FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lawn sprinkler showing my new design;

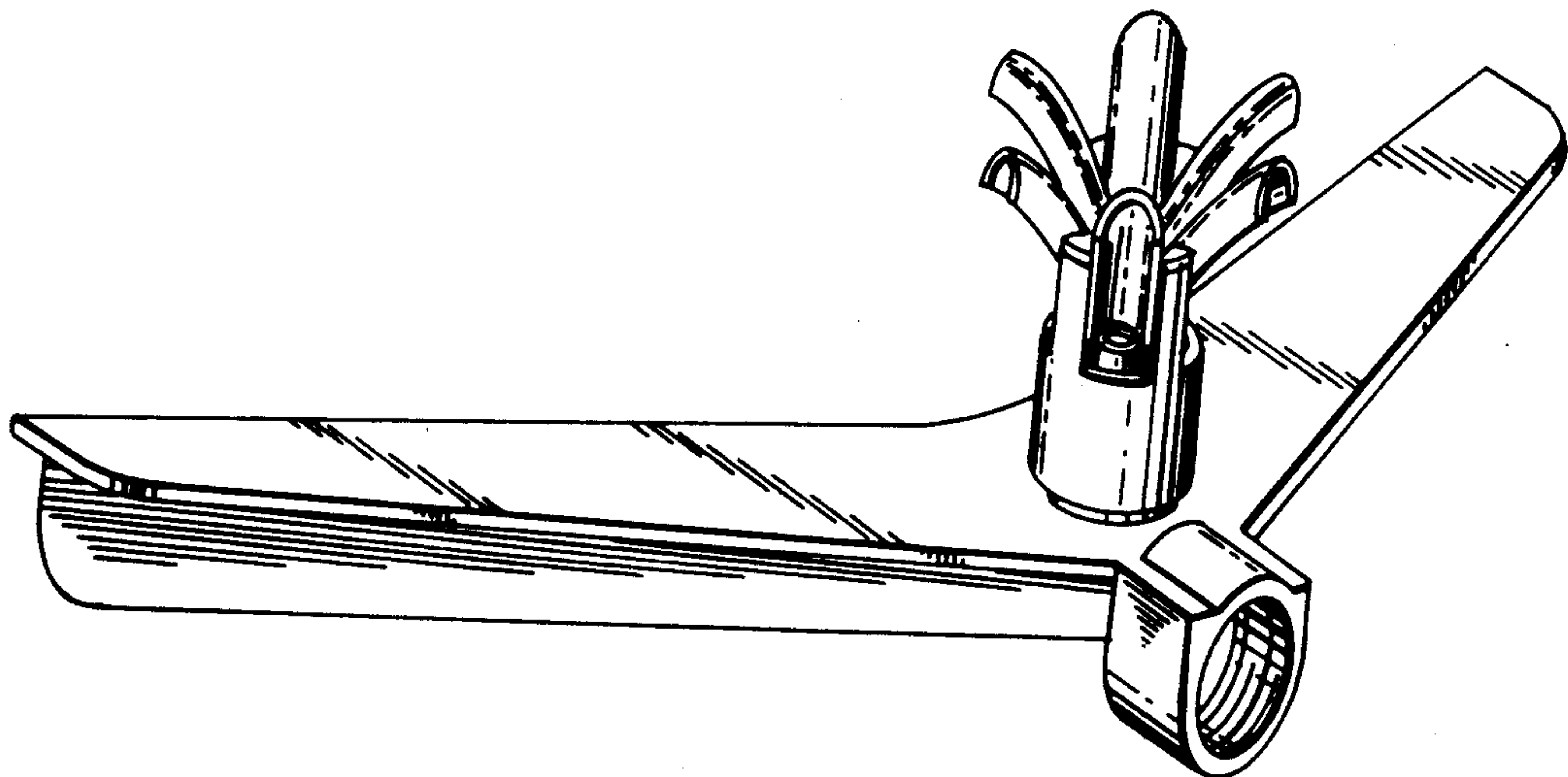
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an elevational view taken from one side thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown.



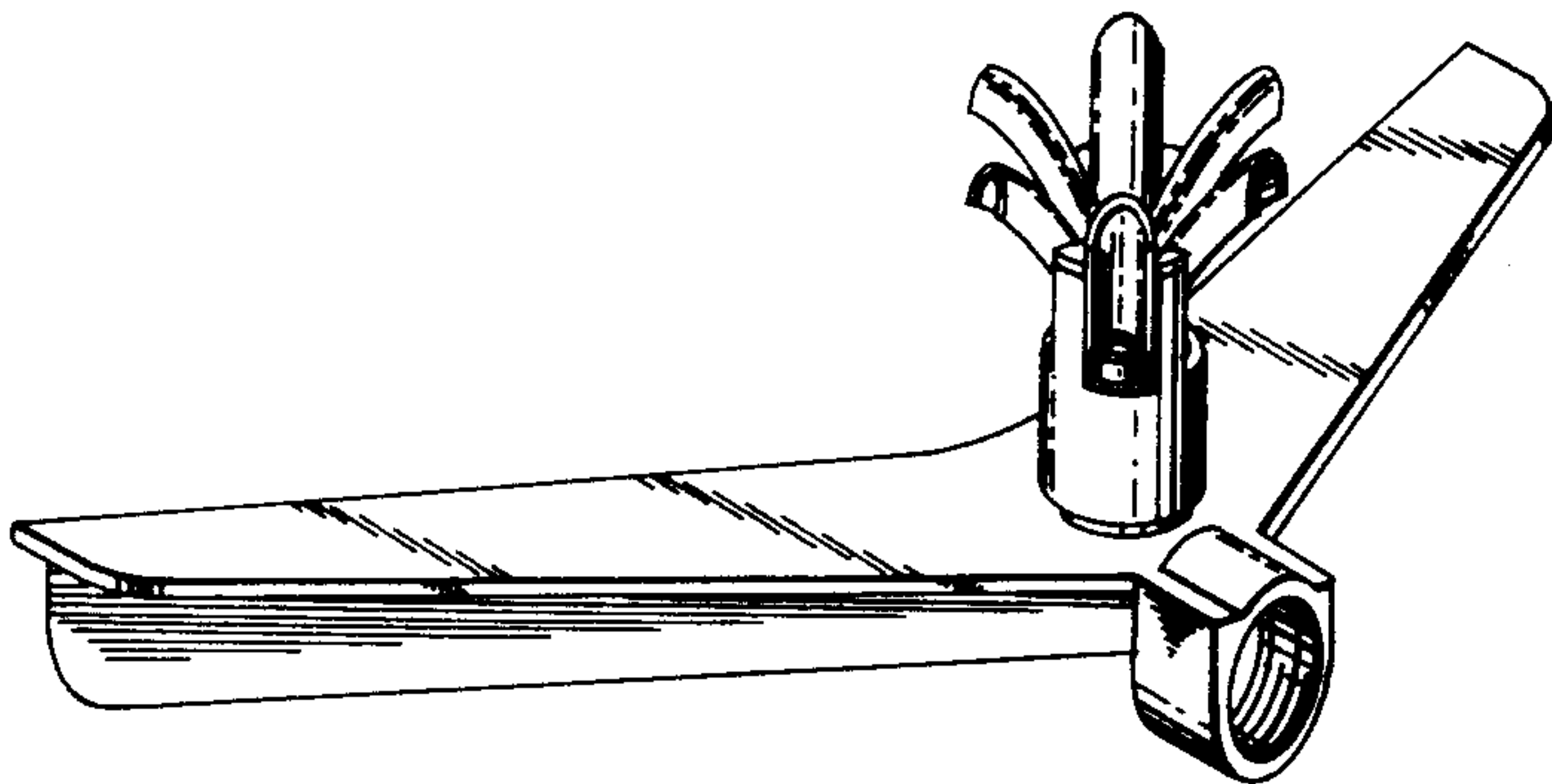

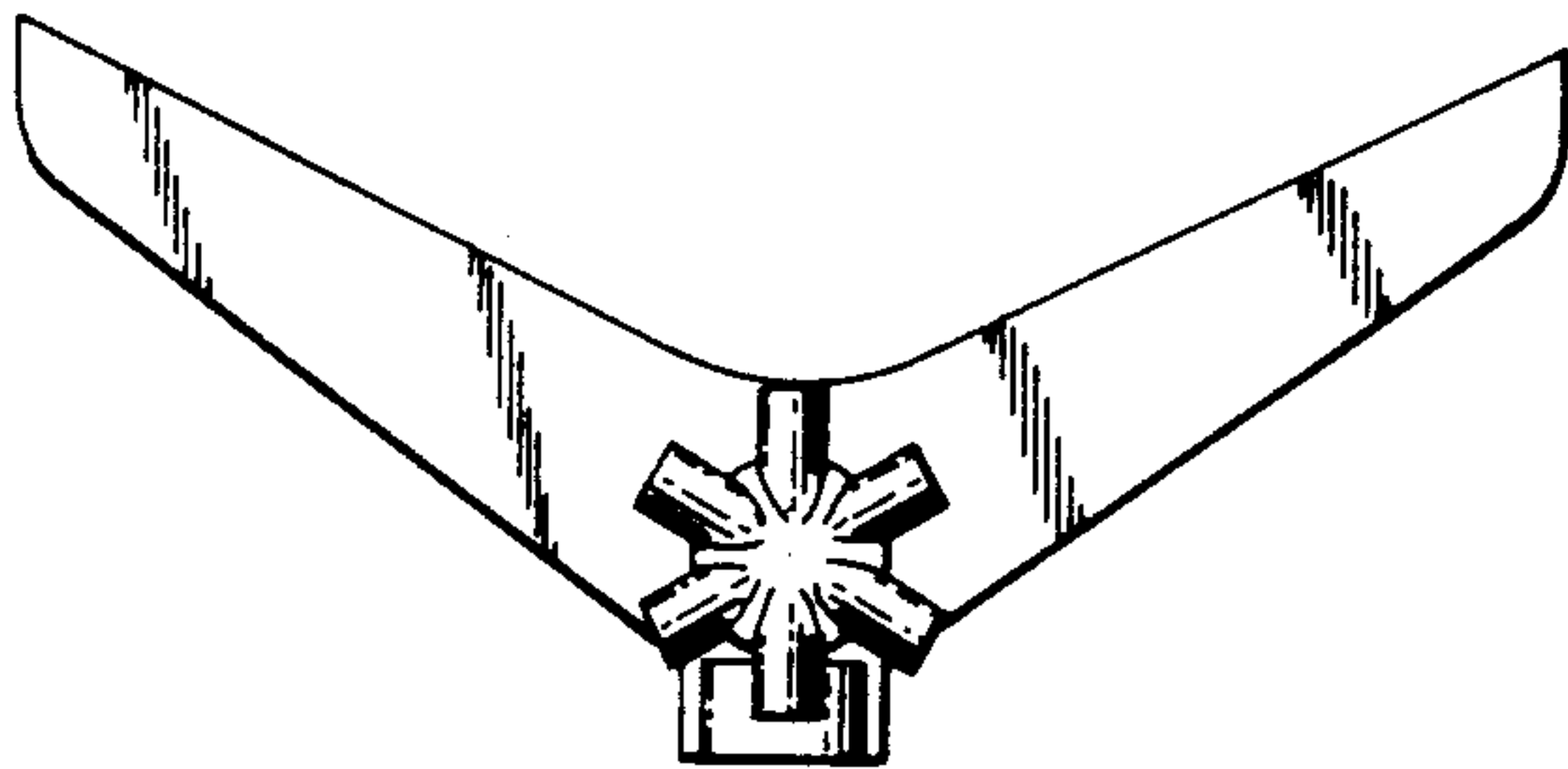

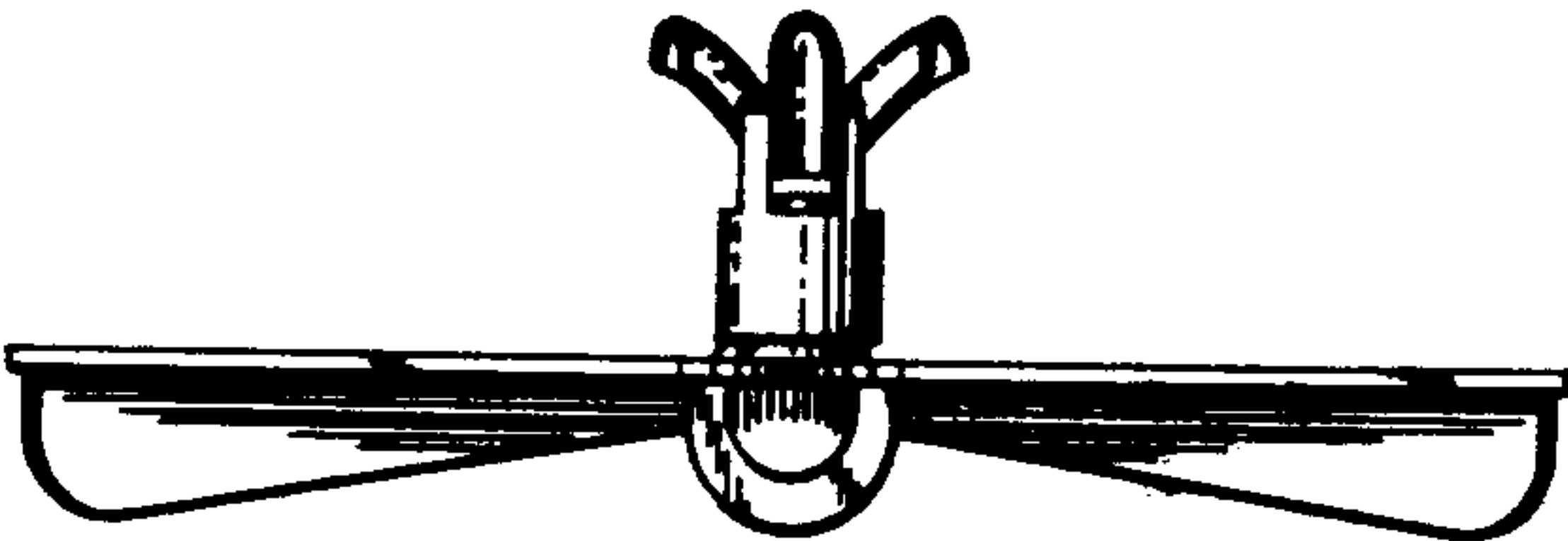

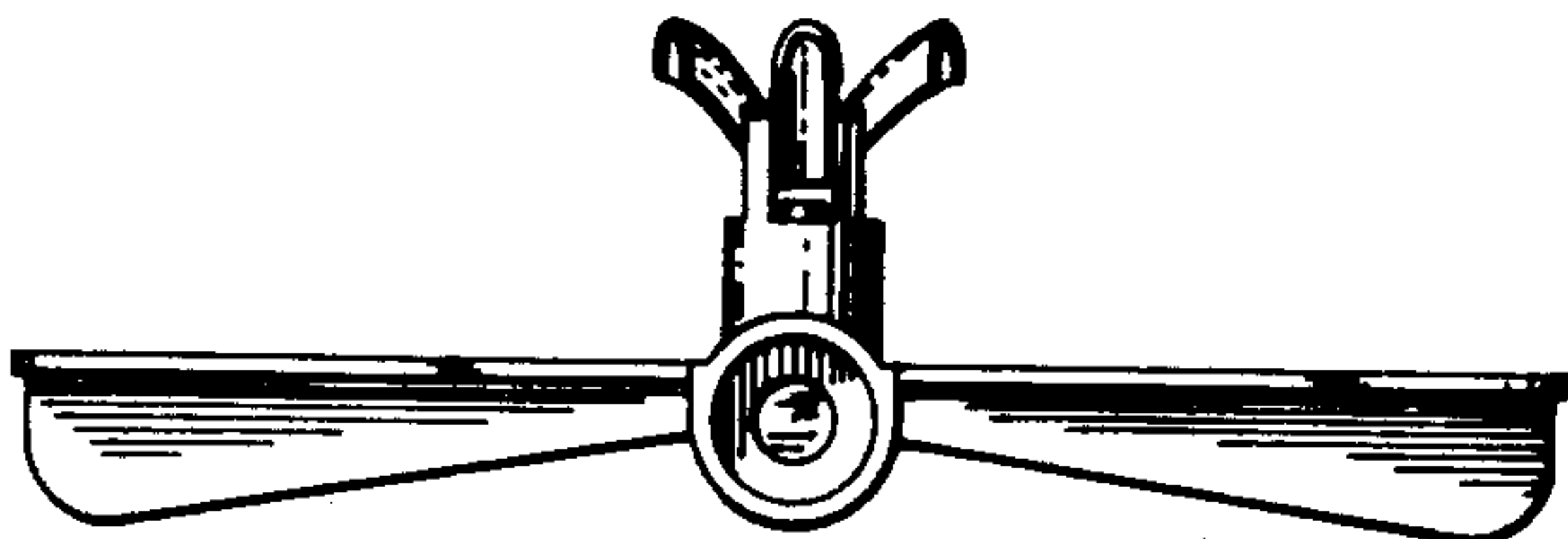

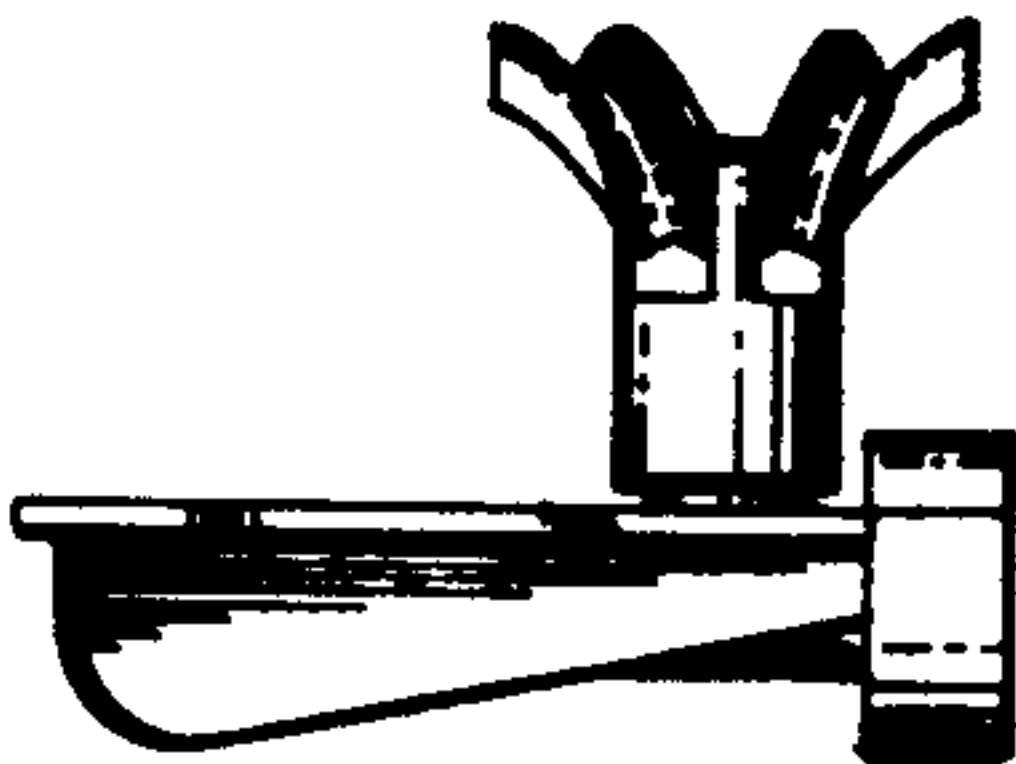

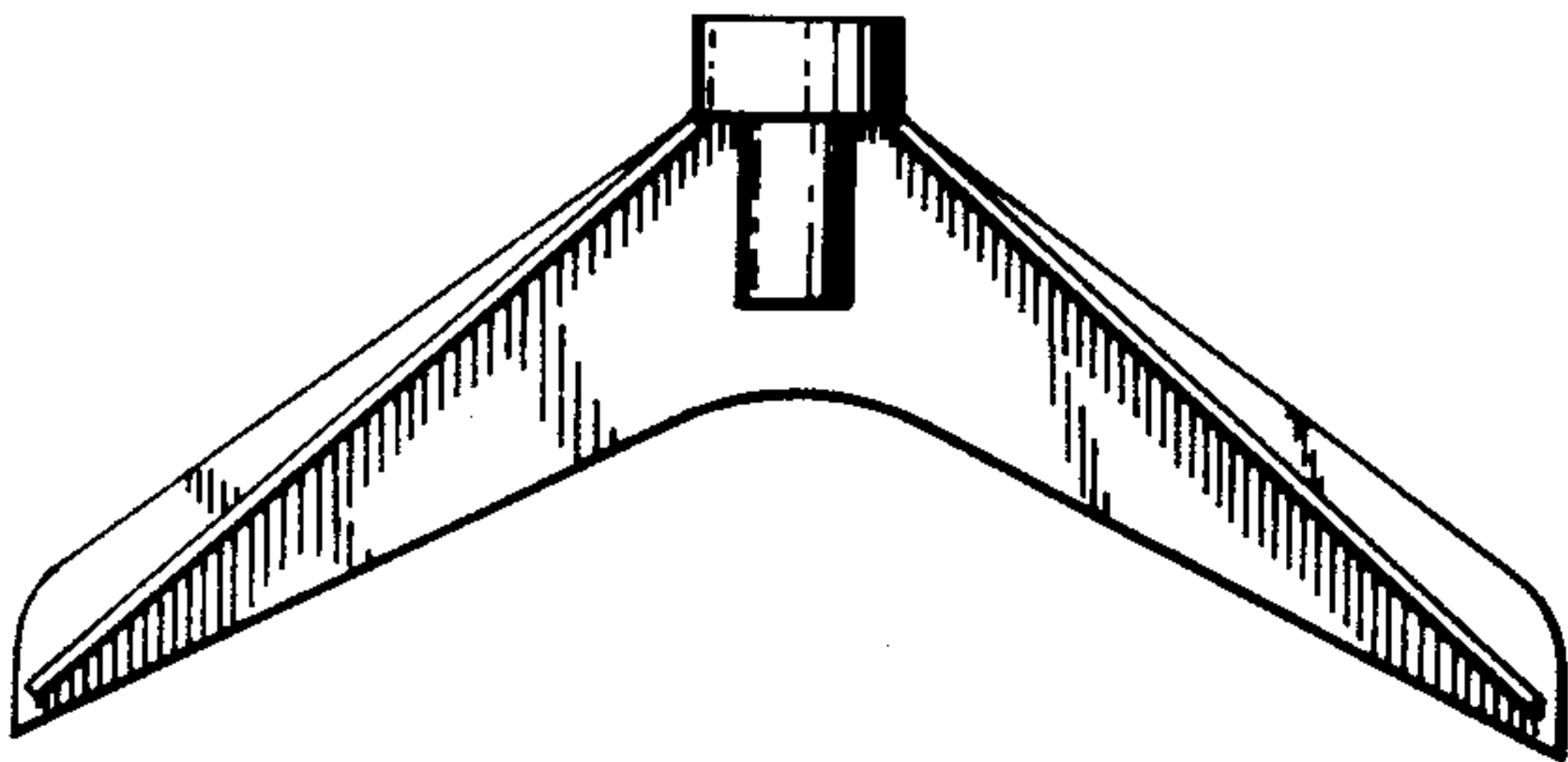
