The ornamental design for a segmental jewelry band, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a segmental jewelry band showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a segmental jewelry band showing an alternate embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of a segmental jewelry band showing another alternate embodiment of my new design; and

FIG. 4 is a transverse sectional elevational view taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 3 and typical of all embodiments.

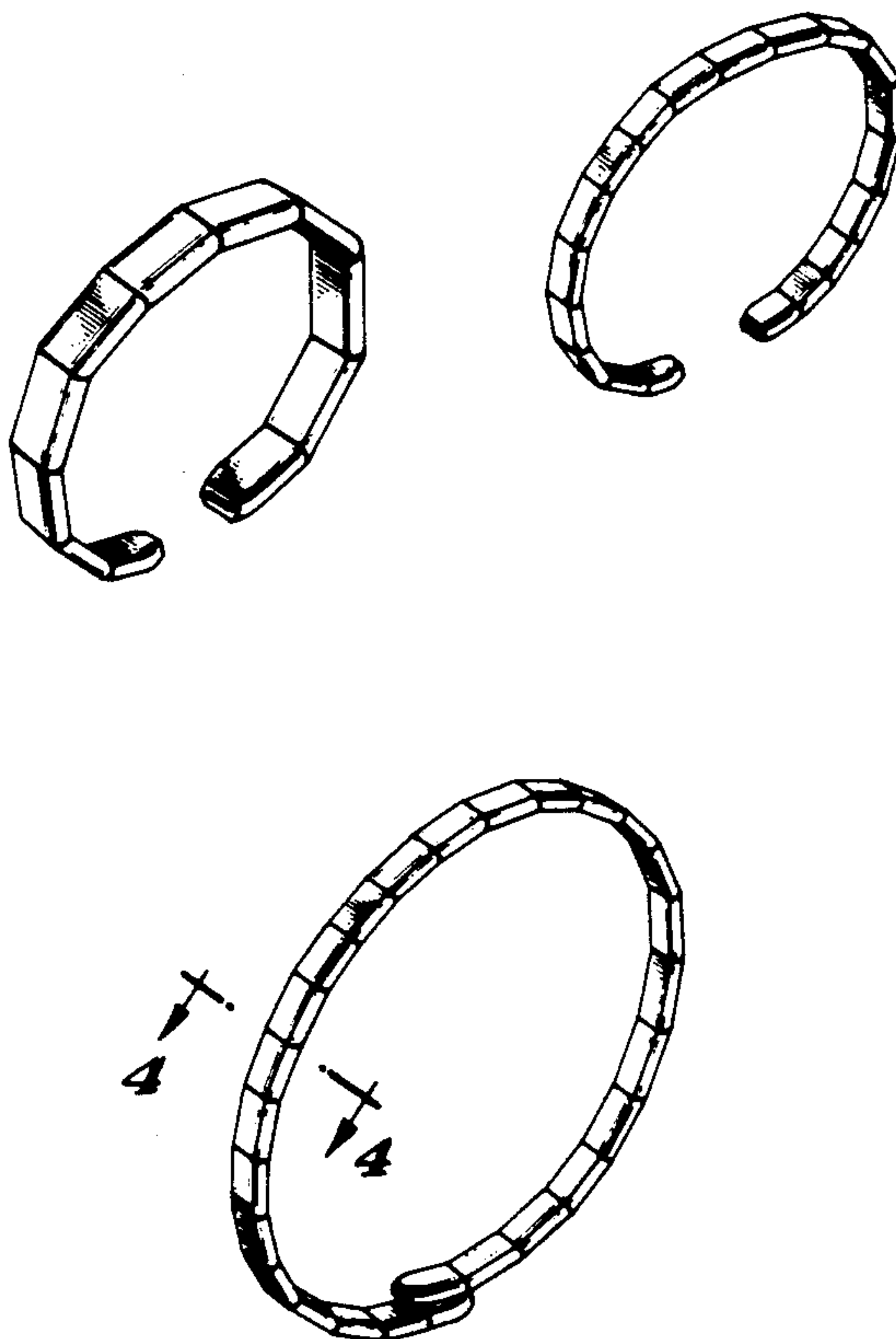

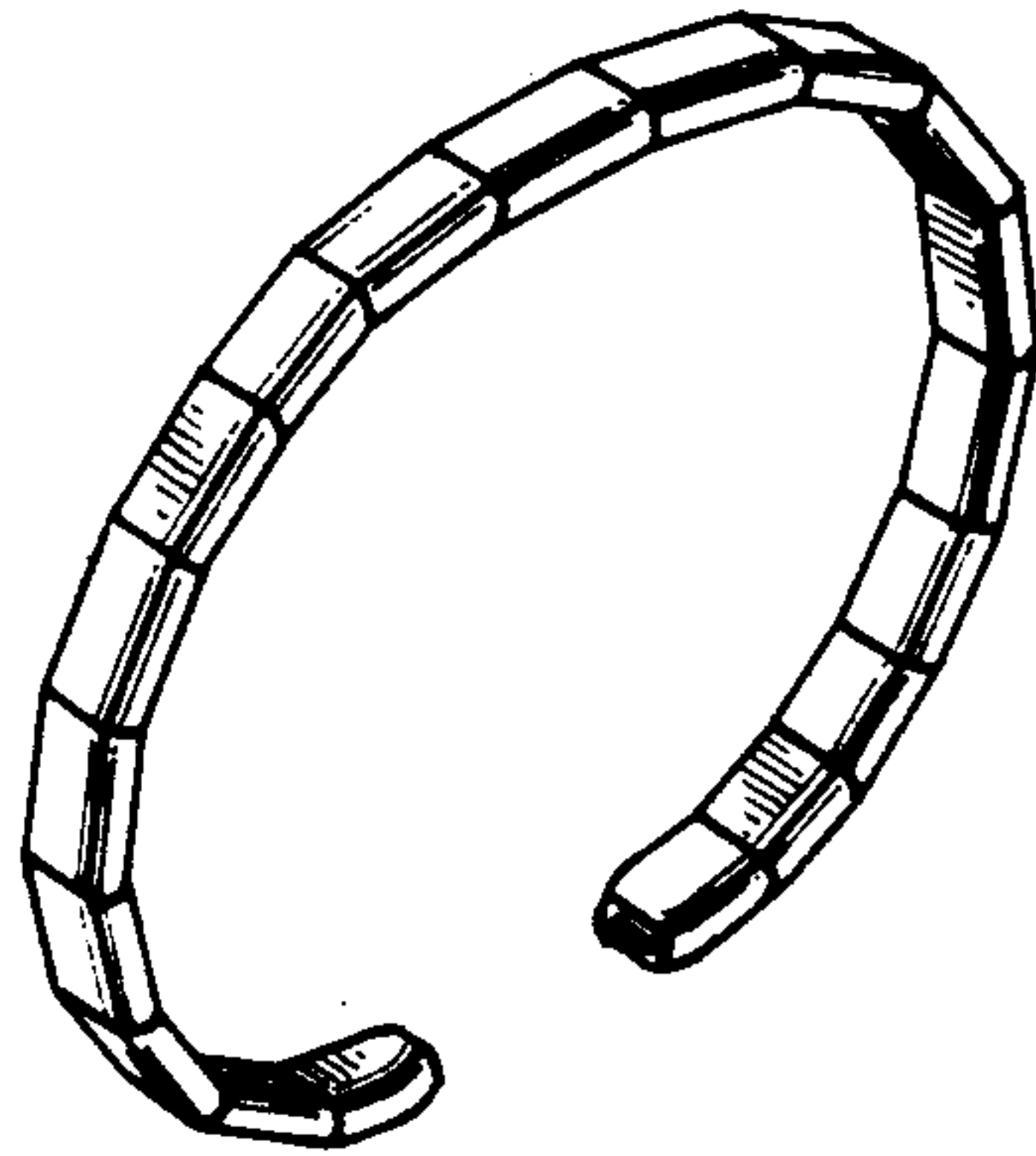

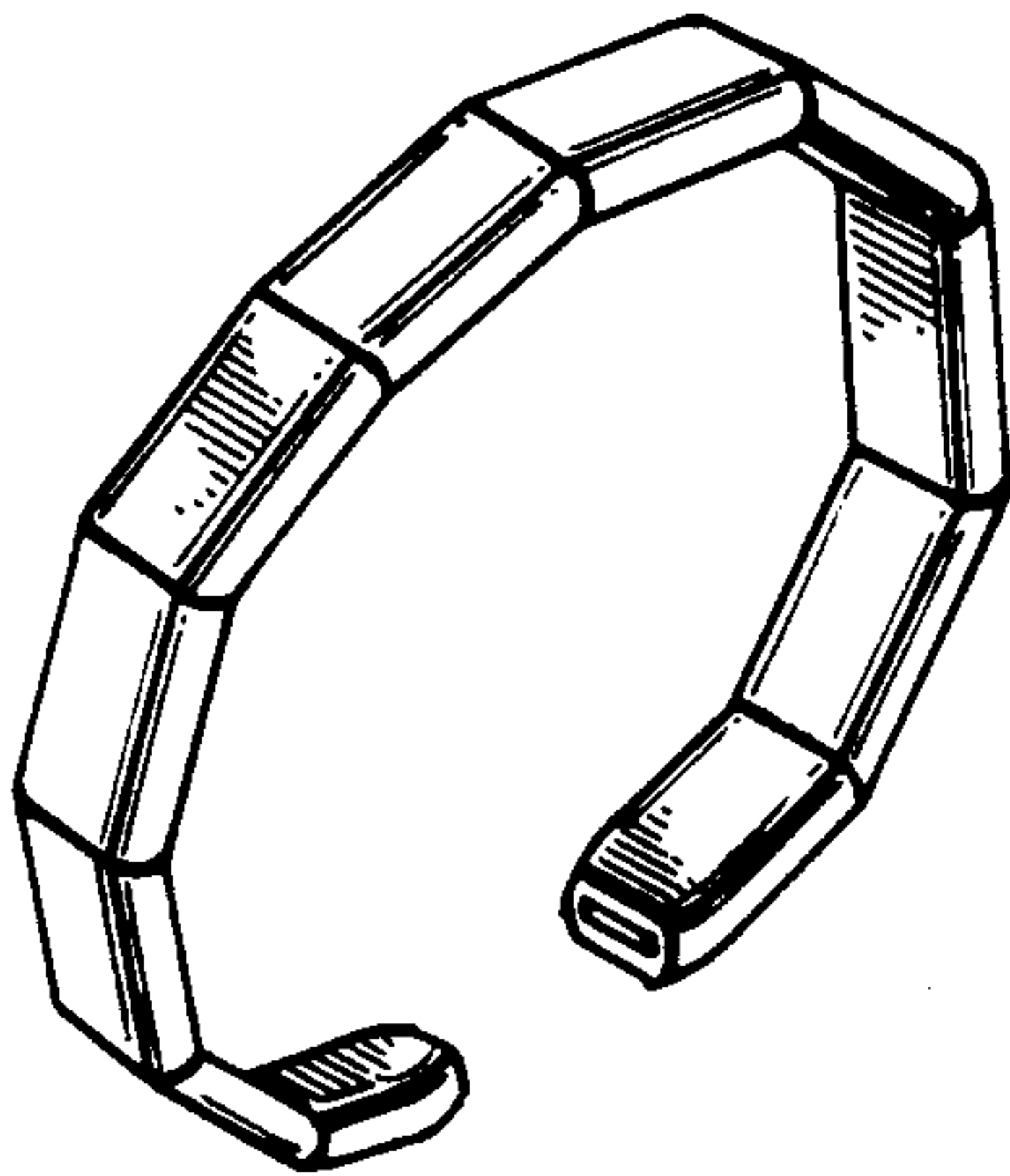
