[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fishing lure, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the fishing lure;
 FIG. 2 is a top view of the fishing lure;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom view looking upwards toward the top of the fishing lure;
 FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken through lines 4—4 shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 5—5 shown in FIG. 1.
