The ornamental design for a dispensing pump, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a dispensing pump embodying our new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view looking from the left side of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and

FIG. 5 is an elevational view looking from the right side of FIG. 1.

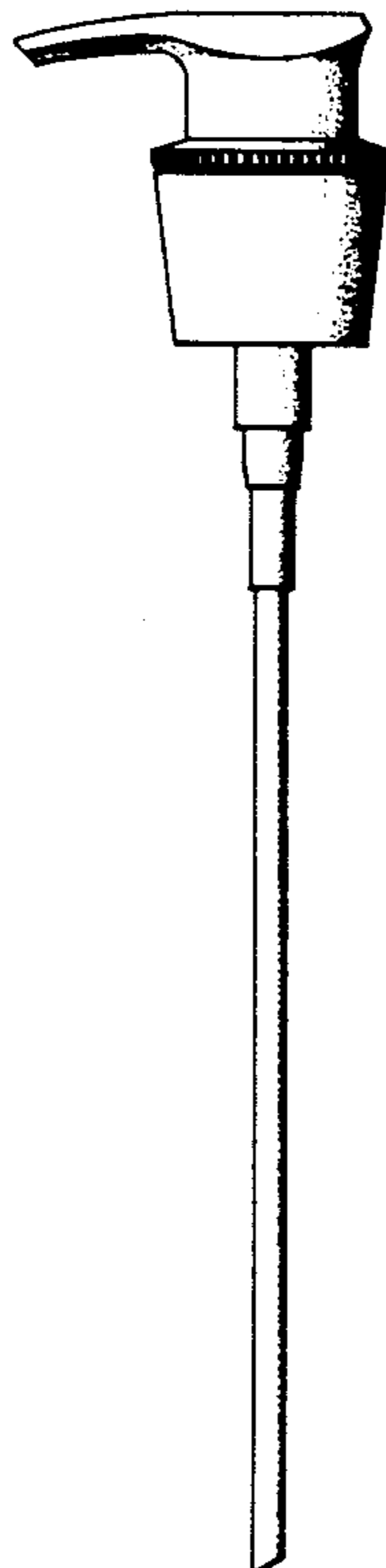

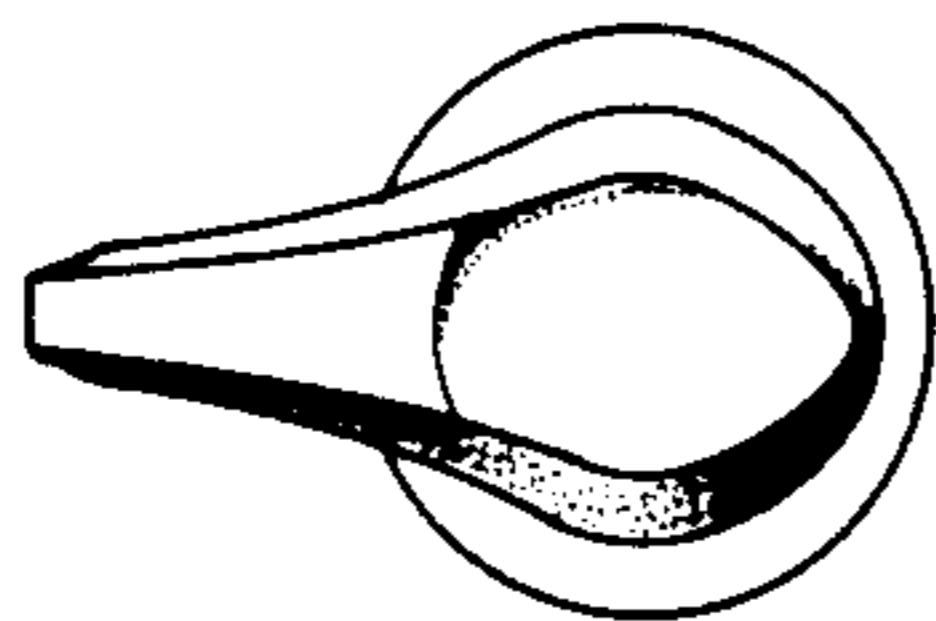

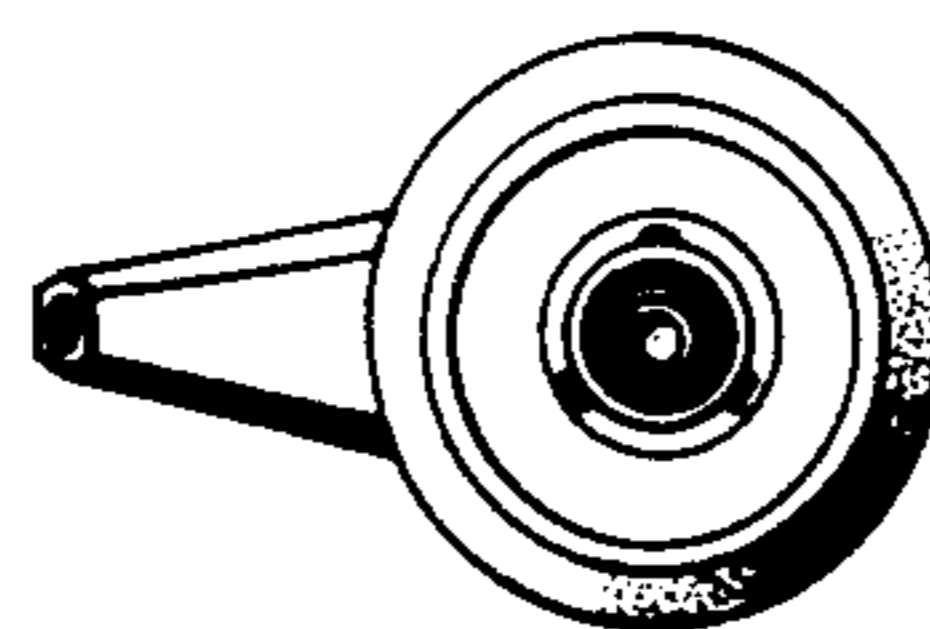

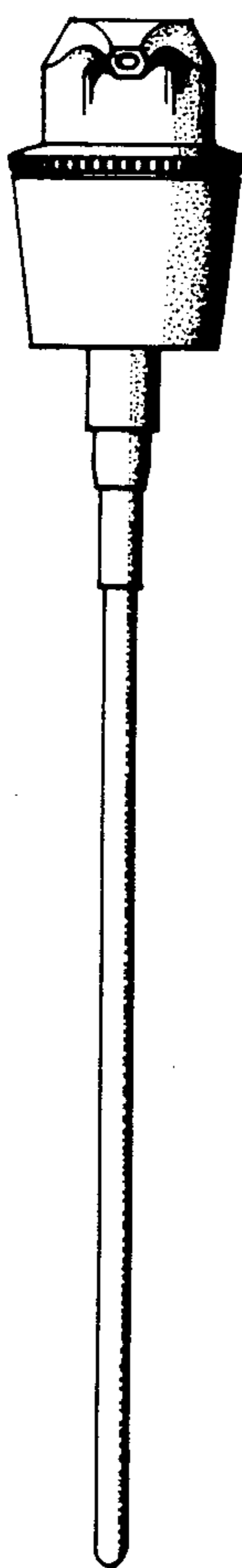

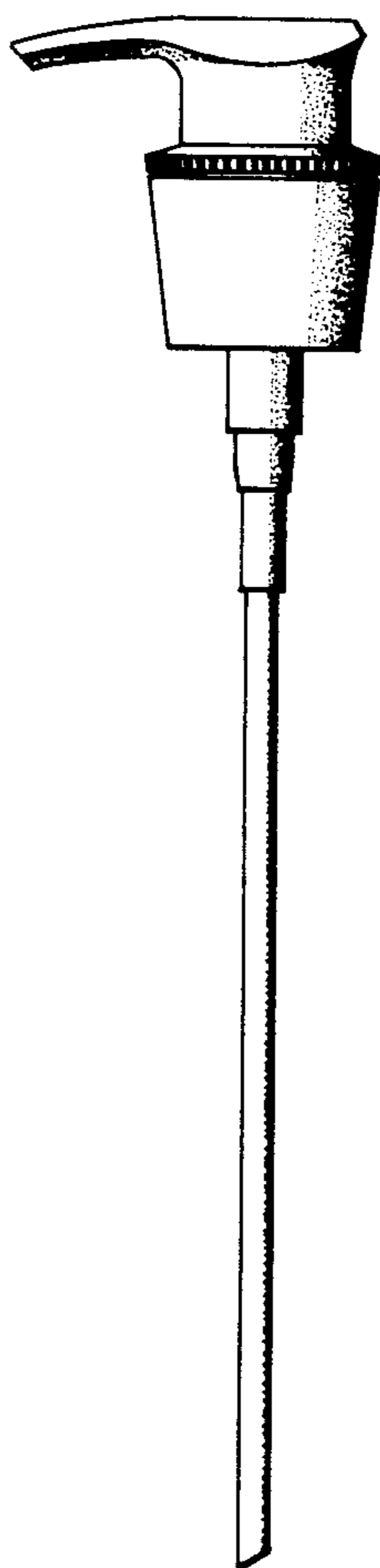
