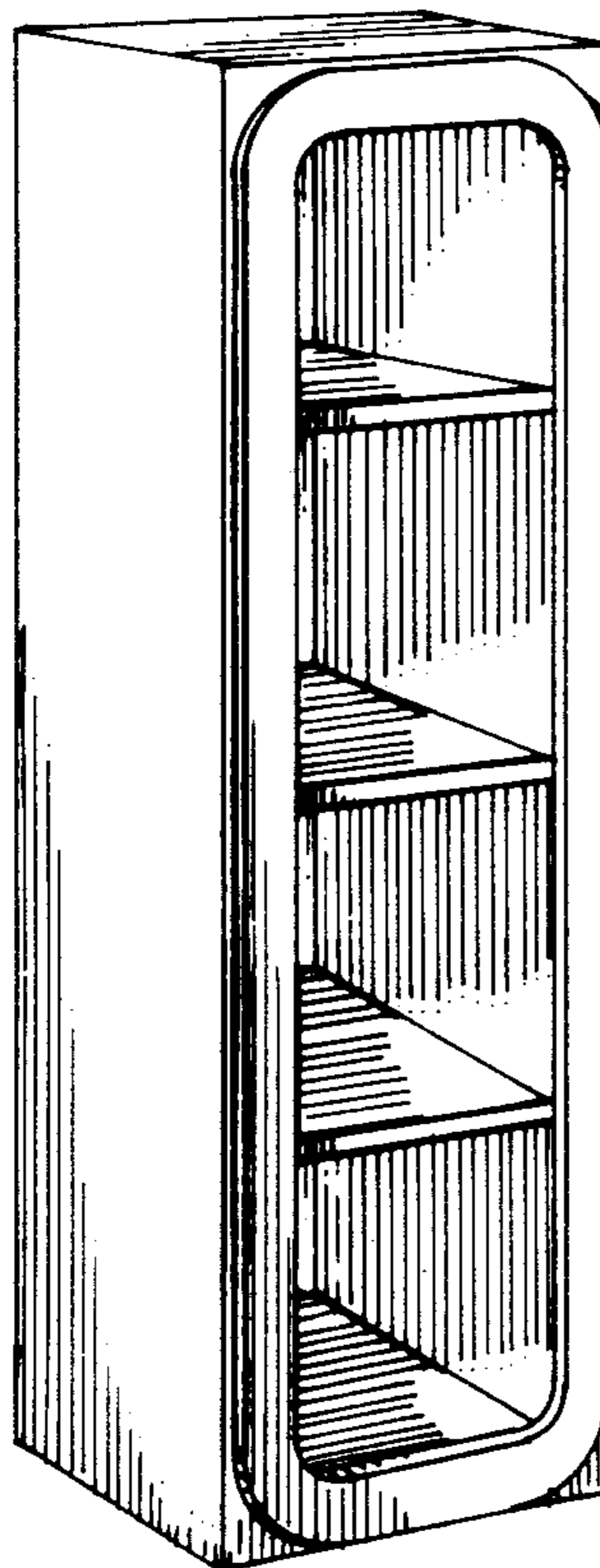
The ornamental design for a cabinet, as shown and described.

The side and rear of the cabinet not shown are conventionally flat and unornamented.



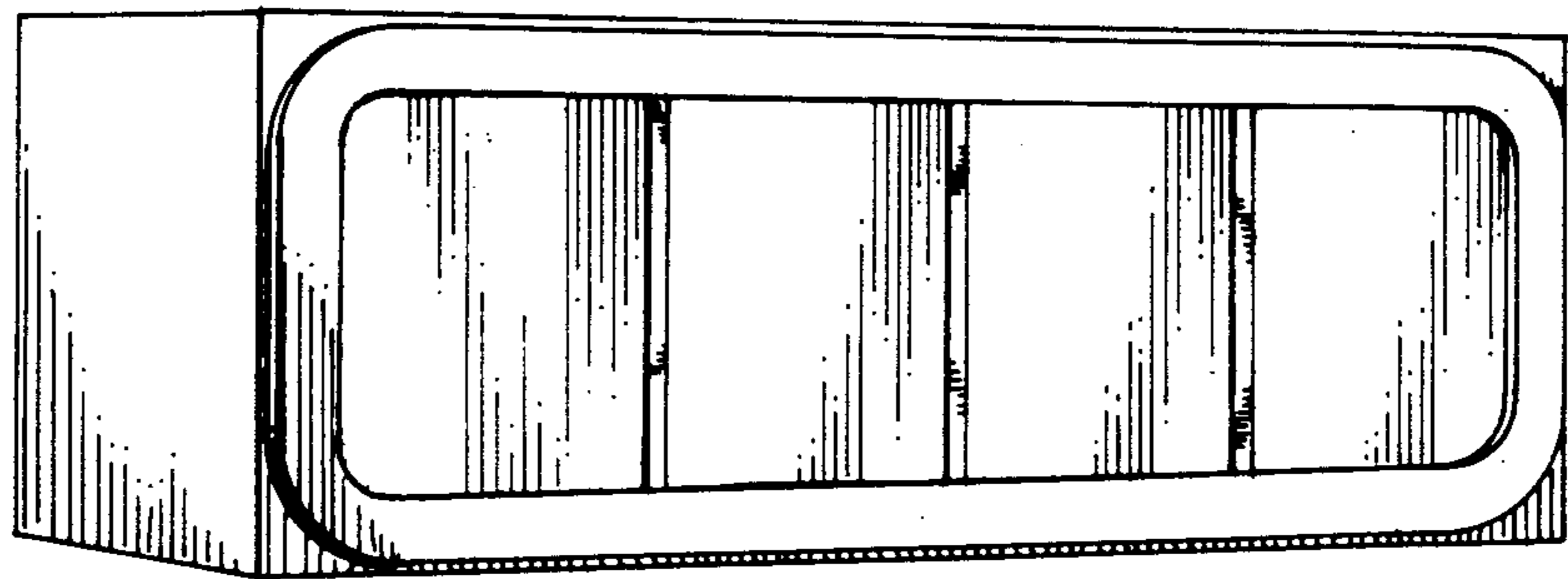

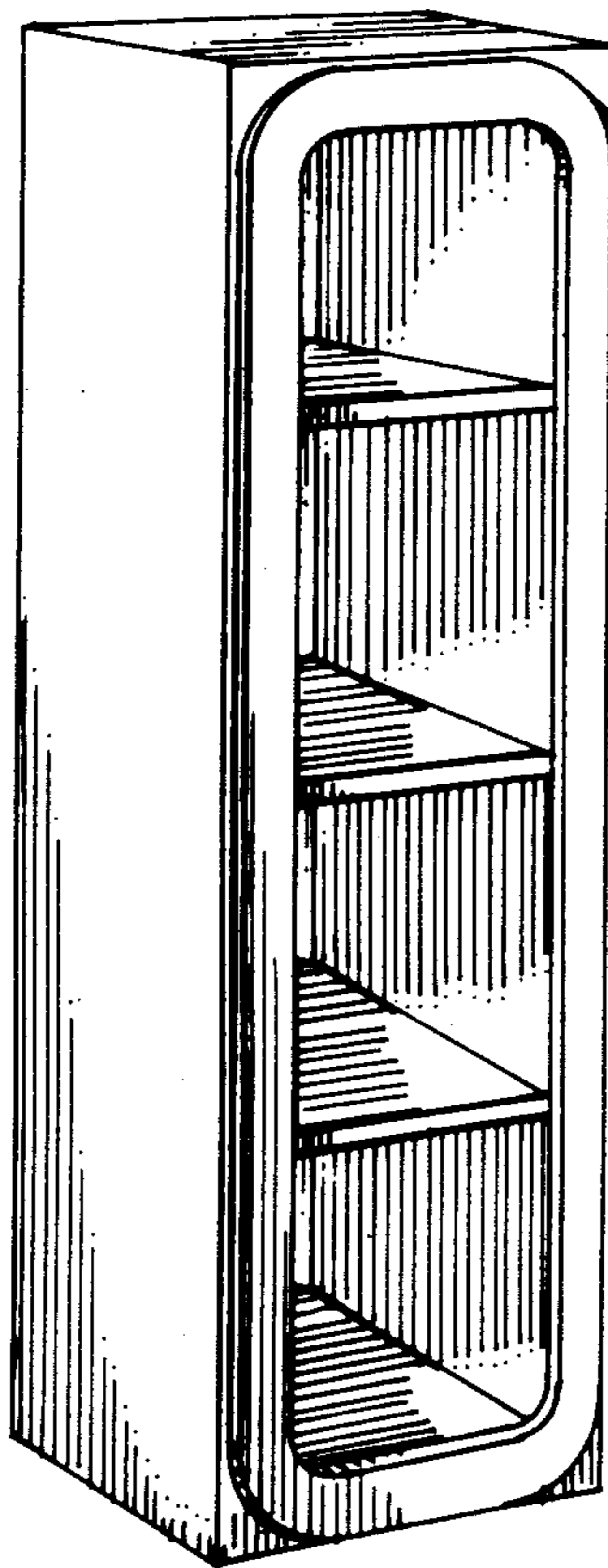
