The ornamental design for hand microphone, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a hand microphone, showing my new design,
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof,
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, looking from the right hand side of FIG. 1,
 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, looking from the left hand side of FIG. 1,
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof,
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of another embodiment of my design,
 FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof,
 FIG. 9 is a side elevational view thereof, looking from the right hand side of FIG. 7,
 FIG. 10 is a side elevational view thereof, looking from the left hand side of FIG. 7,
 FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof, and
 FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The broken lines representing the fragmentary electric cord are shown for illustrative purposes only.
