DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a copy holder for a typewriter or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged scale front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

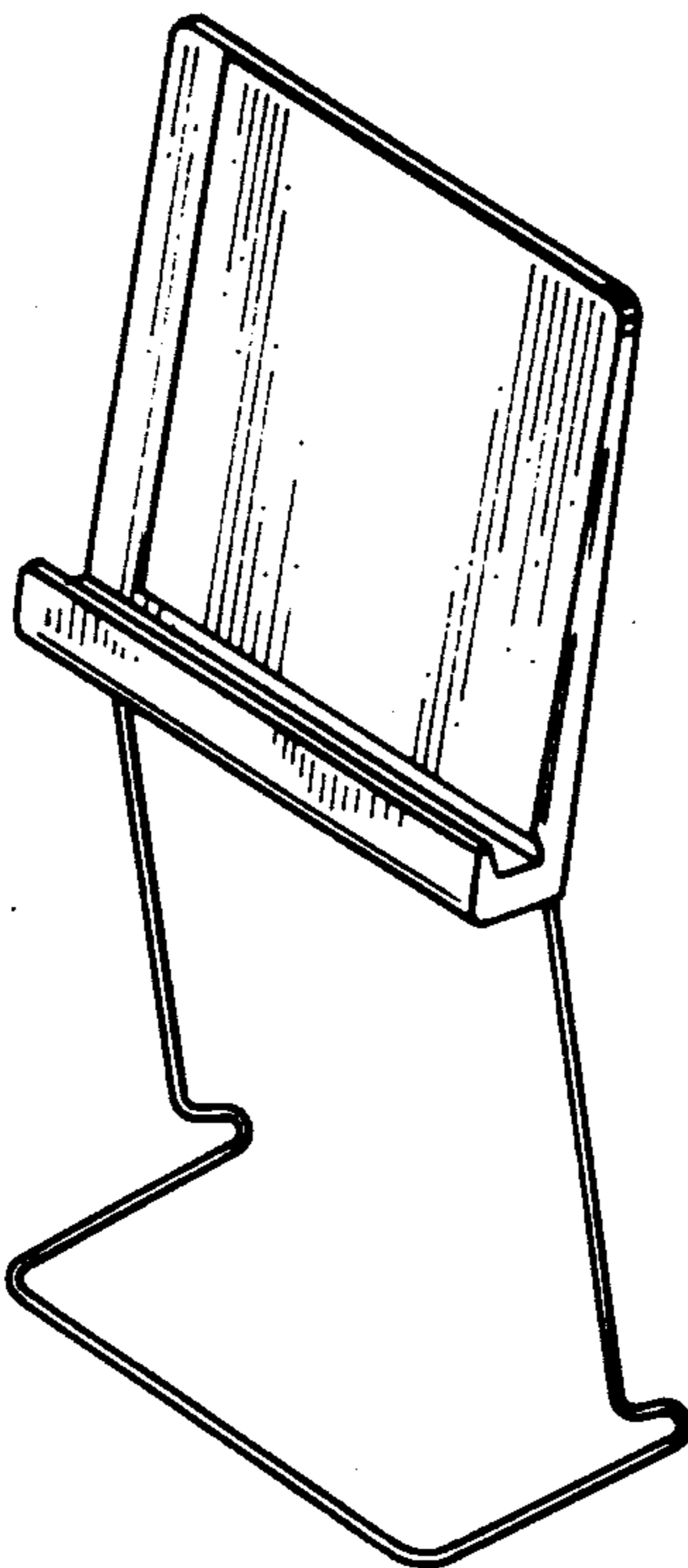

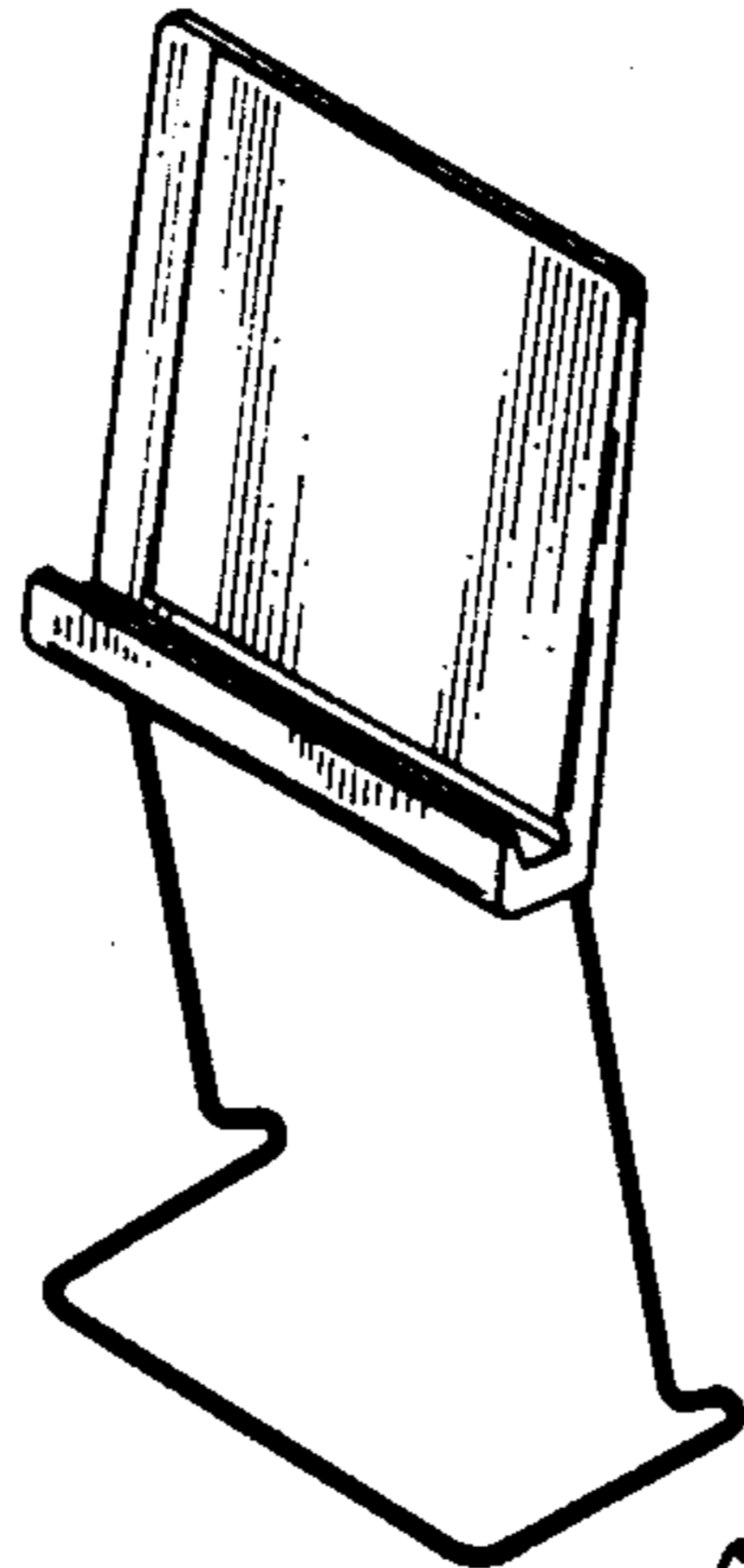

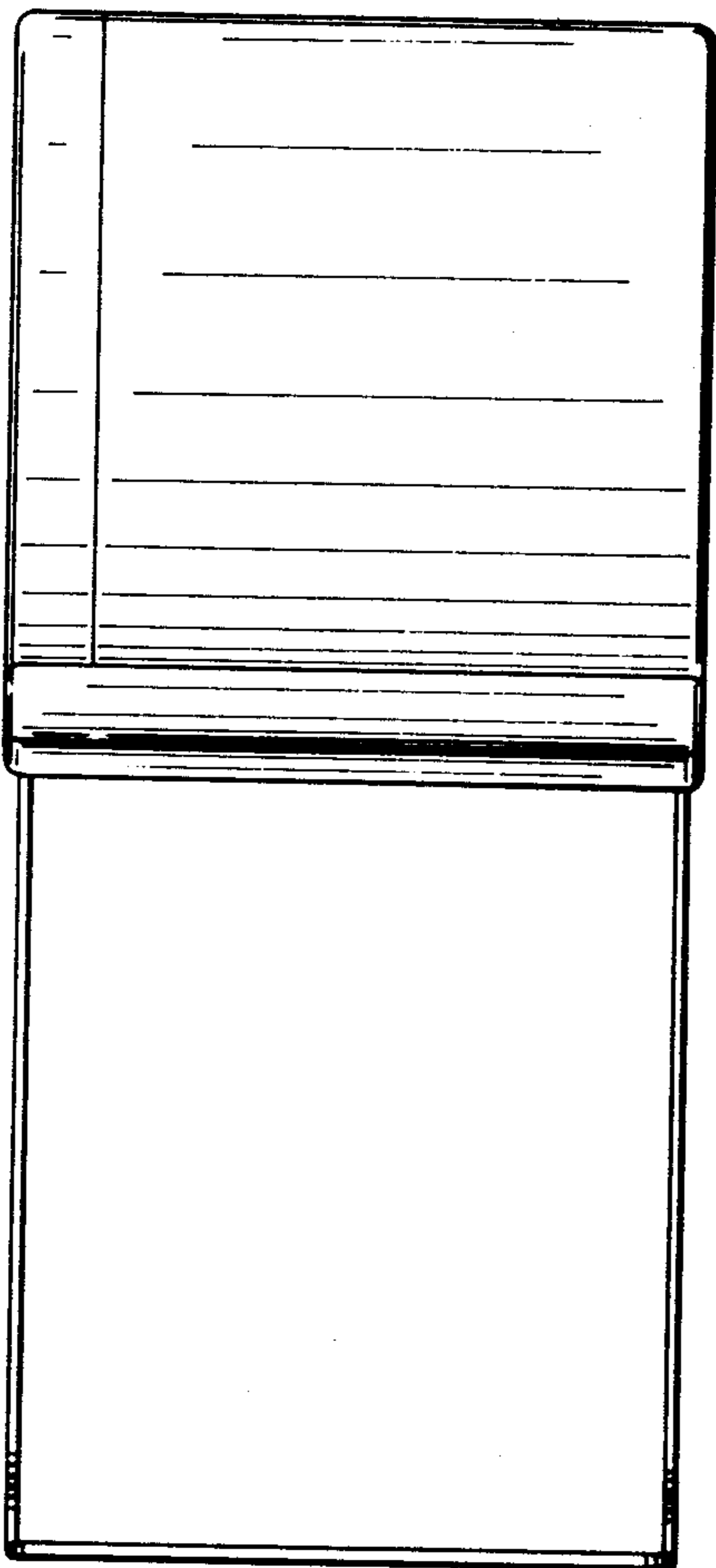

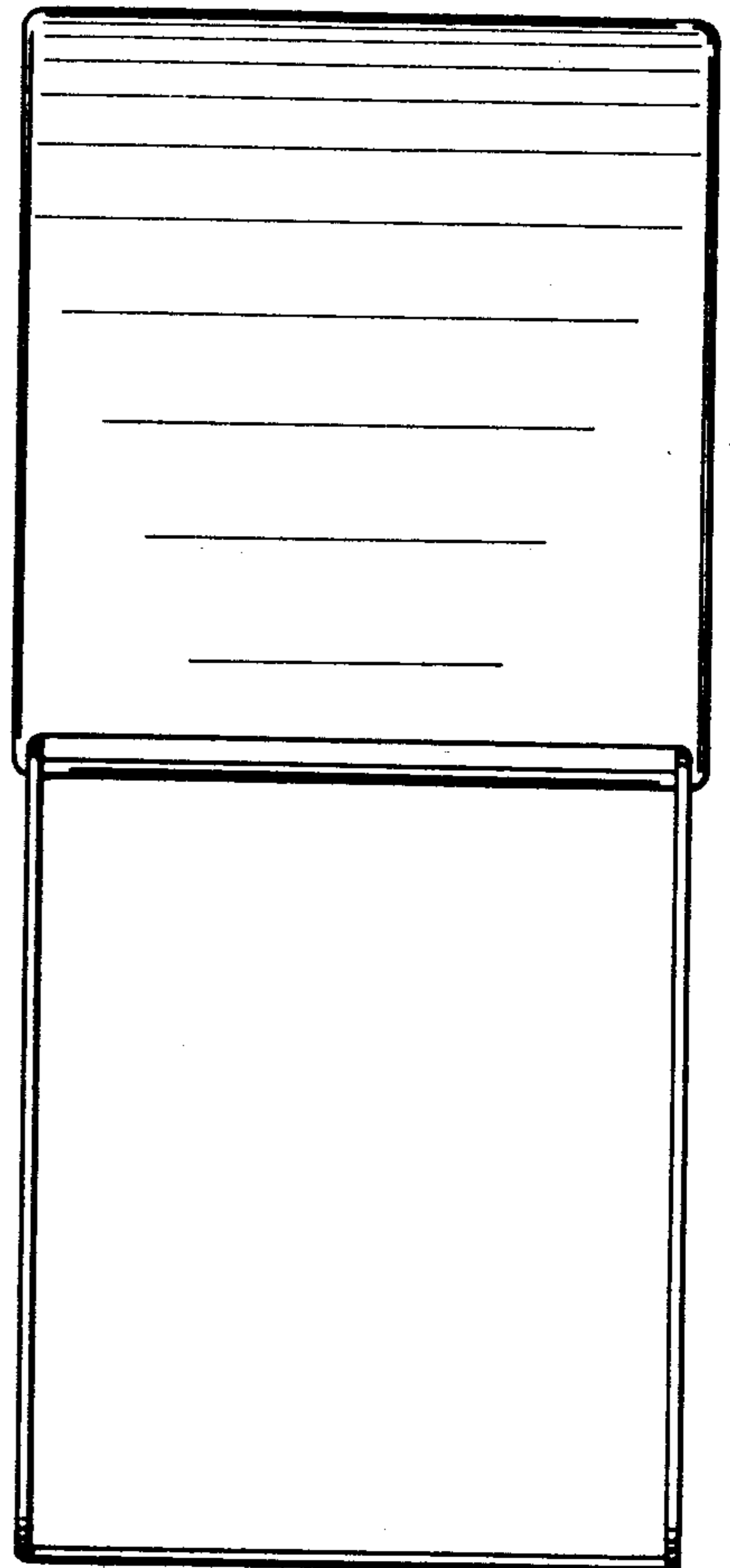

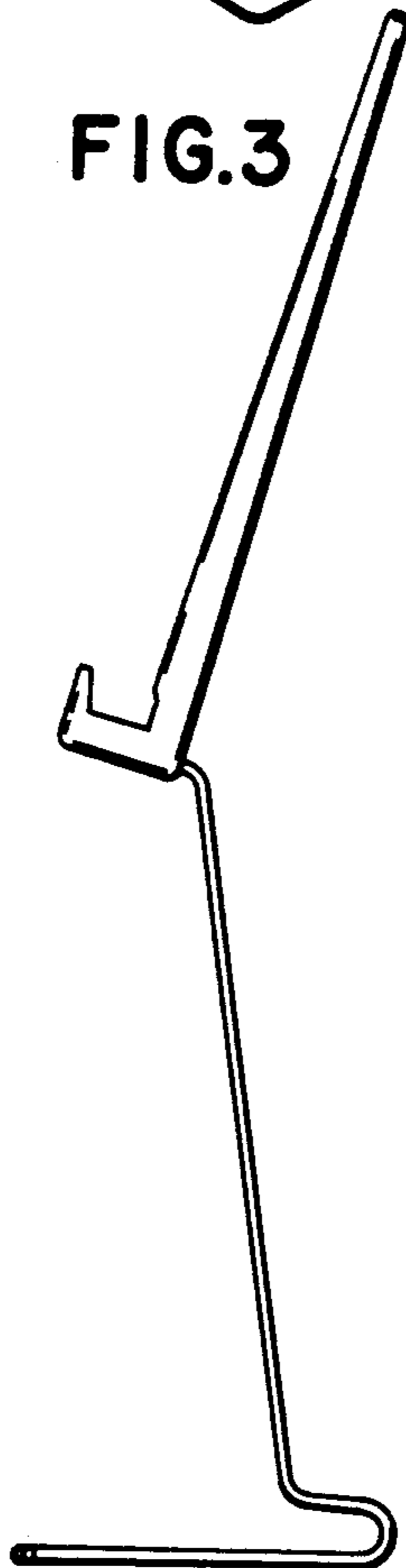
