DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of luggage showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The partial showing of shading indicating a textured surface is understood to be continuous throughout on the surfaces where shown.

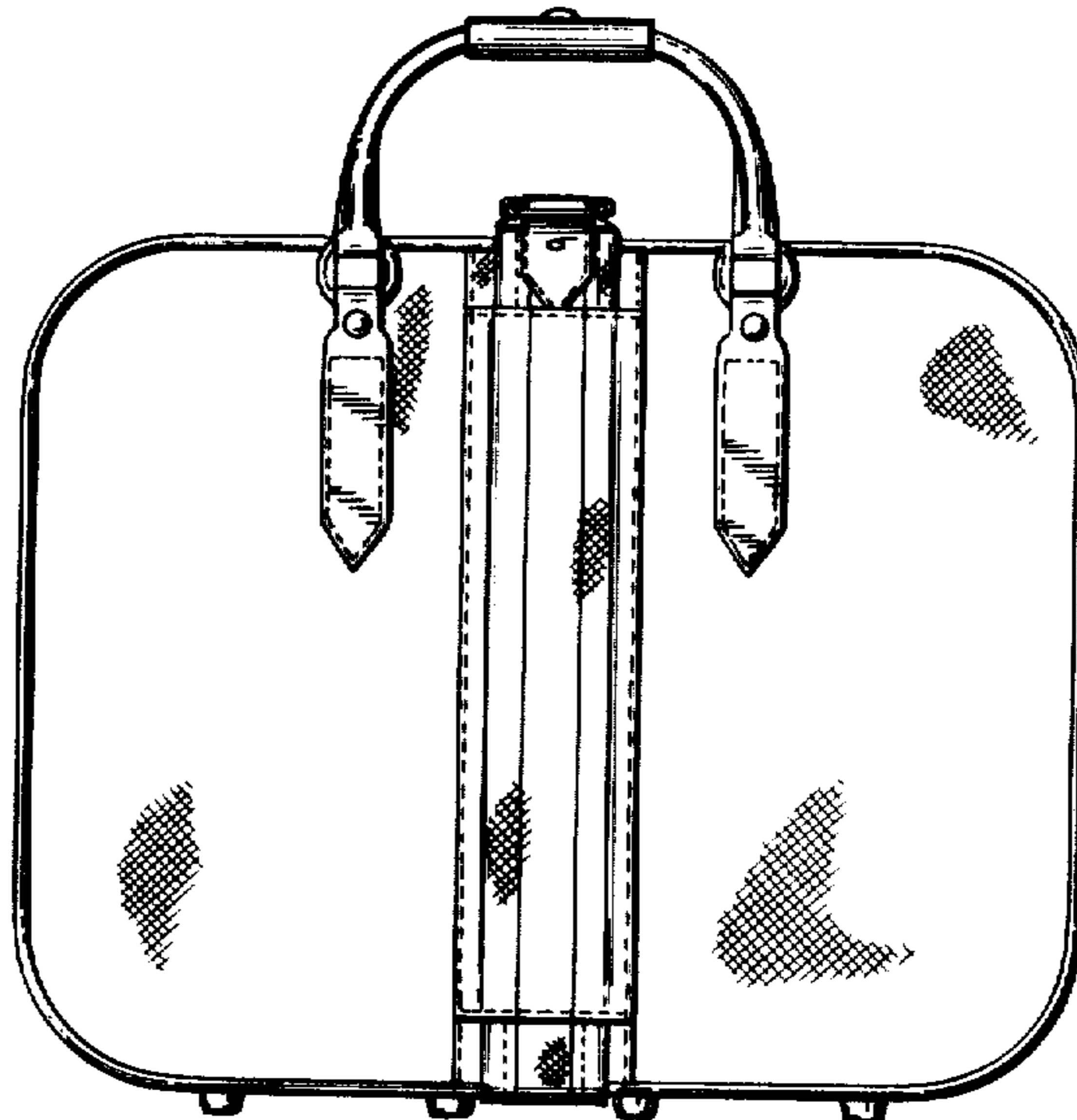
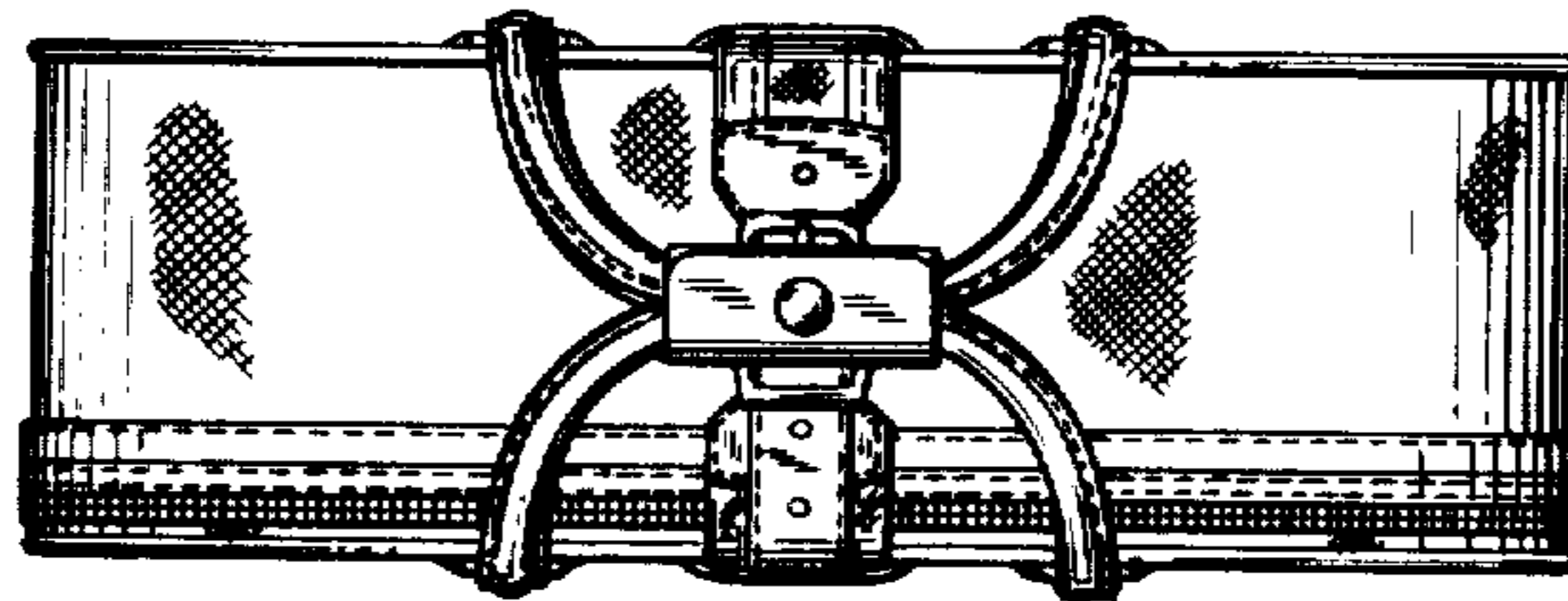

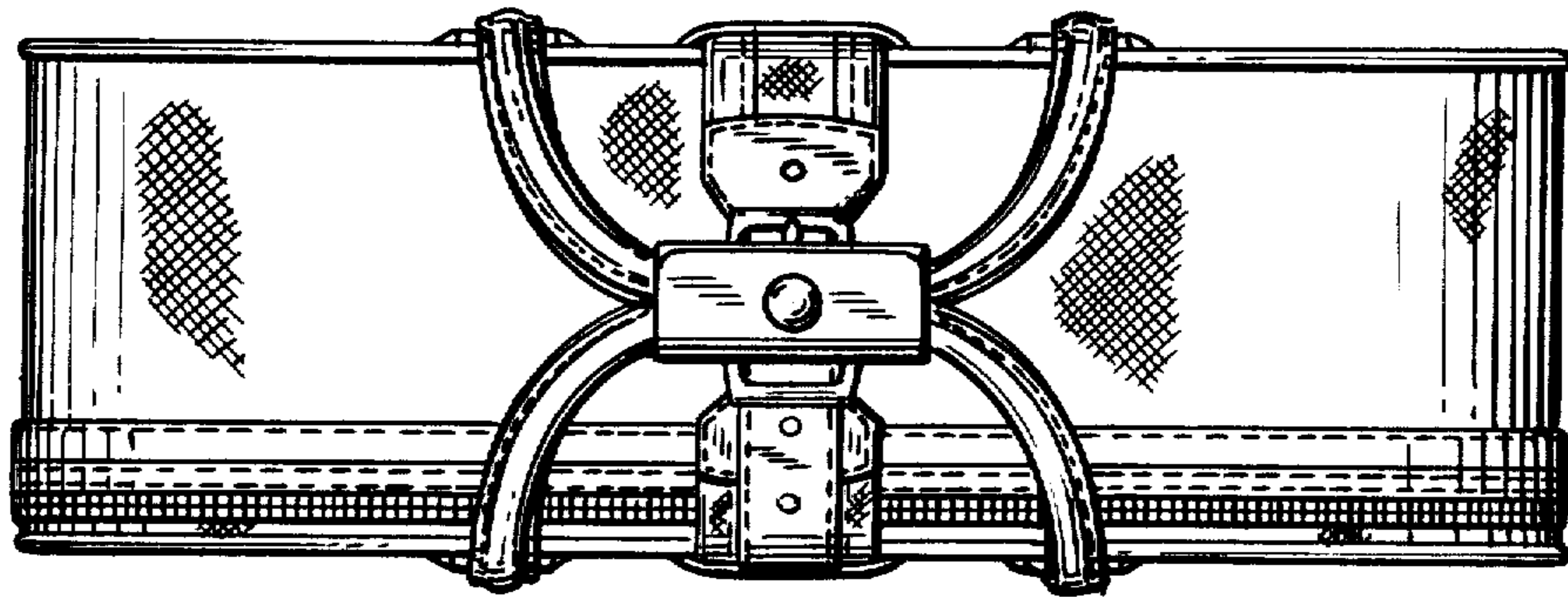

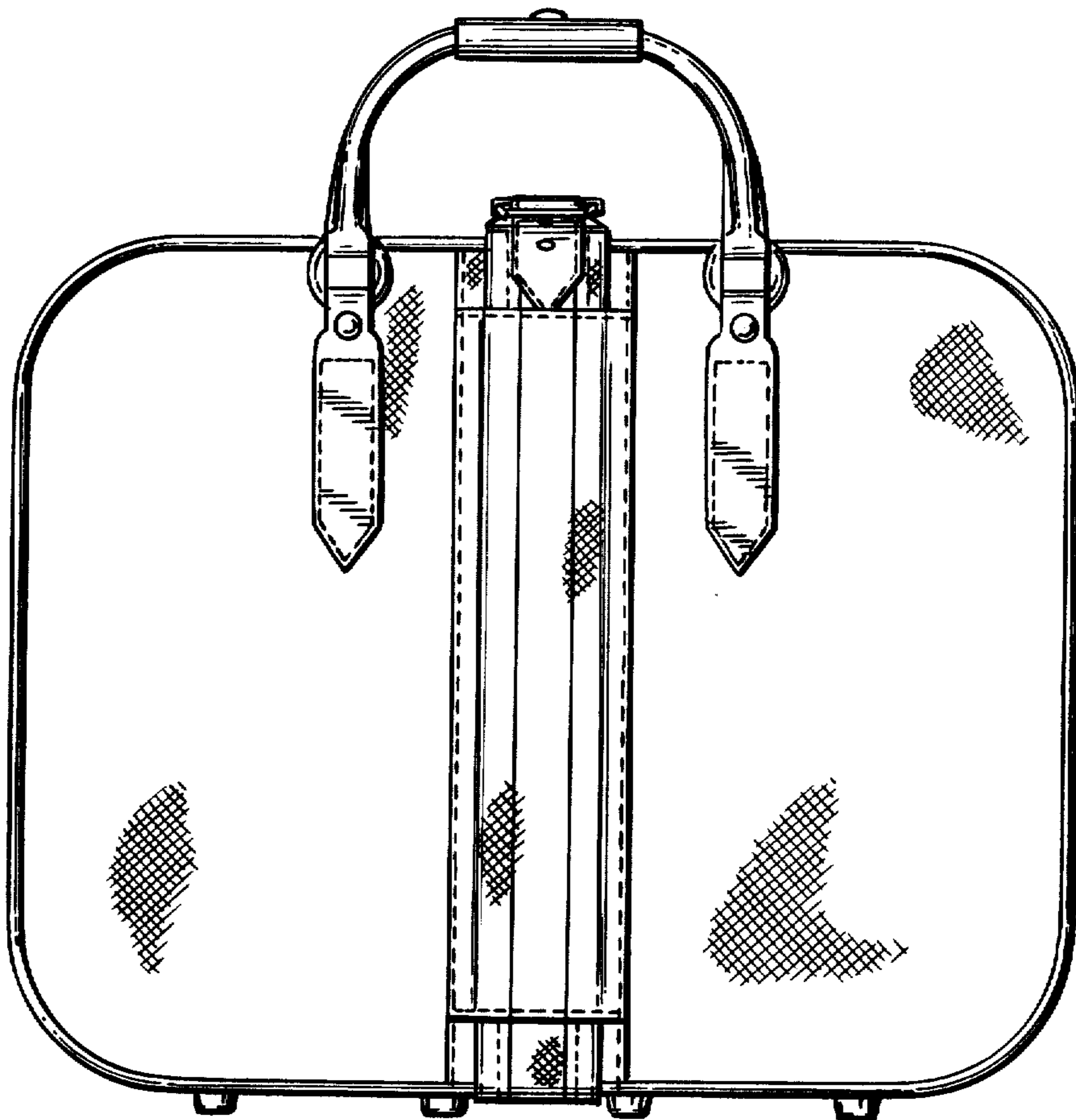

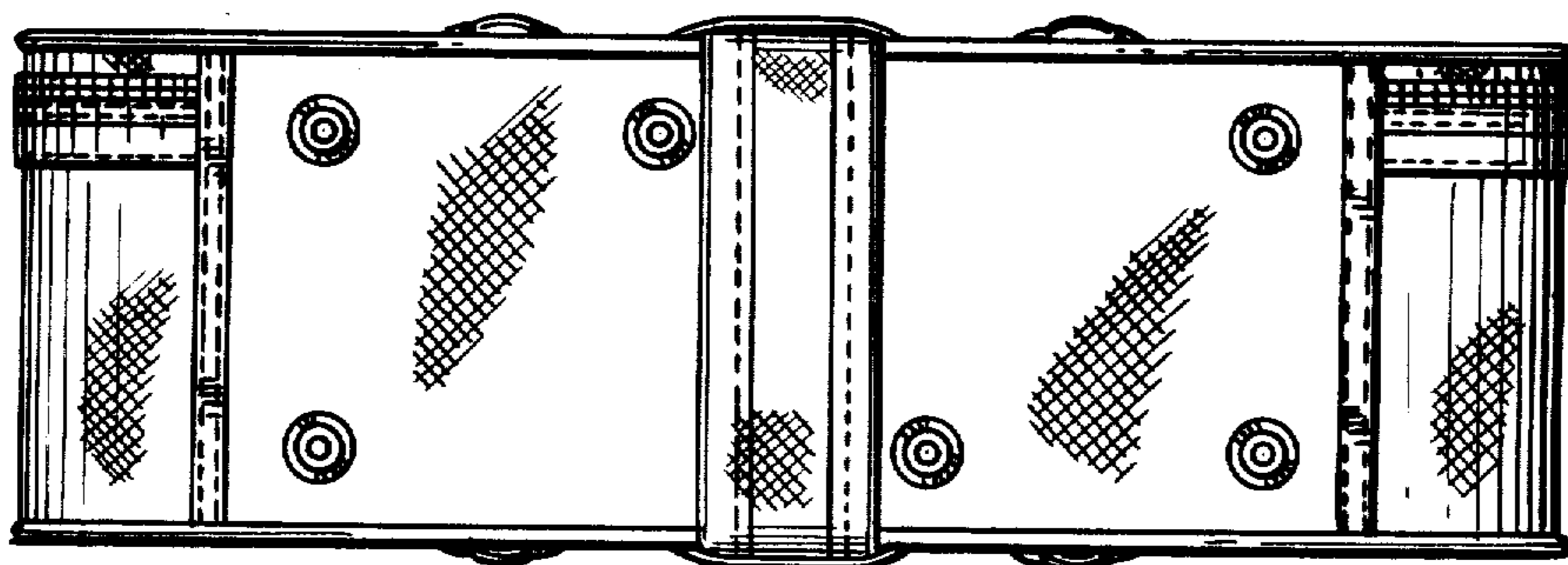

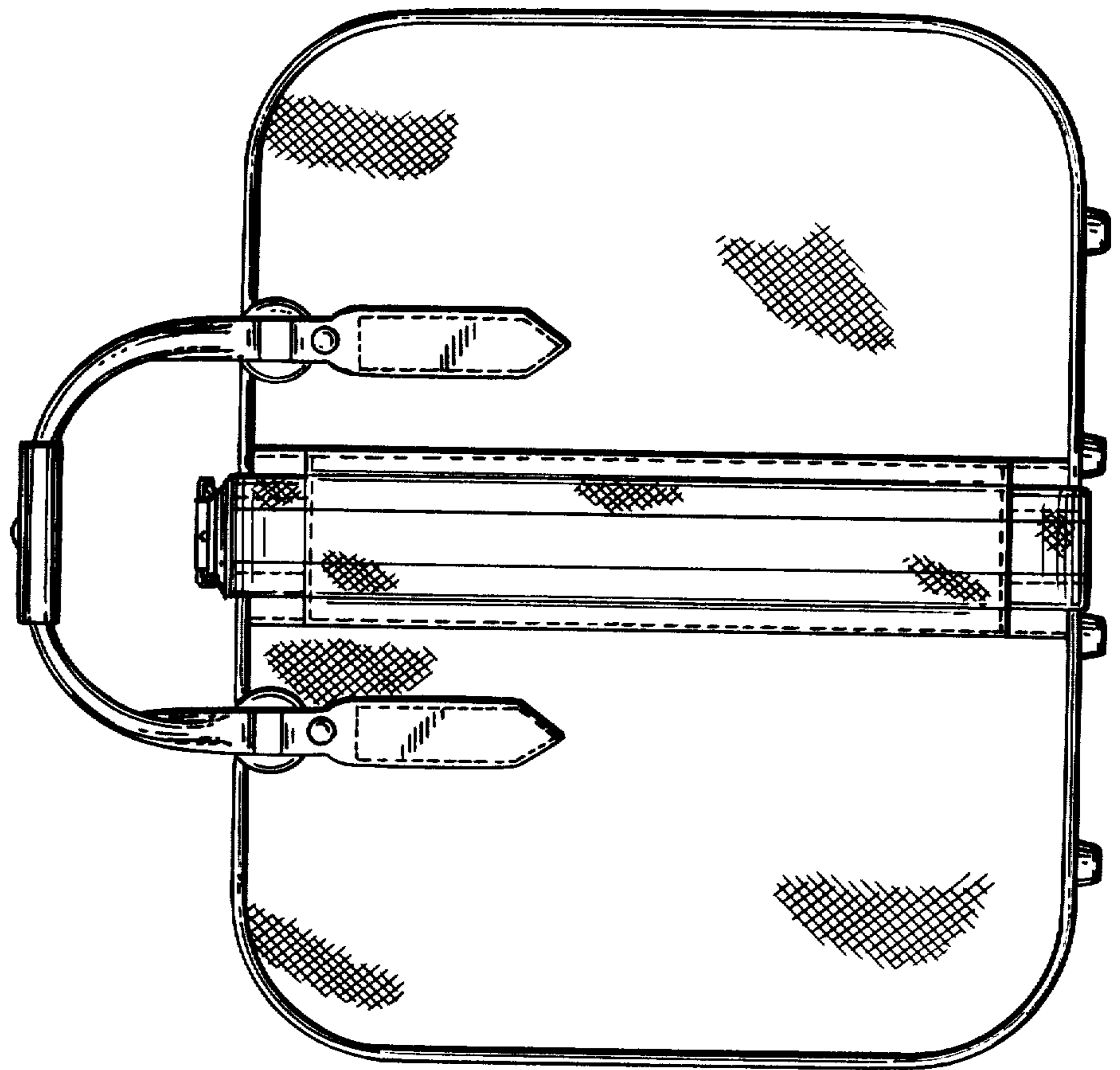
