[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined video cassette storage and ejection cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined video cassette storage and ejection cabinet, on an enlarged scale, showing our new design with two slidable members thereof being shown in different positions of extension;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, also on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The right side elevational view of the combined video cassette storage and ejection cabinet is substantially identical to the left side elevational view of FIG. 4.

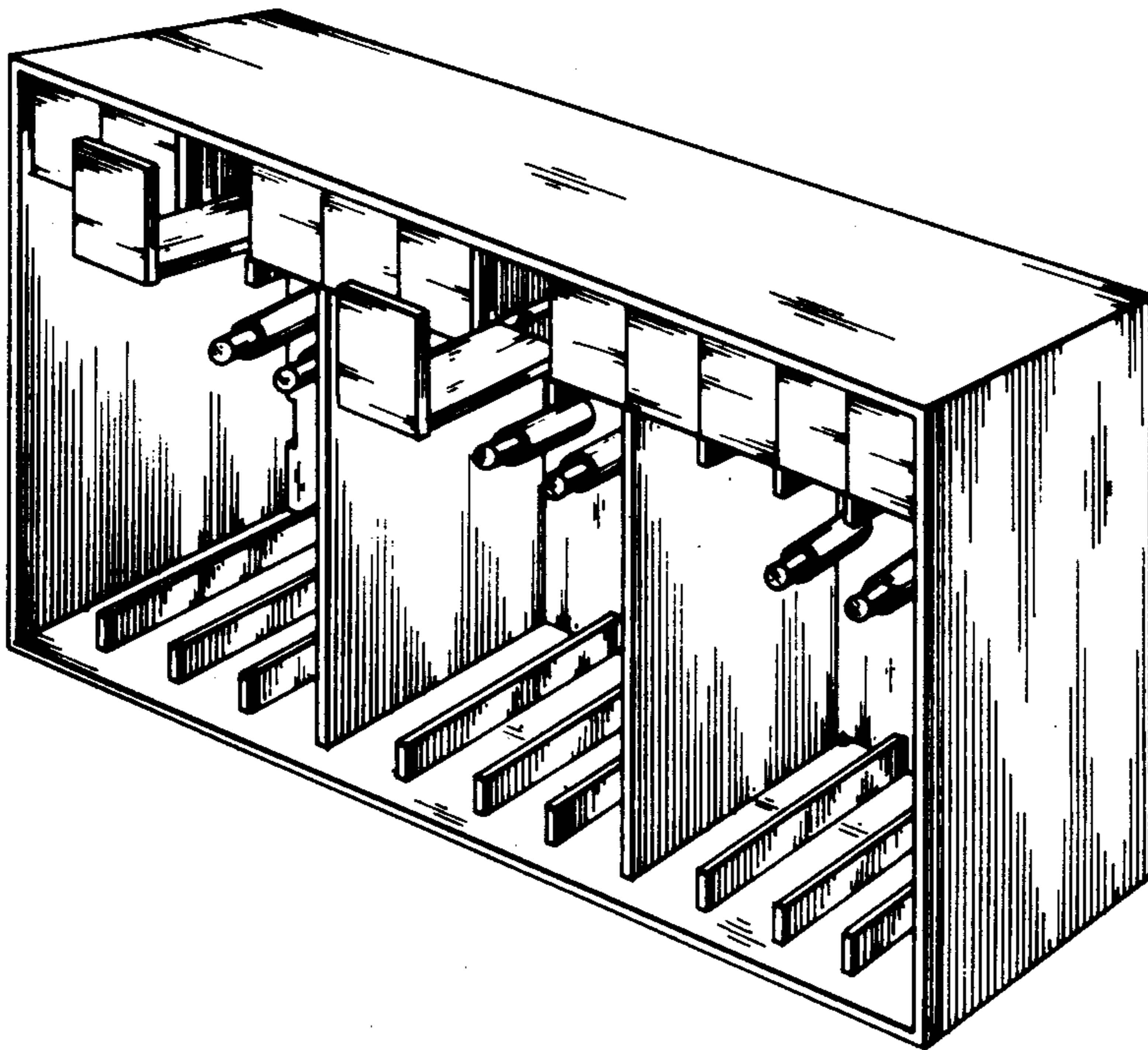
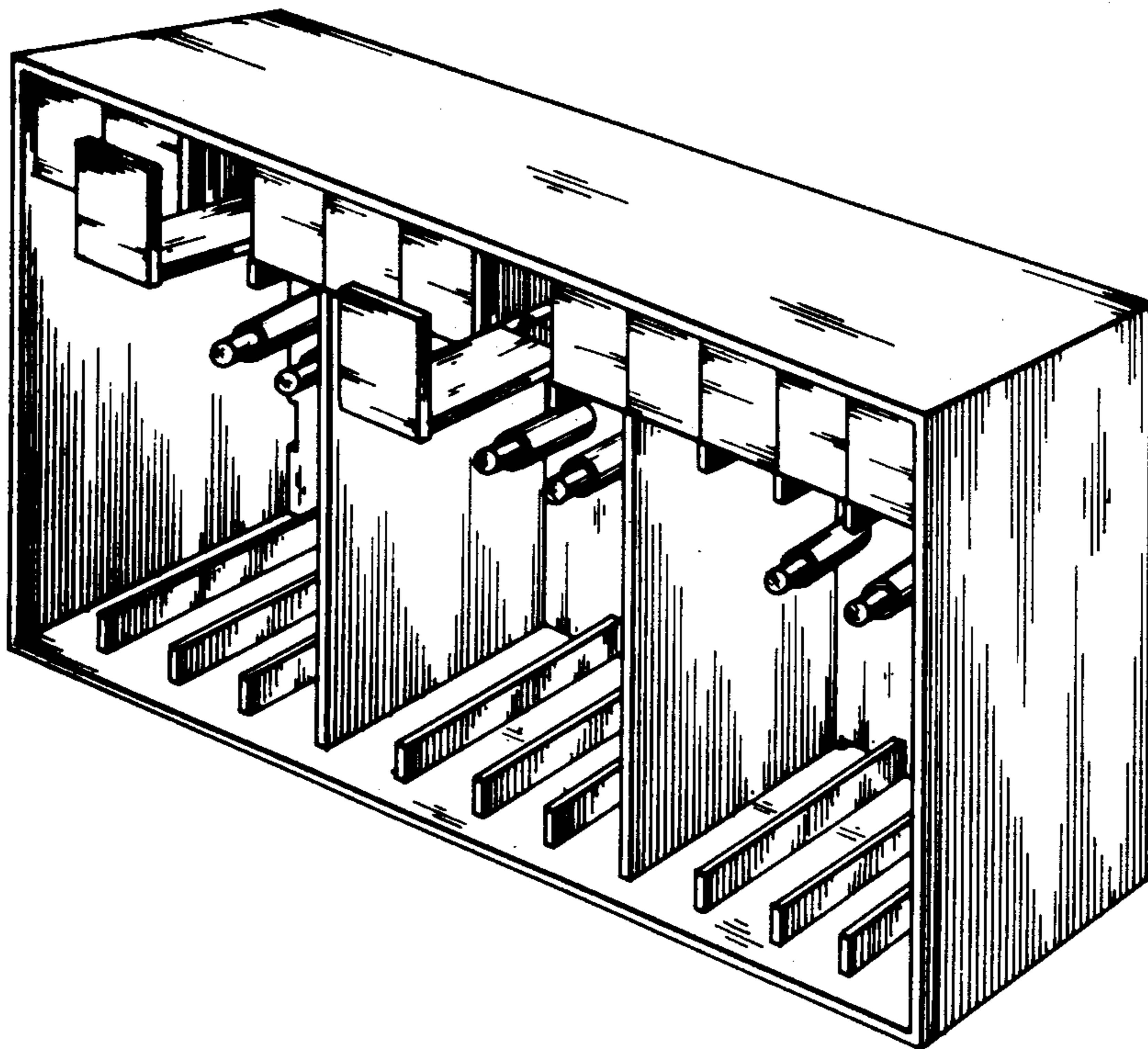

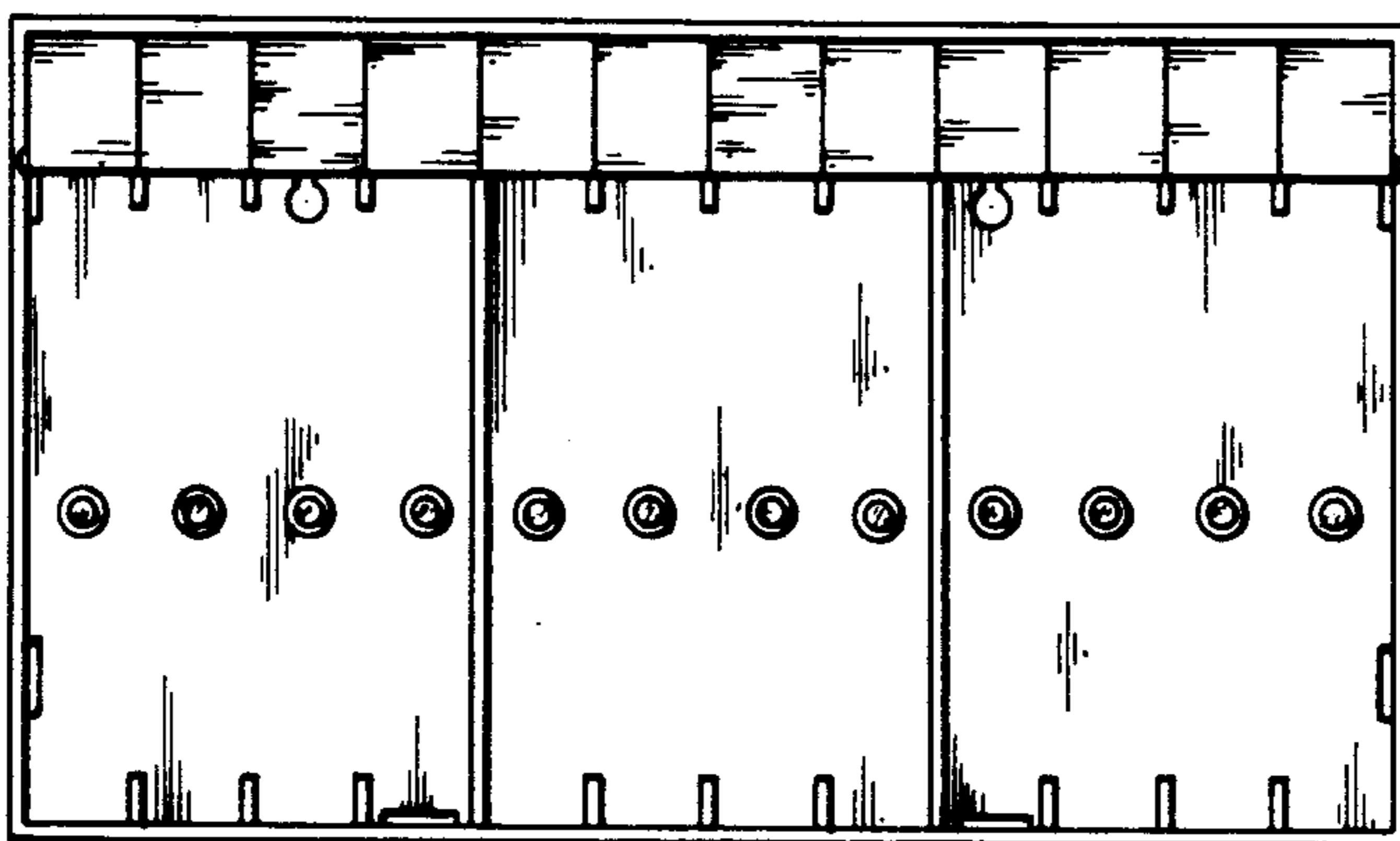

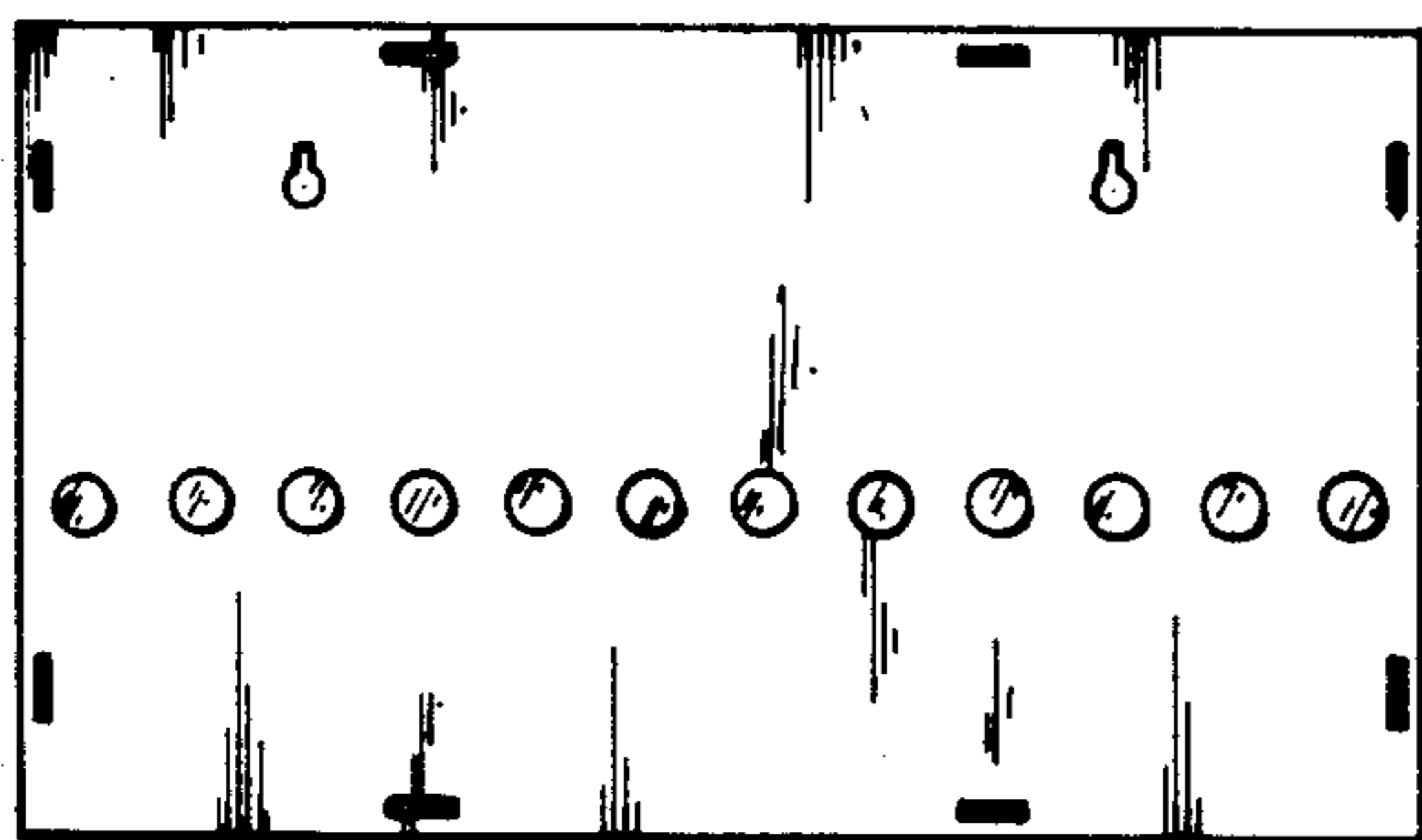

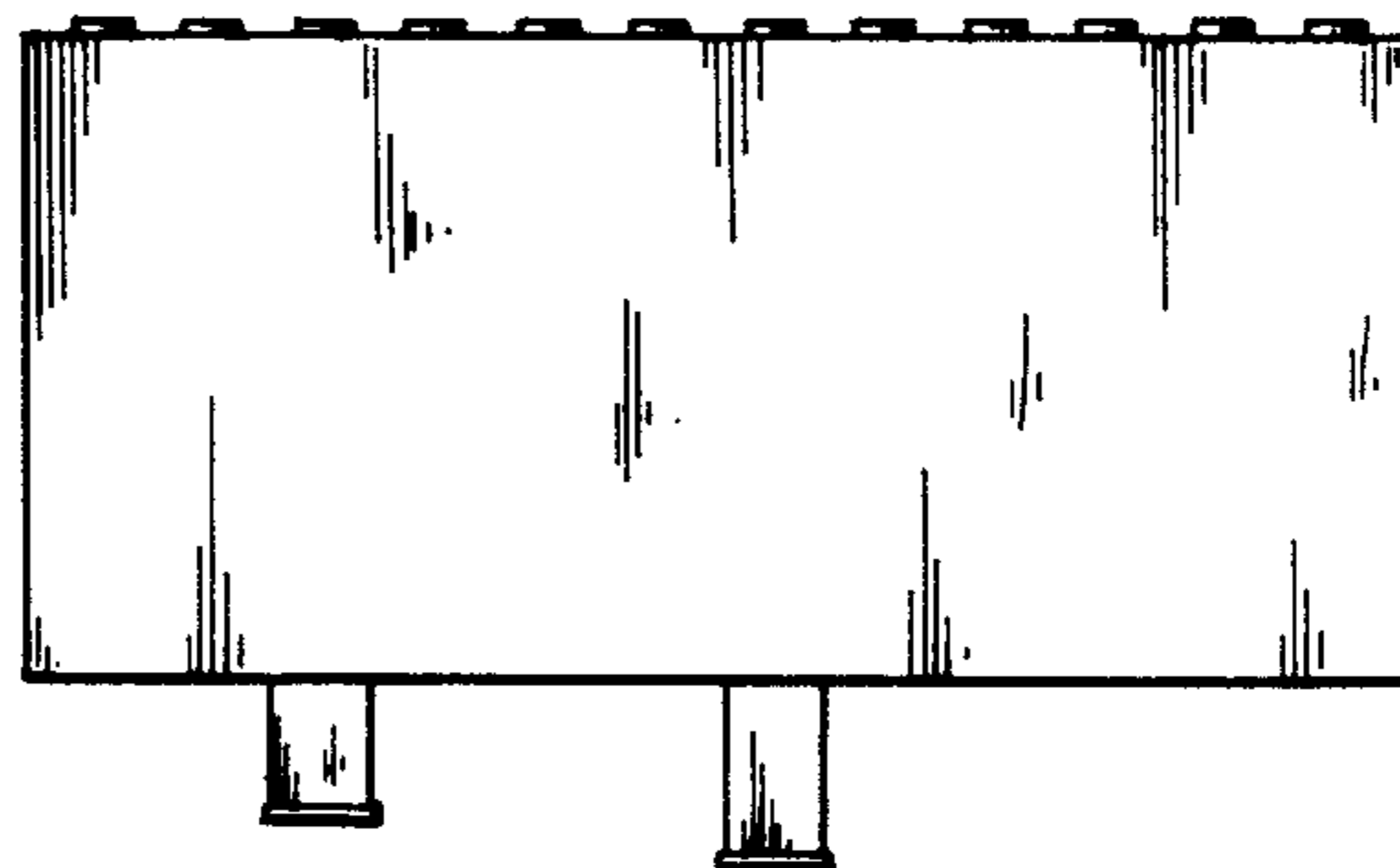

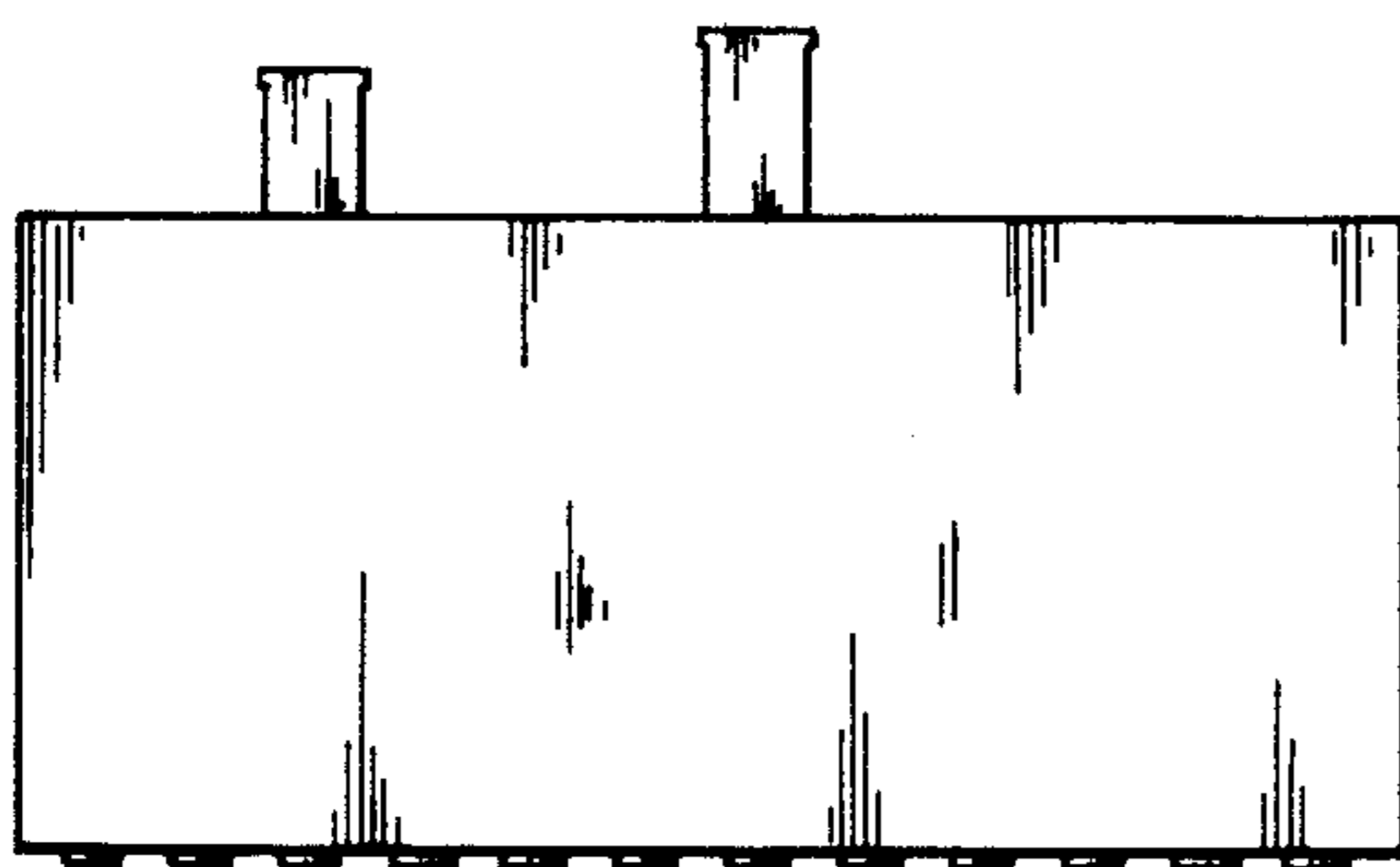
