 FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 7.

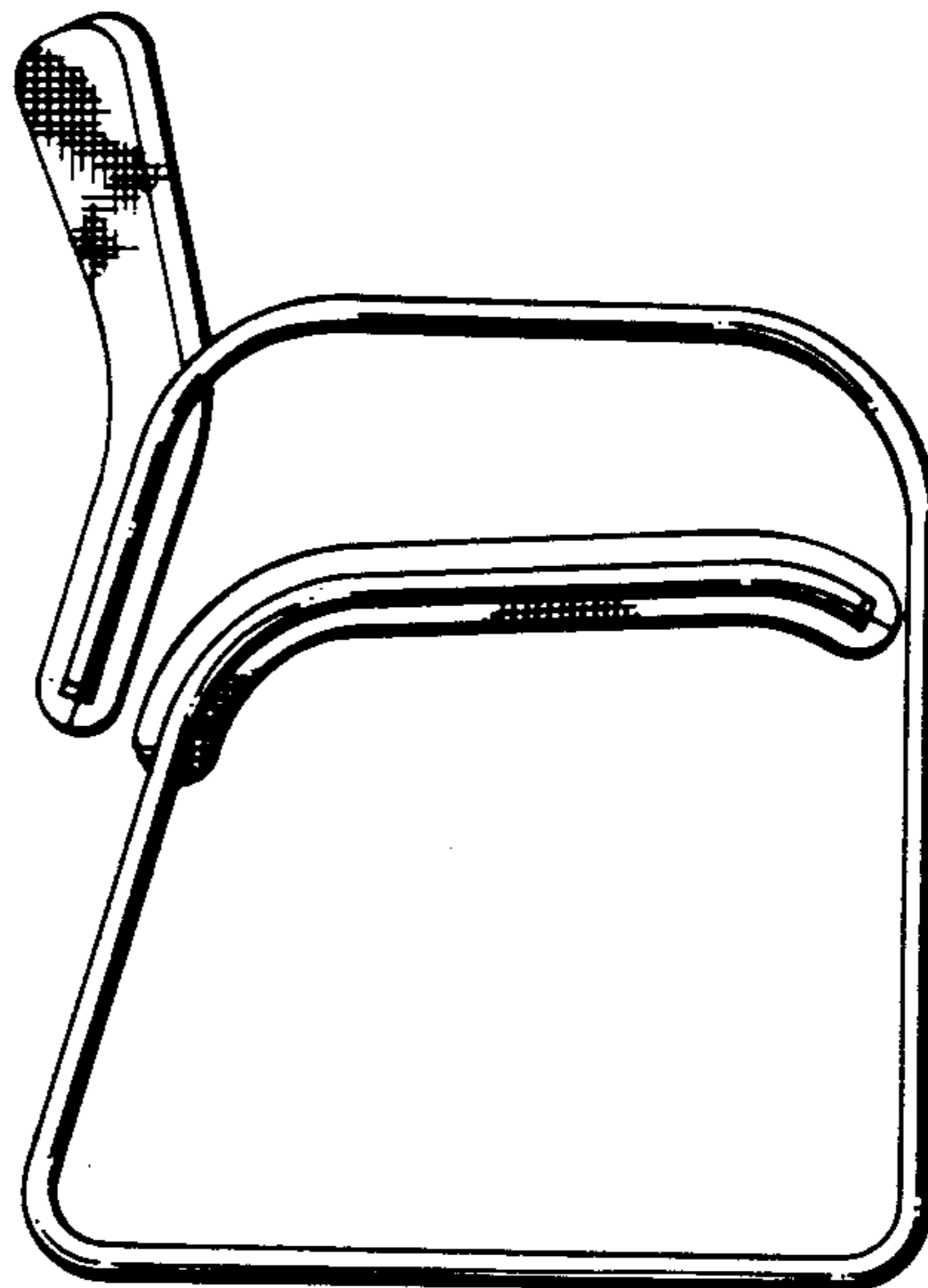
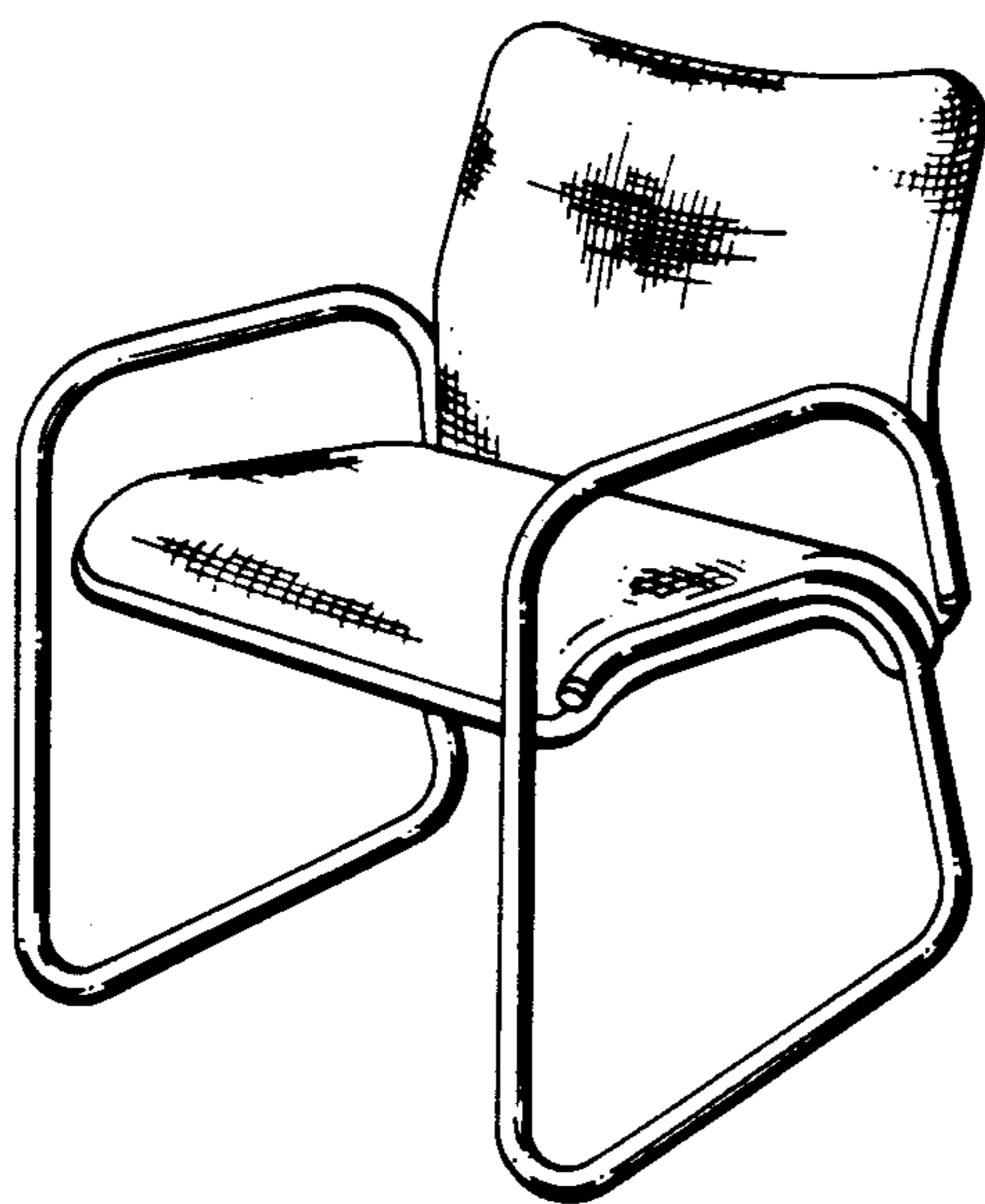

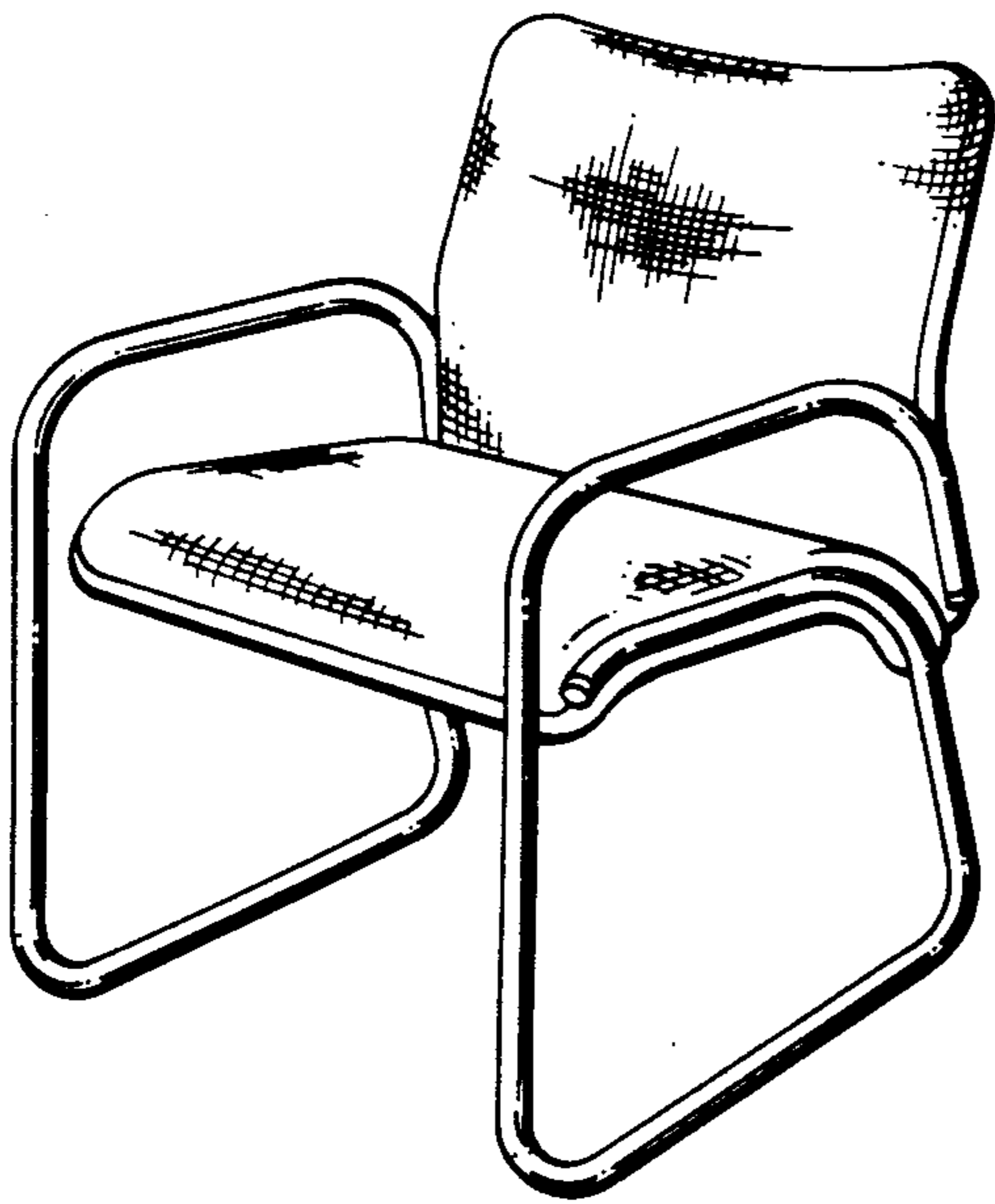

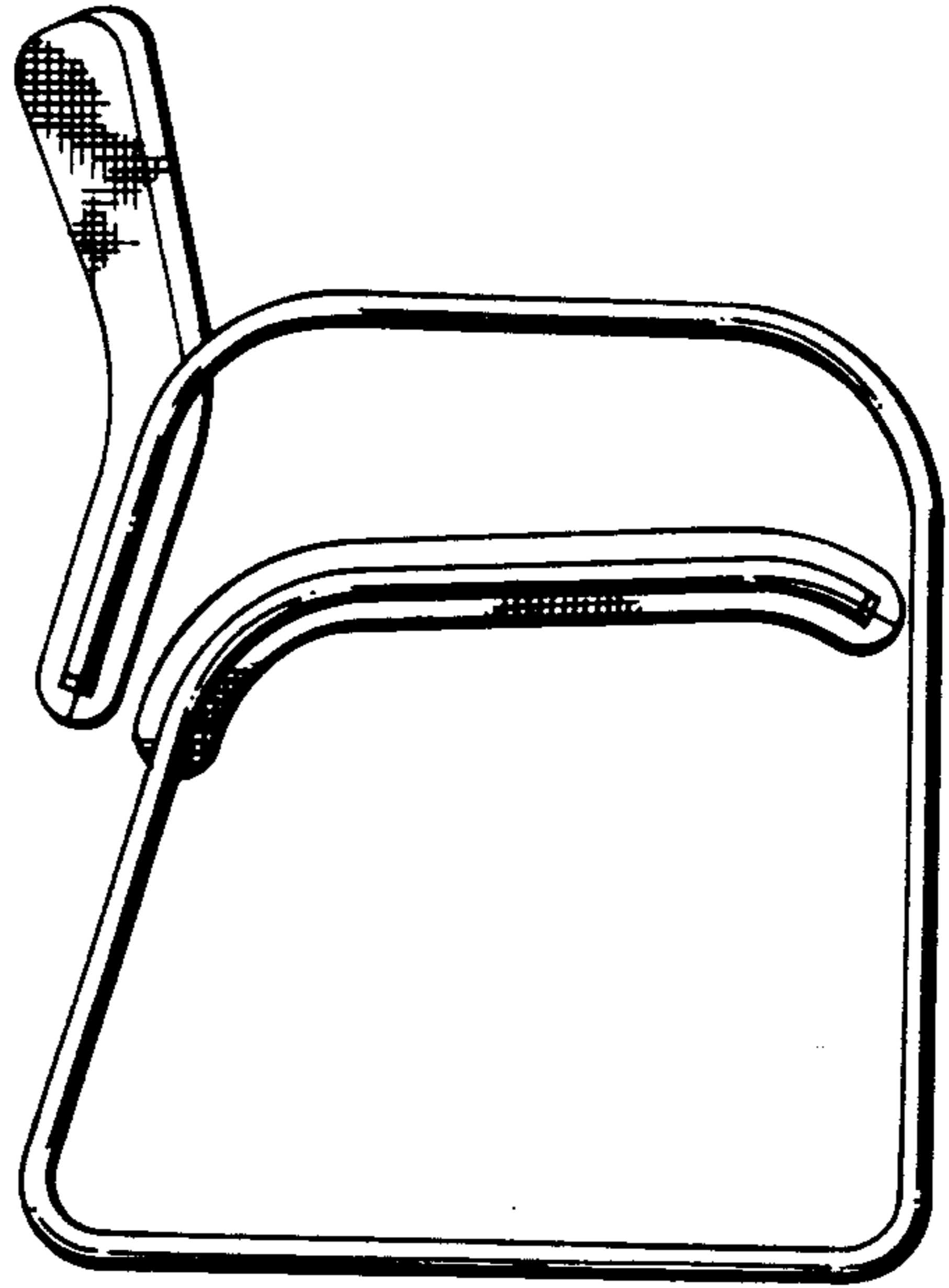

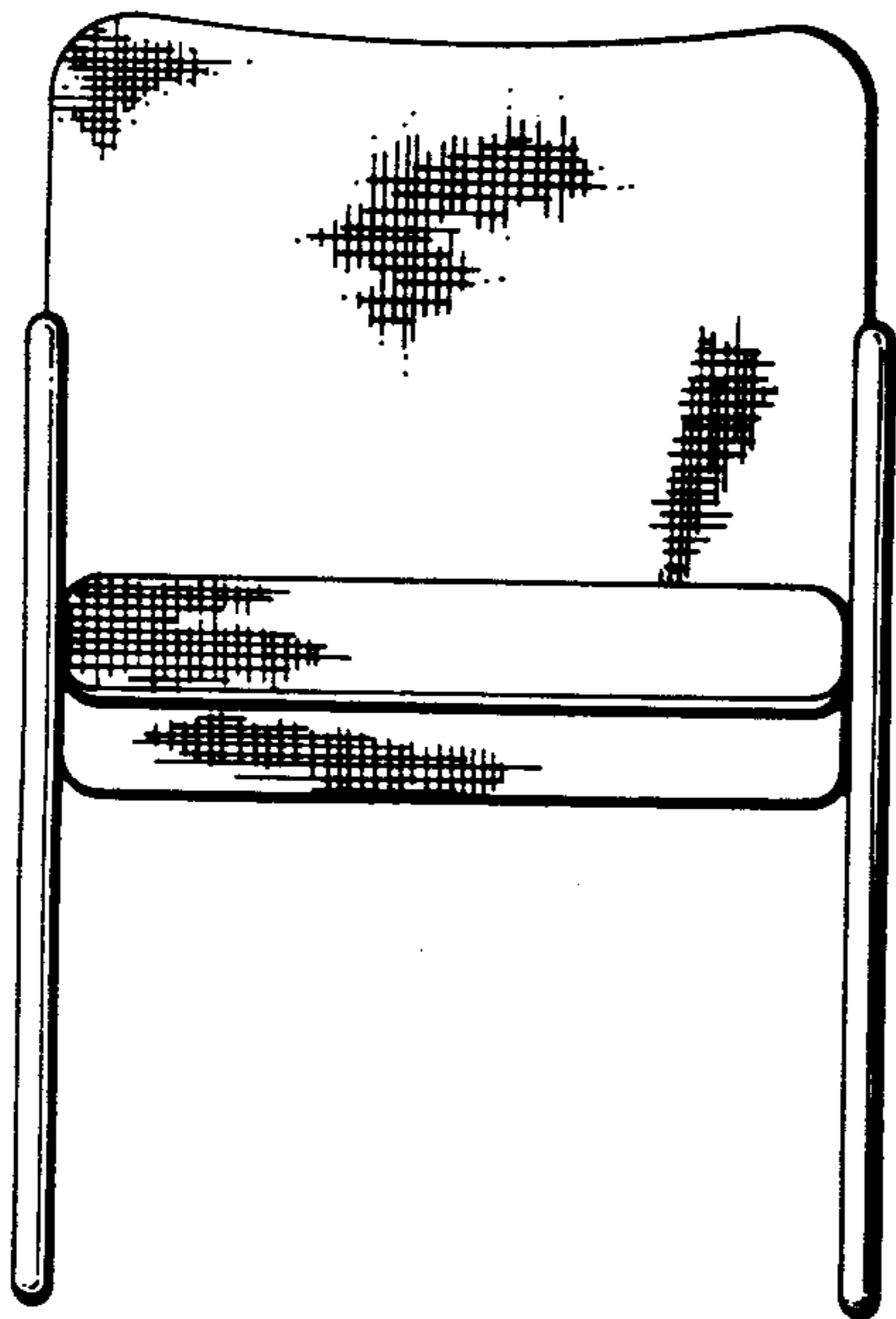

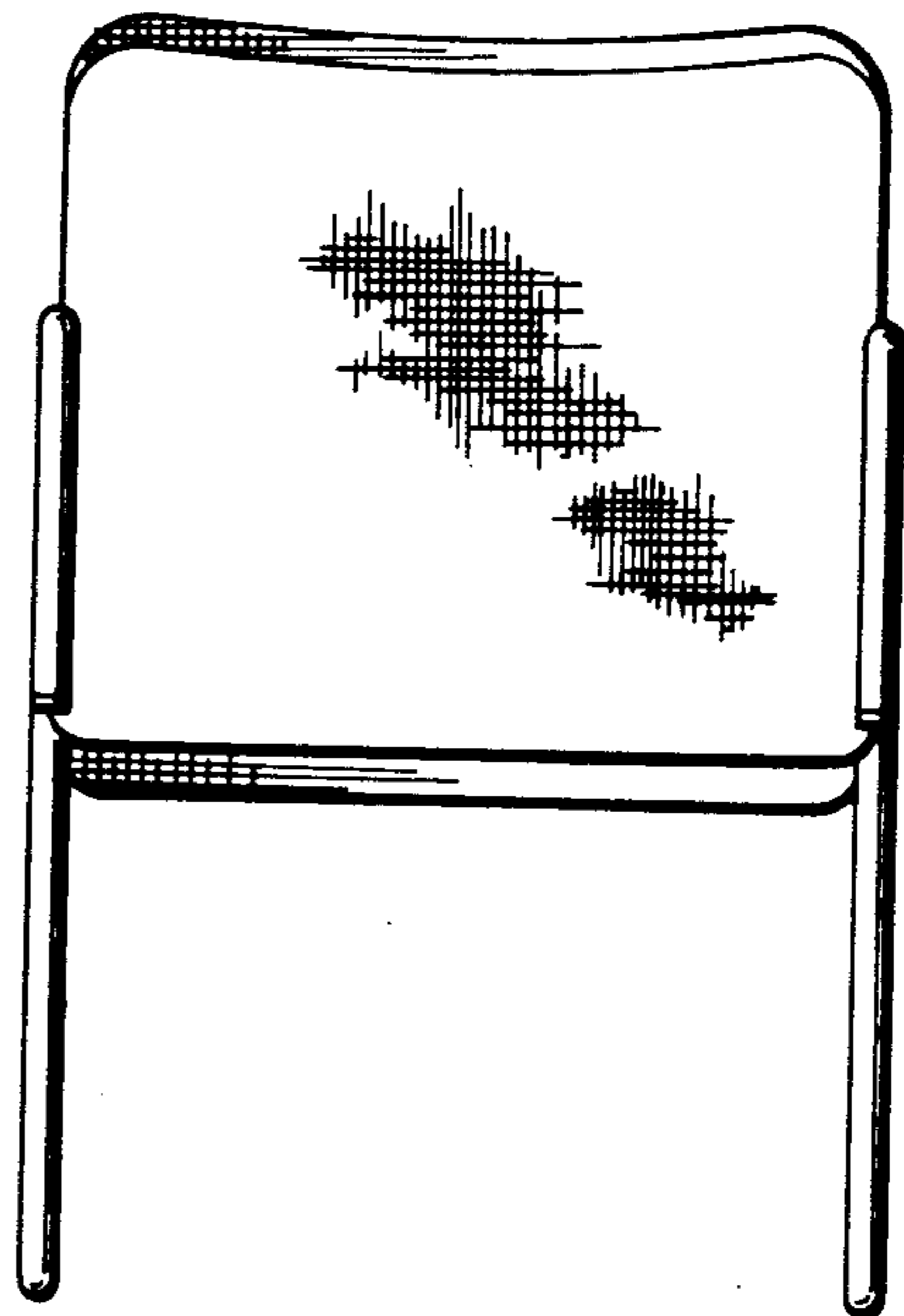

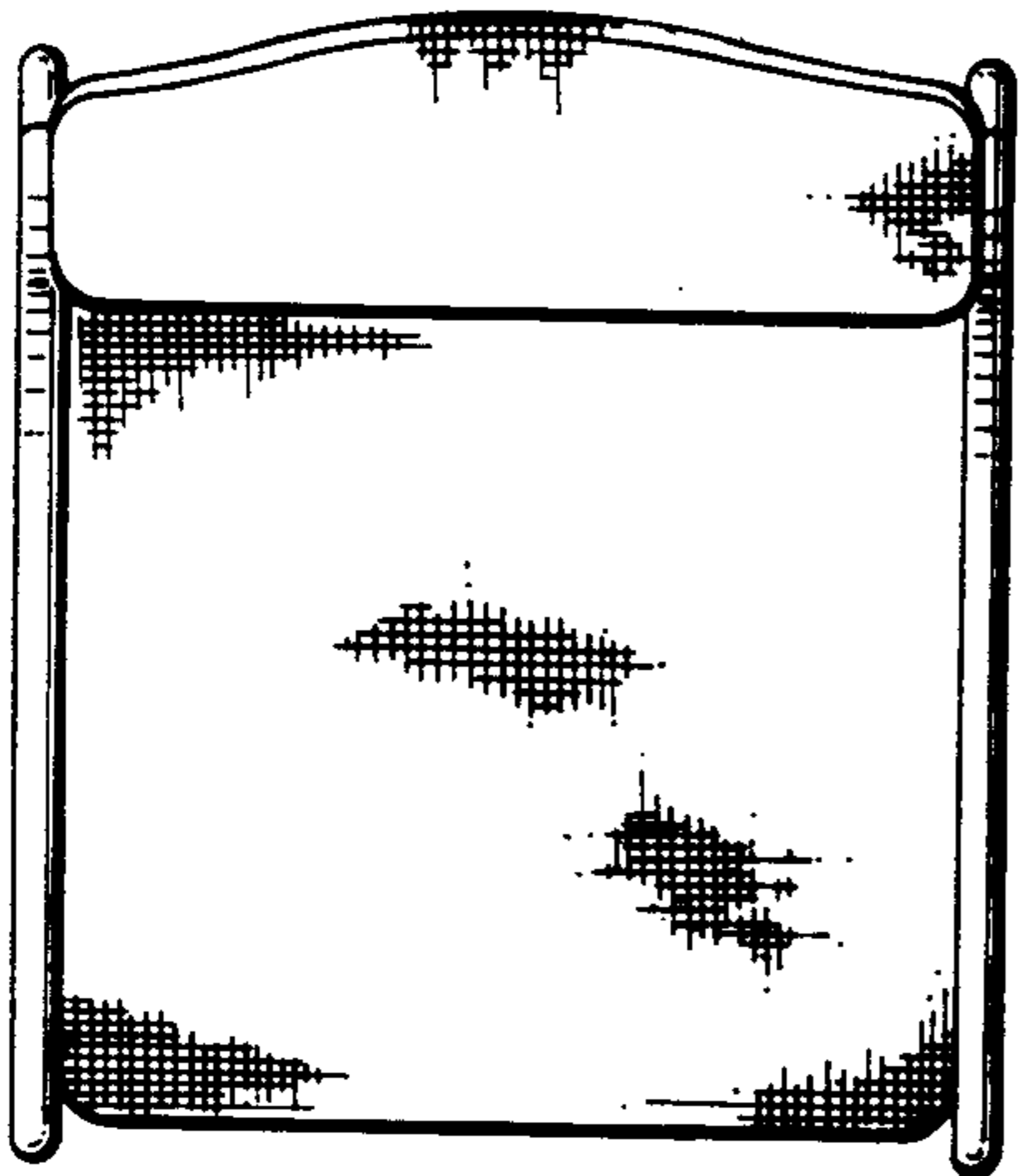

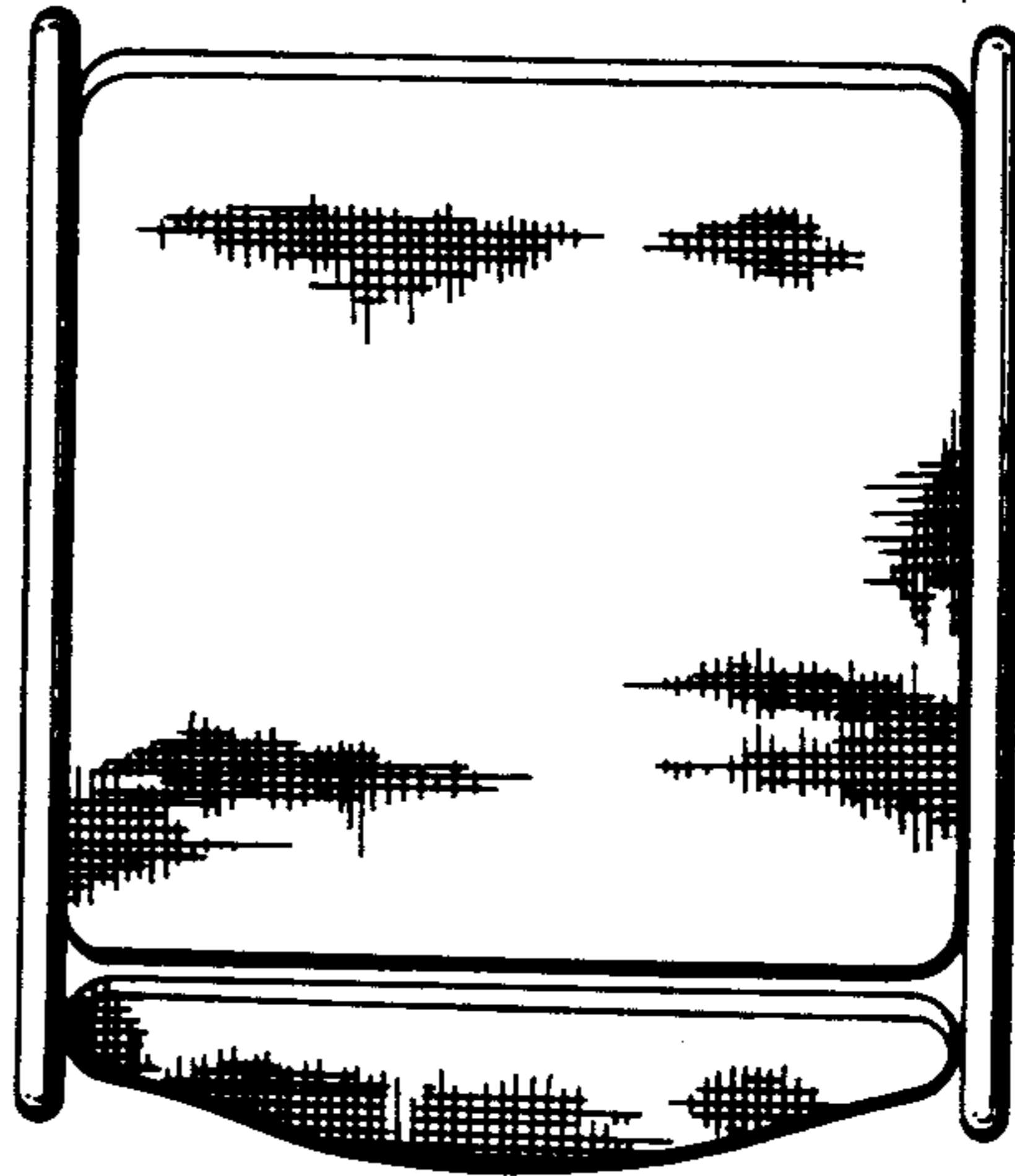

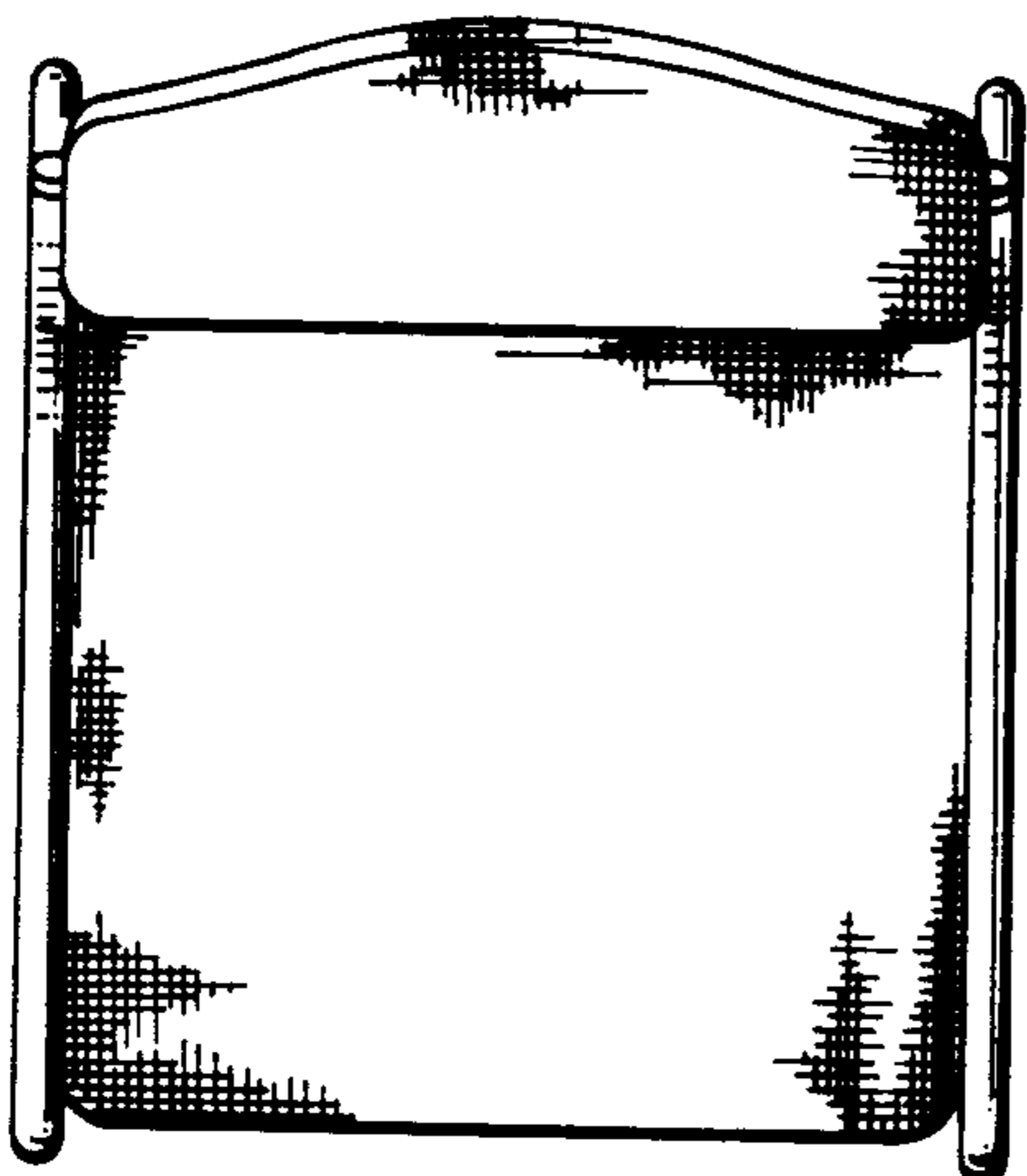

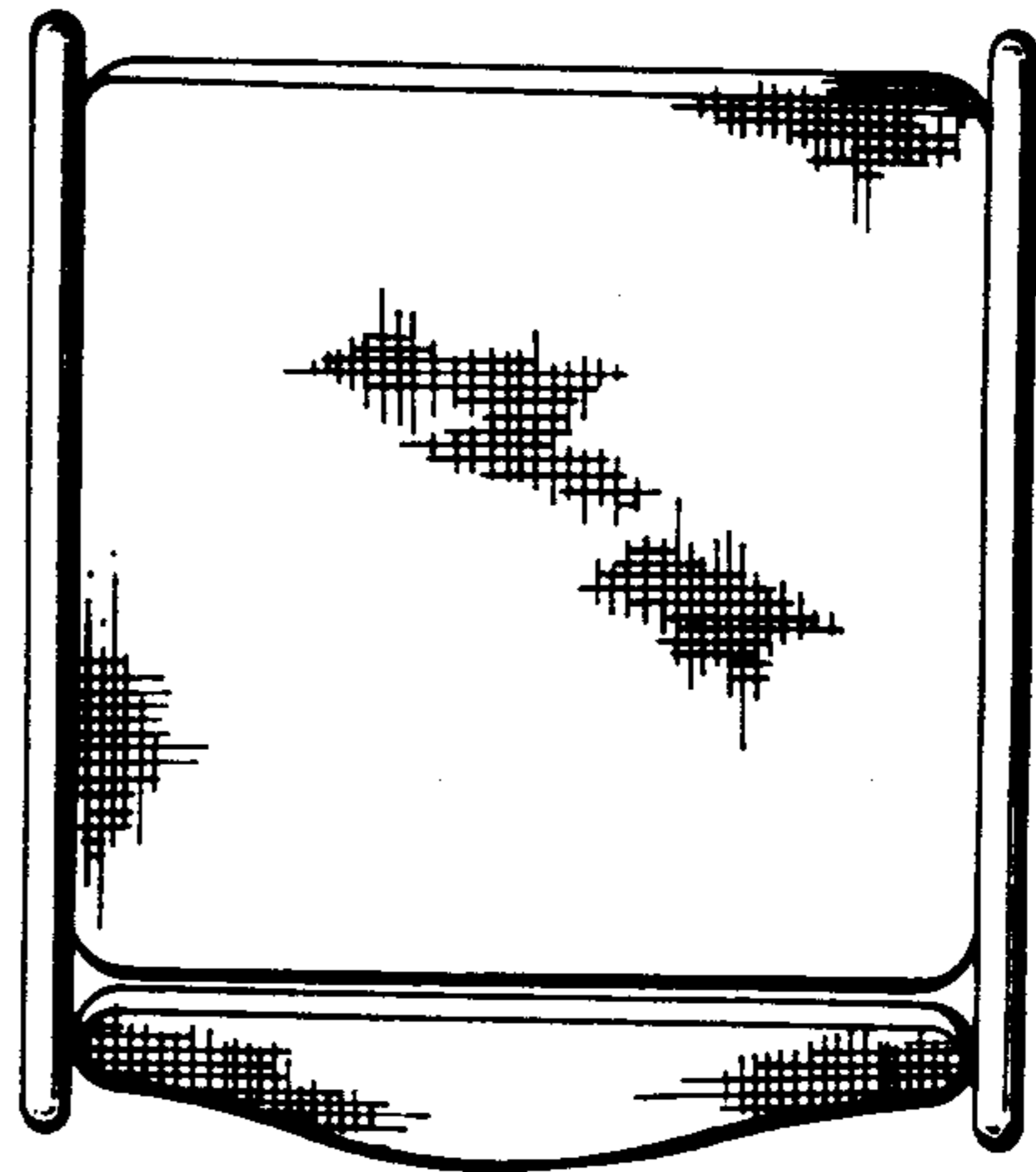

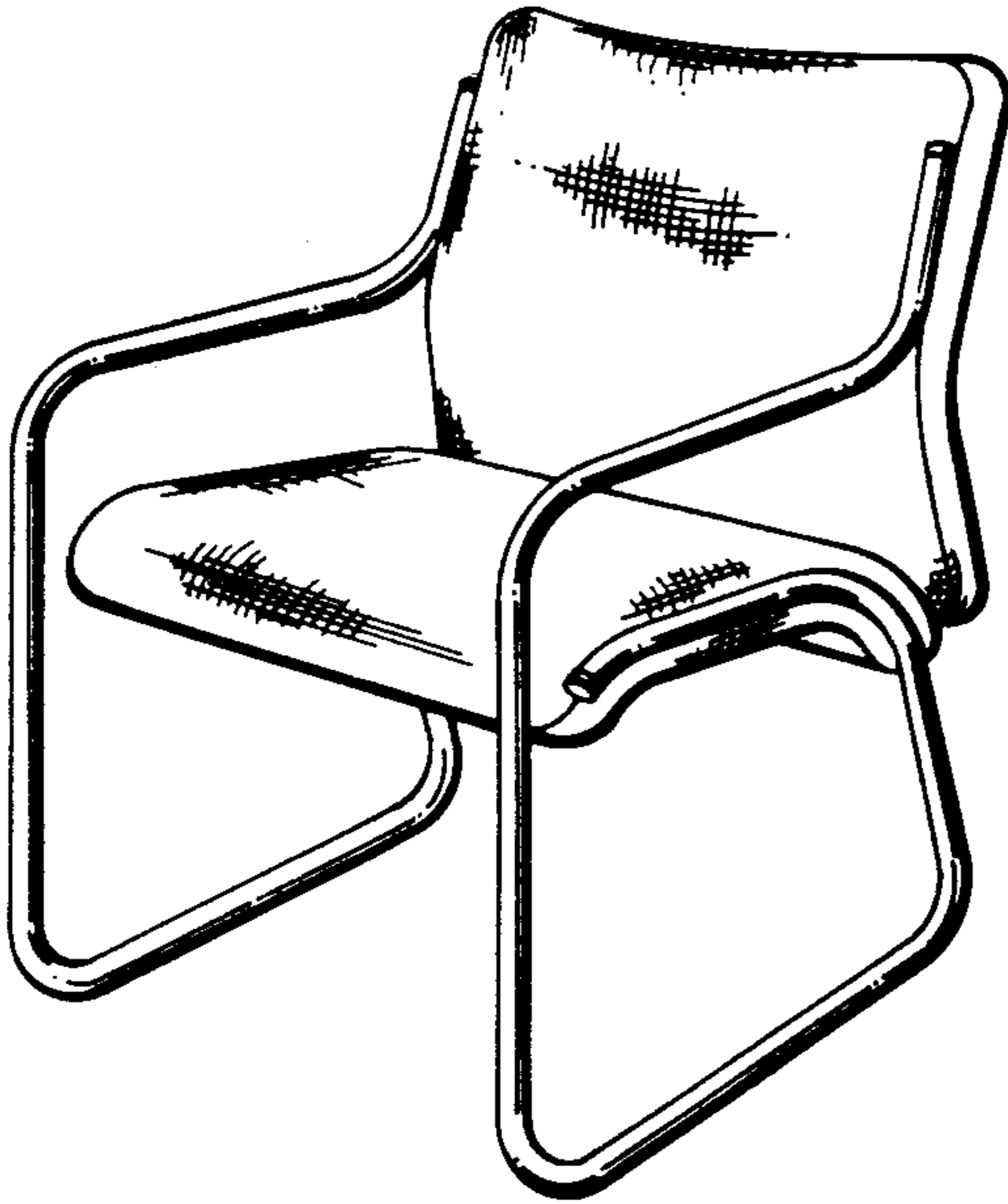

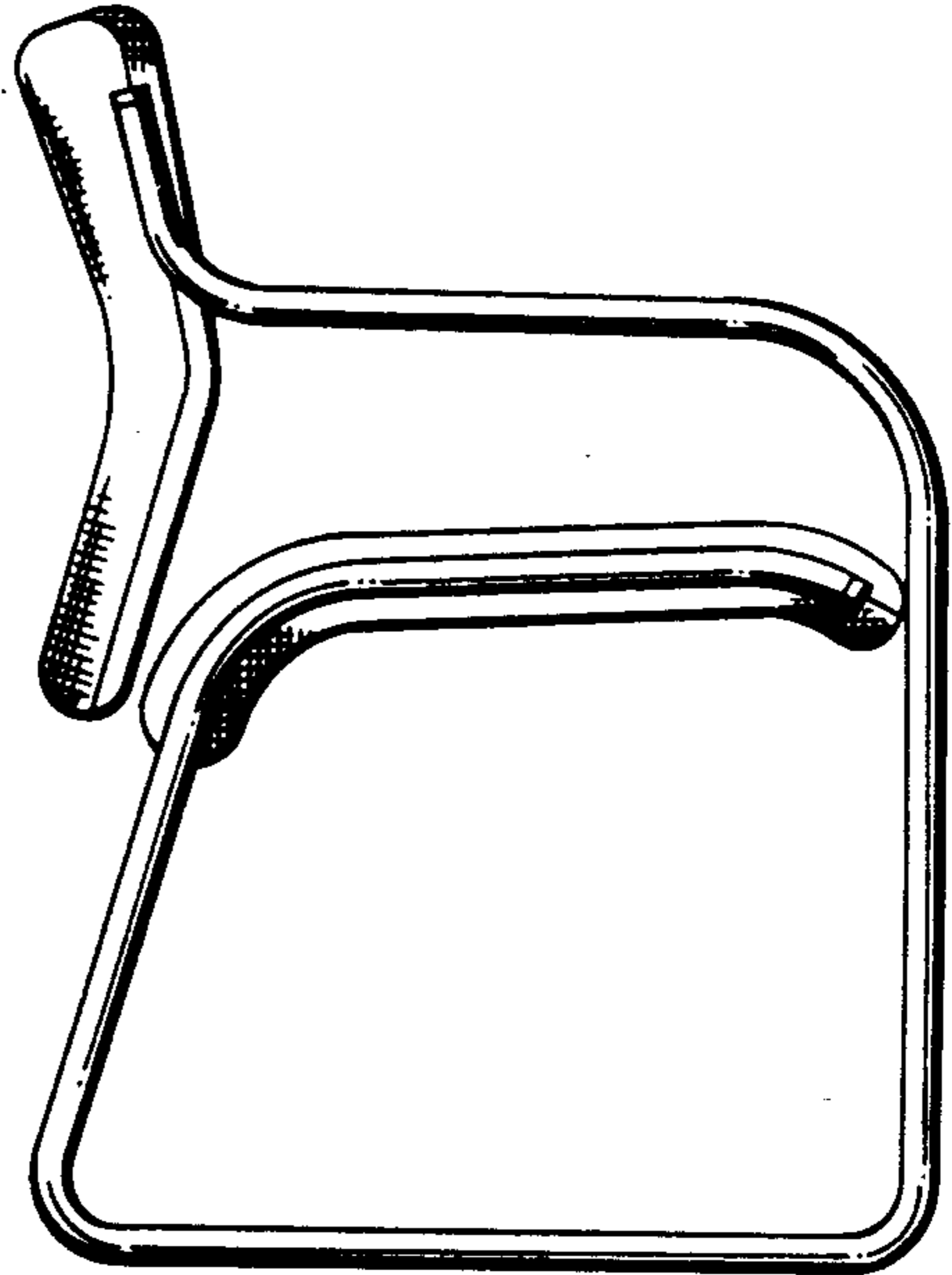

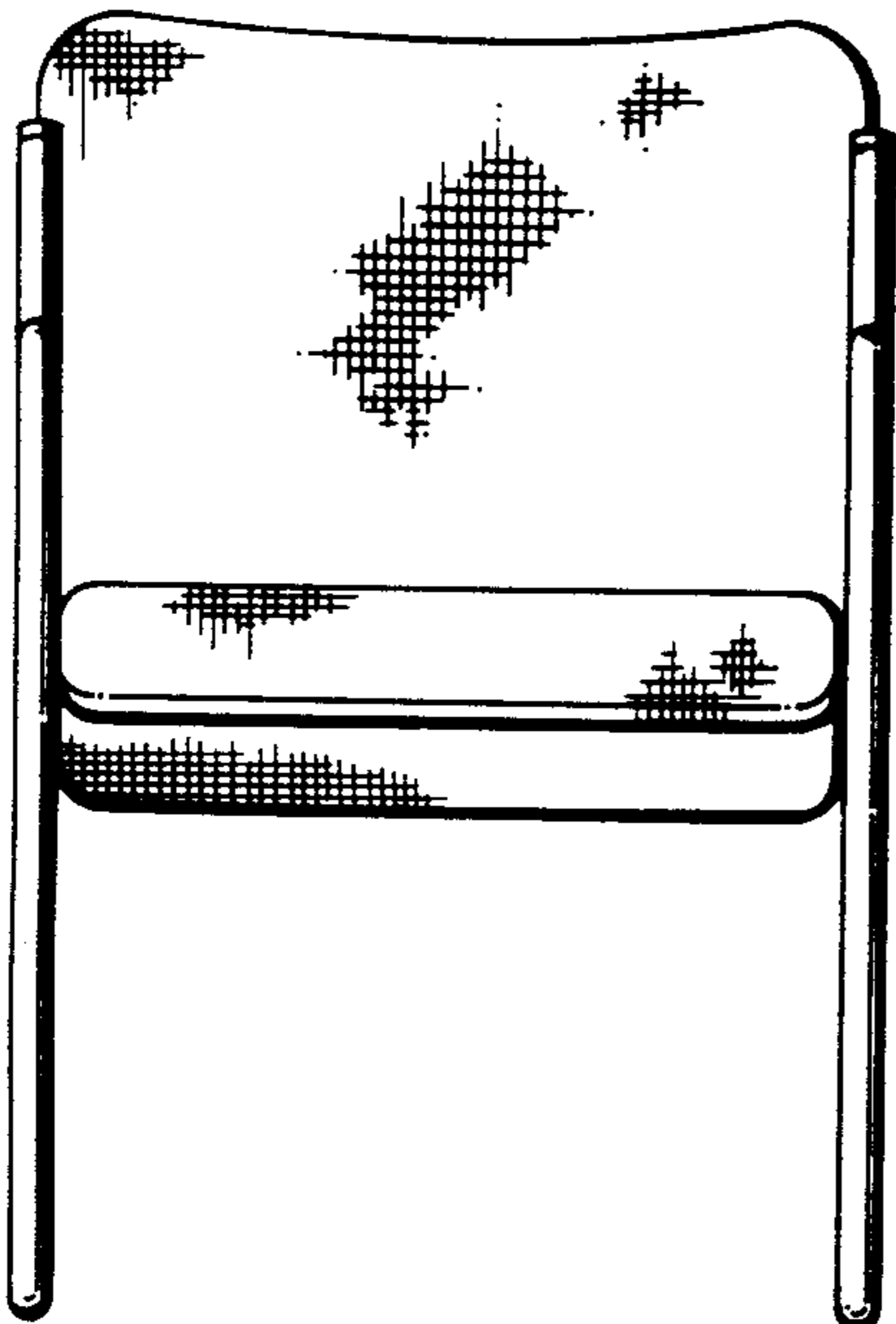
