CLAIM

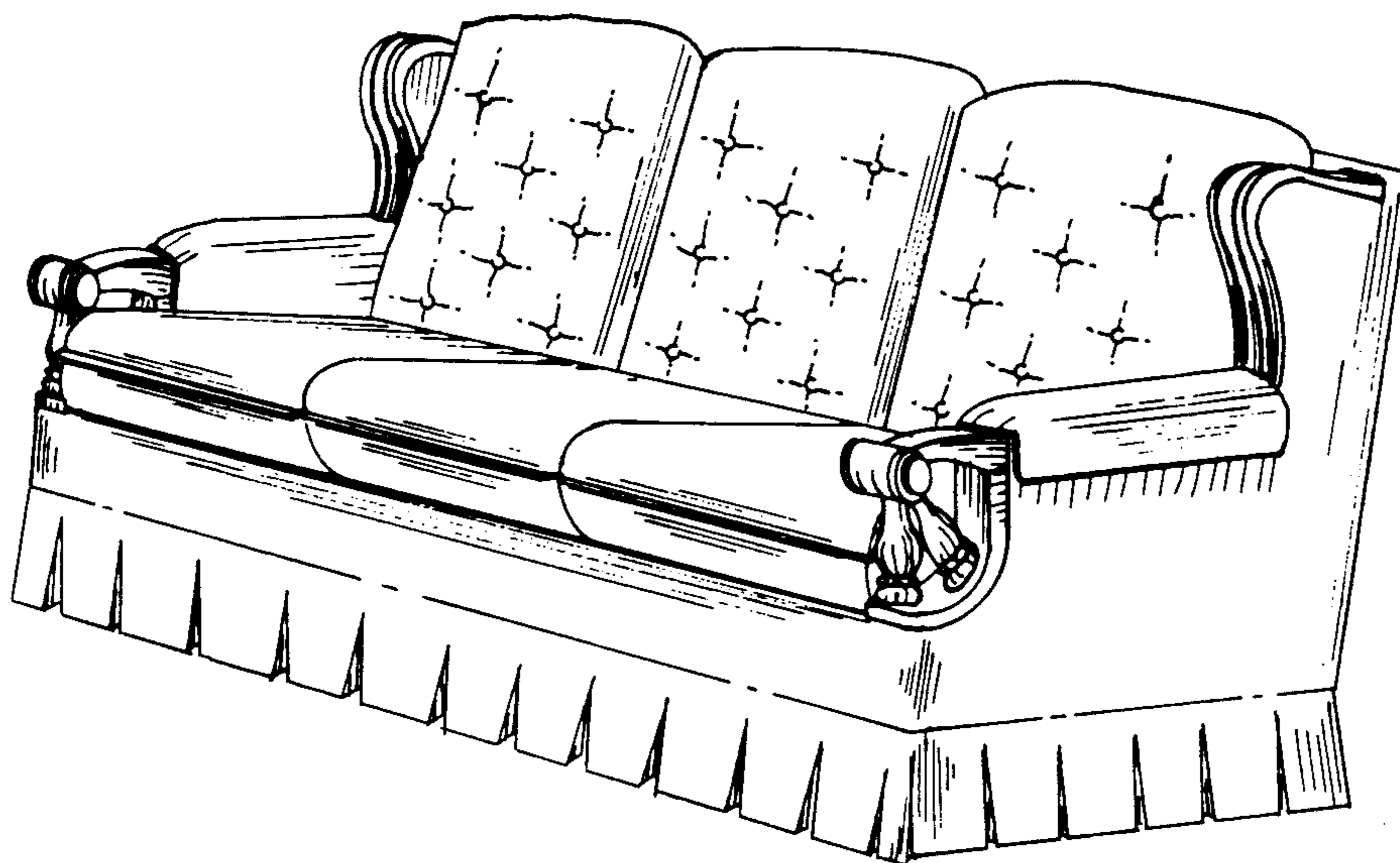
The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the instant design embodied in a sofa.

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the instant design embodied in a chair.

The seat is characterized by the particular spindle arrangement located at the forward edges of the arm rest members, all as best illustrated in FIG. 2.



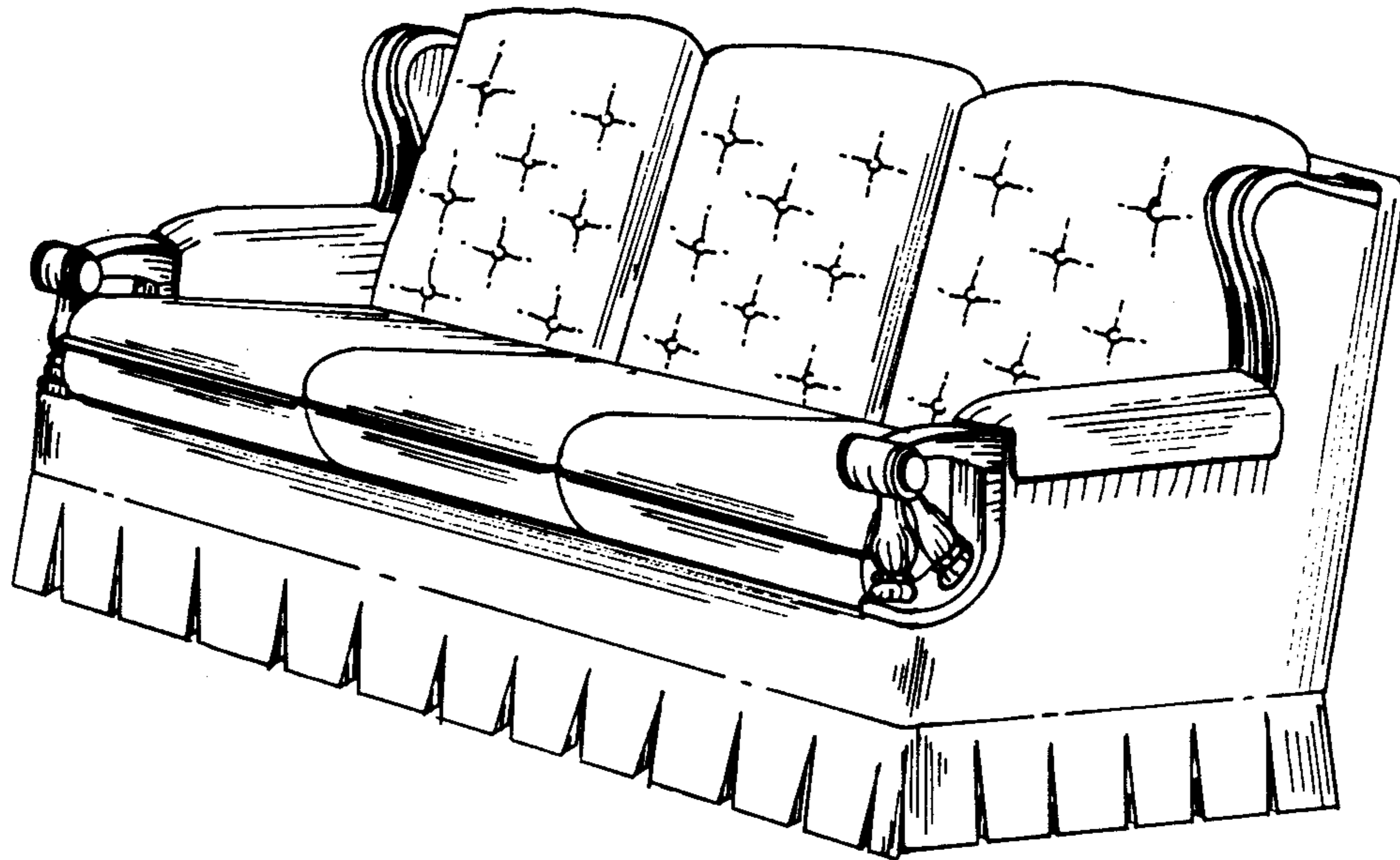

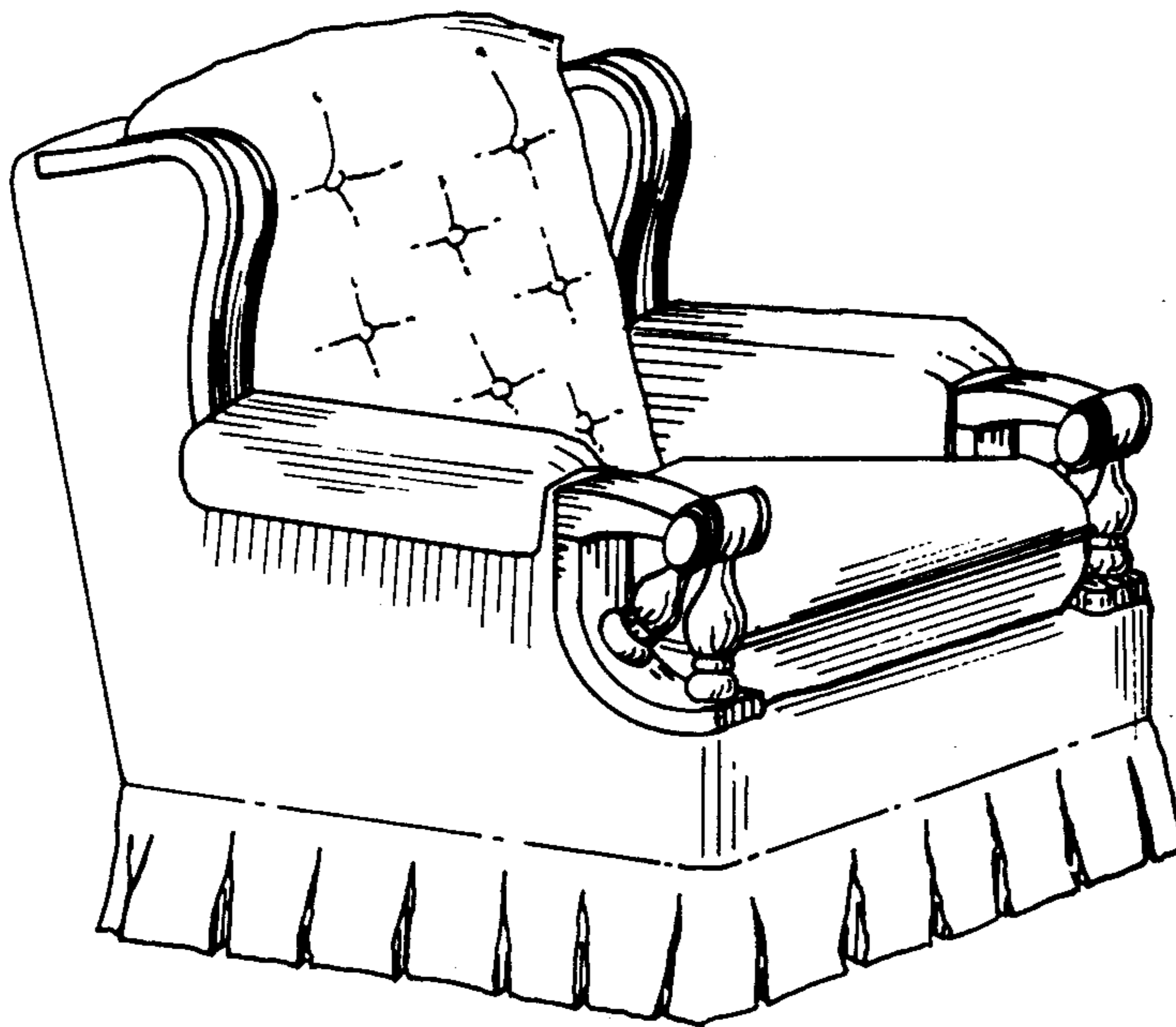
