FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereto.

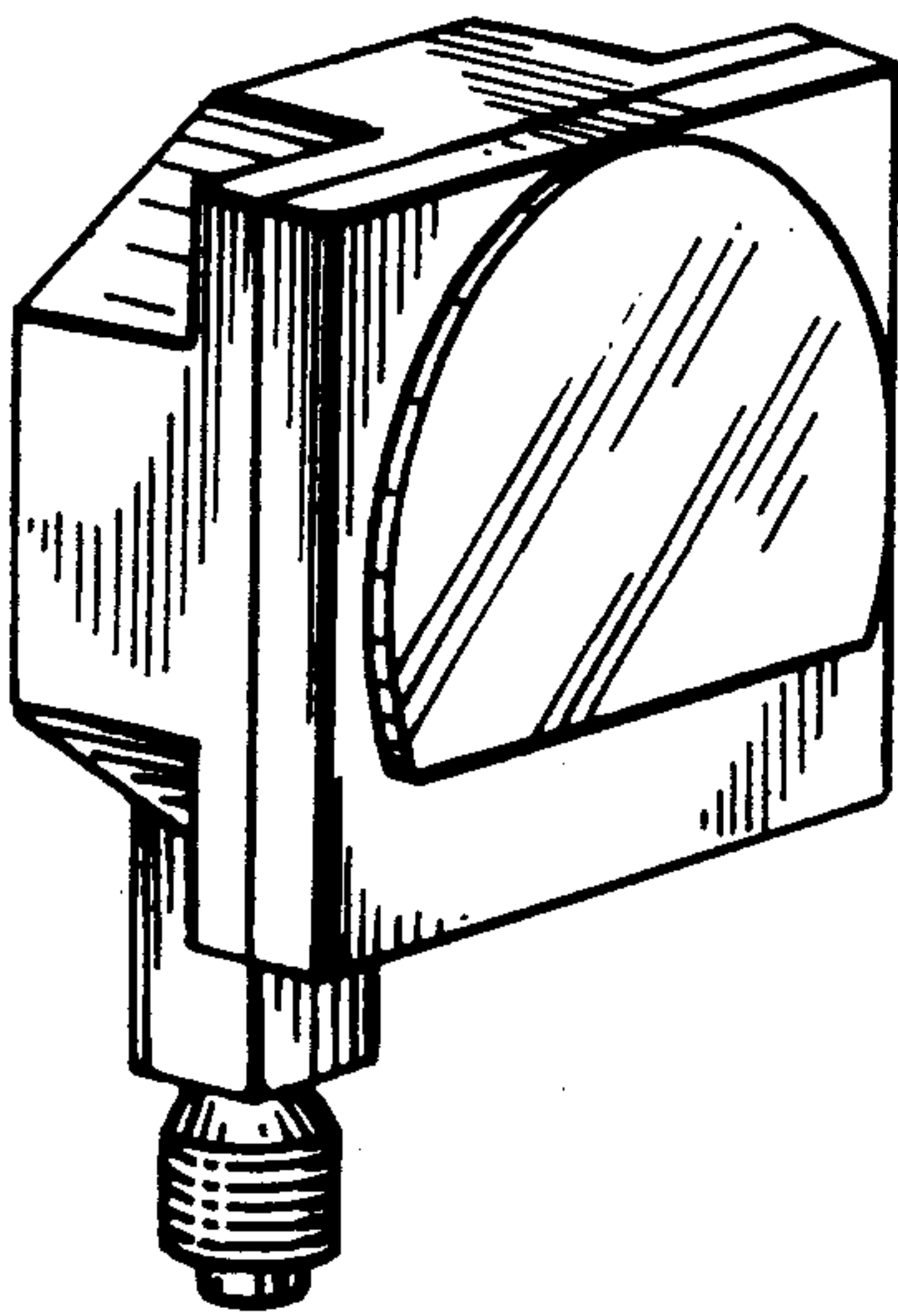

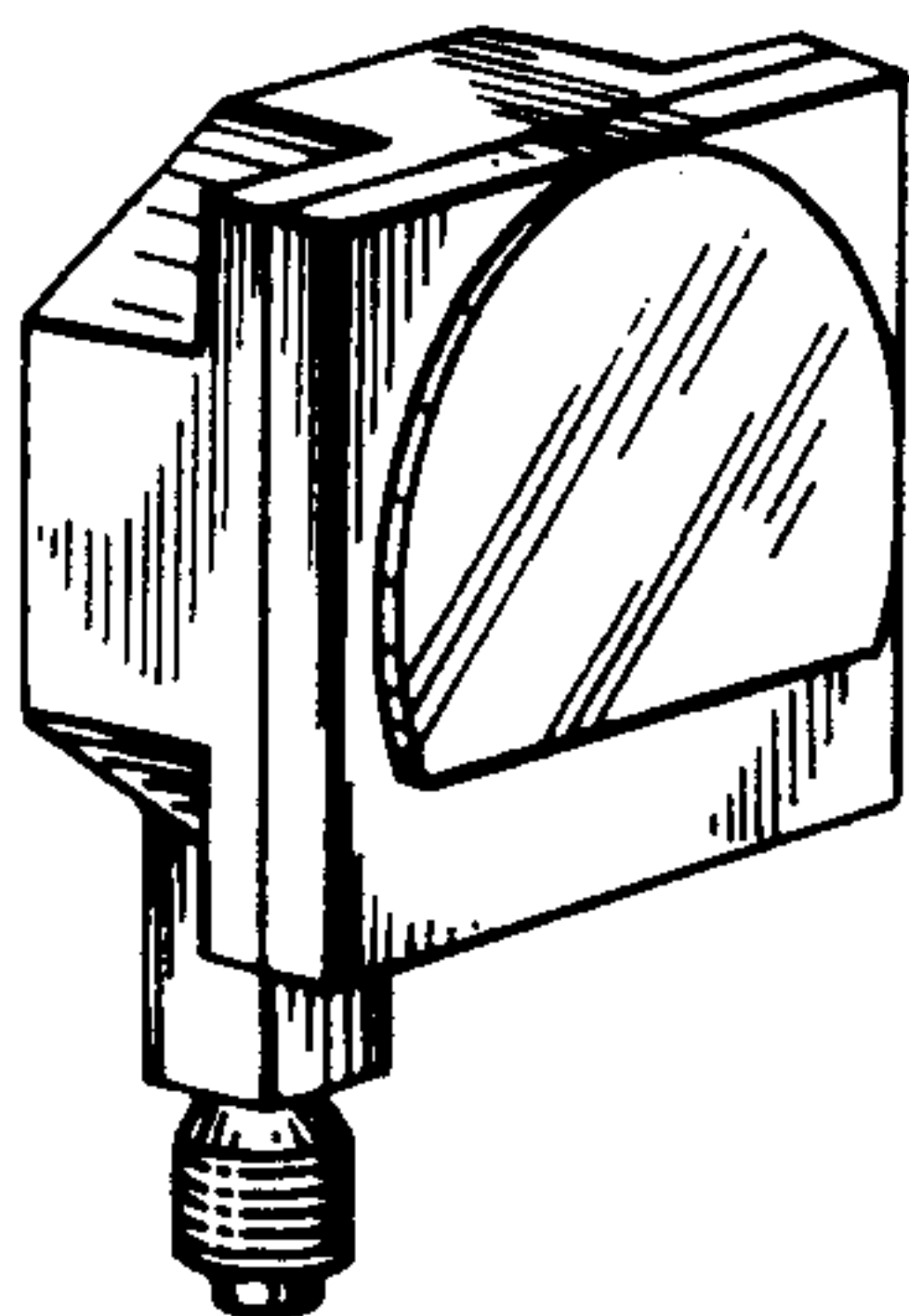

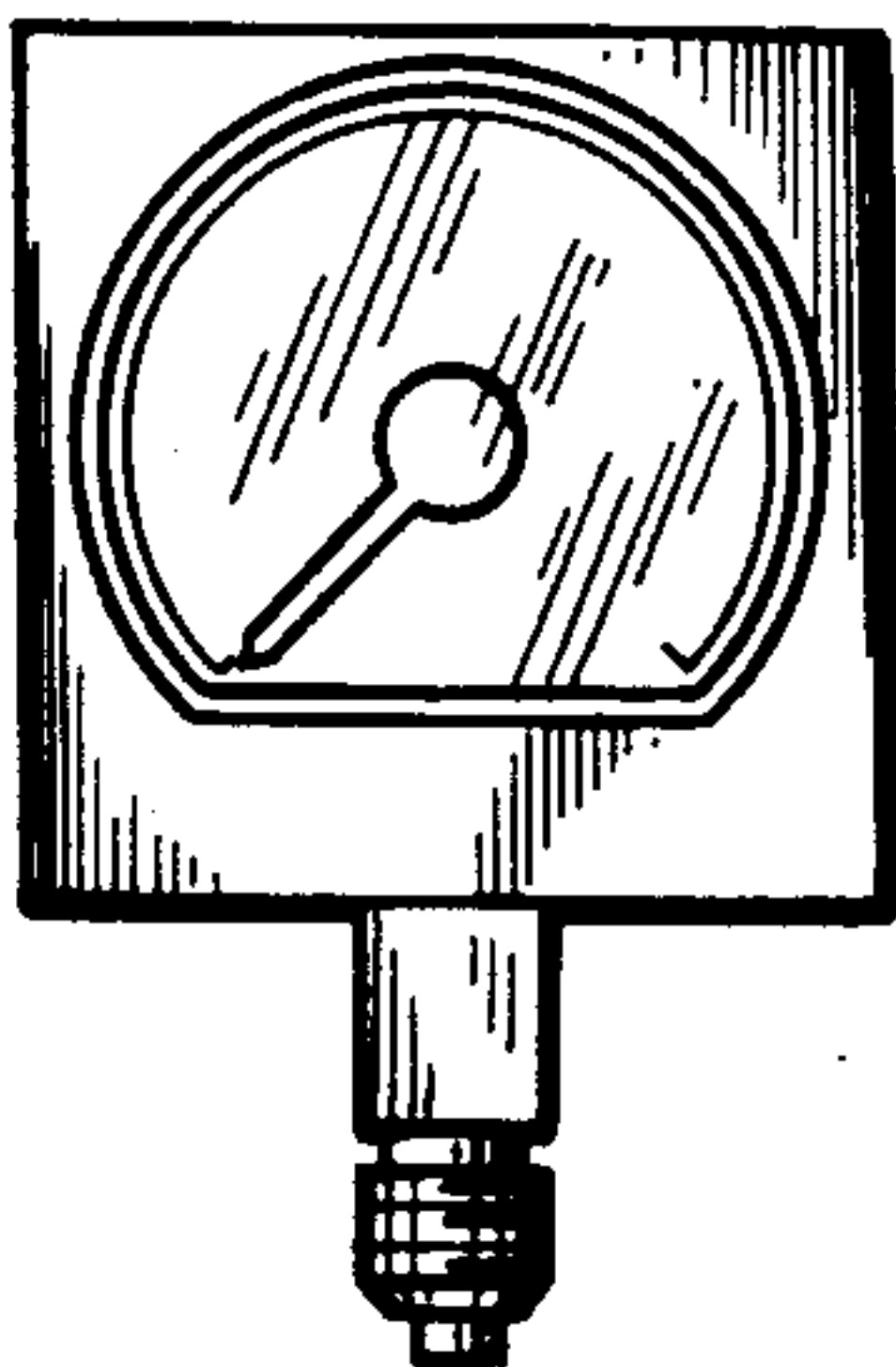

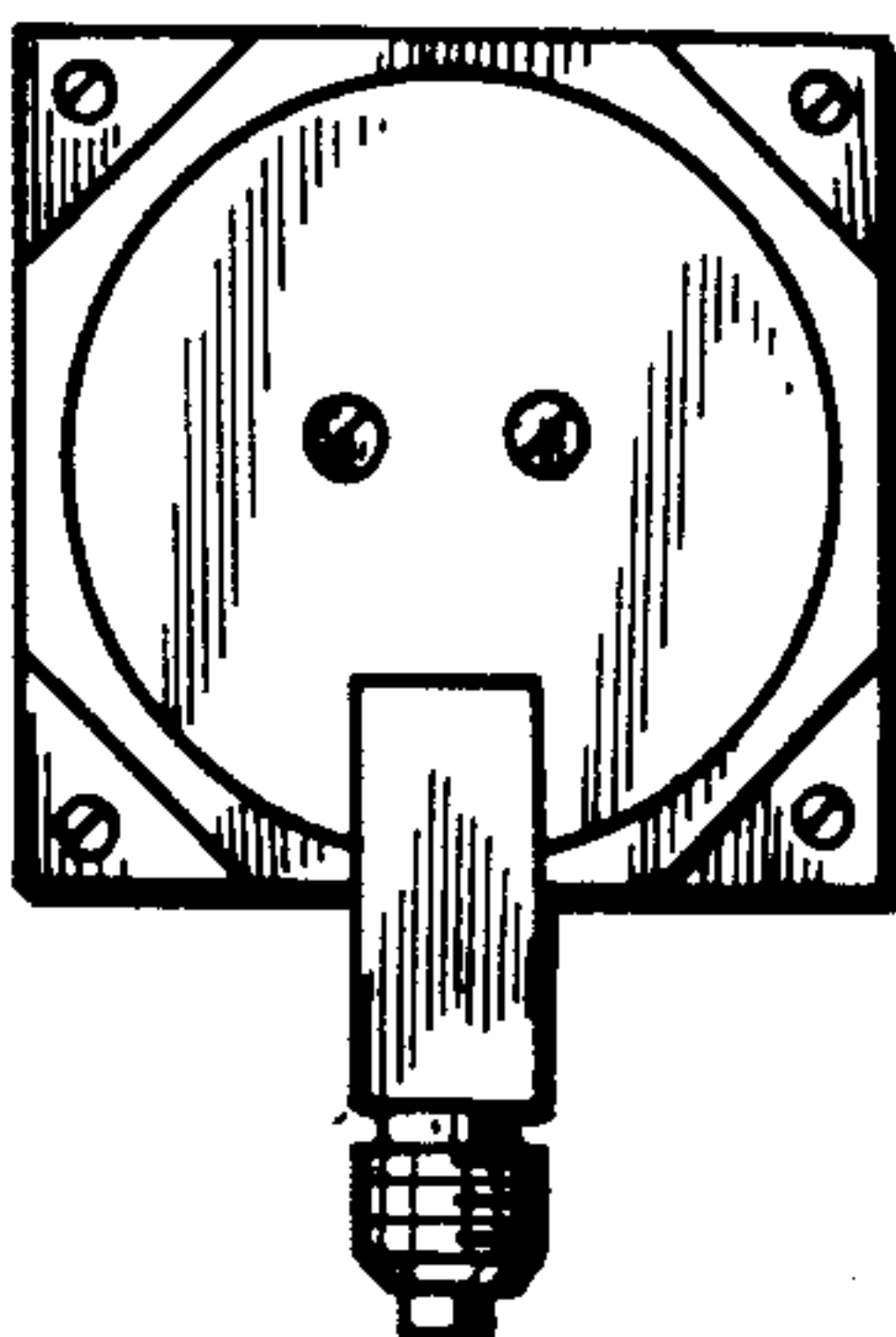

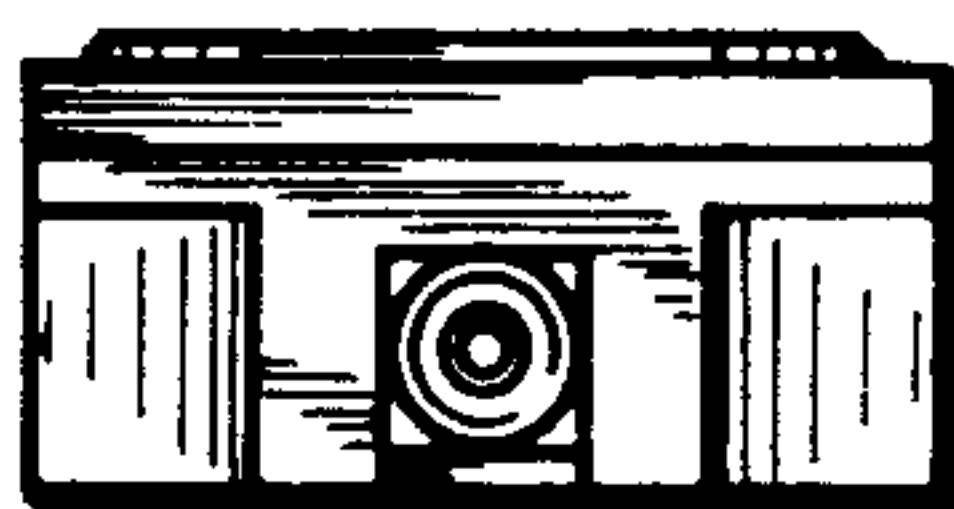
