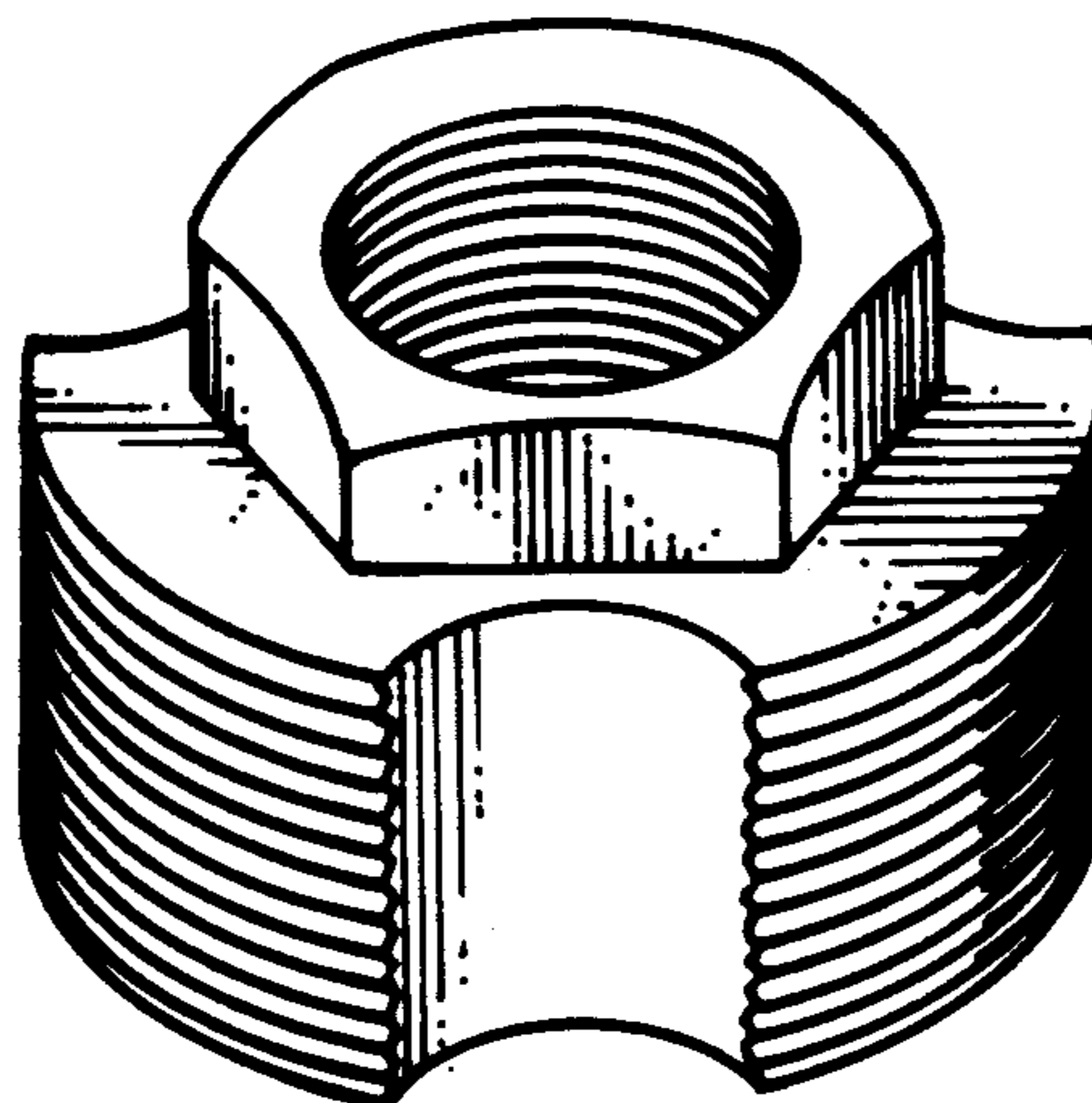

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a collet stop showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a sectional view thereof taken in direction of arrows 5-5 of FIG. 3.



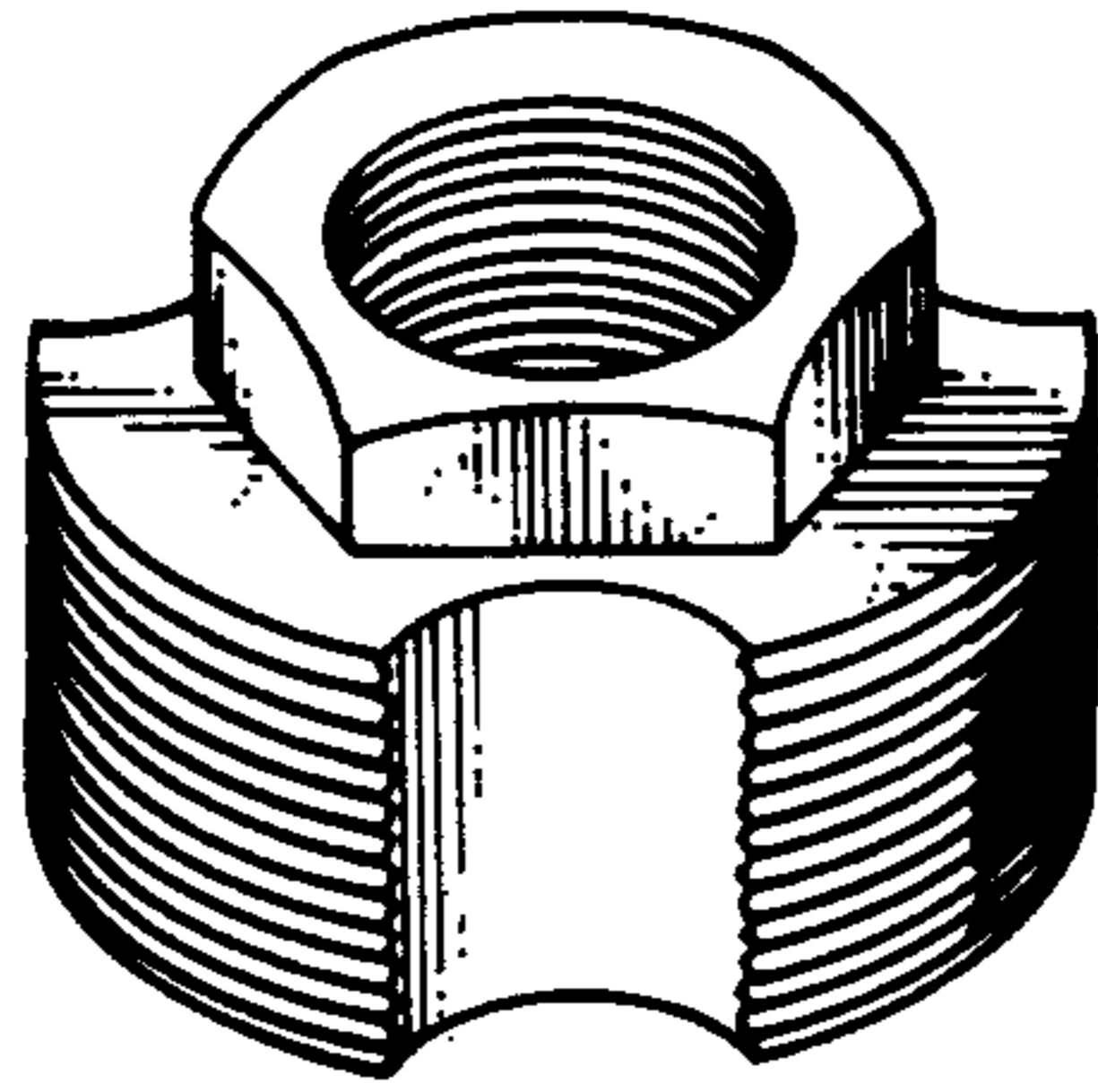

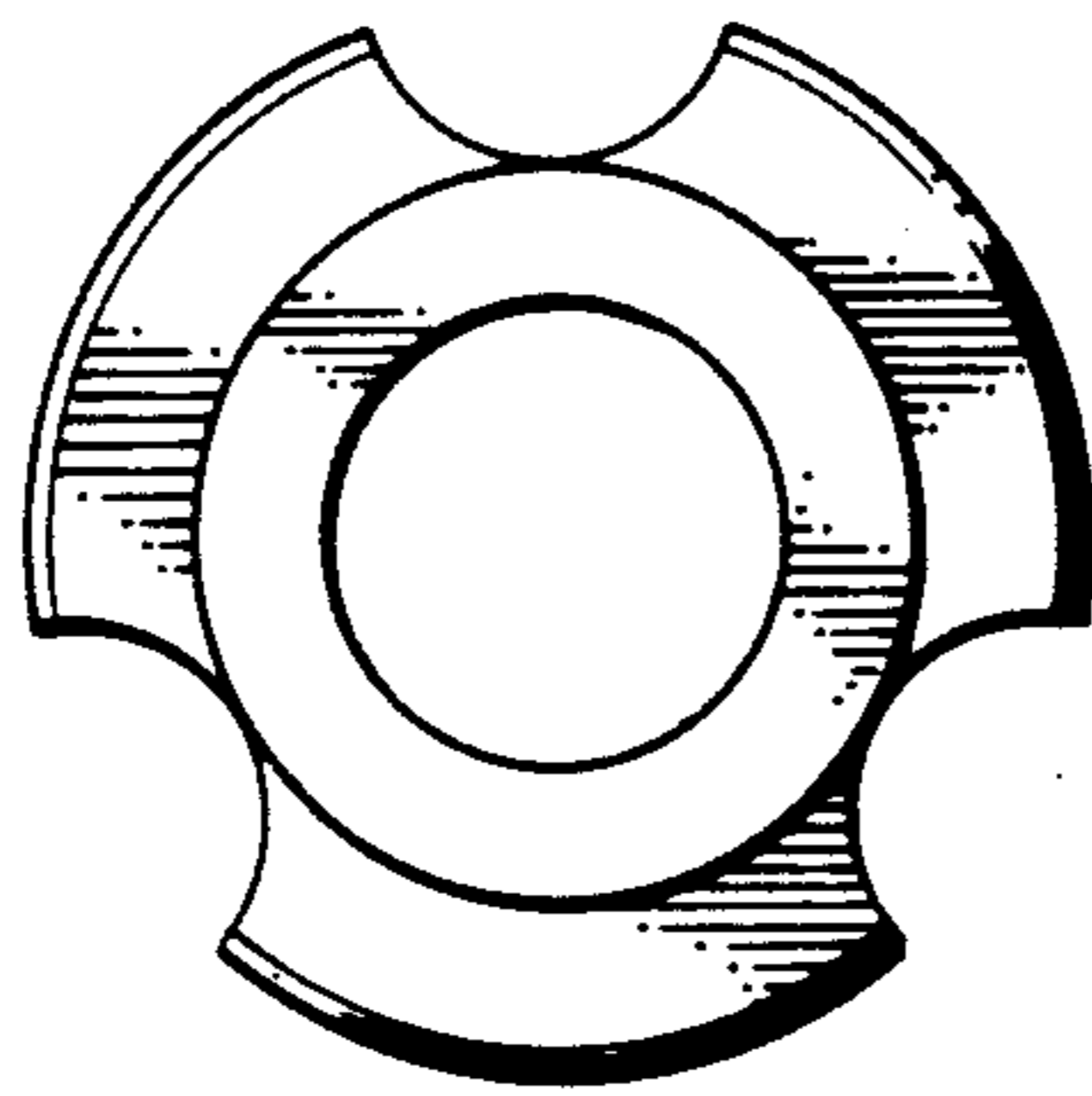

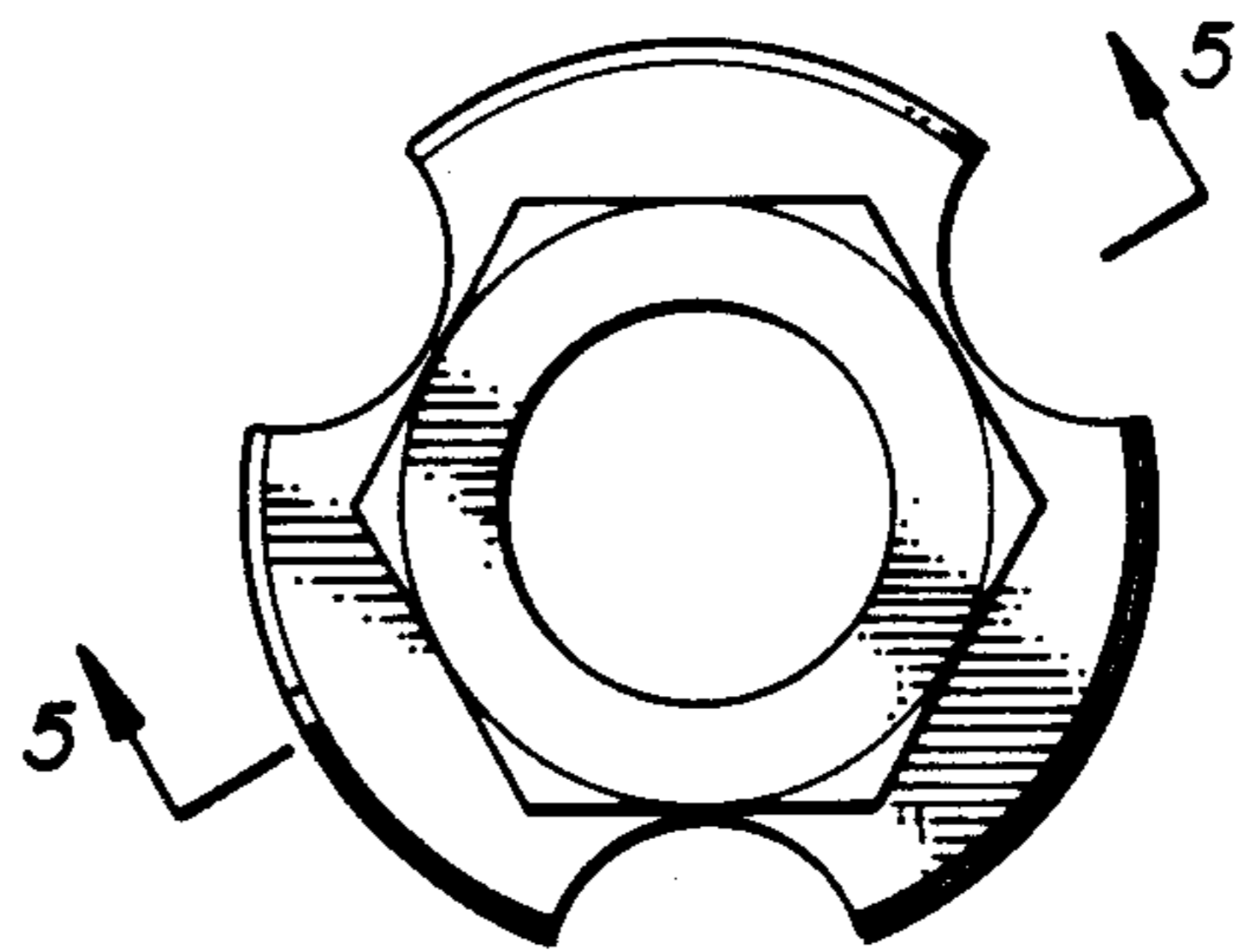

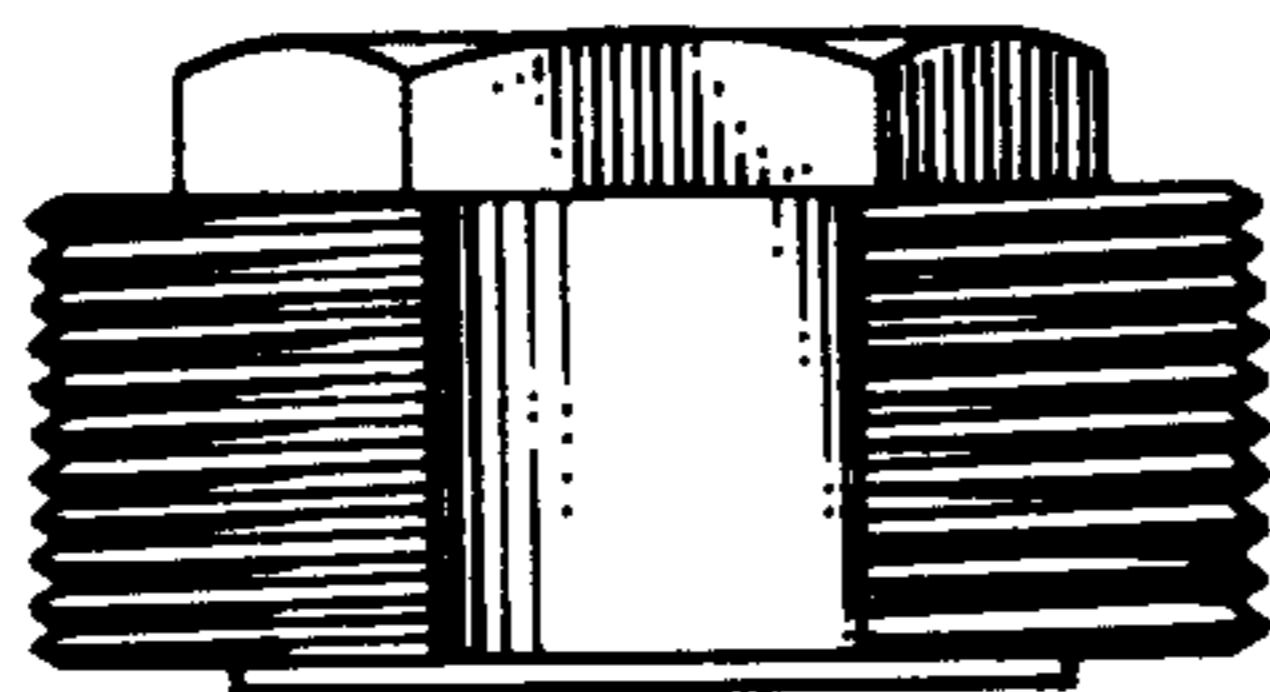

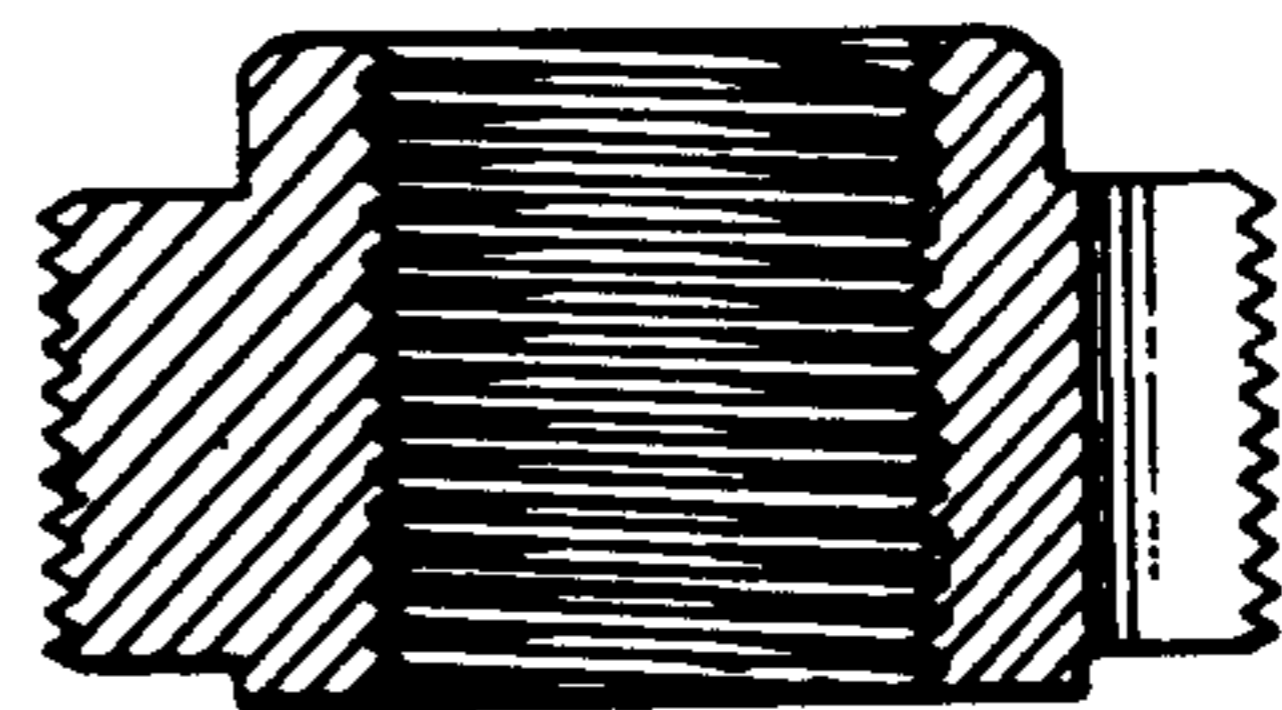
