FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

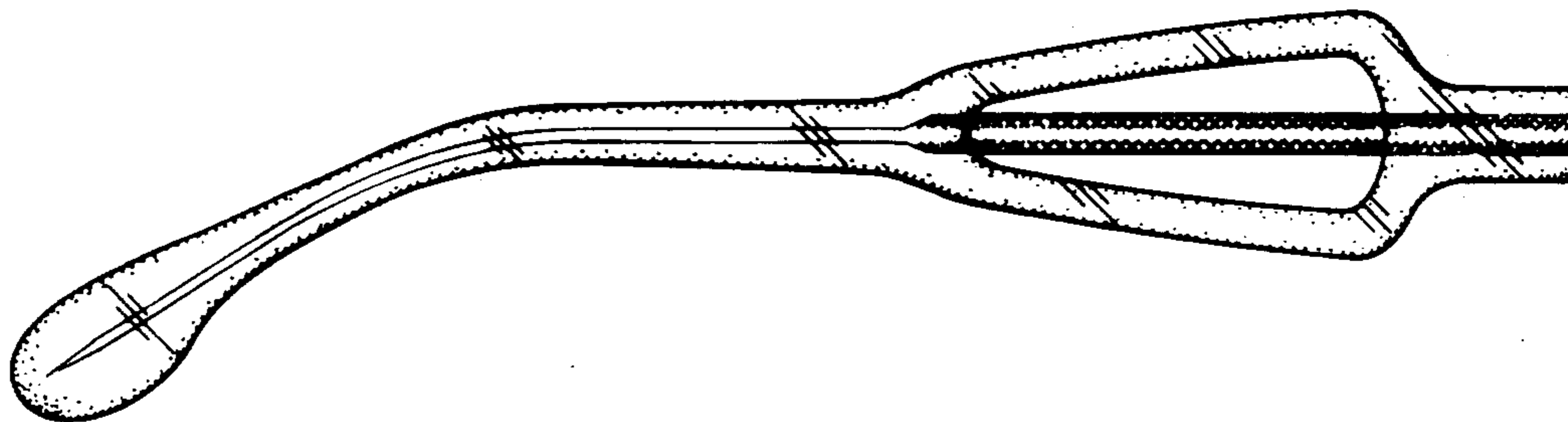
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

The side opposite the side shown in FIG. 3 is a mirror image thereof.



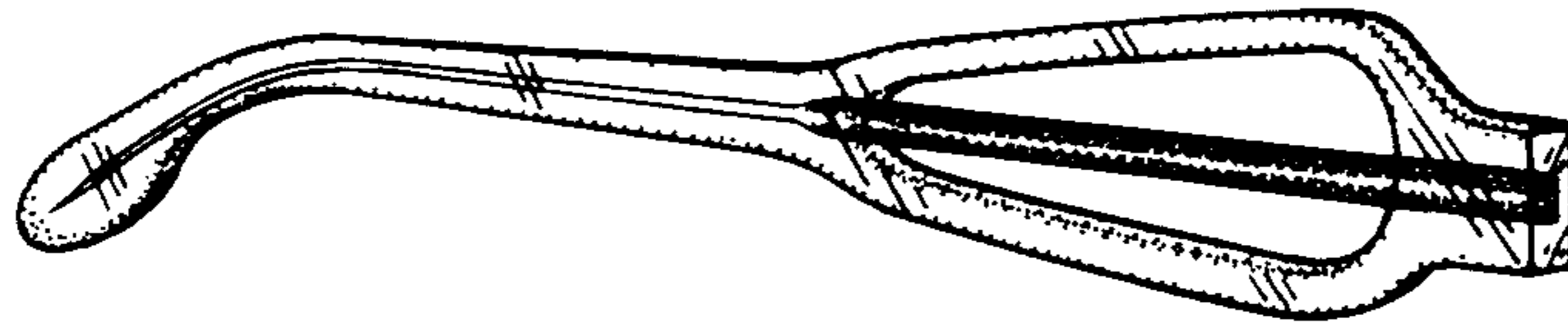

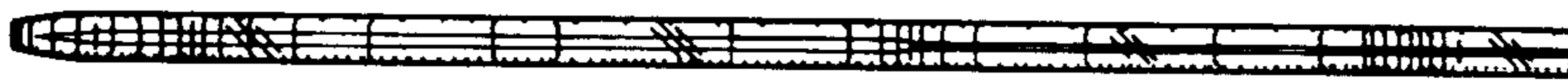

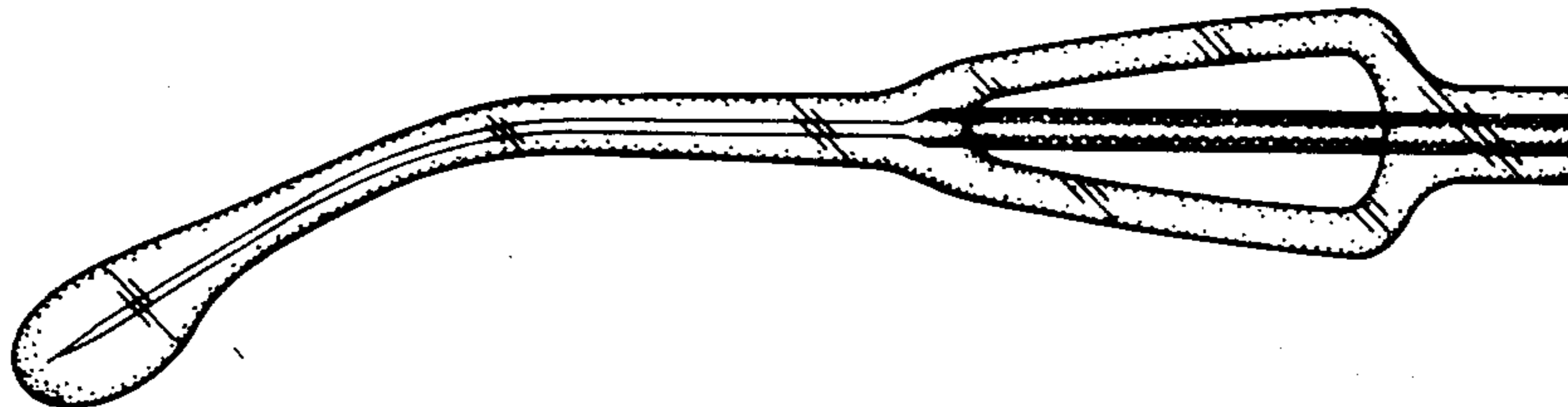

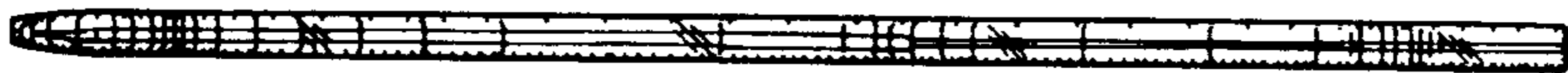
