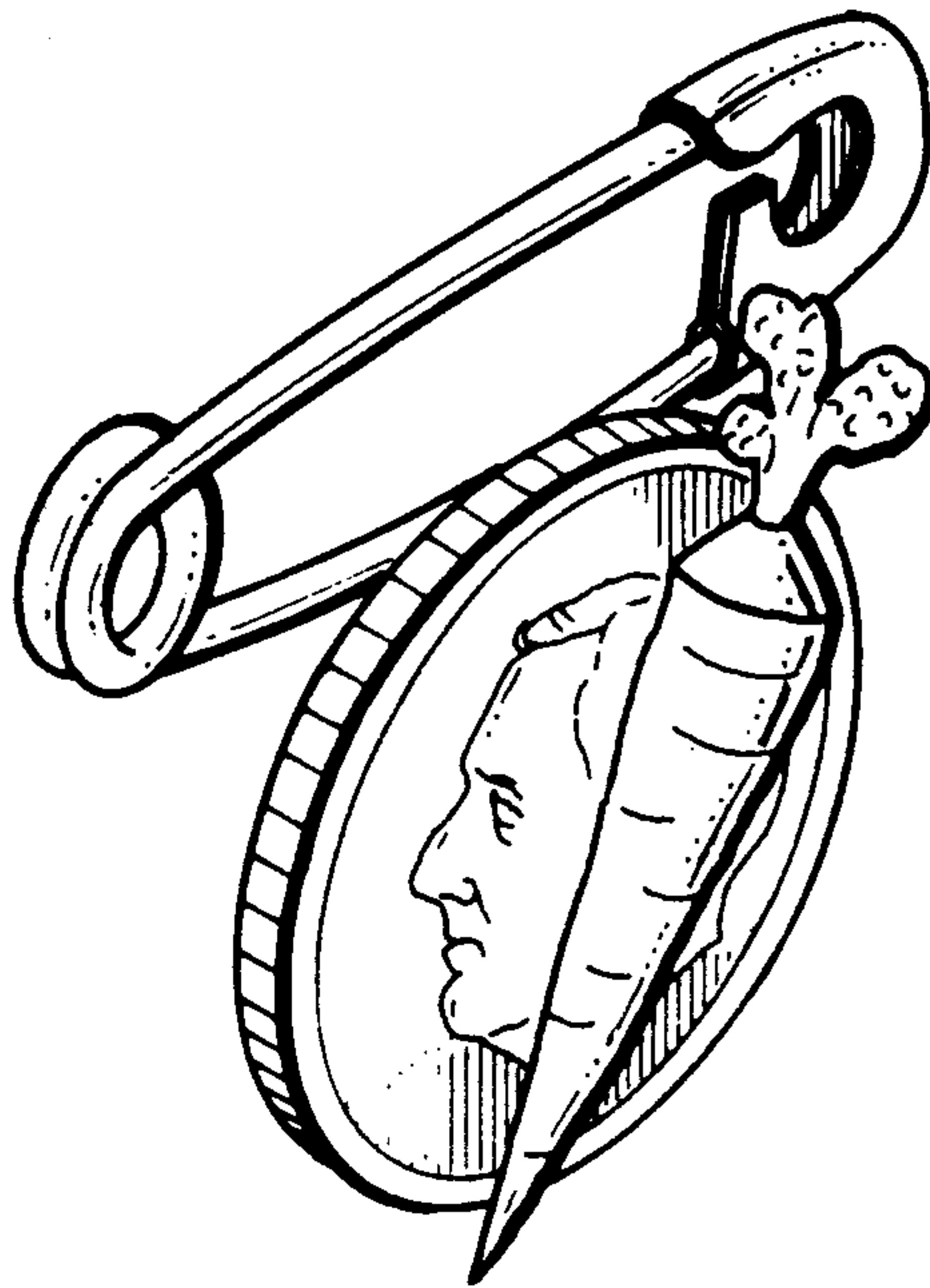

FIG. 3 is a rear top perspective view thereof.



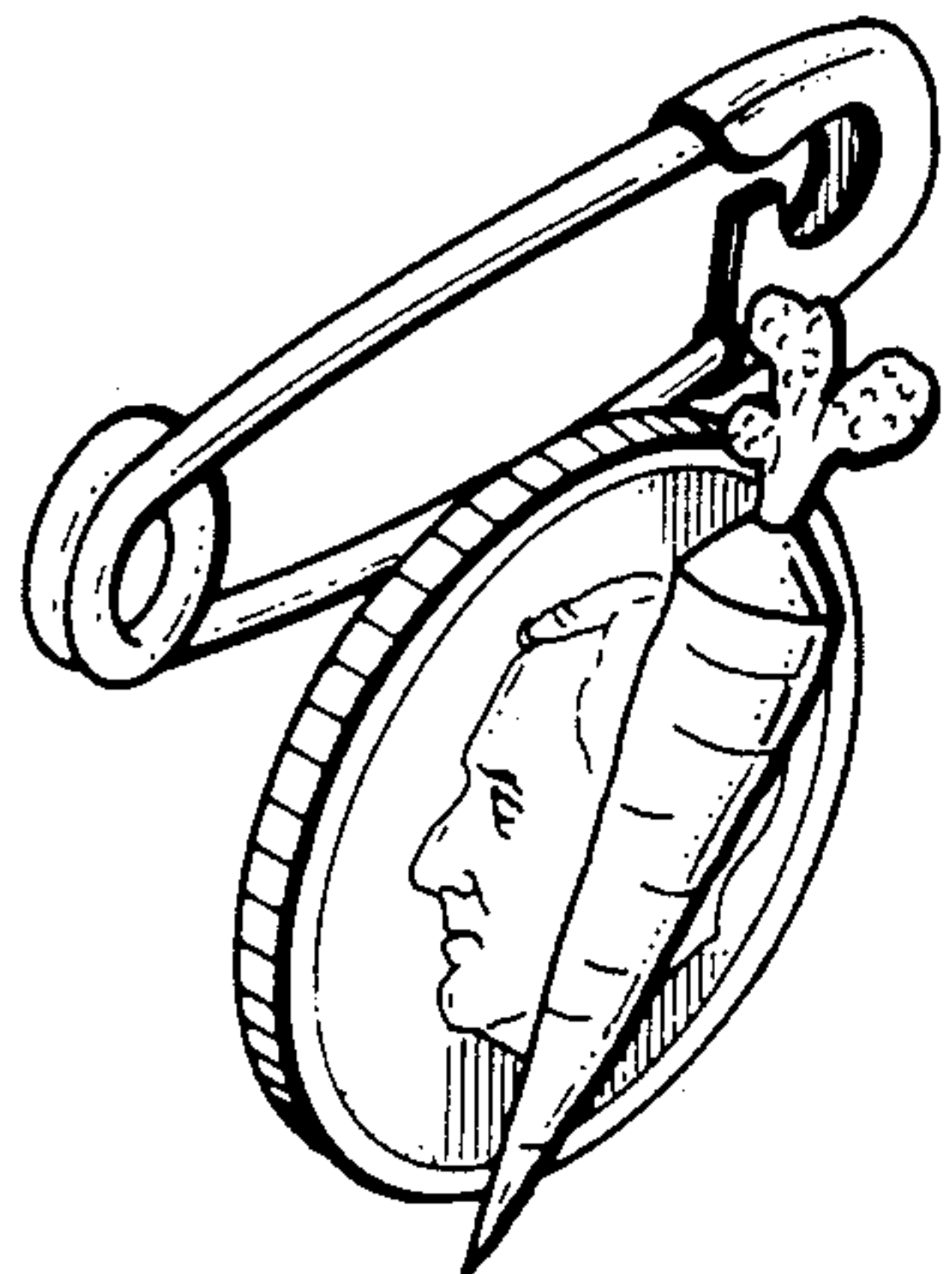

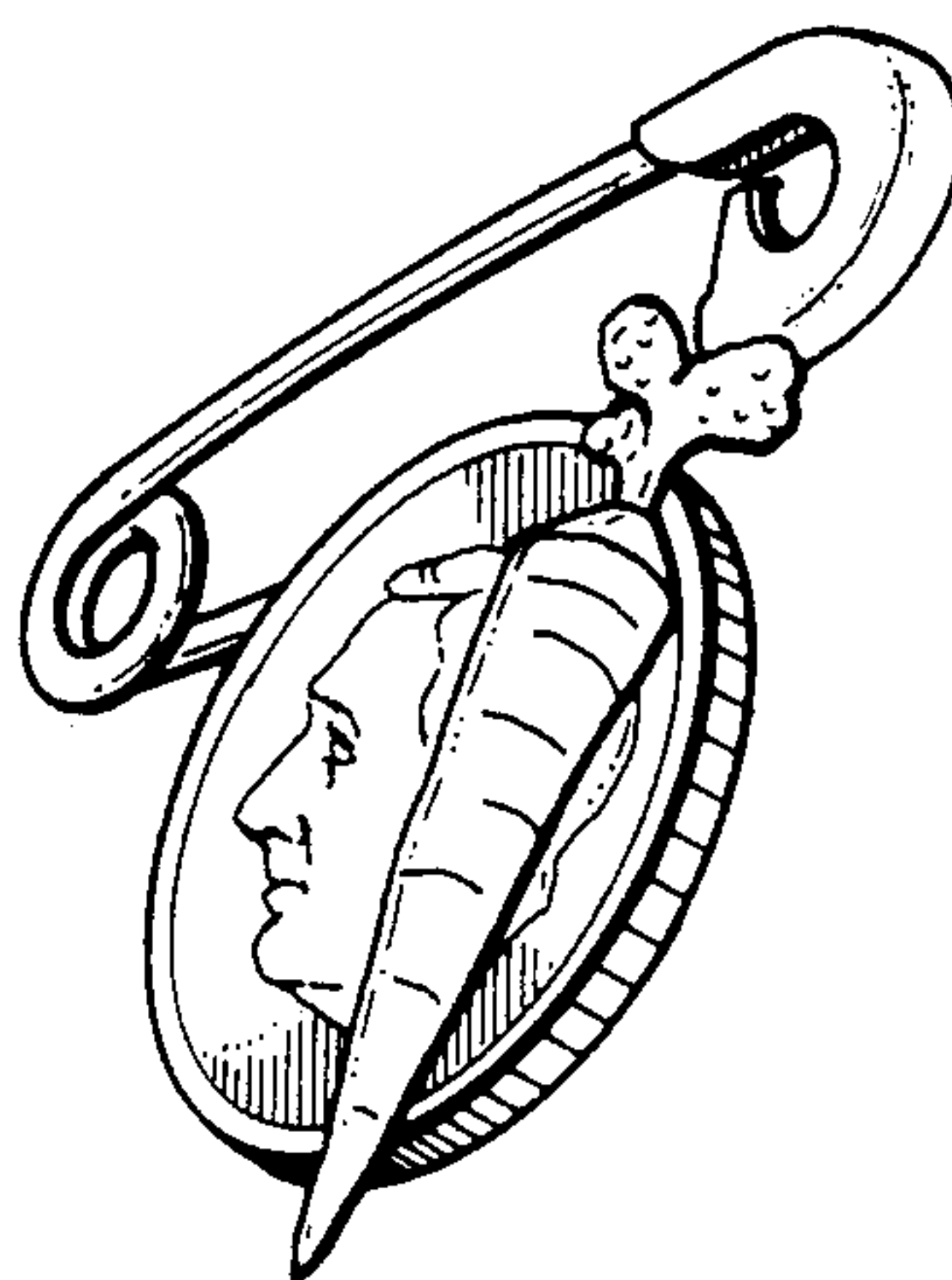

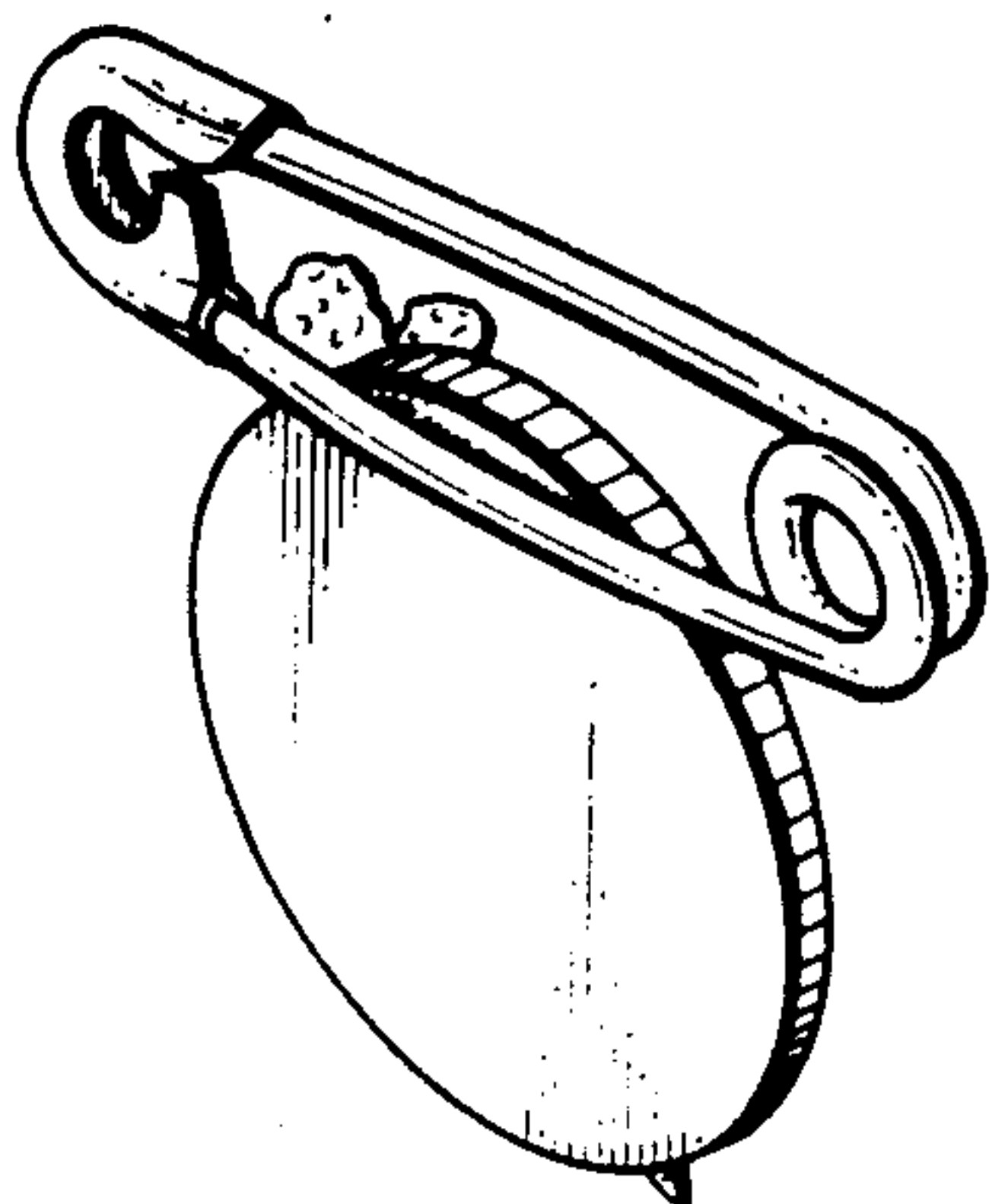
