The essential feature of our design resides in the chevron configuration of the outer frame portions.

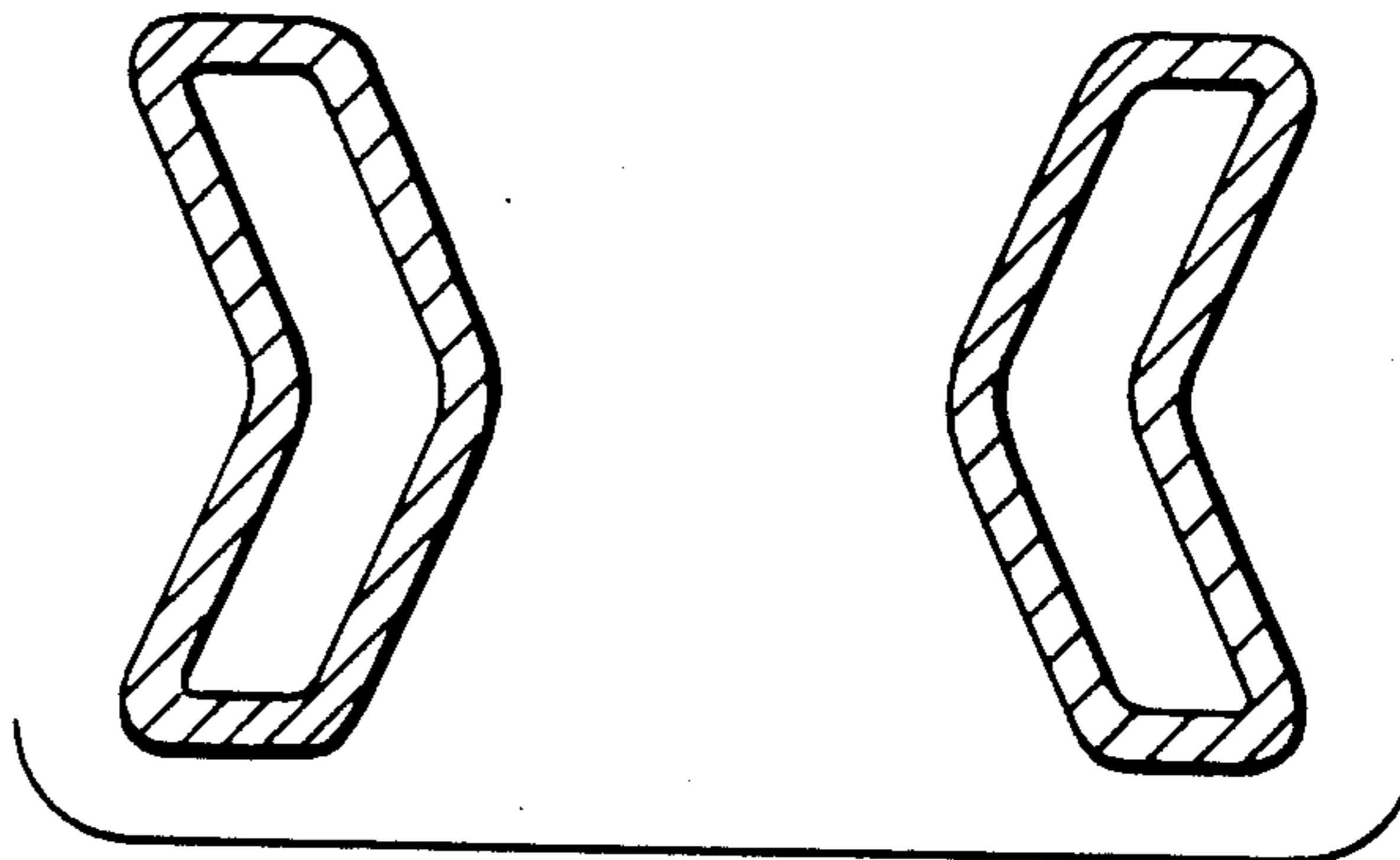
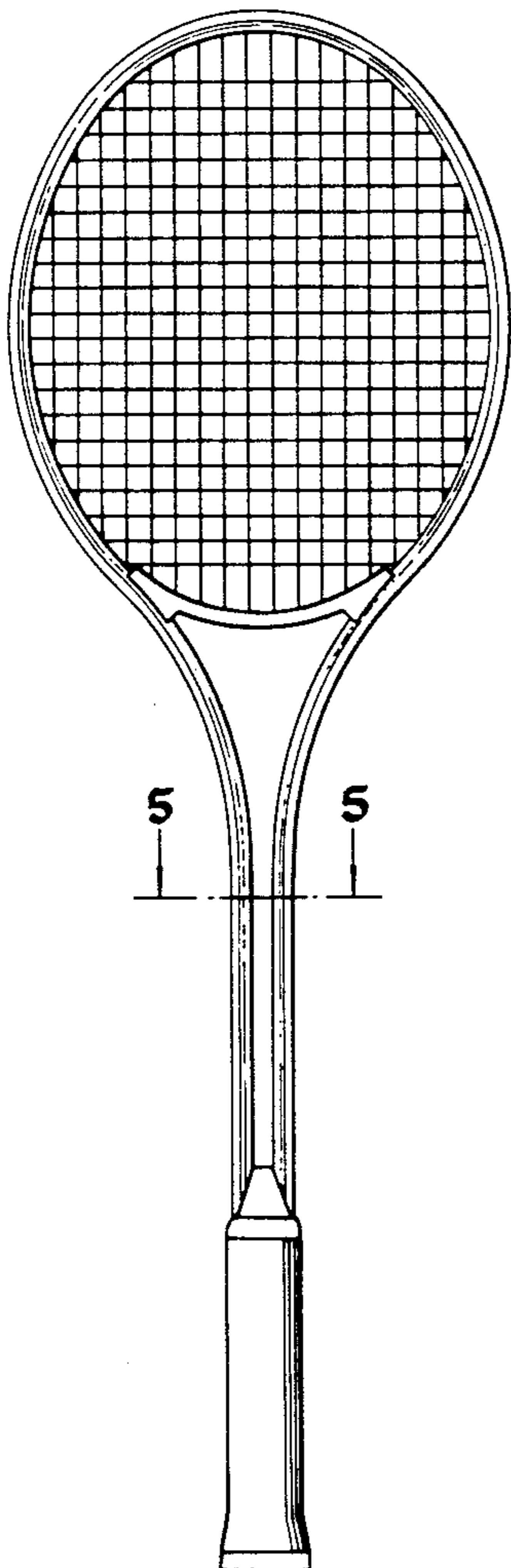

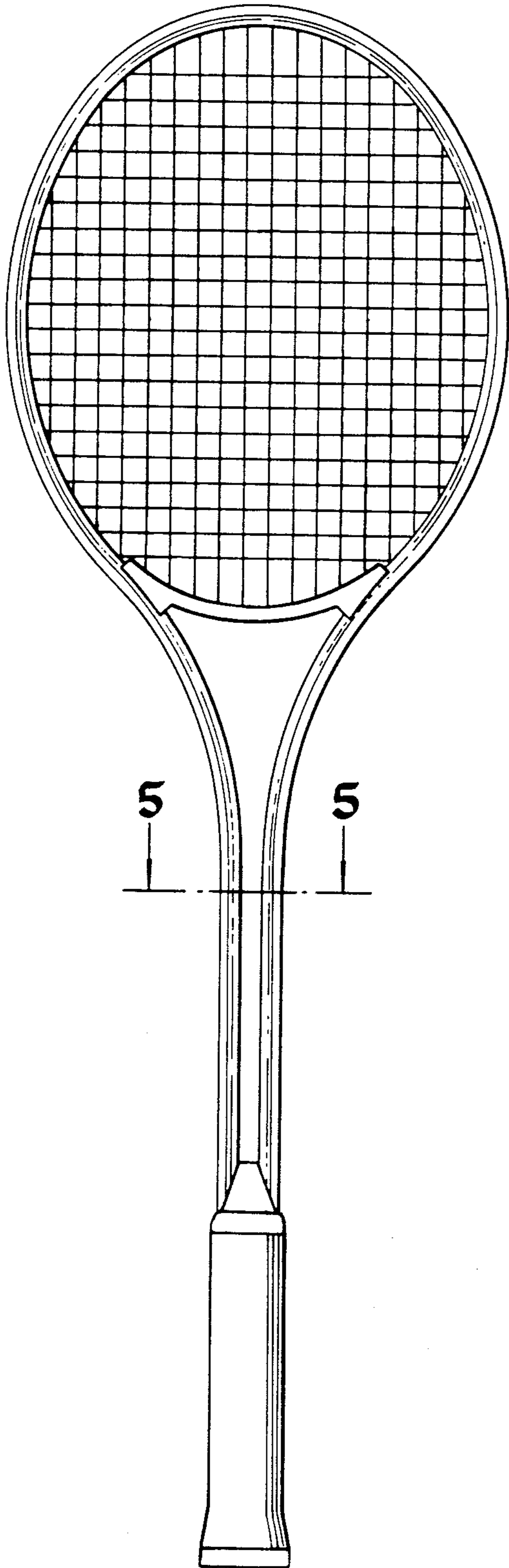

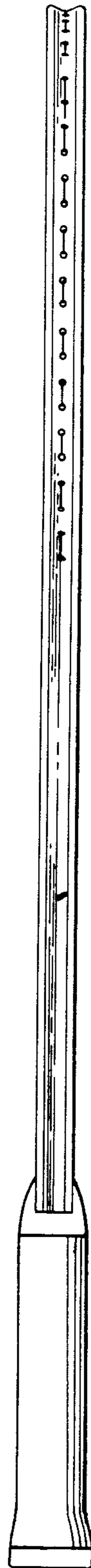

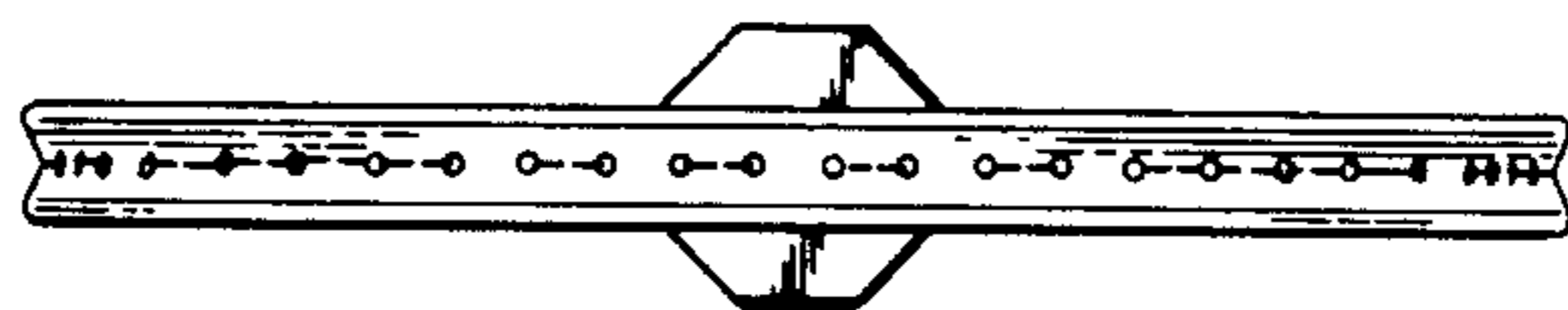

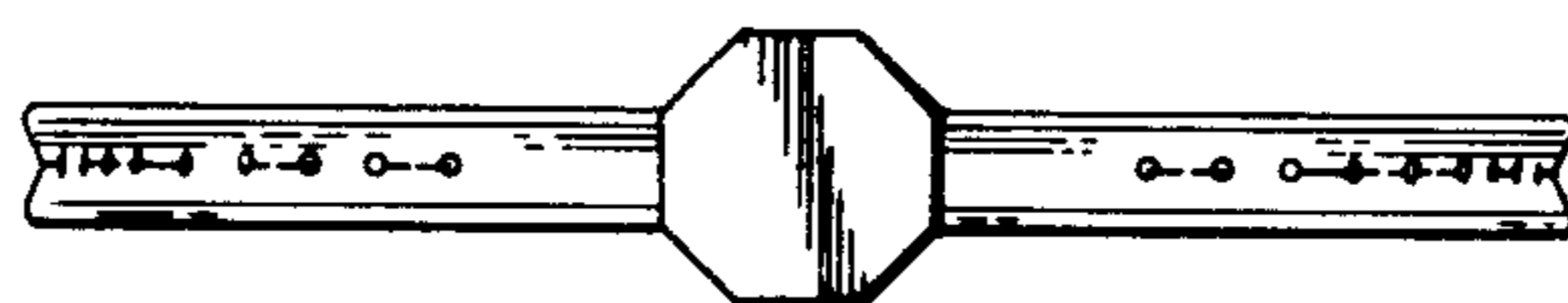

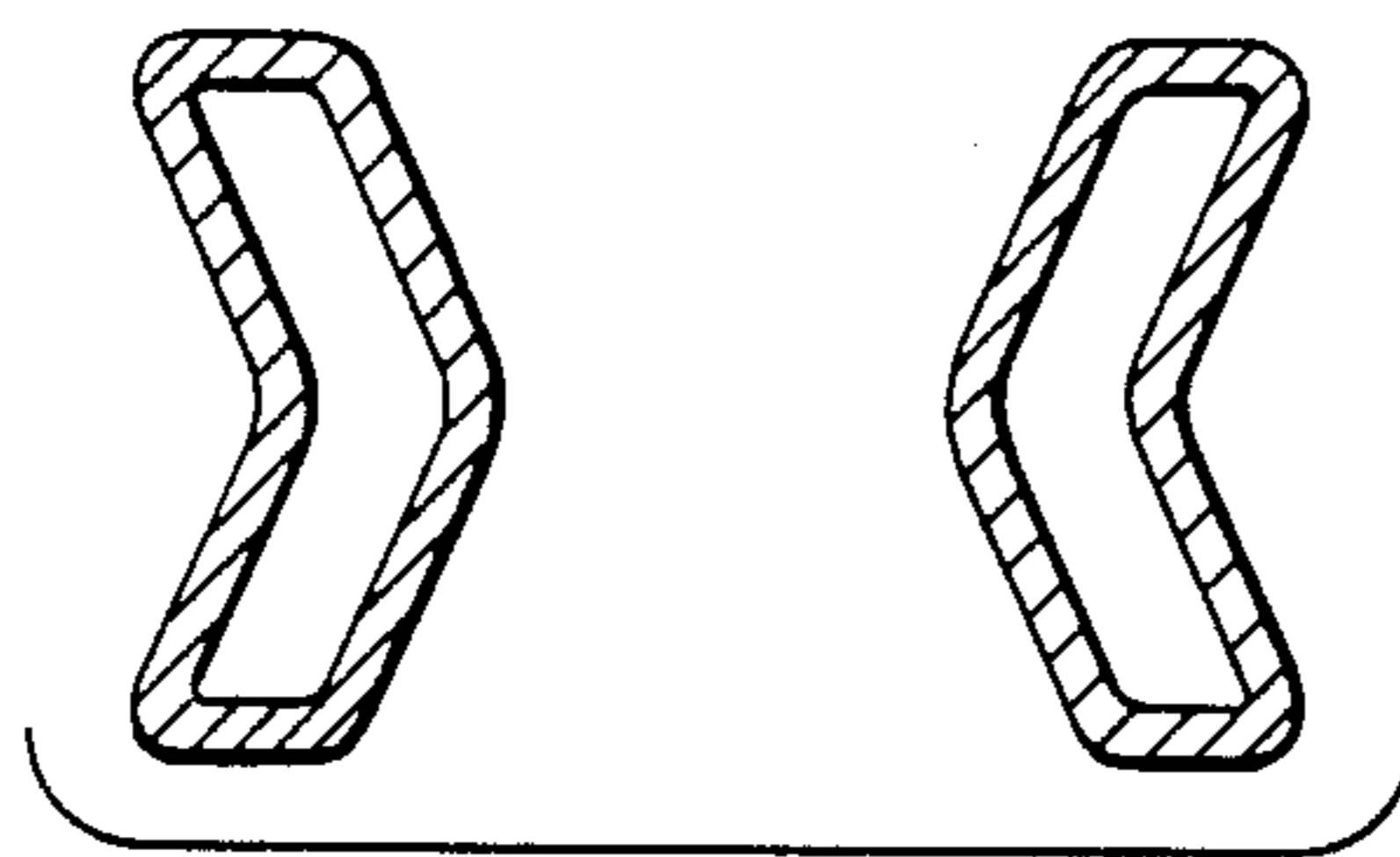
