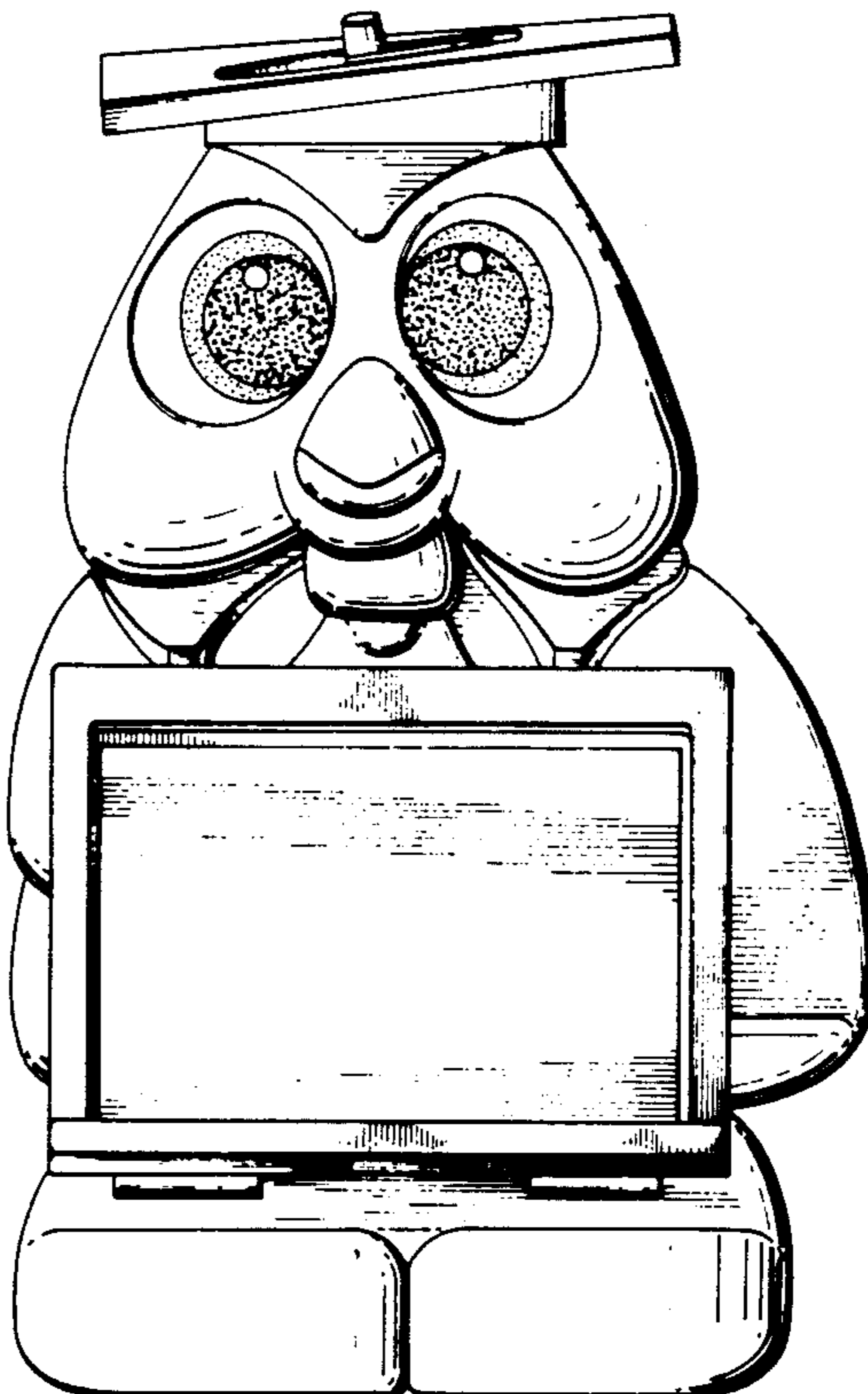

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a simulative toy desk showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof in an open condition;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



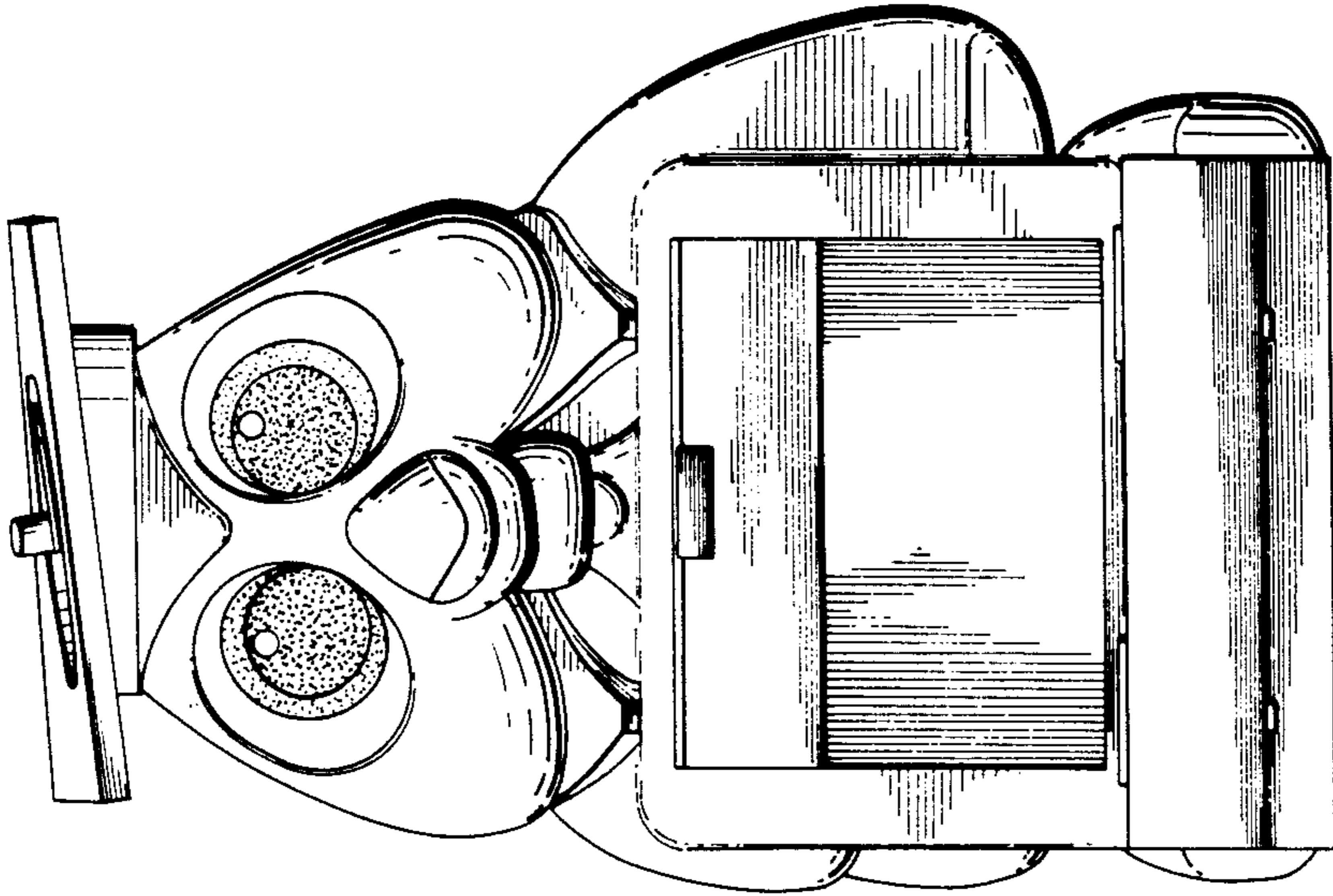

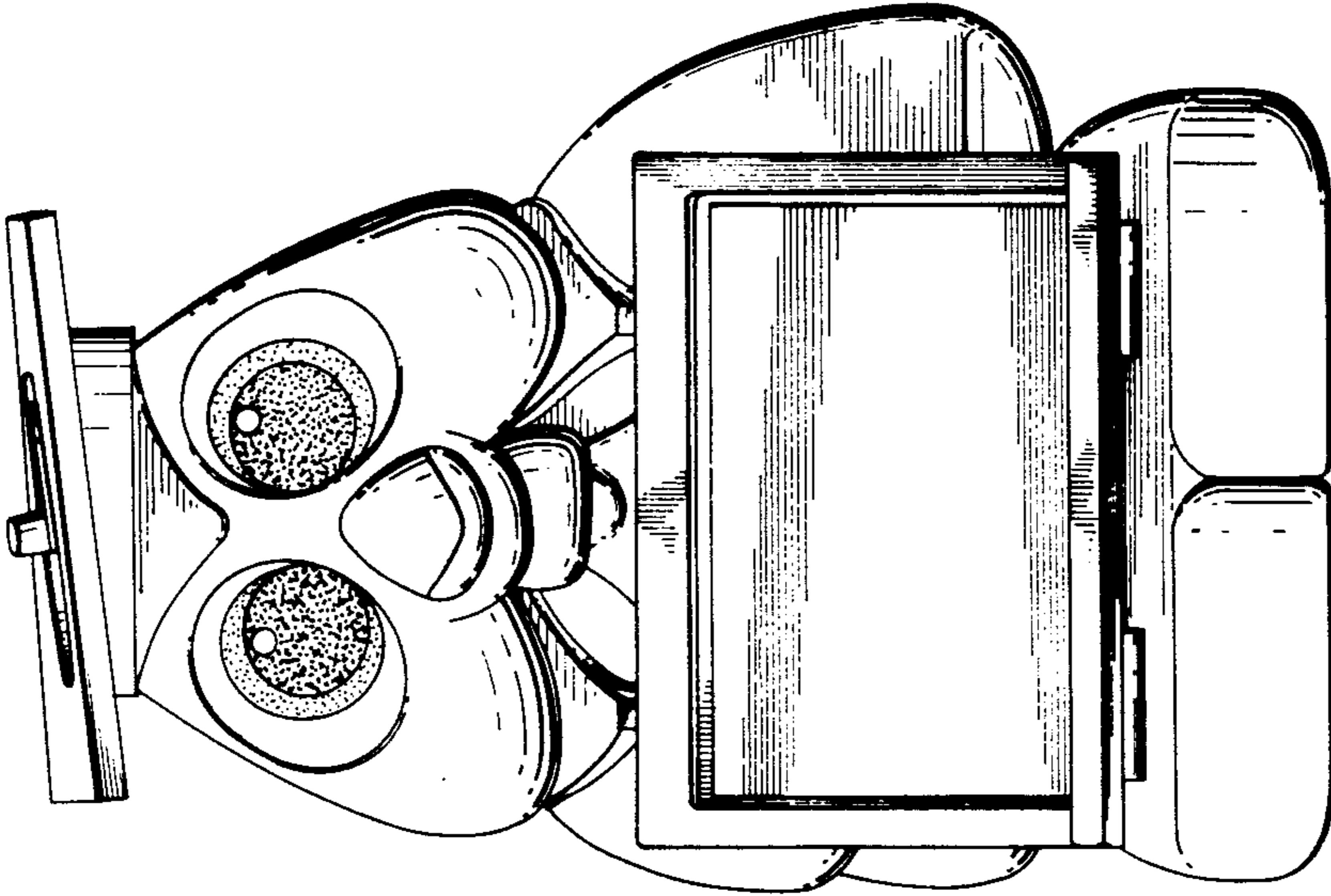

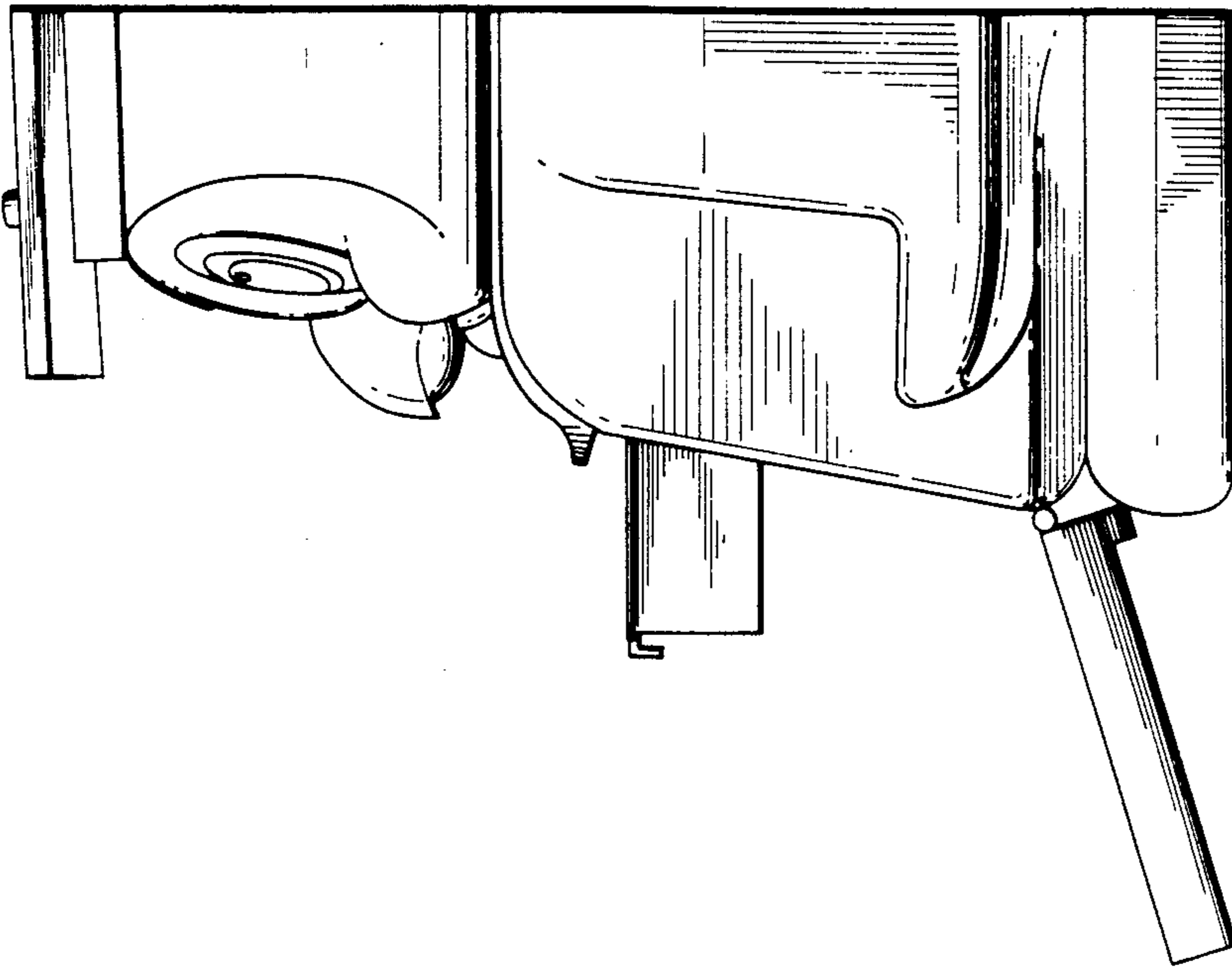

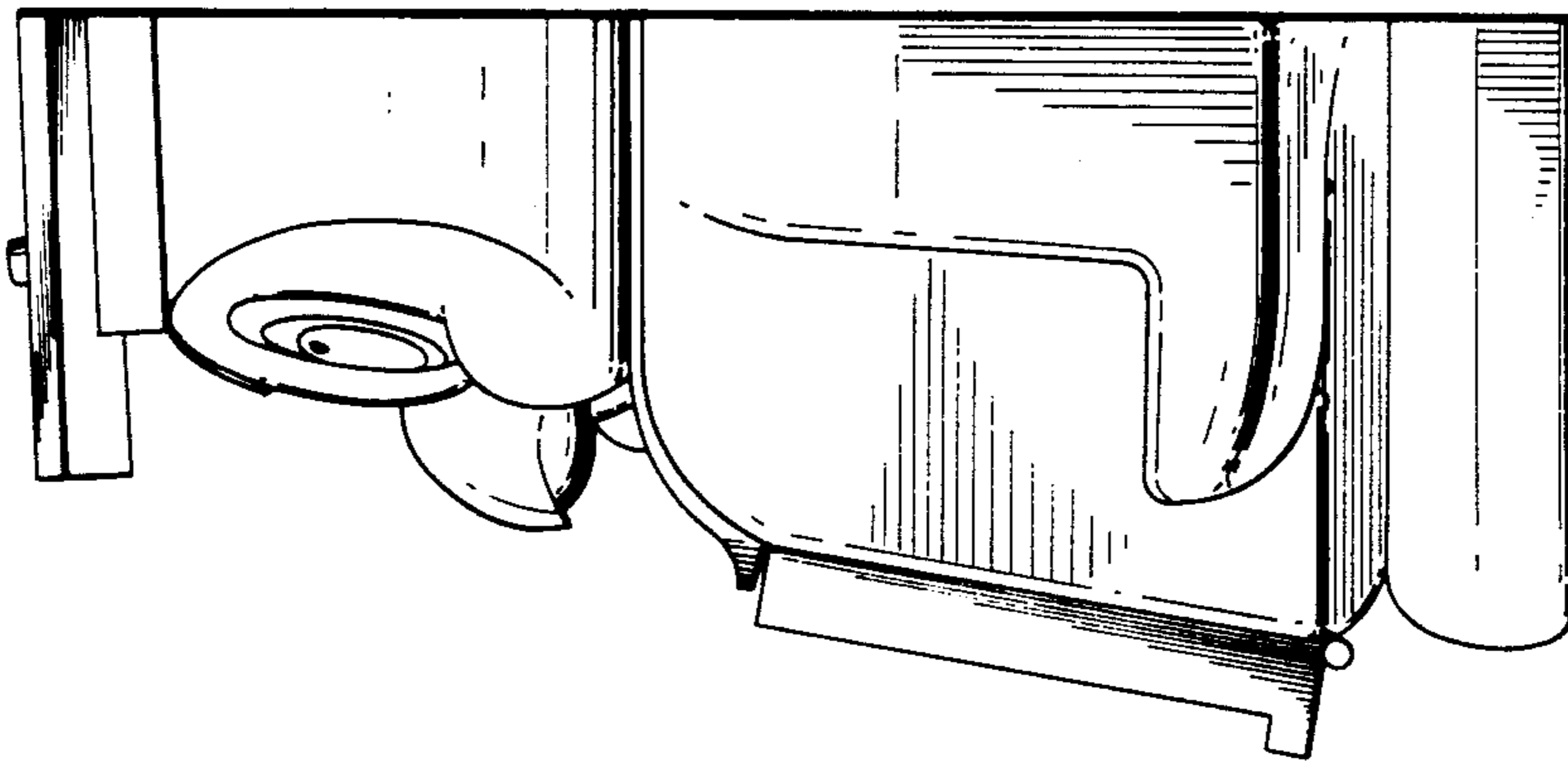

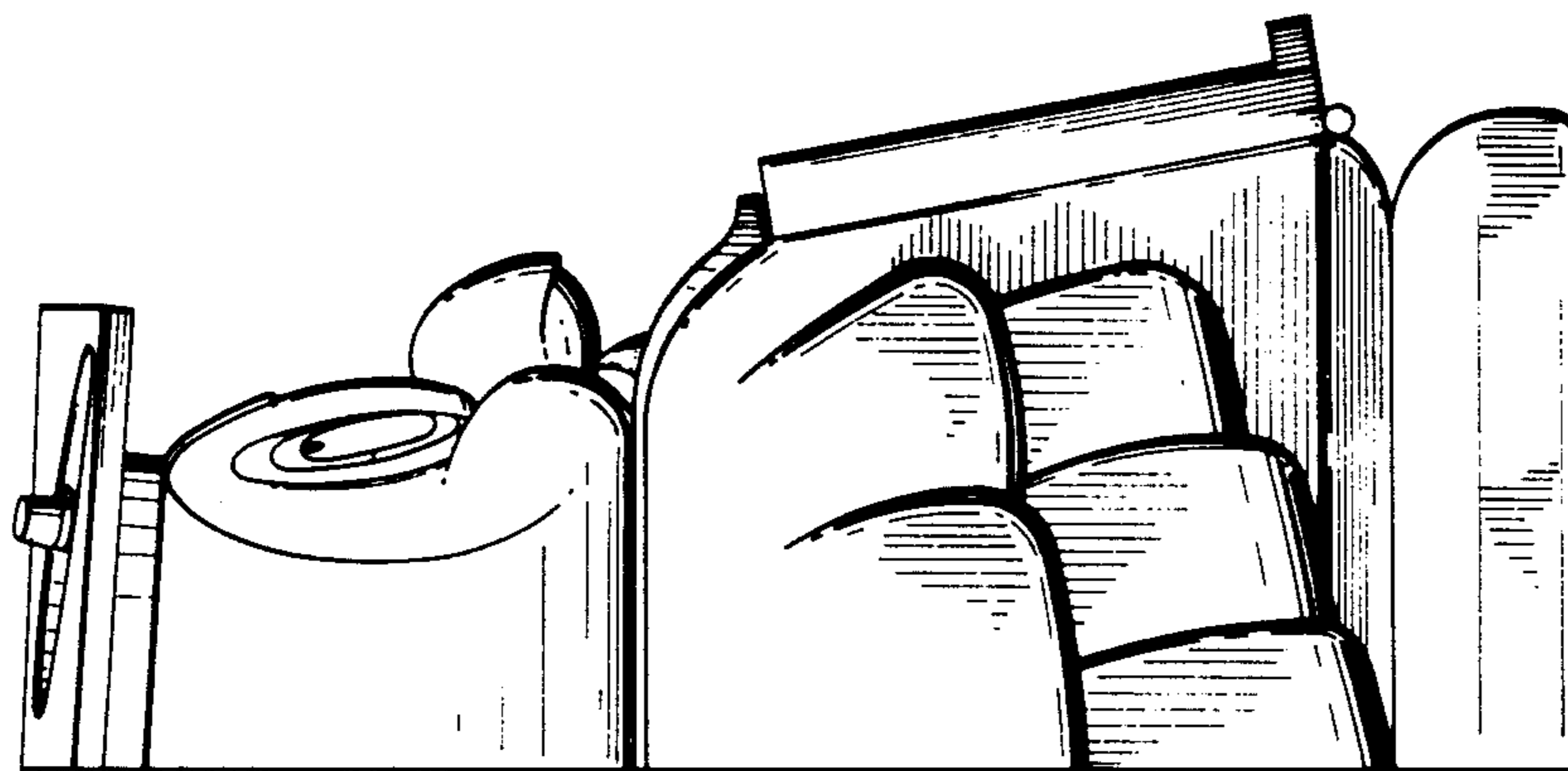

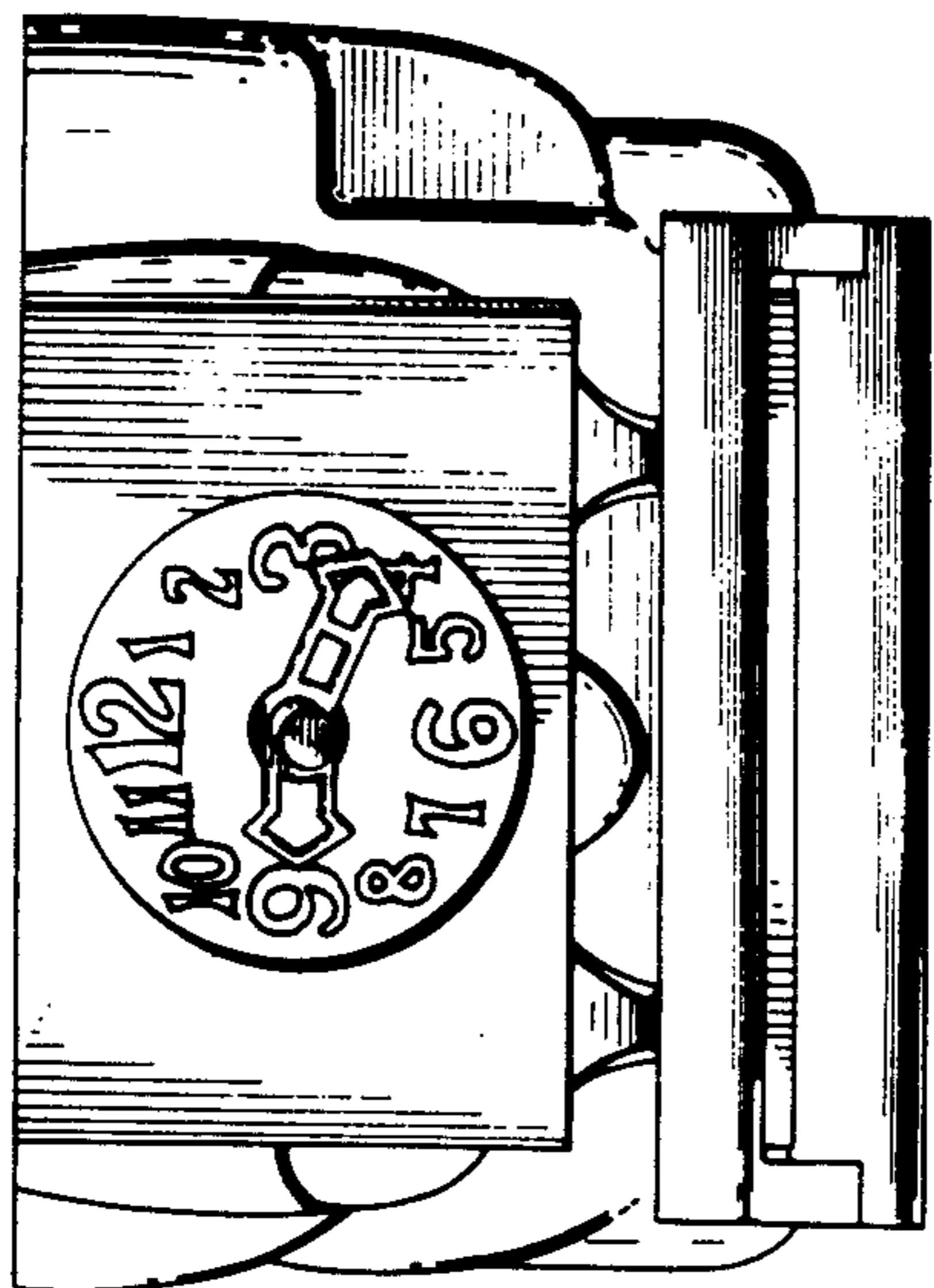

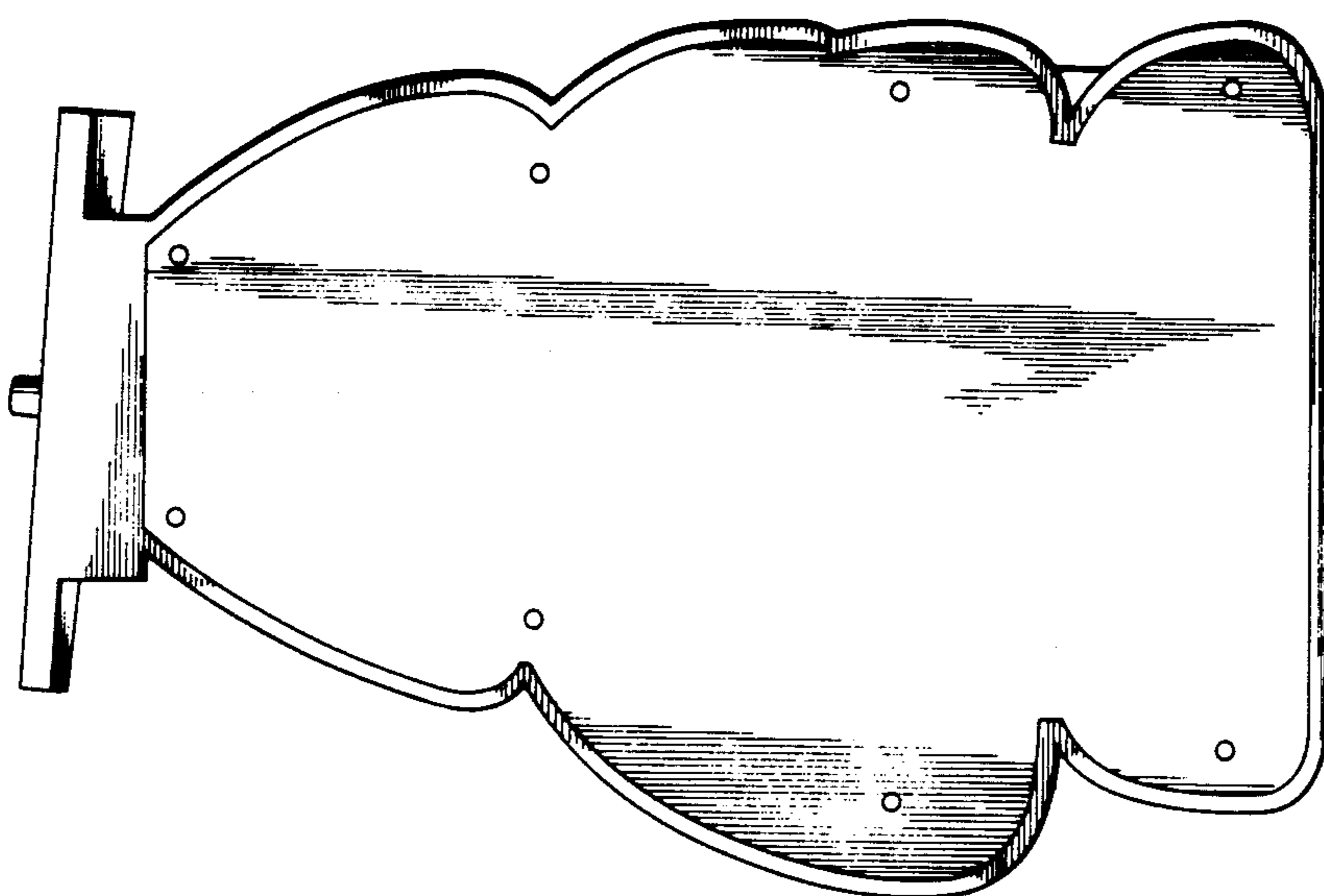
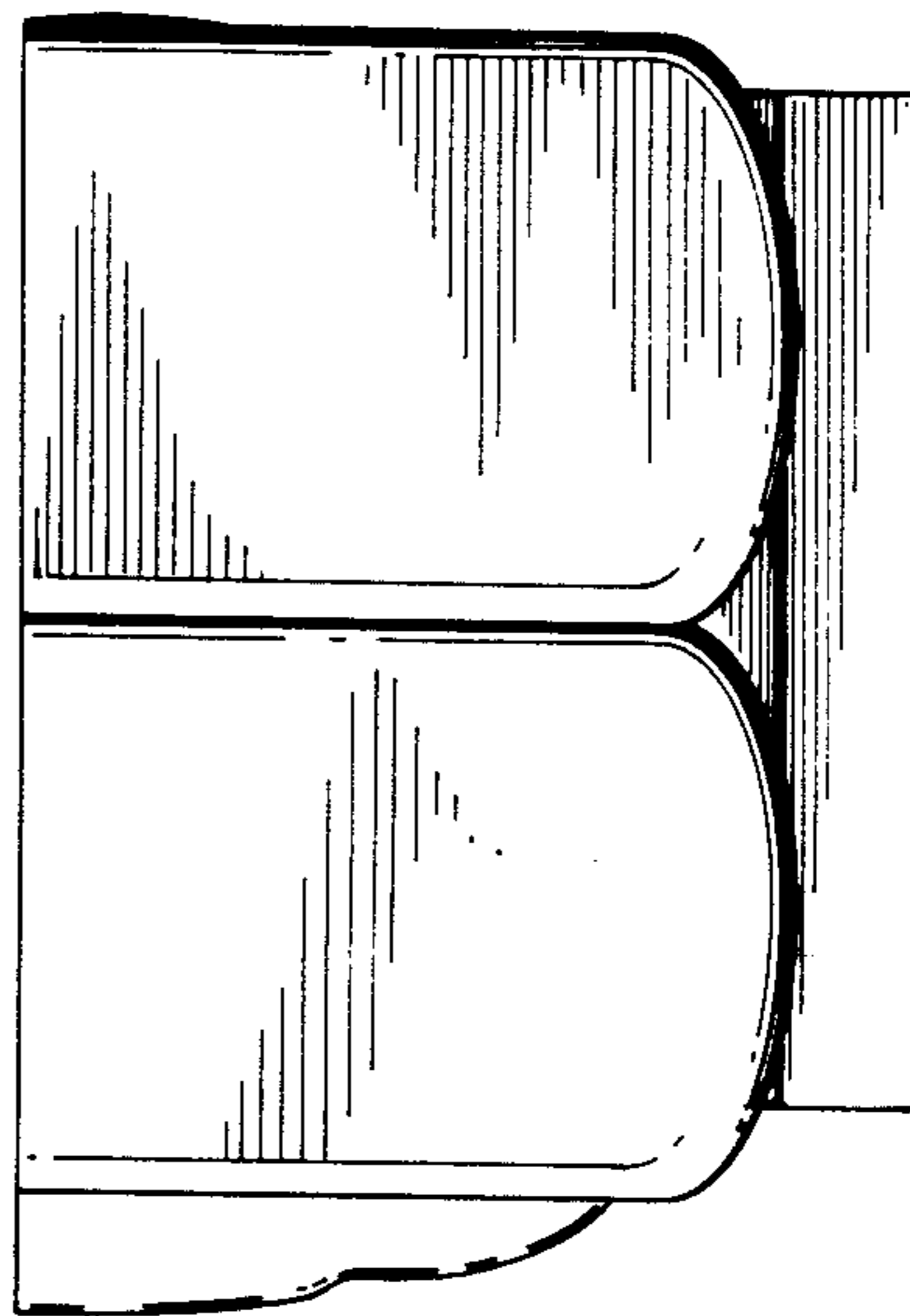
