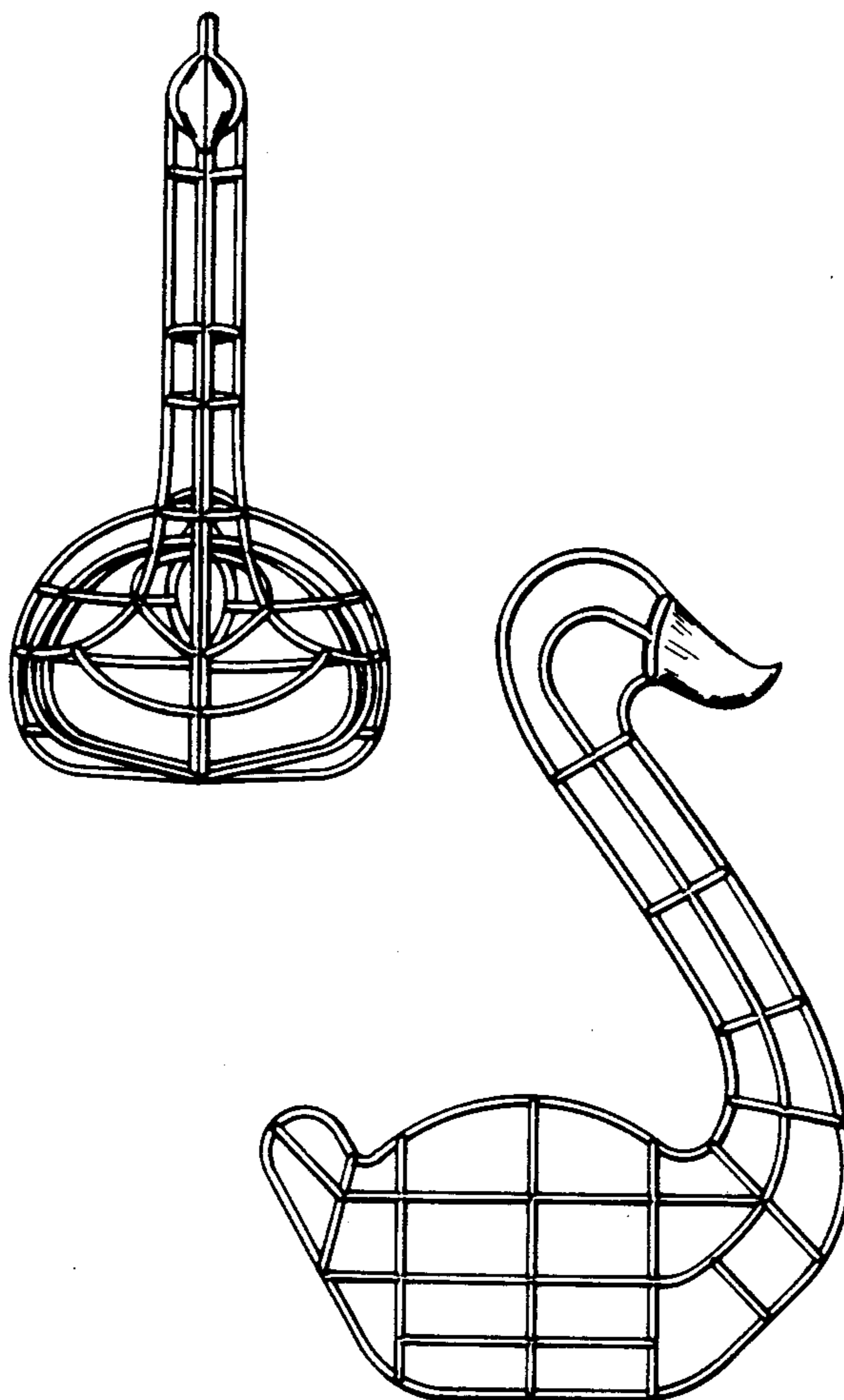

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a three dimensional topiary figure embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



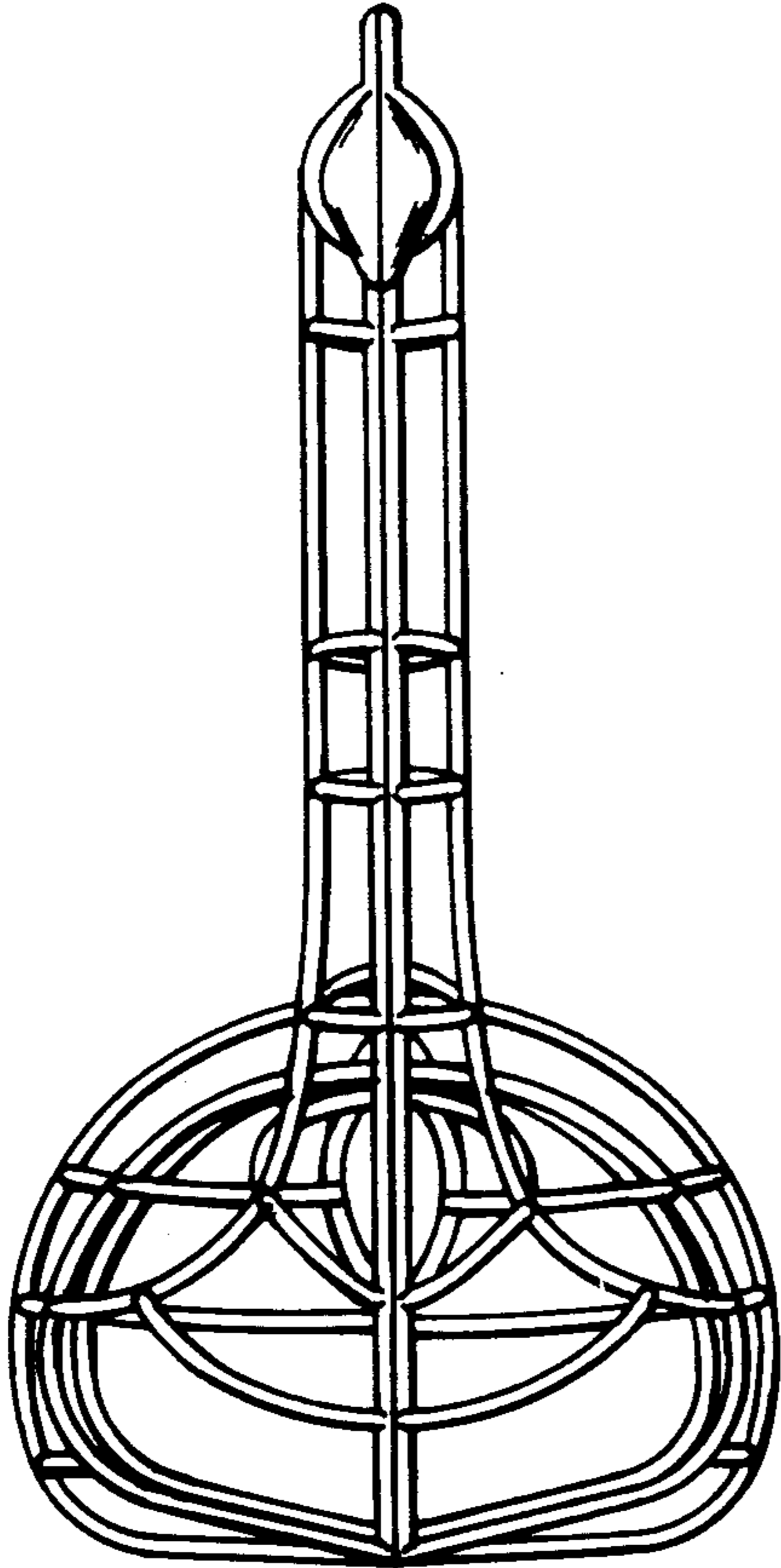

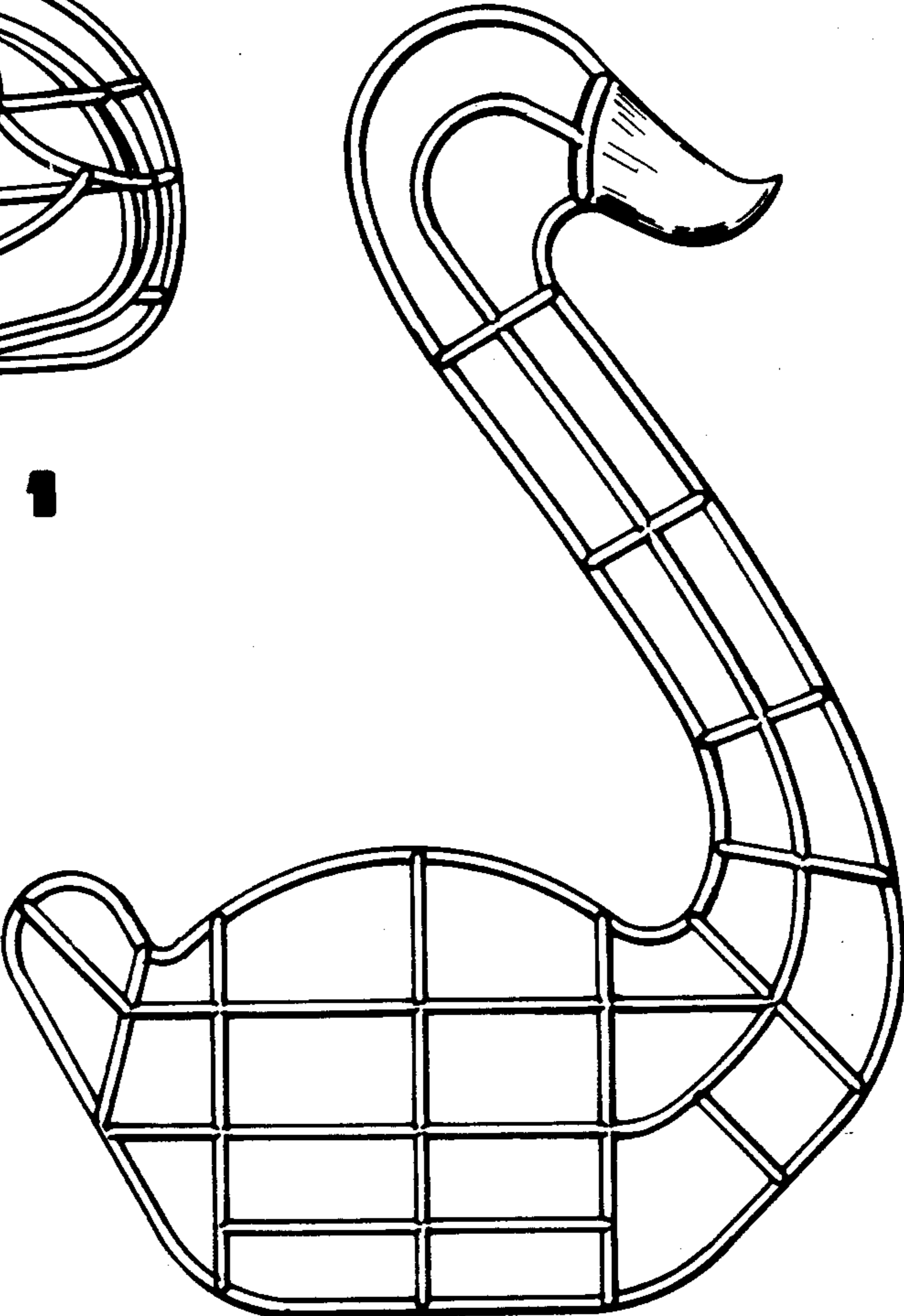

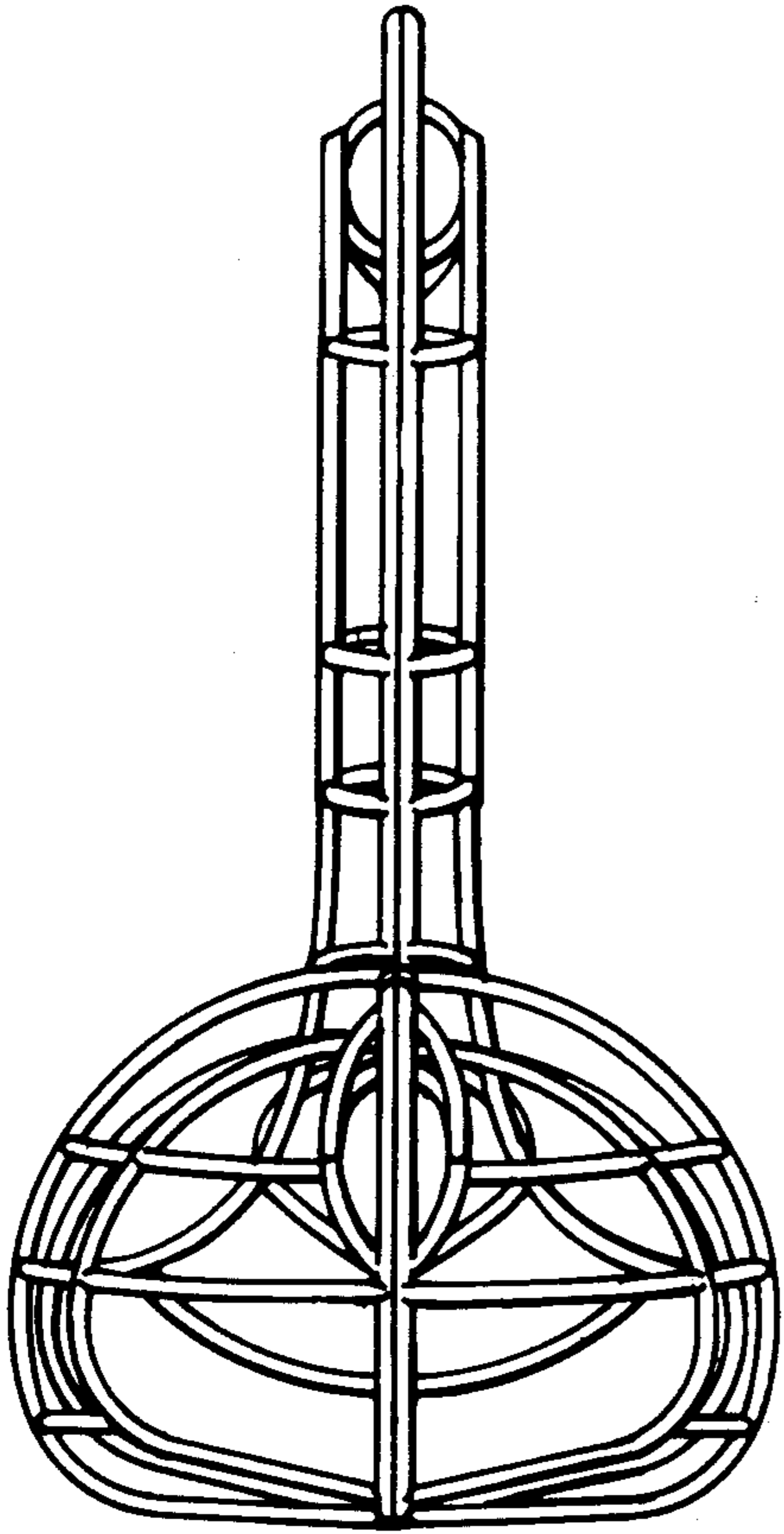

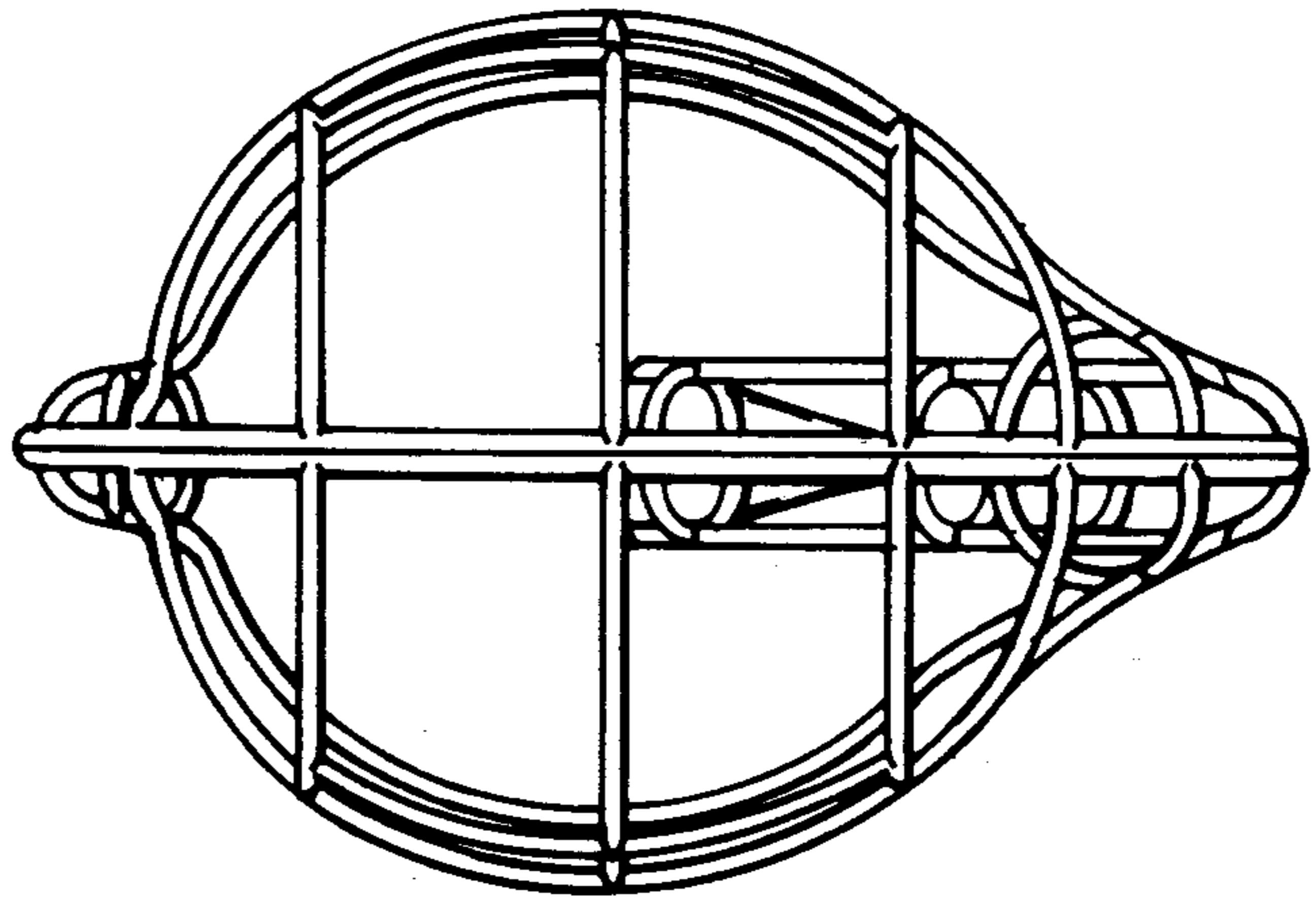

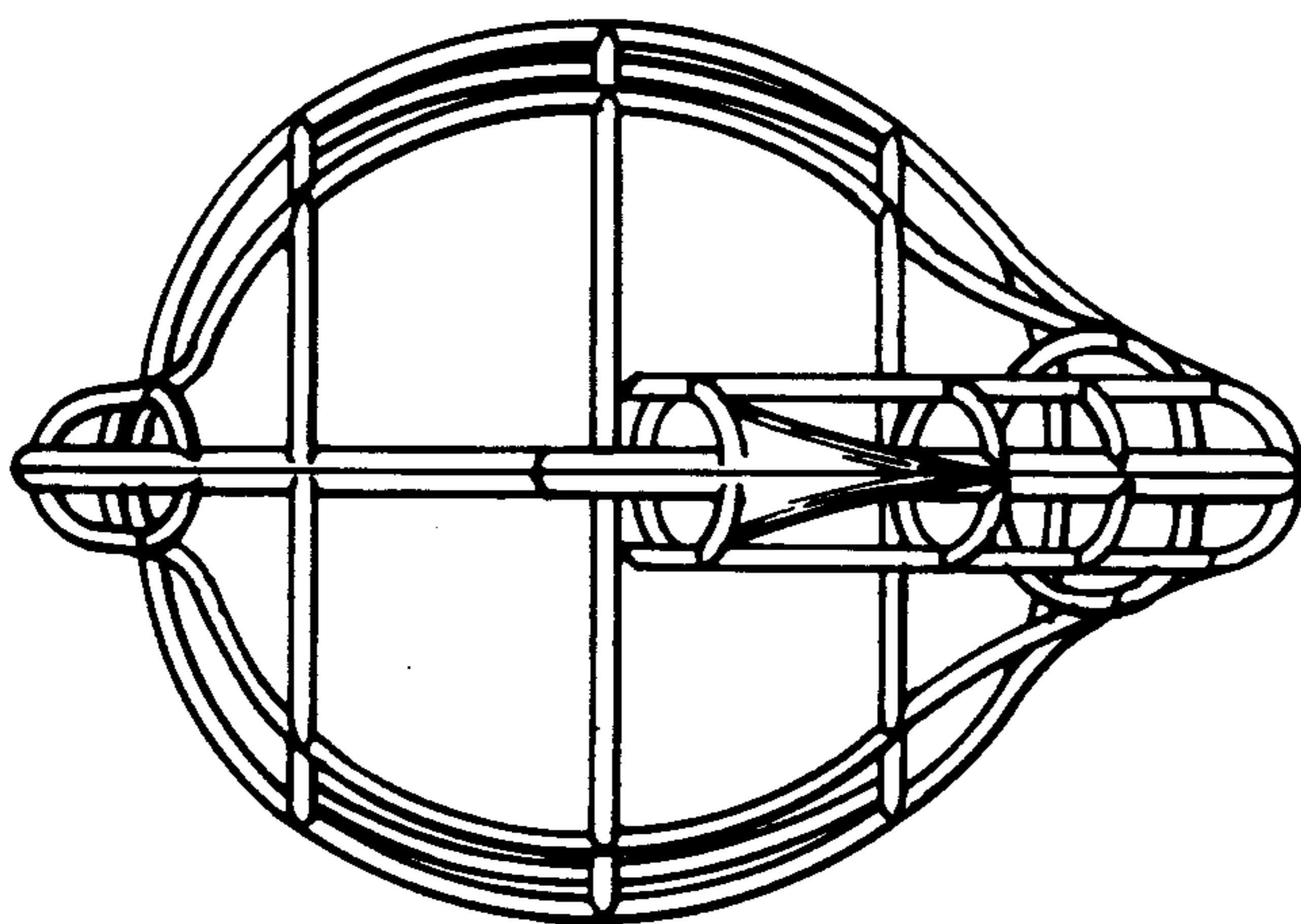
