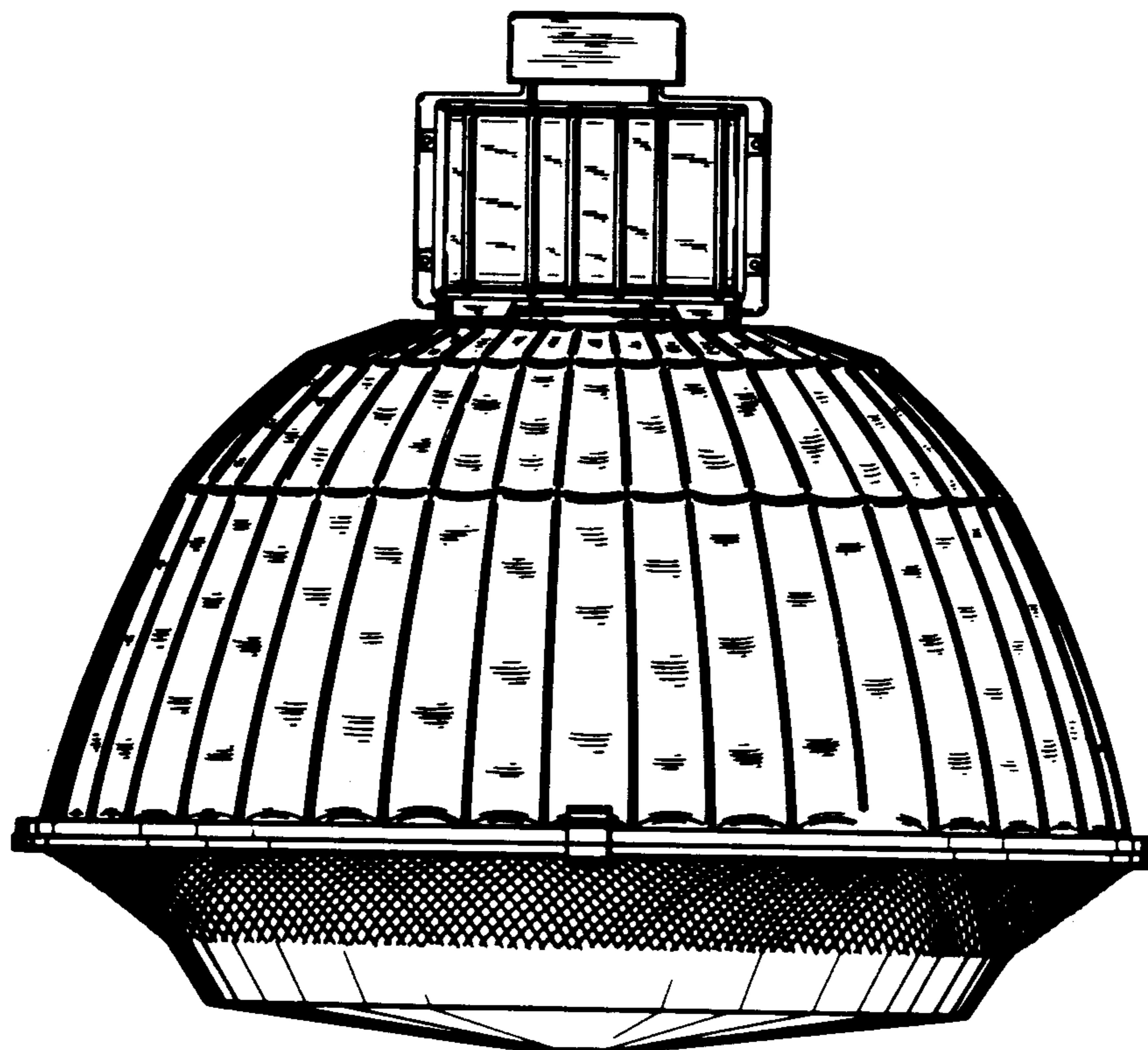
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the luminaire of FIG. 1;

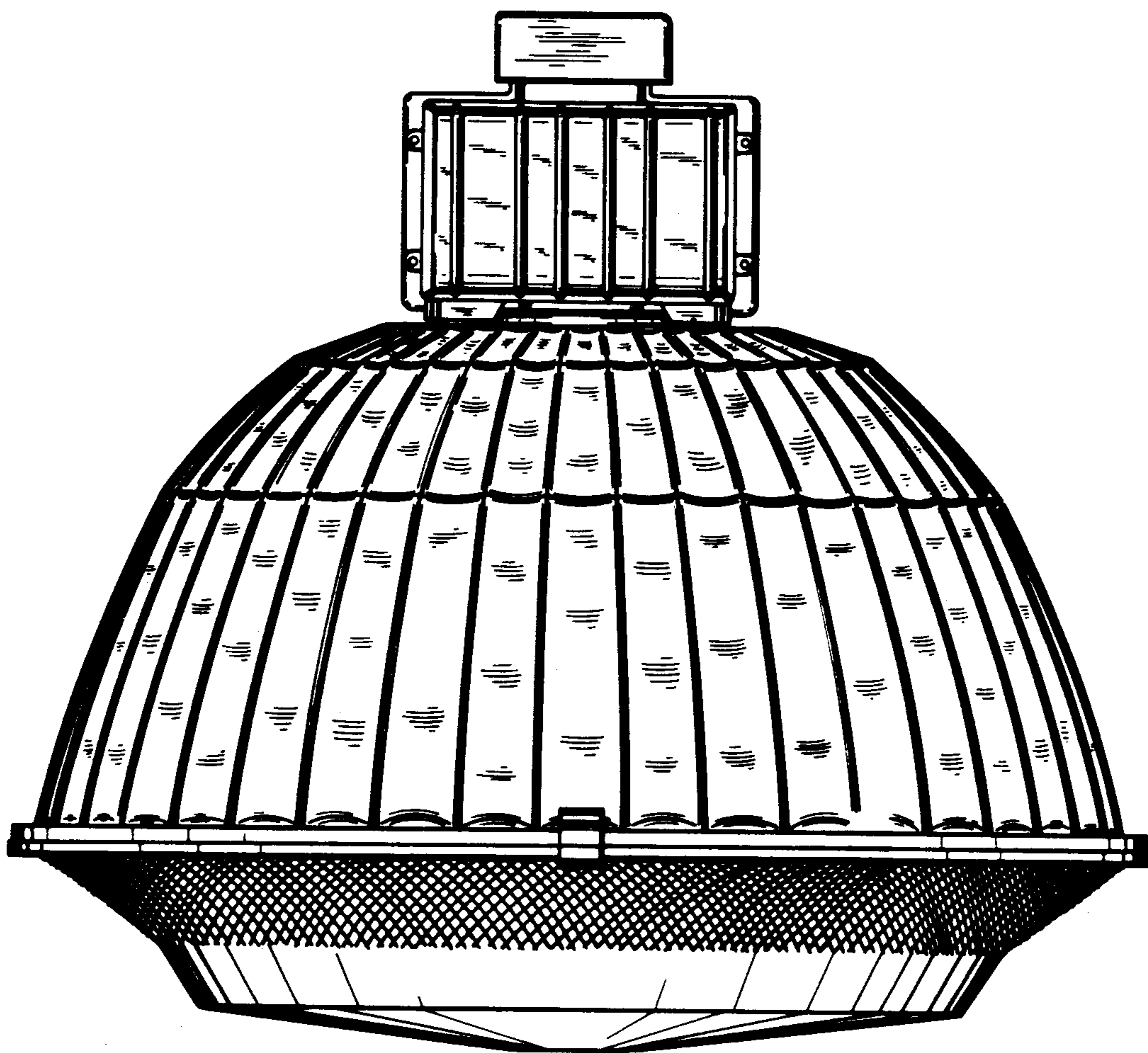
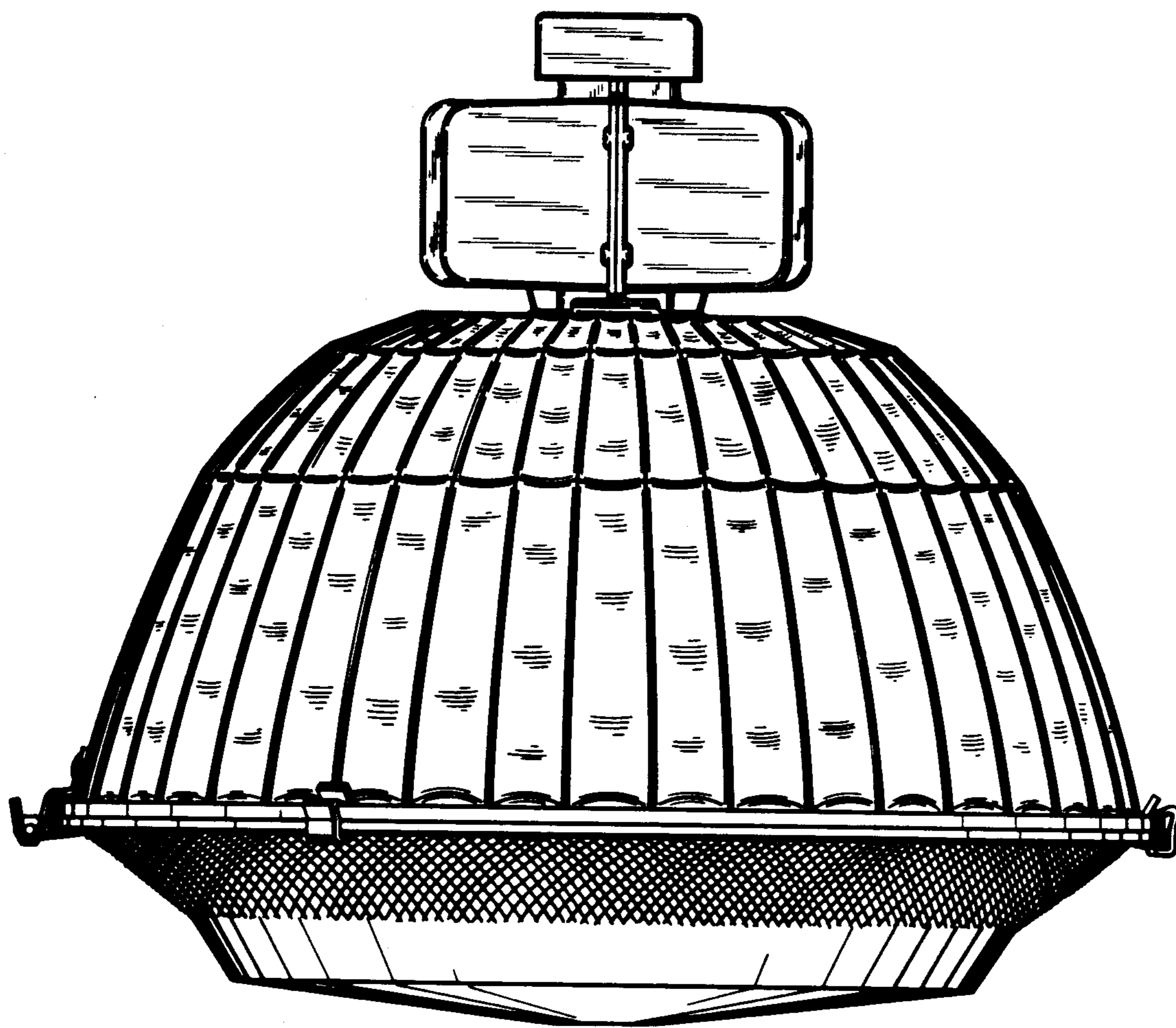

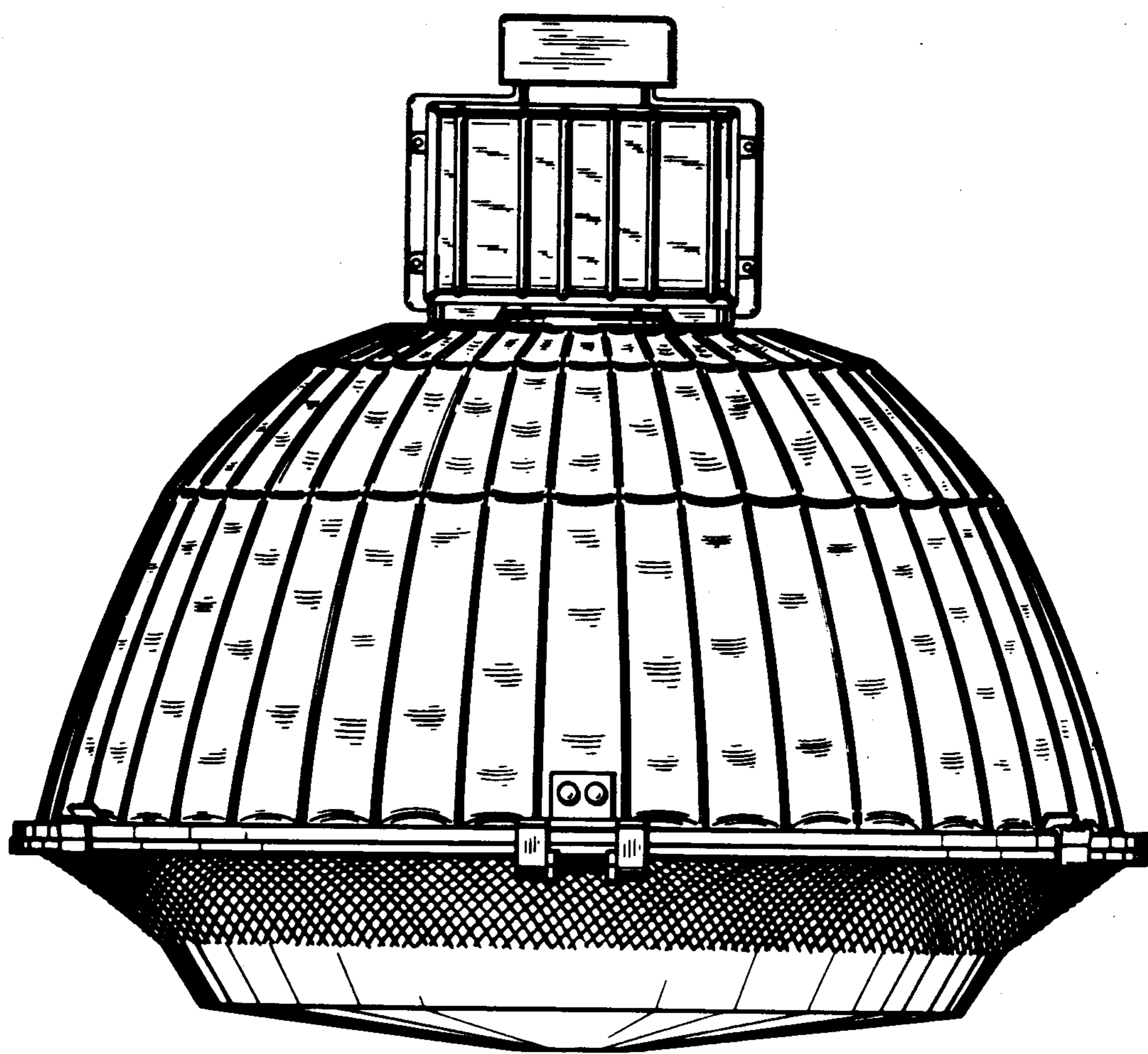
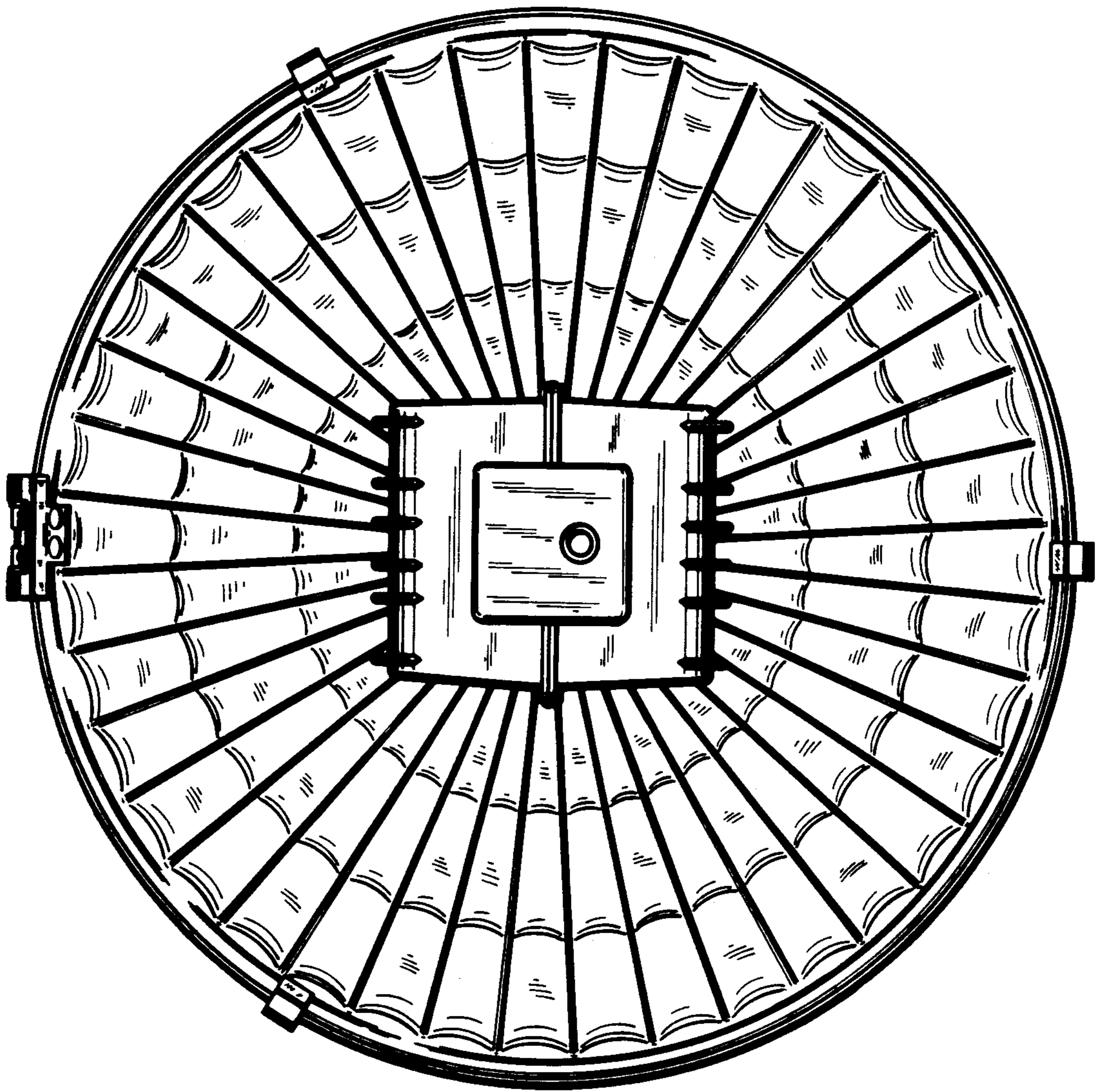

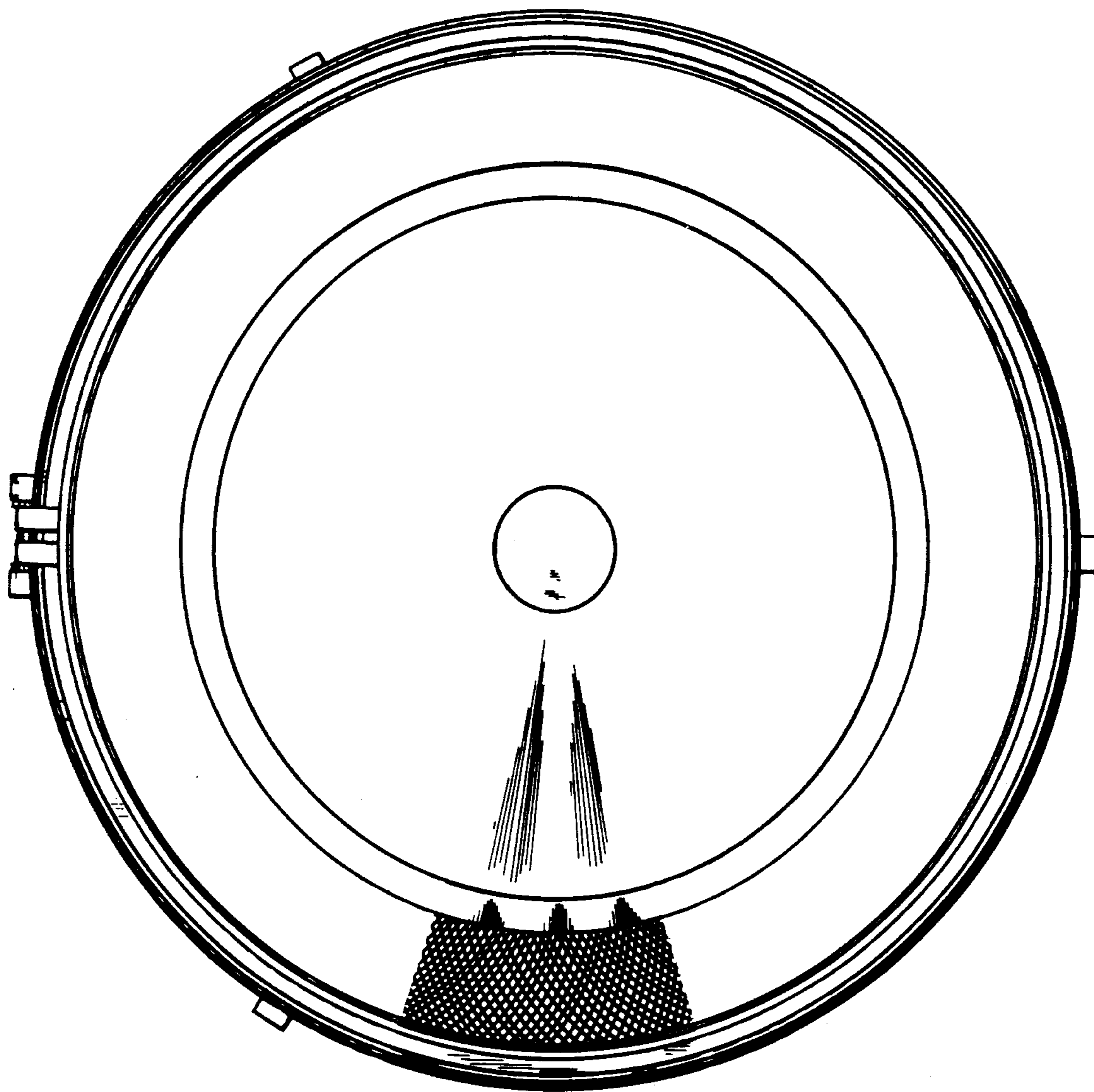
