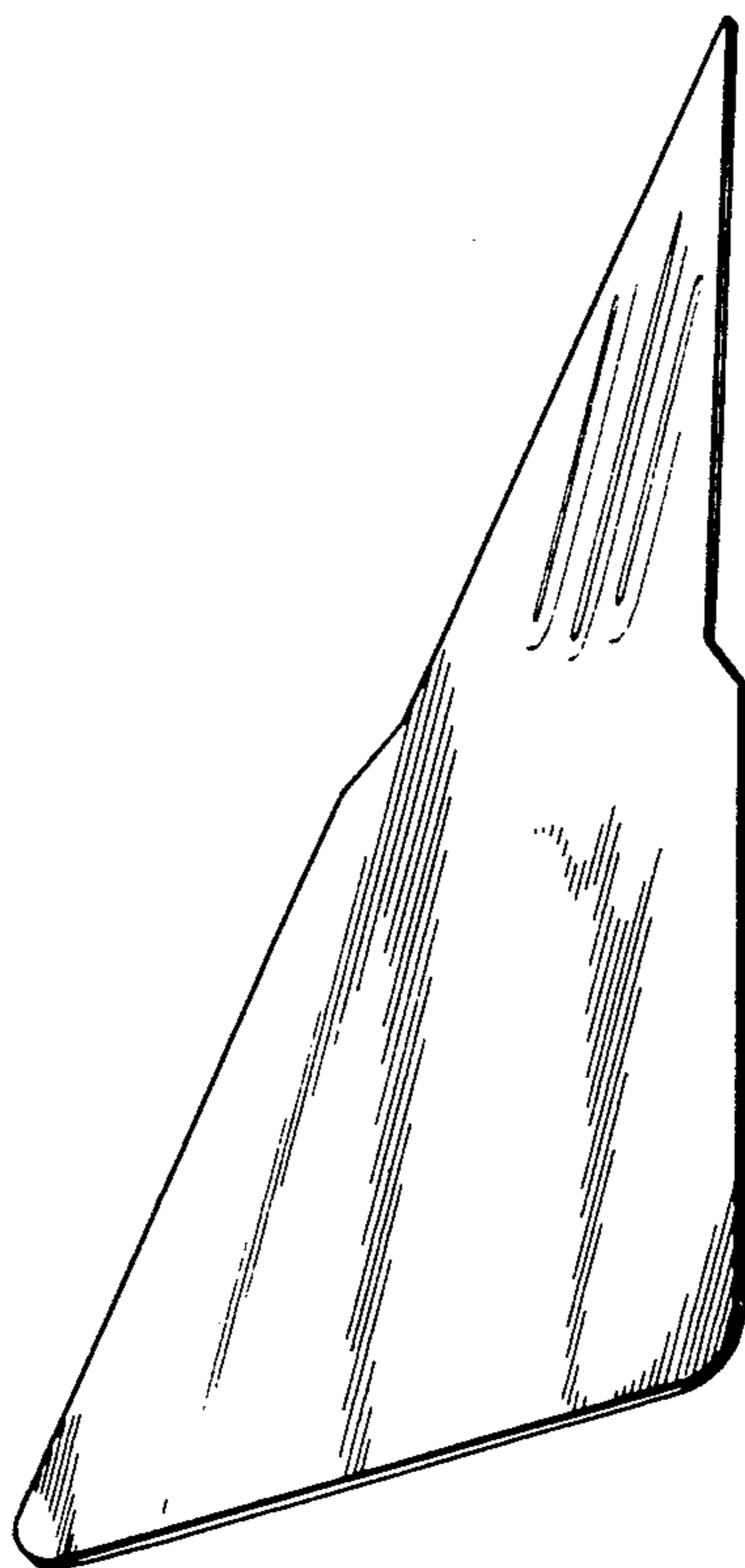

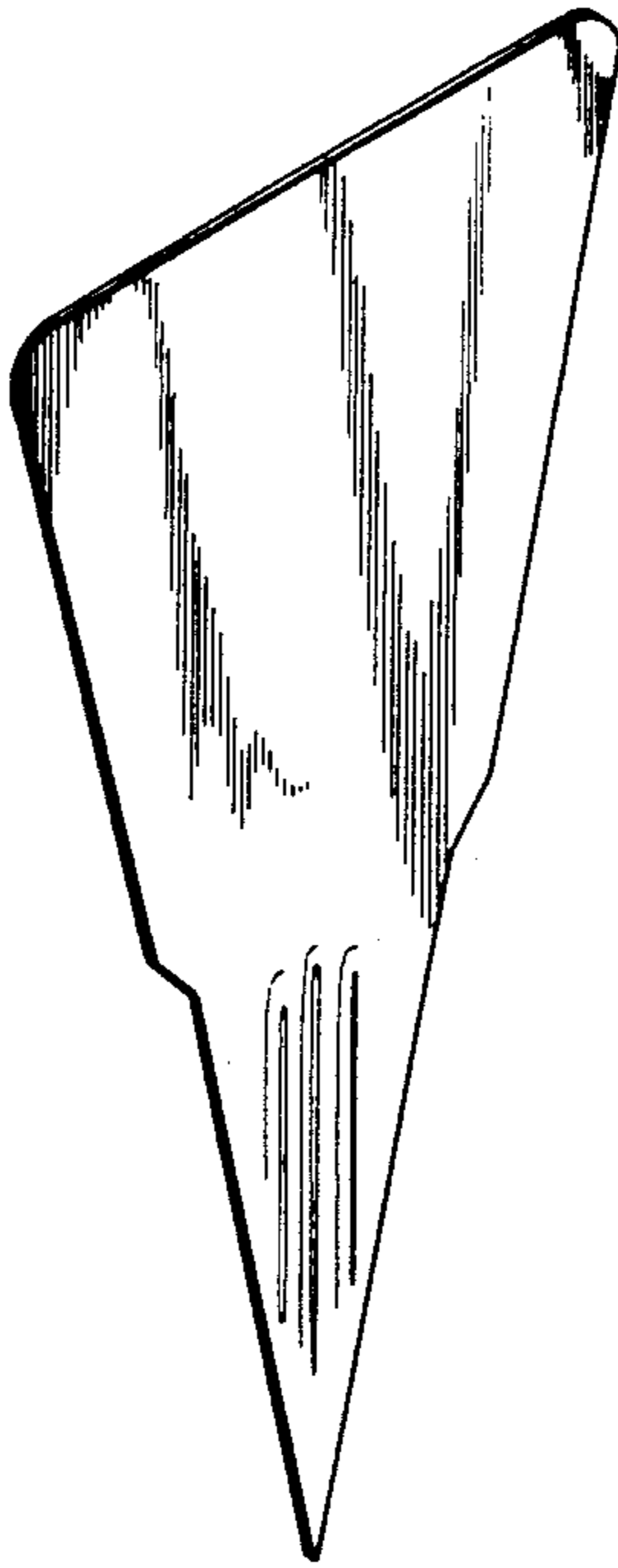

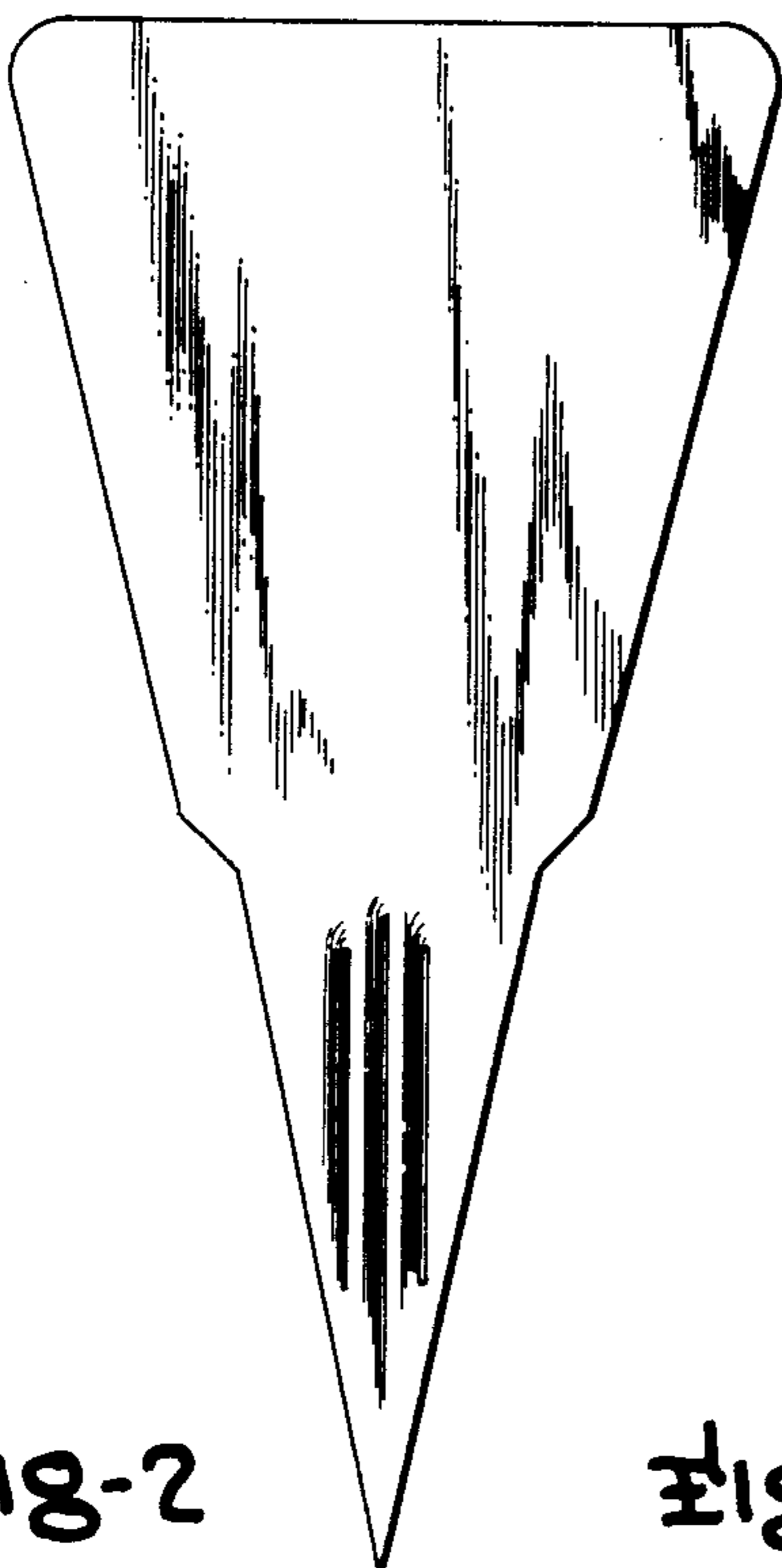
