The ornamental design for a combined canister and flower arrangement container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined canister and flower arrangement container showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof with the lid in position as a pedestal;

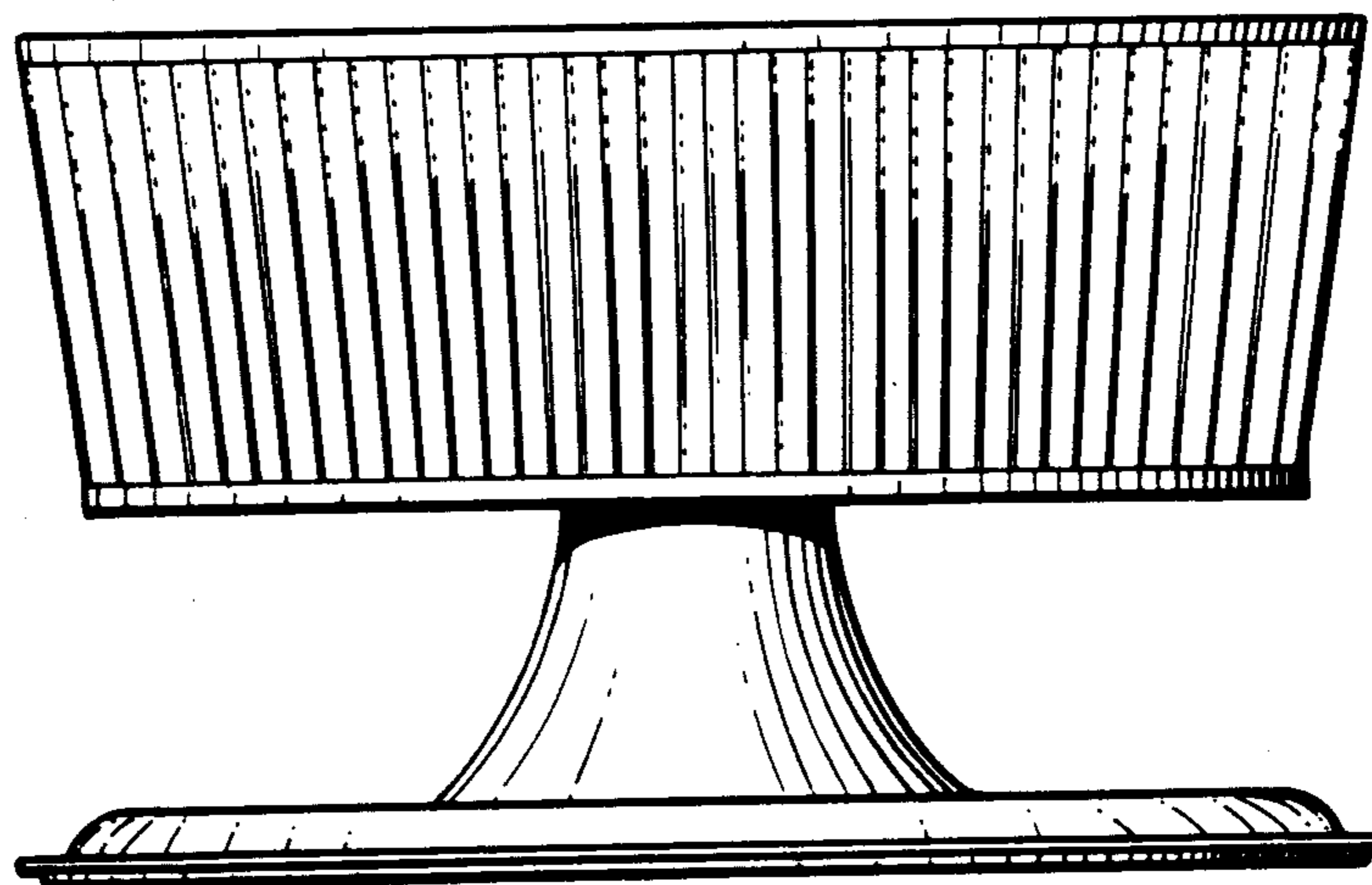
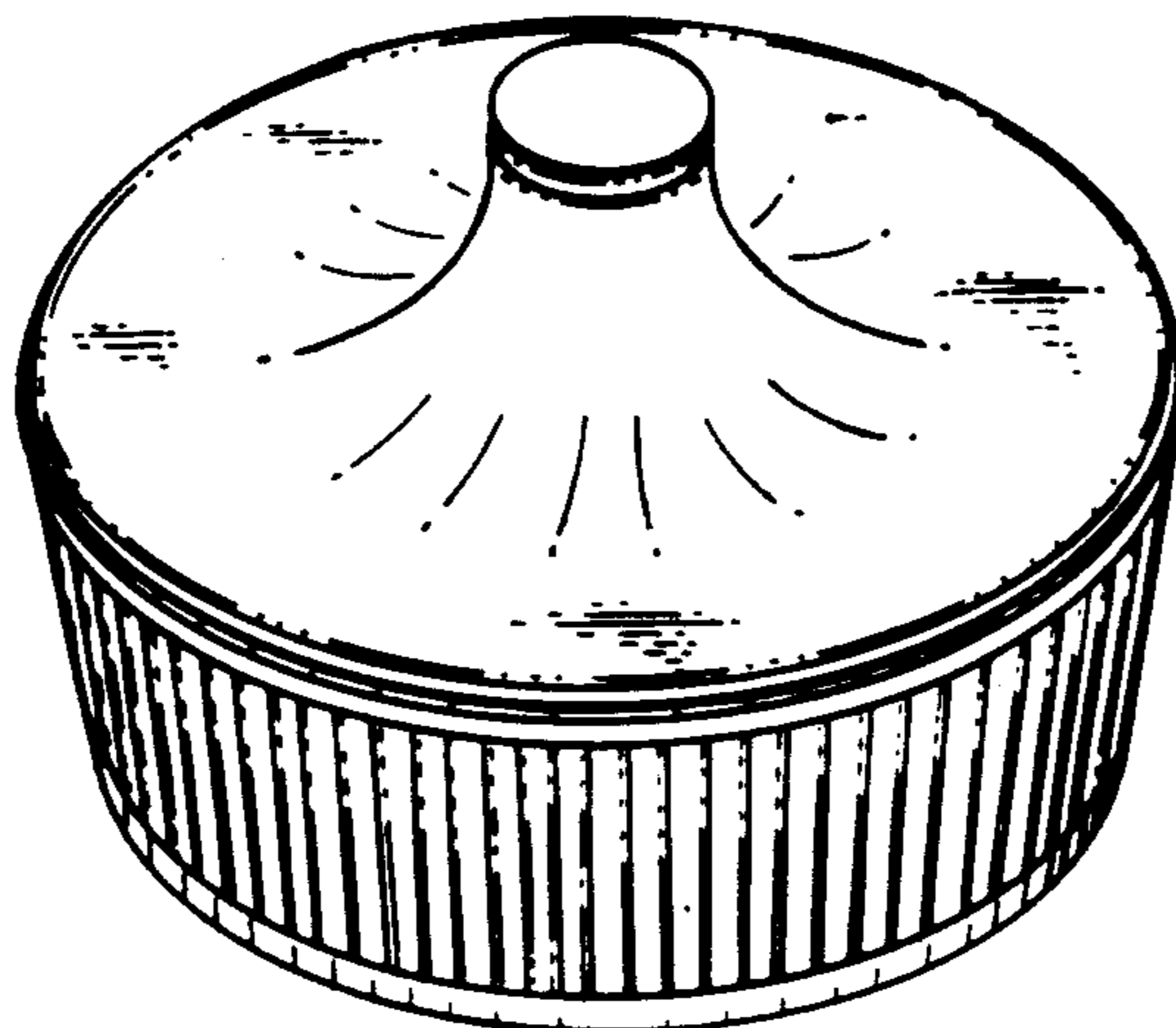
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of FIG. 2 on an enlarged scale.



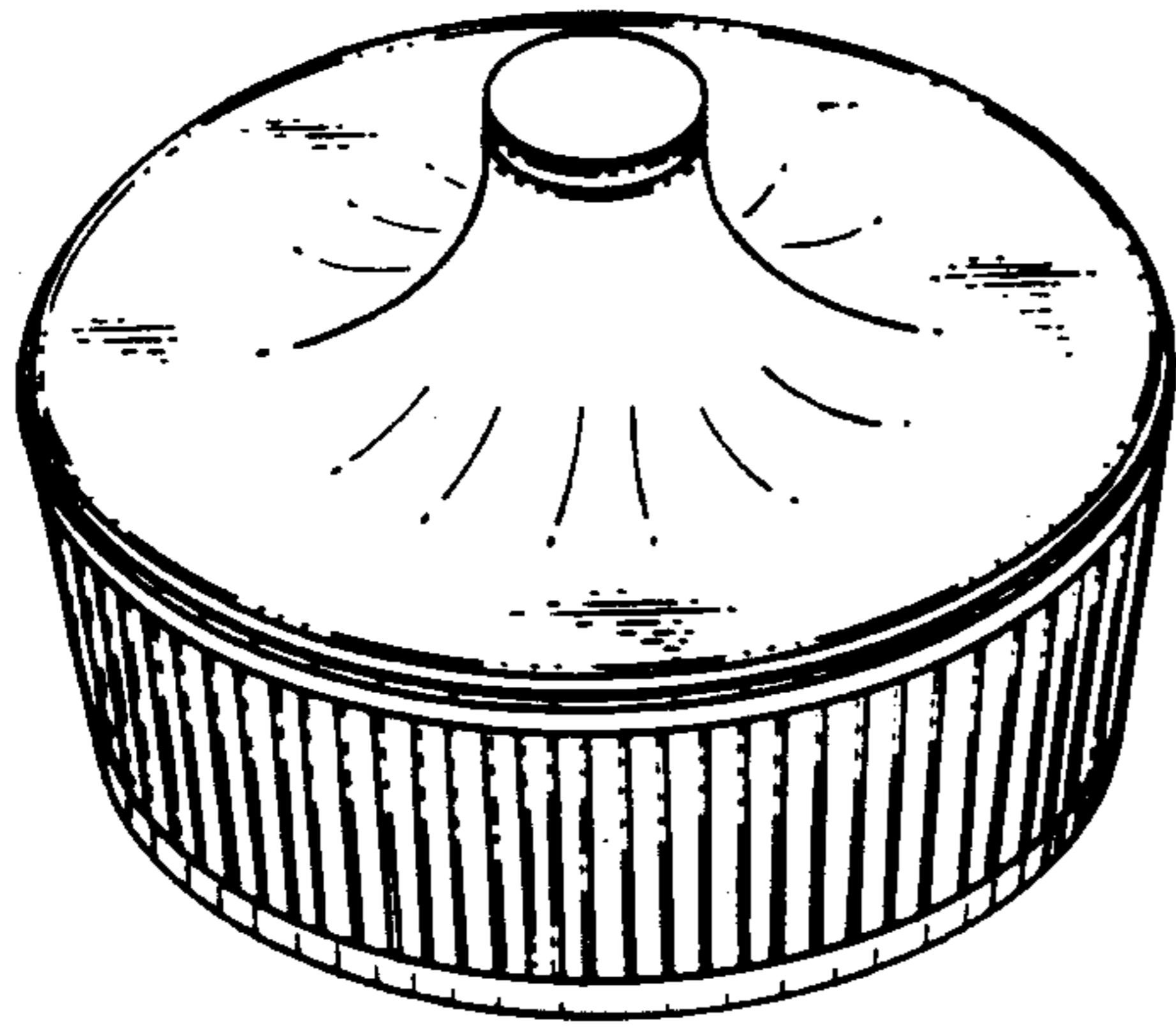

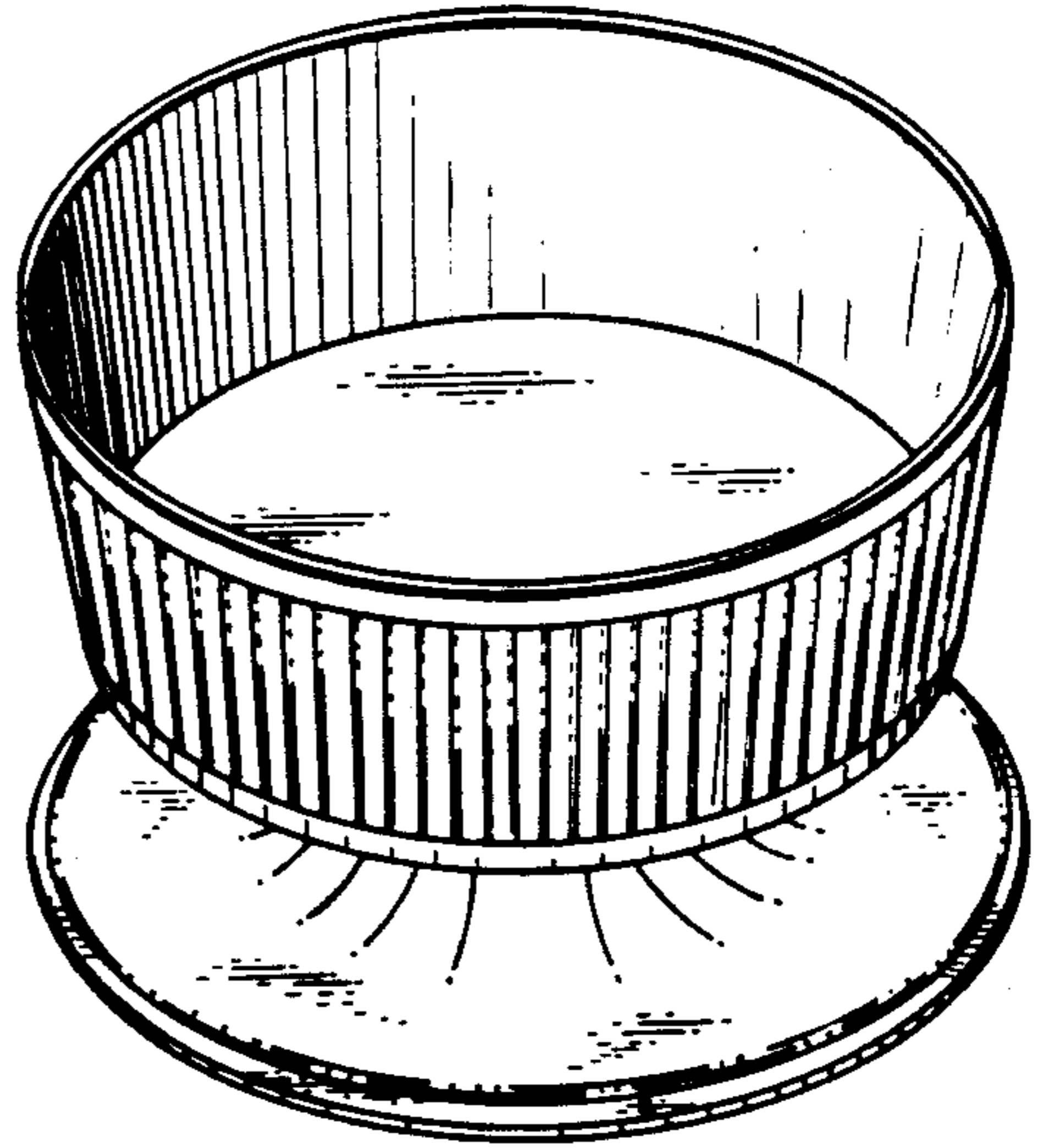

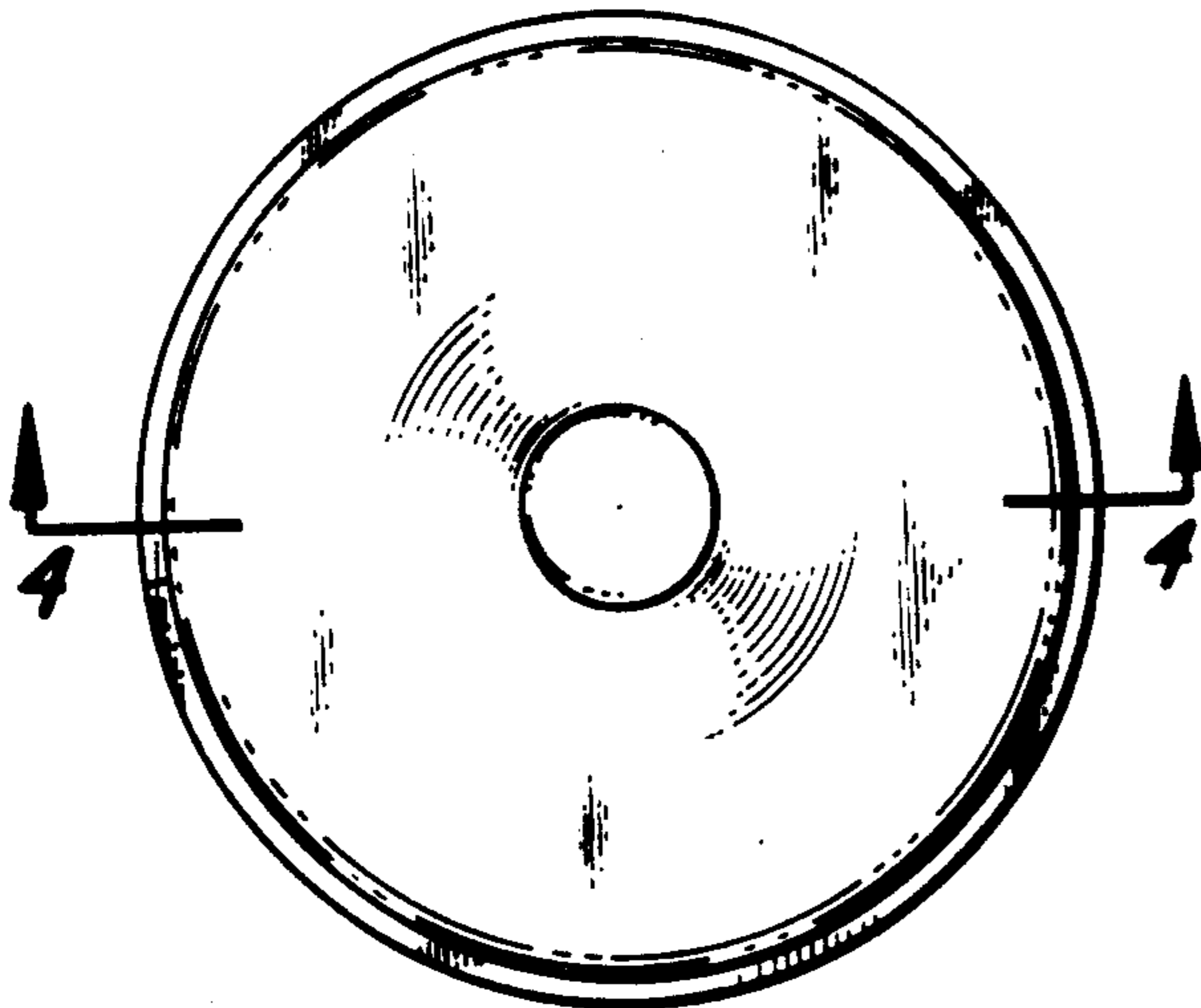

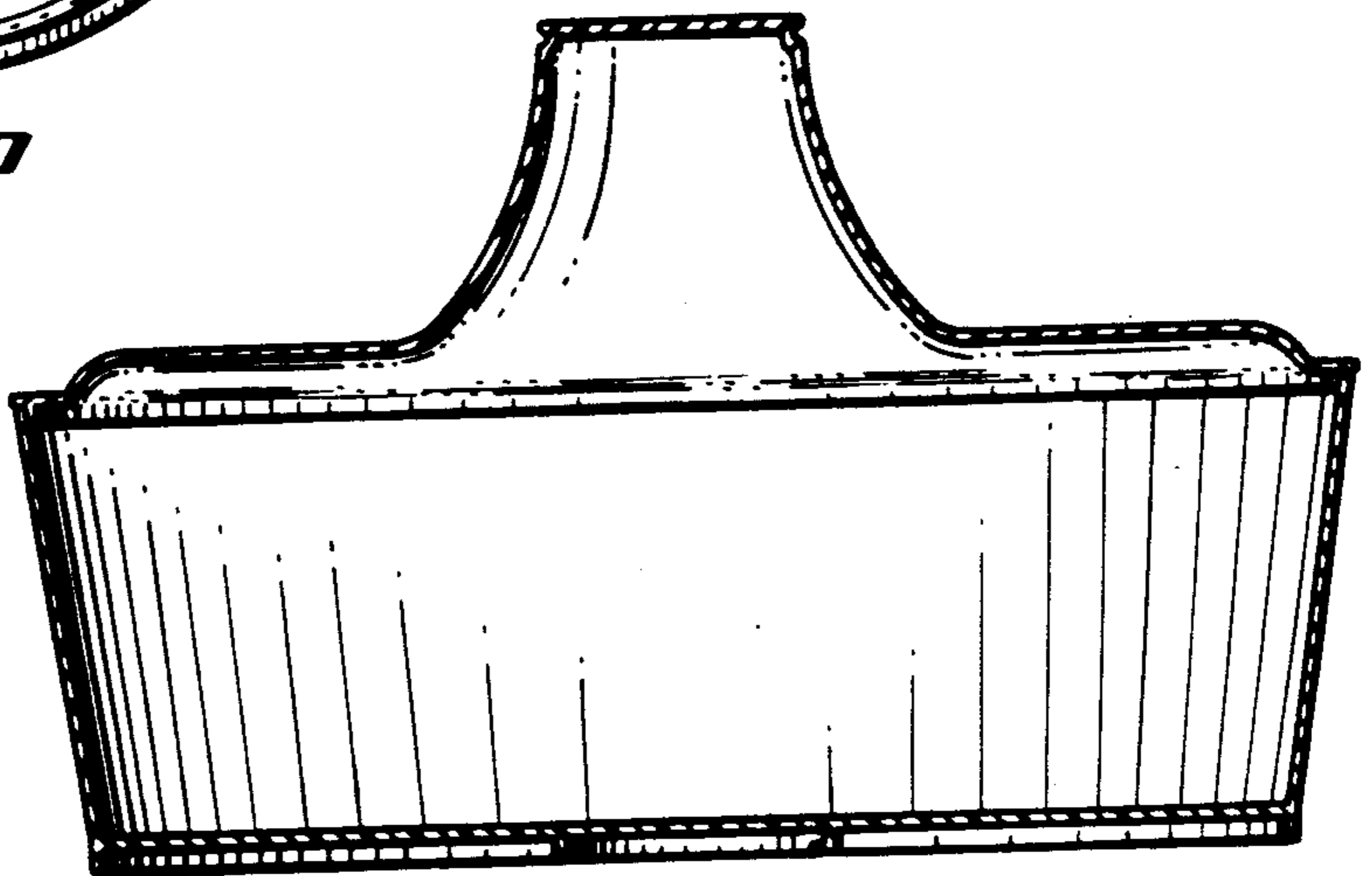
