[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined cane and cue stick, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined cane and cue stick, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof showing the parts in an exploded relationship; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a cue stick formed from the parts of the cane shown in FIG. 4; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof showing the parts in an exploded relationship.

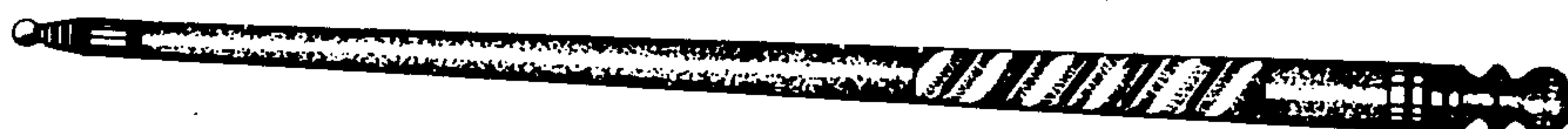

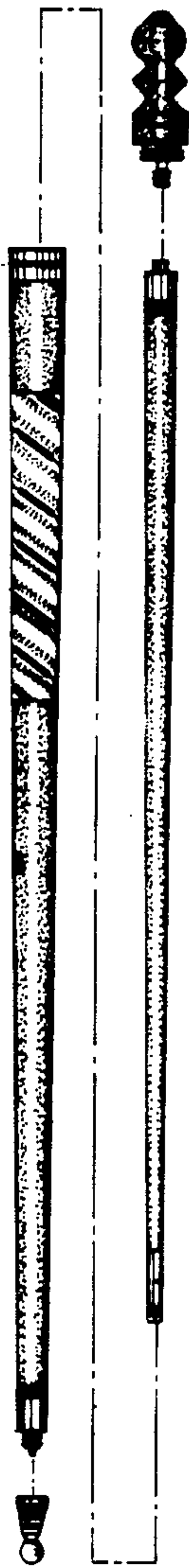
